4. Take Action

- a. At 122000H a squad from Company C (BT 114617) in route to search site received 35 to 50 rounds small arms fire (BT 112617). Squad returned fire with 300 rounds small arms fire and searched area without further contact.
- b. At 122145H a listening post from Company C (BT 114617) sighted six VC (BT 114615). Listening post opened fire and one tank moved up and fired eight 90mm antitank rounds, and 300 rounds .50 caliber. Preliminary search revealed no evidence of VC casualties.

5. Summary

- (4) a. At 130030H a squad patrol from Company C (BT 123610) apprehended 29 VCS males between ages 35-40. No males had been noticed in this area in previous sweep. VCS forwarded to District Headquarters.
- (5) b. At 130905H a squad patrol from Company B (BT 066625) received 30-50 rounds small arms fire and two rifle grenades from an estimated ten VC (BT 064623). VC action initiated by two blast from a whistle. Marines fired 40 rounds small arms and six rounds M-79 as VC withdrew through VCS to village. Patrol pursued but VC broke contact and fled. Search of village now in progress.
- (5) c. At 131100H a squad patrol from Company B (BT 062625) received approximately 10 rounds automatic small arms fire from estimated two VC (BT 061627). Returned fire with six rounds 90mm HE as squad deployed to search area. Six young male VCS apprehended in area will be sent to Battalion CP Forward for interrogation. One 30 year old male VC KIA found without weapon or I.D.
- (11) d. At 131715H Company C patrol at BT 113634 received 5 rounds S/A from an unknown number of VC. One Sad moved into area and received 50 rounds S/A fire resulting in (1) friendly WIA (Non-Evac). Patrol returned fire with 200 rounds S/A and 19 rounds M-79. Noticed one male running. Patrol ordered him to stop. VCS refused to stop. Patrol opened fire wounding VC in both legs. Med Evac to USOM.

(13) e. At 131940H Company A received (6) rounds 60mm mortars at (BT111598) muzzle flashes were observed at (BT 134605). Fire returned with (21) rounds 82mm. enemy fire ceased.

(14) f. At 132000H Plt from Company B vic (BT 089615) received 50 rounds S/A fire from an unknown number of VC. Fire was returned with (50) rounds S/A fire and (3) M-79 rounds. Enemy fire ceased.

(14) g. At 132025H Plt from Company D vic (BT 059644) received (10) rounds S/A from an estimated two VC located approximately 100 meters South West of their position. Returned fire with (70) rounds S/A. Area was swept with no further contact.

3. Miscellaneous

(3) a. At 130807H a Sqd patrol from Company A heard firing in village (BT 124600). Patrol investigated and found a 35 year old women shot in stomach. First Aid was administered and Med Evac called.

(10) b. At 131615H a patrol from Company B vic (BT 089614) located one (1) 82mm dud and one (1) 105mm dud. Survey of duds revealed that they are possibly booby trapped. Demo team requested and blew them in place.

(1) Treated 193 Med Cap

(2) Apprehended 16 VCS later confirmed by ARVN ITT as VC. Civic action currently under way.

NAARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Leave Entry. None

2. Contacts

(1) a. At 130510H, Company M squad patrol, via BT 041705, observed two men approaching their position. They were challenged and fled. The Sqd pursued, apprehending one of them. Separate from this incident, an additional VCS was apprehended, attempting to flee across rice paddy to avoid a fire team dispatched to encircle the original two VCS. Two VCS were apprehended and forwarded to ITT.

(6) b. At 131315H, Company L squad patrol, via AT 966667, received six to eight rounds small arms fire from across river, vicinity AT 964666. Patrol returned ten rounds small arms fire and two rounds M-79. Fire ceased. 3d Bn, 3d Marines notified and will deploy patrol in area. Results unknown. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

(7) c. At 131450H, Company L squad patrol (AT 967688) received ten rounds S/A fire from two carbines approximately 300 meters north of their position. The Sqd returned twenty rounds S/A fire and continued patrol. At 131500H, the squad received twenty rounds small arms fire and automatic fire from two carbines and one automatic weapon approximately 300 meters north; returned ten rounds S/A fire and continued patrol. No further action was taken as exact VC location was undetermined and only approaches to VC were across open rice paddies. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

(8) d. At 131600H Company K patrol (BT 079910) received 10 rounds S/A fire from an unknown number of VC (BT 081708). Returned fire with (5) rounds S/A searched area. Patrol seen (1) VC run into a house. Patrol pursued and apprehended 10 VCS in immediate area. VCS were forwarded to ITT.

(11) e. At 131615H Company K patrol (BT 091692) neared village at BT 090692. Two people ran from the village and launched a small boat in an attempt to leave. Patrol fired 3 rounds S/A and 1 round M-79 at the boat. VCS returned to shore and were apprehended. VCS were forwarded to ITT.

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⑨ f. At 131630H Company L patrol (BT 000614) found (1) M-26 booby trapped grenade. Grenade was disarmed and will be sent to Bn S-2.

⑯ g. At 132040H Company L via (AT 972662) received (1) round S/A fire from an unknown number of VC via (AT 971660). Returned 20 rounds S/A. Enemy fire ceased.

3. Miscellaneous. At 131400H, in meeting between Commanding Officer, 3d Bn, 1st Marines and Hoa Vang District Chief, final liaison was effected with Hoa Vang District Headquarters for County Fair operation to be conducted 15-16 July 1966 in Hamlet of Man Quan (1), vicinity grid square BT 0365.

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
