(7) PRIOR TO COUNTY FAIR 1-17 ONE OF THE MOST ACTIVE ORGANIZATIONS IN THE VIEM DONG HAMLET AREA WAS A VIET CONG SQD COMPOSED ENTIRELY OF YOUNG FEMALE, S BETWEEN THE AGES OF 16-28. ON THE BASIS OF INFORMATION PROVIDED BY A 14 YR OLD MALE VC CAPTURED DURING COUNTY FAIR 1-16, THE SQD LEADER, AN 18 YR OLD GIRL, WAS CAPTURED. IN ADDITION THREE OTHER SQD MEMBERS WERE IDENTIFIED AND TAKEN INTO CUSTODY. TWO FEMALE MEMBERS OF A VC PROPAGANDA CELL WERE IDENTIFIED DURING INTERROGATION PROCEEDINGS AT THE COLLECTION POINT. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THIS CELL IS A RELATED ORGANIZATION TO THE FEMALE SQD. THE ROLE OF THIS SQD IN THE VC INFRASTRUCTURE IN THANH THUY VILLAGE HAS NOT BEEN POSITIVELY ESTABLISHED HOWEVER, PRIMARY INDICATIONS ARE THAT THIS IS BASICALLY A COMBAT SUPPORT GROUP WITH PRIMARY MISSIONS IN THE AREA OF SUPPLY, PROCUREMENT AND PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS. THE IMMEDIATE IDENTIFICATION OF MEMBERS BY THE VC FROM HA GIA HAMLET, CAM HAI VILLAGE, WOULD SEEM TO INDICATE THAT THERE IS A SIGNIFICANT DEGREE OF INTER-ACTION BETWEEN VC ELEMENTS IN THIS AREA.

G. Prior to County Fair 1-17 one of the most active organizations in the VIEN DONG Hamlet area was a Viet Cong Squad composed entirely of young female's between the ages of 16-28. On the basis of information provided by a 14 year old male VC captured during County Fair 1-16, the squad leader, an 18 year old girl, was captured. In addition three other squad members were identified and taken into custody. Two female members of a Viet Cong propaganda cell were identified during interrogation proceedings at the collection point. It is believed that this cell is a related organization to the female squad. The role of this squad in the Viet Cong infrastructure in THANH THUY Village has not been positively established. However, primary indications are that this is basically a combat support group with primary missions in the area of supply, procurement and psychological operations. The immediate identification of members by the VC from HA GIA Hamlet, CAM HAI Village, would seem to indicate that there is a significant degree of interaction between Viet Cong elements in this area.
