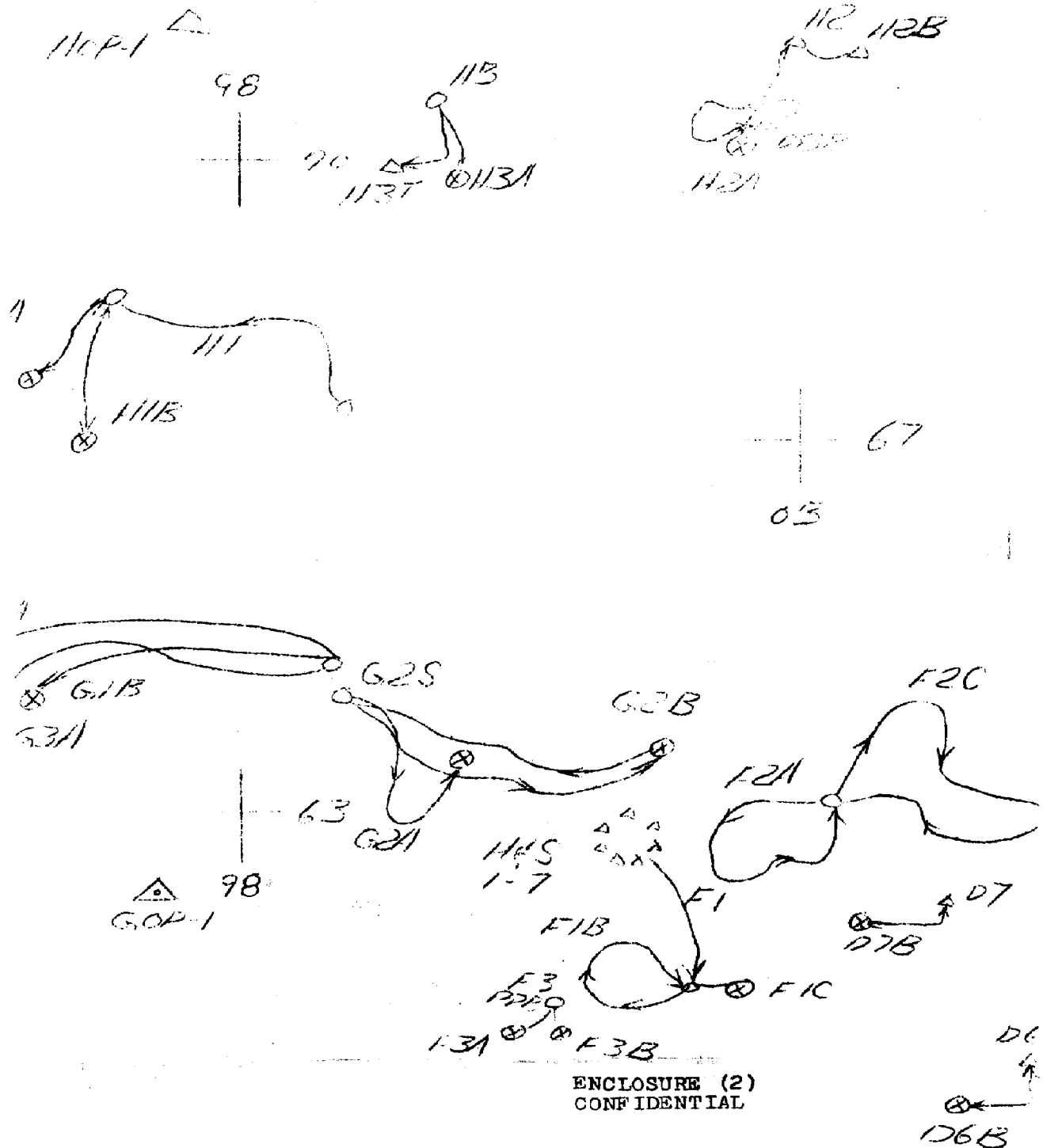
Activity Overlay for