(A) AT 150415H TANK W/UNIT FROM CO C, VIC BT 021576, ENROUTE TO CO C CP DETONATED MINE EST CONTAIN 50 LBS OF EXPLOSIVES RESULTING IN (3) USMC WIA NONEVAC AND SLIGHT DAMAGE TO TANK. TANK WAS REPAIRED AND CONTINUED TO CO C CP.

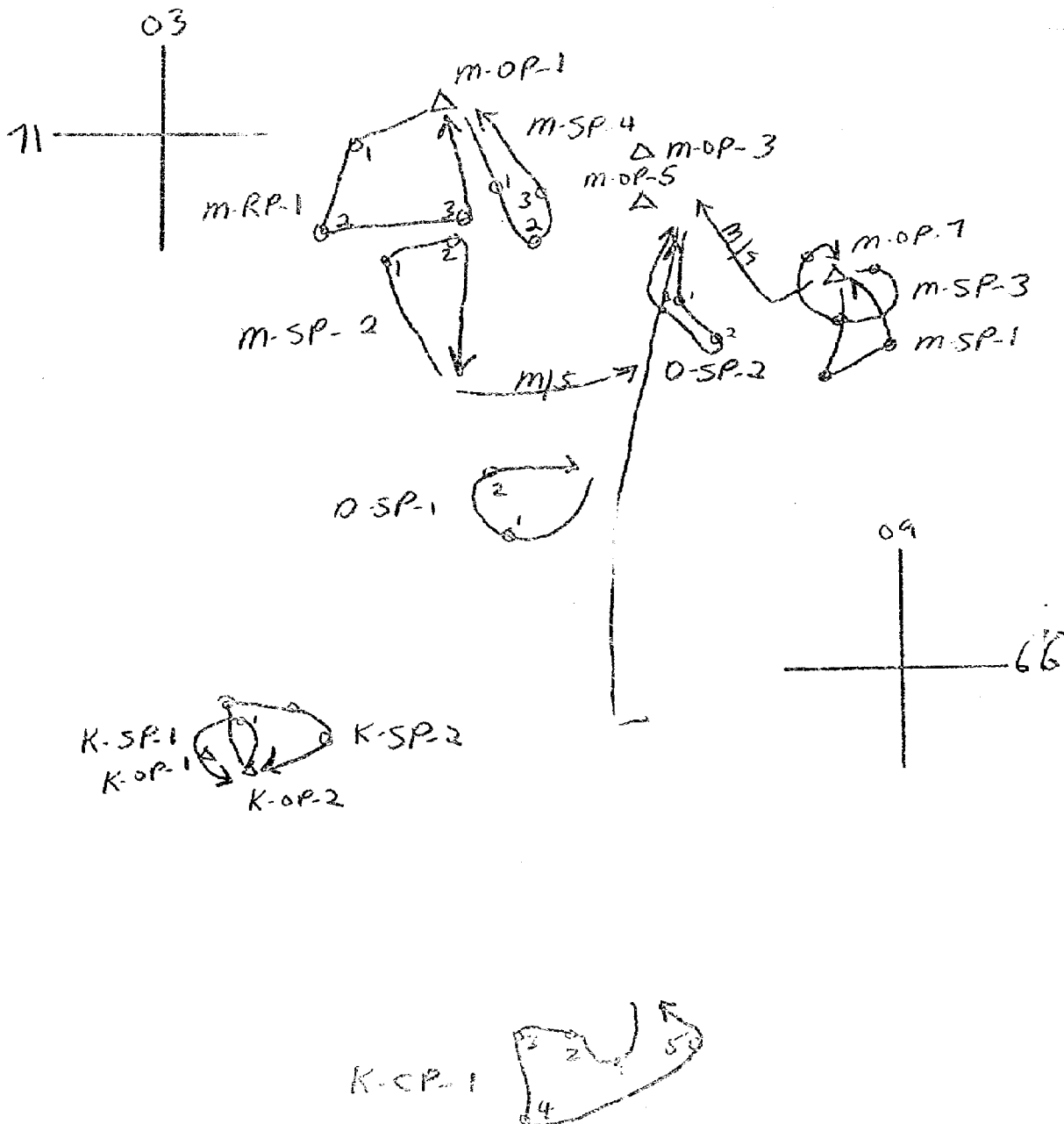
