1st Bn, 1st Mar

1. Late Entry

a. At 052055H a platoon from Company C (BT 078599) received estimated 25 rounds S/A fire from unknown number of VC (BT 078601). Platoon and ARVN unit participating in COUNTY FAIR 1-2 returned fire. VC withdrew under fire. One USMC WIA (med evac).

2. Contacts

a. At 060930H a squad patrol from Company C (BT 099615) and (BT 103614) apprehended 2 VCS at above coordinates. One had no ID. The other had a large amount of money (30-40 100 piaster notes). VCS will be forwarded to HOI AN for interrogation.

b. At 061130H a squad patrol from Company D (BT 045656) received estimated 75 rounds S/A fire and MG fire from 5 or 6 VC (BT 046657). Squad returned 300 rounds S/A, 15 rounds M-79 fire. Artillery mission called 16 rounds 105 fired. Squad searched area revealing no VC casualties and no further contact was made.

c. At 061950H D Company 1st Plt patrol base at BT 066634 received 20 to 30 rounds S/A fire from estimated two VC. Plt returned fire with 40 rounds S/A and 3 rounds 106 from Ontos. Searched area no further contact.

d. At 062022H B Company CP at BT 080600 received 40 rounds S/A and what was believed to be 13 rifle grenades. Returned fire with 400 rounds S/A, 9 M-79 rounds and 24 rounds 90mm. Swept area, no further contact was made.

d. At 062046H a Sqd patrol from D Company at BT 064617 received 10-20 rounds S/A from an estimated 2-3 VC resulting in one USMC scout dog KIA. Returned 75 rounds S/A and 4 M-79 rounds. VC broke contact. Patrol unable to reestablish contact.

3. Miscellaneous

a. At 051715H a fire team from Company A at (BT 160596) moving to intercept a boat crossing river received 20 rounds S/A from opposite side of river. Marines returned 40 rounds small arms. Incoming fire later determined to have originated from ARVN unit on sweep in conjunction with County Fair 1-3. As the team approached the area where boat was beached, an unidentified person was seen fleeing into heavy vegetation. Marines opened fire, search of area revealed a Vietnamese female who had been wounded. Med Evac was initiated and executed.

b. At 060940 CG FMFPAC Lt. Gen. Victor Krulak visited County Fair 1-2 GS (BT 0859).

2. Contacts.

- a. At 061145H, Company K platoon command post (BT 076697) received approximately 100 rounds carbine and automatic fire from an estimated five VC in tree line. Tree line at (BT 077698) at a distance of 150 meters. The platoon returned forty-five rounds .59 cal, two rounds M-79, and 100 rounds S/A fire. A reinforced squad was dispatched; reported negative results. Two USMC KIAs sustained. No confirmed VC casualties.
- b. At 061225H, Company L platoon patrol discovered M-26 grenade booby trapped with wire across trail and attached to sign via (AT 972682). The grenade was destroyed in place.
- c. At 061415H, Company L squad patrol (AT 962677) received five rounds carbine fire from concealed VC position (AT 960677) 200 meters from the patrol. The patrol returned twenty-five rounds S/A fire and searched area with negative results.
- d. At 061630H Company M moving into new CP at (BT 054693) detonated 3 booby traps in 3 separate places covering an area of 150 meters. All detonated within 10 minutes of each other. Two of the booby traps were M-26's attached to punji stakes and the third was detonated by a trip wire. Area searched for further booby traps. Company sustained 1 KIA and 3 WIA, all casualties med evac.
- e. At 061955H a Sqd patrol from Company L received 50 rounds S/A from an estimated two VC. Returned fire with 40 rounds S/A and 1 M-79 round. Swept area, no further contact made. Initial contact made at BT 972661.
- f. At 062000H Company M CP at BT 054693 received 46 rounds S/A. Fire was returned with 150 rounds S/A and 3 rounds M-79. Enemy fire ceased, area will be checked at first light.

3. Miscellaneous. At 061000H, Shore Party road clearing team detected one M-26 grenade in C-Ration can vicinity AT 988659. The grenade pin was pulled and C-Ration can was lying in the open. The grenade was blown in place.
