NARRATIVE SUMMARY
1st Bn, 1st Mar

1. Late Entries

- a. At 042035H a Company D squad patrol (BT 102655) received 150 rounds S/A fire from approximately 12 VC in a horseshoe type ambush. Squad returned 240 rounds small arms, 100 rounds M-60, 25 rounds M-79, 1 LAW and 2 M-26 grenades. VC broke contact immediately. Marines sustained 2 KIA's and 1 WIA (slight). One M-14 rifle belonging to a KIA is missing. A reinforced squad searched area at night and again at first light. The rifle was not located and no contact was made with VC. Medical evacuation was completed 050631H.

2. Contact

- a. At 050605H a LVT providing blocking force at (BT 155590) for Co A County Fair operation sighted three VCS in a boat leaving Island at BT 151596. LVT fired warning shots boat disregarded. LVT fired and received fire from boat. Boat later returned with two female VCS. VCS were taken to PF blocking force at (BT 159594).
- b. At 050715H a LVT from Co A, 1st Amtrac Bn providing blocking force for Co A, County Fair operation, at (BT 156592) observed one VN male in a boat at BT 151596 leaving Island fired warning. Boat disregarded boat was sunk and VCS was observed limping ashore, towards PF blocking force.
- c. At 051000H a platoon sweep from Co D (BT 054642) received 15 rounds harassing S/A fire from estimated 2 VC (BT 053642), wounding one Vietnamese Cadre. The sweep returned fire with 20 rounds S/A and 2 rounds 3.5" WP. Search of area made without contact. Medical evacuation not requested.
- d. At 051050H a Plt from Co D (BT 054642) detonated a booby trap while clearing area to blow a dud in place. Med Evac called for one WIA. Med Evac received fire from estimated 10 VC (BT 054644). Gunship returned fire while Plt fired 250 rounds S/A and 10 M-79 rounds and deployed two squads to sweep area.
- e. At 051310H a Plt from Co D (BT 057655) received estimated 250 rounds S/A fire from 6010 VC (BT 045657) and (BT 050655). Plt returned 1000 rounds S/A, 5 LAW, 24 M-79 rounds. Artillery mission called, 28 rounds 105 fired. Area now being swept.
- f. At 051445H a sqd patrol from Co D on clearing mission at BT 099640 sighted 6 VC at BT 098640 who failed to halt when ordered by Marines. Marines opened fire with 225 rounds S/A and 7 rounds M-79. Swept area apprehended 2 VC and found 4 VC KIA.

SITREP FOR PERIOD 042400H TO 052400H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries. At 041930H, a combined FMC/RF patrol, vicinity AT 971666, observed two VC in the process of putting in a booby trap approximately 300 meters from the trail, vicinity AT 973666. The RF's opened fire on the VC immediately and the VC fled; one northeast, the other west. The entire patrol pursued physically and found a blood pool near the area of first sighting. The patrol recovered one M-26 grenade and a spool of trip wire. The VC could not be trailed beyond this point, a search of the surrounding area revealed nothing. No friendly casualties, one VC WIA.
2. Contacts. At 051500H, a patrol from Company K, vicinity BT 037677, received five rounds small arms fire from approximately 500 meters, vicinity BT 042677. Twenty round small arms fire returned to area, patrol searched area with negative results. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.
3. Miscellaneous. None.


