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NARRATIVE SUMMARY
1st Battalion 1st Marines

1. Late Entries.

- A. At 101900H a platoon from Company D in their PPB (BT 053656) observed 2-3 young females trying to lure Marines into village (BT 053656). Villagers in area pointed to females and yelled VC. Two squads were sent to apprehend VCS. Marines challenged, then fired 2 rounds M-79 as VCS ran. One female VCS was apprehended. A young girl was wounded by shrapnel and medevaced to USOM hospital.
- B. At 102100H a platoon base from Company D (BT 089659) received 50 rounds automatic S/A harassing fire from estimated four VC in three locations. (BT 087659), (BT 089657), (BT 090661). Returned fire with 100 rounds 7.62, 5 rounds M-79 and 2 LAW's. Two squads searched area without contact or evidence of VC casualties.
- C. At 102100H a PPB from Company B (BT 085569) heard three rounds mortar fire discharged (BT 092563) toward Dien Ban HQ. VC shifted fire to (BT 094569) a former PPB then (BT 105560) and (BT 095560). Arvn returned fire with indirect fire weapons. Request for artillery mission turned down by Hoi An HQ. A child wounded seriously by VC fire was medevaced.
- D. At 102105 a squad patrol from Company A set in ambush (BT 166589) received five rounds S/A fire from (BT 167589). A first team checked area without contact. Squad continued mission.
- E. At 102110H a patrol from Company D (BT 090653) received 35-40 rounds automatic S/A fire from estimated three VC (BT 092653). 55 rounds 7.62, 4 rounds M-79 were fired in return. Search made without contact or evidence of VC casualties.
- F. At 102110H The 1st platoon PPB from Company A received 15 rounds S/A fire from estimated 2 VC (BT 157603). A squad ambush (BT 160605) sighted one VC and fired 40 rounds 7.62 and 1 round M-79 while the PPB fired 7 rounds 90mm and 50 rounds 50 caliber. Sqd searched area under tank illumination with no further contact.
- G. At 102130H a platoon base from Company B (BT 092602) received 20-30 rounds automatic carbine fire from estimated 2 VC (BT 090604). Returned fire with 150 rounds 7.62 and 5 rounds M-79. No further contact was made.
- H. At 102140H a platoon base from Company C (BT 119640) received 5 rounds harassing S/A fire. Squad sent to maneuver into area (BT 116645) received heavy (200 rounds) S/A automatic fire. Marines fired 300 rounds 7.62 and continued search without further contact.
- I. At 102230H the 1st platoon base from Company D (BT 053657) received 10 rounds S/A fire from estimated 2 VC (BT 053659). Platoon fired 25 rounds 7.62 and 3 rounds M-79 before making search, which produced no further contact.

2. CONTACT

- A. At 110005H a platoon patrol base from Company D (BT 053657) received 20 rounds S/A (BT 052656) and (BT 050859) returned 30 rounds 7.62 and 2 M-79 rounds. Area searched without further contact.
- B. At 110025H a platoon base listening post from Company B (BT 091602) spotted 10-12 VC in open (BT 091608). Artillery mission fired 16 rounds 105mm on target. Two squads searched area and found no evidence of VC casualties.
- C. At 110645H a road mine sweep patrol from A Company 9th Engineers (BT 069665) spotted 1 VCS heading into treeline (BT 069667) carrying what was believed to be a French carbine. Security fired five rounds at VCS and continued mission.
- D. At 110730H a patrol from Company C (BT 108623) detonated a directional type mine. Mine detonated approximately 50 meters in front of patrol slightly wounding two Marines. Medevac was not requested.
- E. At 110755H a squad patrol from Company C (BT 108623) received 200 rounds S/A fire from (BT 105628). Squad returned 300 rounds 7.62 and 4 rounds M-79. A Marine was wounded in leg when he detonated a punji pit booby trap as squad moved out to check area. Medevac chopper received 10 rounds S/A fire during lift off. Artillery mission requested fired 48 rounds 105mm HE with excellent target coverage.
- F. At 110935H blocking force for County Fair from Company A apprehended 2 male and 2 female VCS (BT 166596) who acted suspicious while fishing with nets in river. VCS will be detained and sent to Dien Ban district HQ for questioning tomorrow.
- G. At 111000H a squad patrol from Company C searching area of previous contact - Spot Report 110755H at (BT 100629) found four booby trapped punji pits (destroyed in place) 25 rounds 50 caliber unserviceable ammo, one warning device and 100 feet of communication wire. One wounded VCS captured and sent to Dien Ban for treatment and interrogation.
- H. At 111530H a patrol from Company B vic (BT 096639) observed four VC vic (BT 098636) armed. Patrol fired (110) rounds S/A, (6) rounds M-79. Area was swept in an effort to regain contact. Contact was not reestablished.
- I. At 111530H a Sqd patrol from B Company vic (BT 094495) apprehended three VN boys age 8-12 observing PFB. Boys were taken to Company B CP and identified by village chief as VC spies. VCS forwarded to District Hq.

