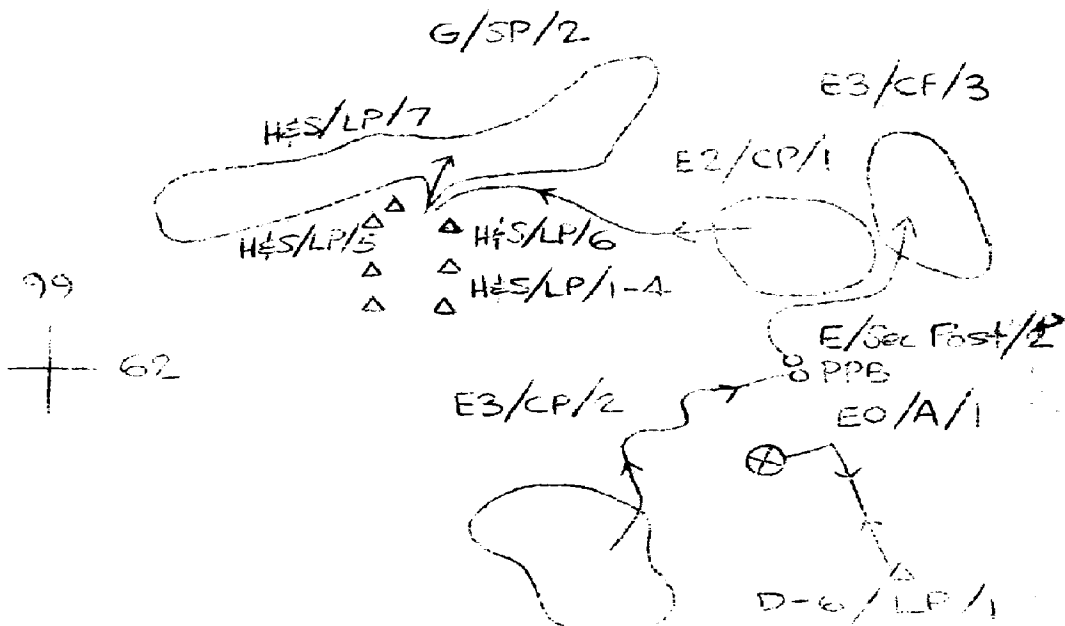
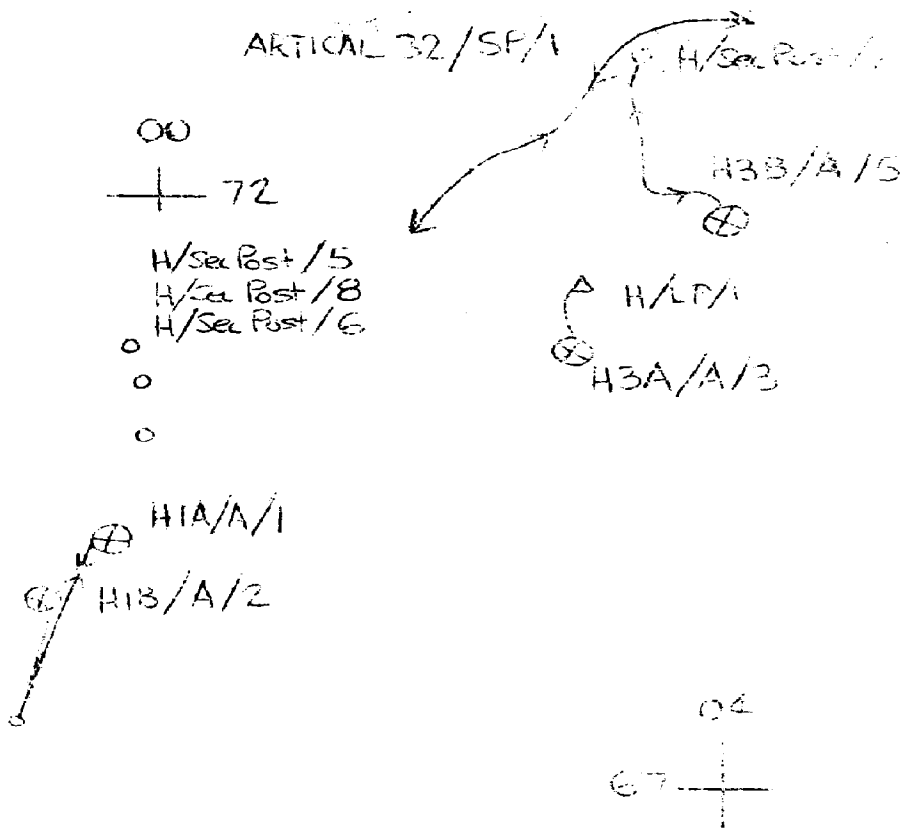
