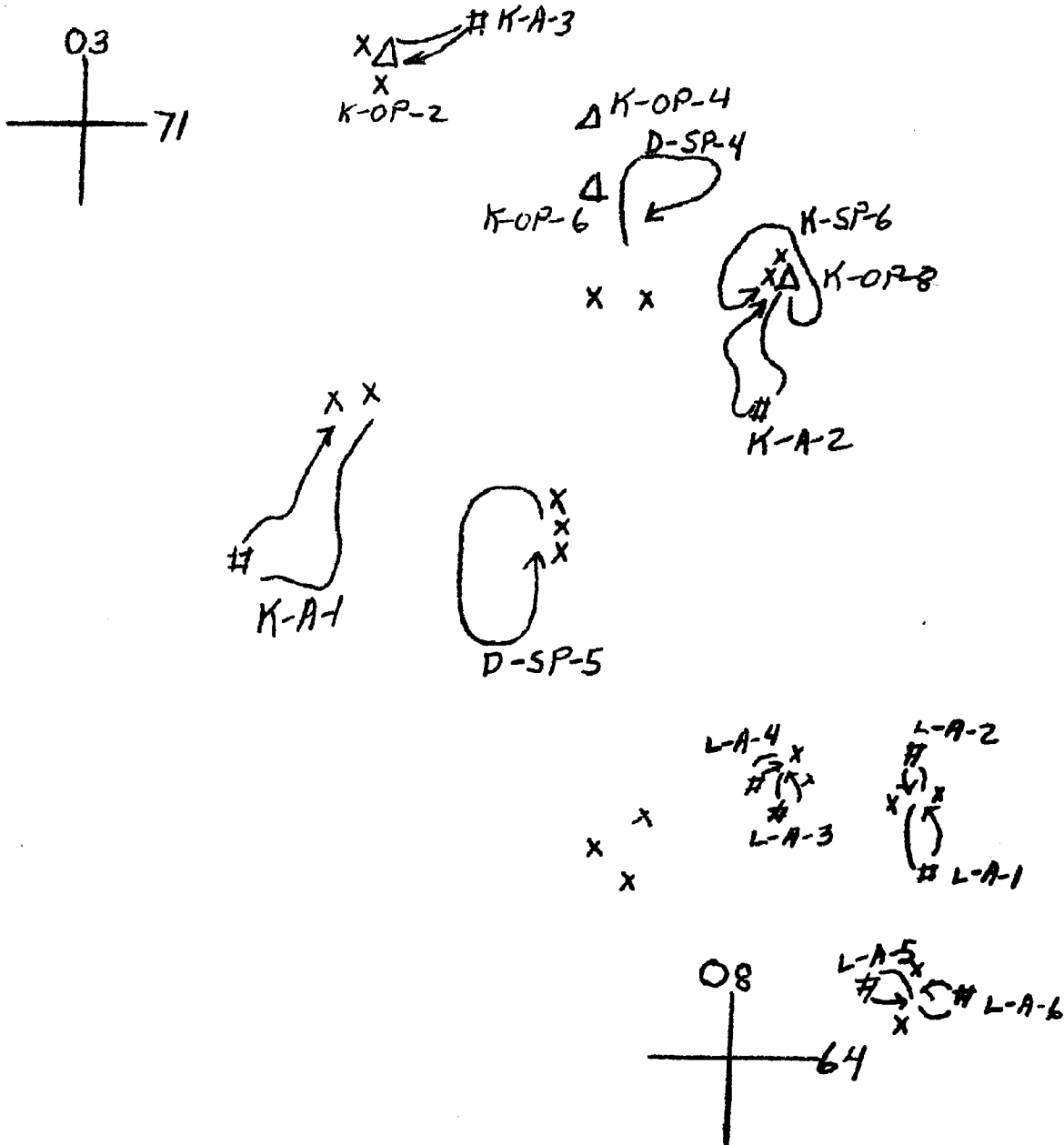
DAY PATROLS FOR PERIOD 250600H TO 260600H
