5. Psychological Warfare

a. During the past week several conferences were conducted with all Psychological Warfare Officers in the 1st Marine Regiment. Arrangements have been made to furnish 3d Battalion, 1st Marines with films, leaflets, pamphlets and taped broadcasts for use during operations. A U-10 Aircraft will also be used for leaflet drops and taped broadcasts when desired.

b. The 1st Marine Division Band is scheduled to play Saturday, 16 April on KY HOA and KY XUAN Islands.

c. The 2d Battalion, 4th Marines plans to conduct Psychological Warfare operations during the forthcoming harvest season (Golden Fleece). A Vietnamese Drama team is also available for use in villages and hamlets.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Contacts

1. At 10030H, Company I patrol received four rounds small arms fire from treeline vicinity coordinates BT 507147. Patrol returned fire with twelve rounds small arms fire. Fire ceased. Area was searched without locating any confirmed VC casualties. At this same time, it was noted that a boat located thirty meters off shore may have been source of fire. Upon further investigation, and in consultation with village chief, it was established that boat in question was not VC but had grounded on sand bar and was abandoned early in the night.

2. At 101655H, Company K patrol, while searching stream bank vicinity coordinates BT 444149, sighted VC who attempted to evade capture by diving into water and swimming to underground cave with opening under water. The patrol continued to probe stream bank and uncovered tunnel complex. Patrol entered water and swam into cave; encountered VC who again attempted to escape; shot and killed VC. Upon further investigation, a larger cave complex, caves ranging from three to six feet high, three feet wide and four feet long, reinforced with bamboo matting, was discovered. Within these, two other VCS were found. VCS were placed under security and will be returned to Battalion for interrogation. Further search revealed nothing and caves were destroyed. No friendly casualties were sustained.

3. At 102010H, Company K Command Post received fifteen rounds small arms (carbine) fire from vicinity coordinates BT 434161. Fire was returned with 100 M-60 rounds and two M-79 rounds. Area will be searched at first light. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

B. Miscellaneous. At 101400H, Company E, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines commenced relief of Company I, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines for responsibility of security of Class V Dump and southwest sector of MAQ-12 Airfield security. At 101530H, relief was effected and Company I returned vicinity of 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines Command Post.

1. Contacts

- a. At 1025H a platoon patrol (H-6) located at BT 449030 received 2 rounds of sniper fire from the south. Exact location unknown. No fire returned. Platoon continued patrol.
- b. At 1255H a platoon patrol (H-6) located at BT 441039 received 14 rounds small arms fire from an unknown number of VC located at BT 443038 and BT 442043. Returned fire with 50 rounds M-14 and ten (10) rounds of M-79. Area searched. Negative results.
- c. At 1406H a platoon patrol (H-6) located at BT 452053 receive approximately 30 rounds S/A fire from 3-4 VC located at BT 445045. Fire returned with 50 rounds of M-14, 4 M-72 (LAW) Artillery Mission fired. Results unknown.

2. Training

- a. Training conducted during period 4-10 April.
 - (1) A total of 20 men attended land mine warfare school on 4 and 5 April.
 - (2) Co G FAM fired M-72's (LAW) and crew-served weapons.

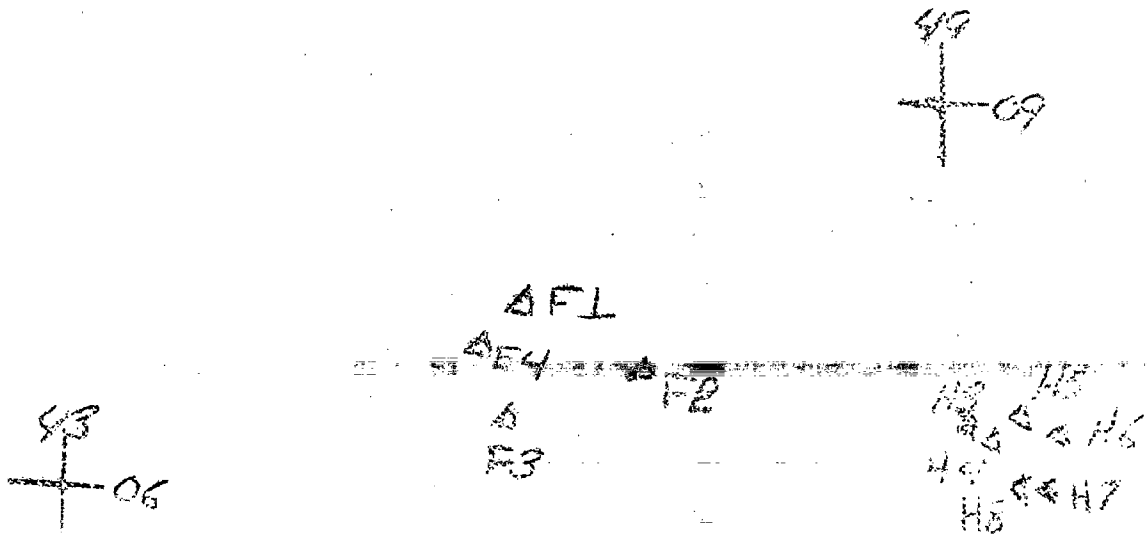

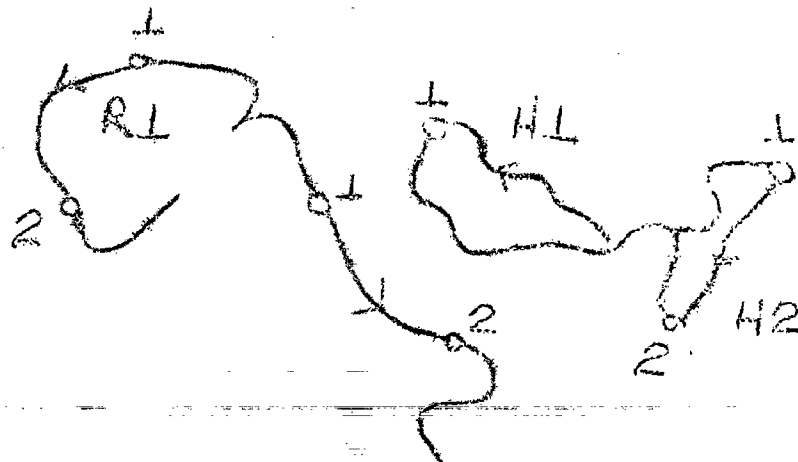
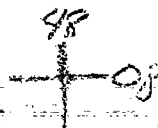