DAY TIME ACTIVITIES

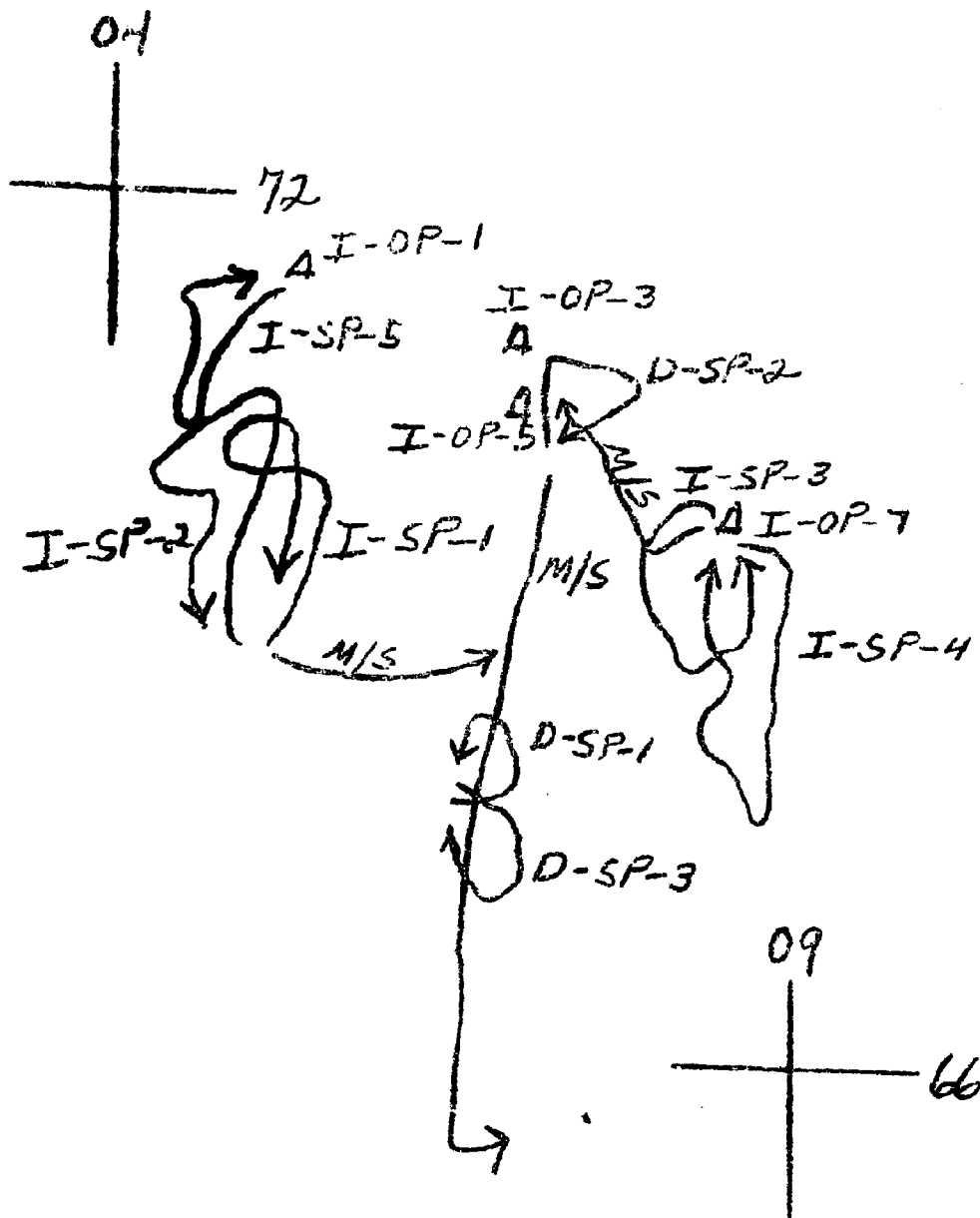