- J. At 111635H a Sqd patrol from Company D vic (BT 038651) received (10) rounds S/A fire from an unknown number of VC vic (BT 031651). Returned fire with 75 rounds S/A, 4 rounds M-79. Area was swept. Three VCS were spotted and ran from patrol, one VCS caught, and will be forwarded to ITT.
- K. At 111705H a Sqd patrol from Company D vic (BT 049647) received 15 rounds S/A fire from an unknown number of VC vic (BT 055649) patrol returned fire with 75 rounds S/A and 3 rounds M-79. Swept area with no further contact.
- L. At 111730H Company C on clearing mission apprehended three male VCS at (BT 104653) and one female VCS was apprehended at (BT 136615) and one 15 year old male with shrapnel wounds in arm. Another male VCS was apprehended at BT 121632. All VCS will be forwarded to District Hq.
- M. At 111920H an outpost from Company D apprehended a male VCS who appeared to be checking out position. VCS had a ID card and a temporary safe conduct pass. VCS ID card stated that he was 39 years old but looked younger. VCS will be forwarded to District Hq at first light.
- N. At 112015H a Sqd ambush from Company C while moving to ambush sight vic (BT 115646) received (6) rounds S/A fire from an estimated two VC vic (BT 112646). Sqd returned (150) rounds S/A and (3) M-79 rounds. Area was swept with no further contact. Sqd sent to ambush position.

3. Miscellaneous

- A. At 110745H a platoon from Company A prior to setting in blocking position searched some houses in their area (BT 166598). Platoon found 10 maps of this area and Japan, two Khaki uniforms and one utility cover. Gear sent to Bn. CP forward.

REPORT FOR ACTION 100100H TO 111200H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries. At 103210H, a two-man listening post fifty meters beyond the Battalion Command Post perimeter, vicinity coordinates AT 092676, received one incoming hand-grenade. The grenade, type unknown, landed approximately fifty meters in front of listening post. Listening post and adjacent posts returned approximately thirty rounds small arms fire in expected direction from which grenade came. Area was searched with negative results. After contact was broken, listening post moved to a new position.

2. Contacts

a. At 110830H, Company H squad patrol located one Claymore mine vicinity coordinates BT 051688 rigged with communications wire leading to a self-defense shelter near an abandoned house approximately seventy-five meters south of mine. Within shelter, a PRC-6 battery was found attached to the communication wire. Shelter and mine destroyed. No friendly casualties.

b. At 111025H, Company I squad patrol, vicinity coordinates BT 002679, received two rounds small arms fire from a distance of approximately 300 meters, vicinity coordinates BT 005679. Patrol returned two rounds small arms fire. Area was searched with negative results. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

c. At 111020H, Company H platoon-size patrol, vicinity coordinates BT 051680, received ten rounds small arms fire from a distance of approximately 500 meters, vicinity coordinates BT 040683. Patrol returned fifteen rounds small arms fire. Area was searched with negative results. One USMC MIA sustained; no confirmed VC casualties.

d. At 111120H, Company I squad patrol, vicinity coordinates AT 072688, moving along rice paddy dike, detonated a buried grenade with pressure type fuse. Grenade was detonated by fourth man in column. Third and fifth in column were treated for minor wounds at Battalion Aid Station; the fourth was medical evacuated. Area was searched for further evidence of booby traps with negative results. Three USMC MIA.

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e. At 111720H a Sqd patrol from Company L vic (AT 967670) received (1) round S/A fire from an unknown number of VC vic (AT 965670). Patrol returned fire with (1) round M-79. Enemy fire ceased patrol continued mission.

f. At 111730H a patrol from Company M vic (BT 075664) received (5) rounds S/A fire from an unknown number of VC vic (BT 076668). Patrol returned fire with 60 rounds S/A. VC broke contact, area swept, no further contact.

g. At 111745H a Plt patrol from Company M vic (BT 049681) received 10-15 rounds S/A fire from an unknown number of VC vic (BT 048679) and a second position vic (BT 051673). Fire was returned with 30 rounds S/A. Area swept resulting in two VCS being apprehended.

h. At 111750H a Sqd patrol from Company L (AT967670) received (4) rounds S/A fire from an unknown number of VC (outside of TAOR) Vic (At 969671). Fire was returned with (10) rounds S/A, (3) rounds M-79. Enemy fire ceased, patrol continued mission.