period 230600H to 231800H

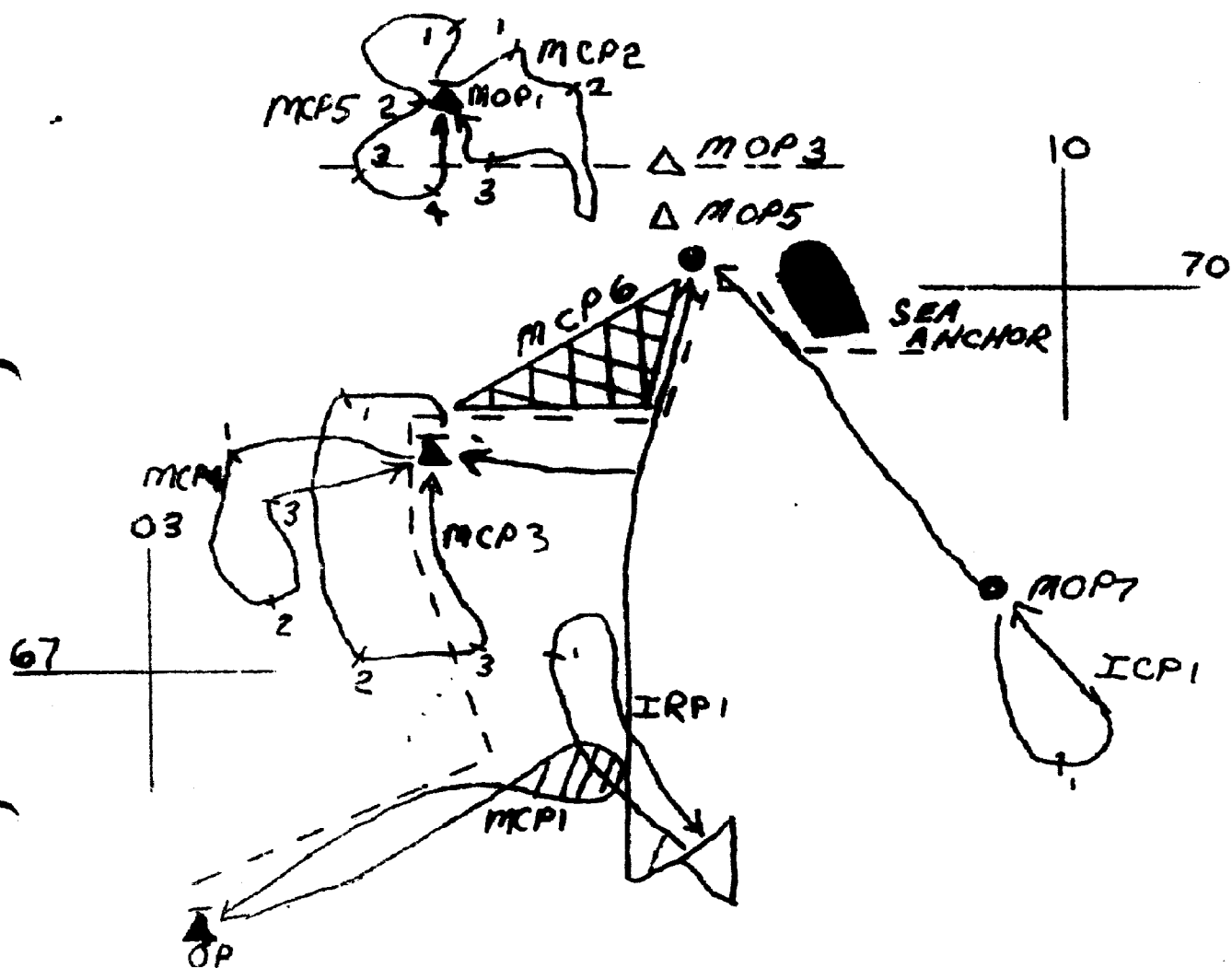