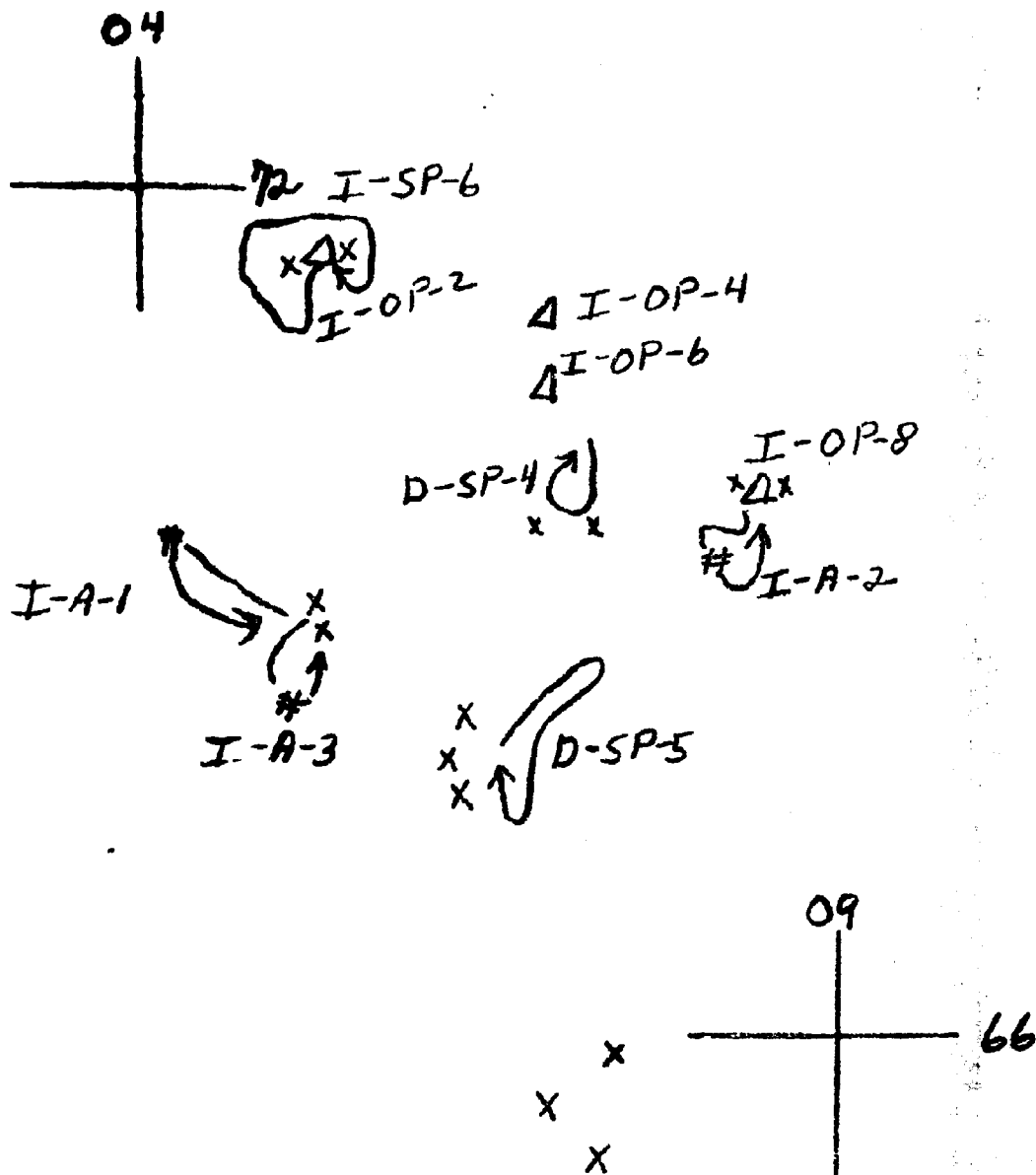

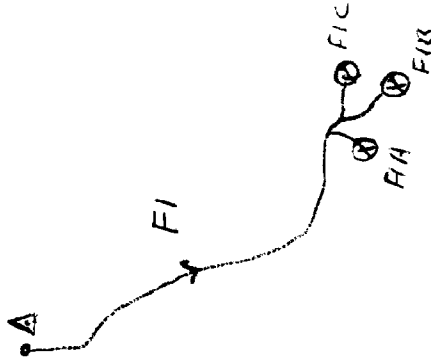