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3. Miscellaneous

a. At 111000H, Company K reported that villagers had brought the body of a Vietnamese boy and two wounded Vietnamese children (male) to the 1st Platoon Command Post, vicinity BT 065682. A civic action team was directed to investigate and reported the wounds were sustained by shrapnel in the vicinity BT 073470 at approximately 110900H. No determination, however, was made of the origin of the explosive (believed to be mortars). No friendly units reported firing in this area. There was no hostile reaction by the Vietnamese people. Both wounded boys were taken to the Da Nang Hospital; the body was returned to its family.

b. At 111000H, 242,000 leaflets were dropped throughout the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines tactical area of responsibility (TAR). Areas covered included: grid squares AT 9665, AT 9666, 9667, 9668, 9766, 9668, 9669, BT 0269, 0268, 0365, 0367, 0468, and 0467. In each sector, a combination of the following leaflets were dropped: 23-66 (22,000), 23-66 (22,000), 34-65 (22,000), 39-65 (22,000), 44-55 (22,000), 47-55 (22,000), 49-66 (22,000), 55-66 (22,000), 54-66 (22,000), and 124 (22,000). These leaflets, in brief, explained that the Marines are friends of the Vietnamese people and are in their villages to help them, that the Marines seek the cooperation of the Vietnamese people, and ask them to adhere to the regulations now established: to wit, do not leave their village during the hours of darkness, do not run from the Marines, or harbor VC in their village, that, in doing so, they place in jeopardy themselves and their personal property. In addition, the cooperation of the civilian populace was encouraged by reward for information leading to VC mines and booby traps. The remaining leaflets were directed at the VC, delineating his plight, his unhappiness, and fears, and asked his choice: Peace or death.

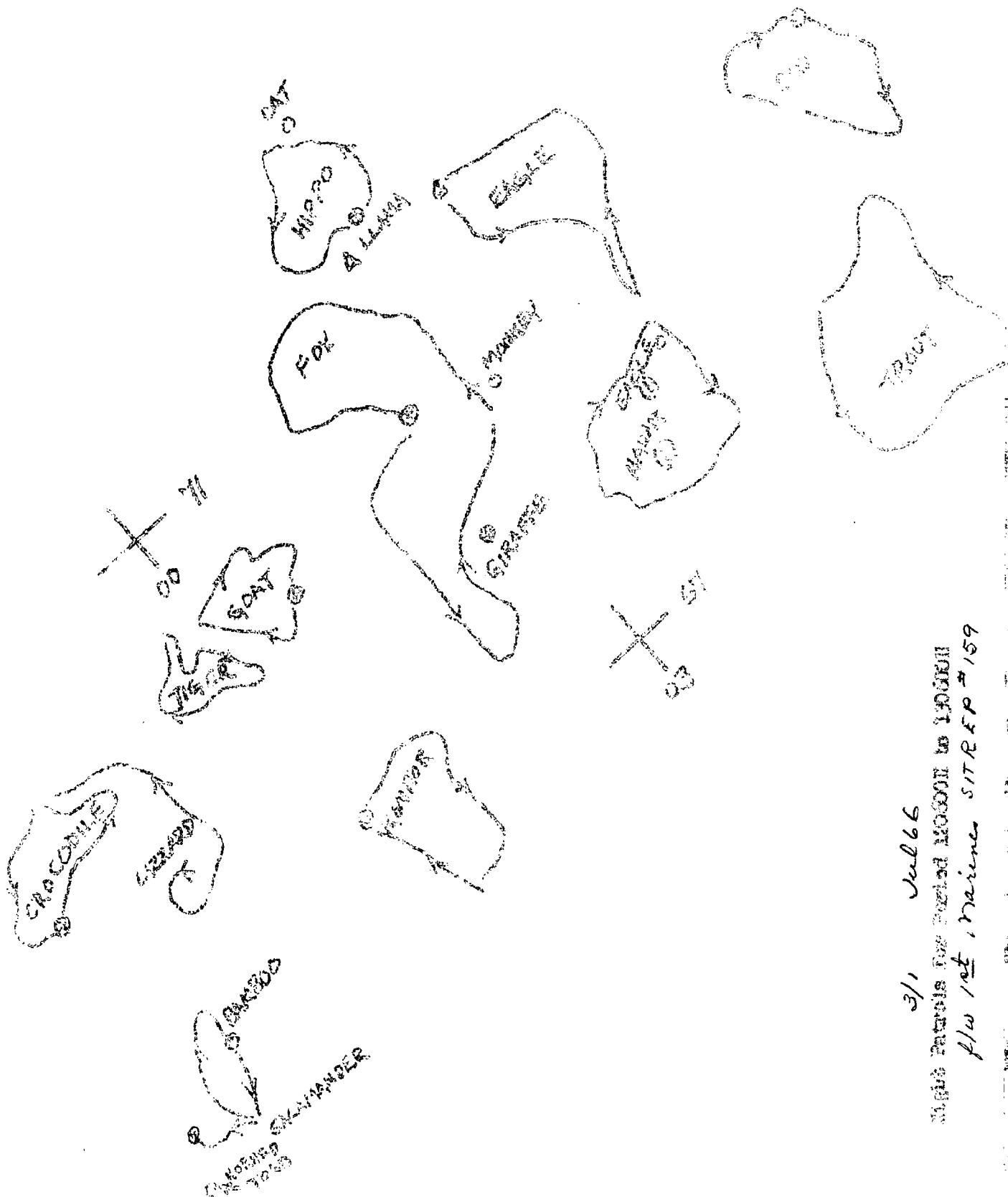
