At his invitation, a joint Catholic - Protestant Christmas Eve service was conducted with Chaplain Nguyen Tu, 1st ARVN R Regiment, for Vietnamese and American personnel. The service consisted of a dual celebration of Christmas Eve mid-night Mass and Protestant Communion.

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d. Related Activities:

(1) A conversational English teaching program was established in the Quang Tri High School. Fourteen officers and enlisted men were scheduled to teach in eight two hour sessions, four of which were classes for students and four of which were for high school teachers. By the end of the month, a total of 17 Marines had been involved in this program, which has been exceptionally well received and considered by appropriated high school authorities as highly successful.

(2) Approximately 200 boxes of Christmas gifts, received from individuals and organizations CONUS, were distributed to 1st Marines' personnel.

(3) Red Cross and USO packaged gifts were distributed to each Marine in the command.

SECTION B

ENEMY WEATHER AND TERRAIN

1. Weather. The weather during the month of December was generally mild for the season. There were, however, several periods of crachin weather lasting from 5-7 days. These periods were characterized by low ceilings and visibility, heavy rain showers, and continuous drizzle when not raining and low temperatures. The average high temperature was 90 degrees and the average low temperature was 54 degrees. The mean humidity was 88%. The average wind speed was 7 knots from a NE direction. The total rainfall for the month was 8.26 inches.

2. Terrain. Trafficability on all main routes of communication remained good. Cross country movement was fair to poor during the periods of heavy rainfall.

3. ENEMY. Enemy activity in the AO was limited almost exclusively to small arms/sniper fire and mining activity. On 14 December the Regimental S-2 while on an Aerial Reconnaissance of the AO, observed two (2) elephants moving on a trail at (YD 272452). The elephants were taken under fire with M-60 and one (1) elephant was observed to fall and disappear over a cliff. On 15 December, 2/4 and MAG-36 at AI TU Airfield (YD 310549) received approximately 50-60 rounds of 82mm mortar fire. The majority of the rounds impacted at the southern end of the runway into the billeting area and messing facilities of MAG-36. Equipment damage was one (1) CH-46 and three (3) H-34s

3. See Tab A to Section B for an enumeration of incidents and enemy losses during the reporting period. There was a small decrease in the total number of incidents during December as compared to November (233 vice 256), but a slight increase in VC initiated incidents (82 vice 66). A marked increase was noted in s/a-a/w incidents (89 vice 34).

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PART II
SECTION C
OPERATIONS

1. MISSION. First Marines conducts search and destroy operations, provides for defense and security of vital installations, establishes combat base in vicinity of La Vang, maintains an active ground surveillance program and conducts spoiling attacks throughout assigned area of operations to detect and destroy infiltrating NVA/VC forces. 1st Marines continues coordination with 1st ARVN Division and local GVN forces in adjacent areas and provides support as approved by CG, 3d MarDiv to 1st ARVN Division by conducting unilateral or combined operations. Further, 1st Marines remain prepared to provide reaction forces to counter enemy attacks on low level GVN structures, maintains reaction forces up to and including one infantry battalion with a Regimental Command Group prepared to establish and operate a task force headquarters to provide assistance to US/GVN forces as directed.

2. OPERATIONS

a. The First Marines continued to conduct operation OSCEOLA during the period 1-31 December 1967, concentrating heavily on search and destroy operations; combat, security and reconnaissance patrols and small unit LP's, OP's and ambushes to accomplish its assigned mission within its area of operations. The First Marines, concurrently with its daily activities, continued to conduct "Operation Mine Find" with excellent results; provided increased support in the way of reaction forces for rough rider convoys; continued the tactical/civic action program in the hamlet of NHU LE (YD 312478) which commenced on 27 November 1967, and continued defense of the Quang Tri Combat Base. Additionally, the First Marines conducted one helicopterborne search and destroy operation in its AO from 9-12 December, maintained one battalion as 3d Marine Division Reserve from 14 to 31 December, commenced a second tactical/civic action program in the hamlets Nhan Bieu (2) (YD 315505) and Than An Do (YD 326514) on 19 December, rotated 2d Bn, 1st Marines to Con Thien during the period 22-23 December as relief for the 1st Battalion, and provided two companies OpCon to 4th Marines during period 25-31 December 1967.

b. Throughout the reporting period, the First Marines continued its combined tactical/civic action/psychological operations in the hamlet of Nhu Le (YD 312478) with relative success. Extensive use was made of Armed Propaganda Teams, and aerial leaflet drops and broadcasts to establish/foster a pro GVN attitude in the hamlet. Additionally, civic affairs/PsyOps personnel, in conjunction with Quang Tri Provincial Headquarters, succeeded in reestablishing the hamlet chief in Nhu Le. The program continues to show success in that several VC sympathizers have been apprehended, and during the period 22-31 December, no less than six boats carrying VC attempting to flee the hamlet during hours of darkness were attacked by the unit in Nhu Le, resulting in nine VC KIA Confirmed. This activity occurred after several weeks of relative inactivity. It is considered that the VC became desperate at the continued presence of Marines and were attempting to extricate themselves.

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c. Early in the first week of December 1967, low level agent reports indicated the possibility of rocket storage sites and logistic caches in the vicinity of Hill 80, (YD 247444). Also, agent reports and recent operations in the area revealed evidence of enemy presence and strong possibility of ordnance storage areas. Commencing 091022H, 2d Battalion (-) First Marines conducted a helicopterborne assault against the Hill 80 complex in accordance with First Marines Frog Order 93-67. The operation consisted of a three company assault on the objective, with the entire force conducting detailed and methodical search and destroy operations throughout the objective area in attempts to locate these caches, destroy them and destroy NVA/VC forces located in the objective area. The operation terminated at 121458H, and succeeded in verifying the non-existence of any caches in this area, and the non-presence of NVA/VC forces.

d. Commencing 19 December 1967, 2d Battalion, 4th Marines established one rifle company in the vicinity Than Nhan Bieu (2) Hamlet (YD 315505) and Than An Don Hamlet (YD 326514). These areas were VC dominated and the enemy operated freely in these hamlets. A mortar attack on Quang Tri Airfield on 15 December originated from this area. Since establishment of the Combat Patrol Base, the rifle company has conducted extensive search and destroy operations throughout the area and has successfully eliminated overt guerrilla activity in these hamlets. In conjunction with the tactical operations, an extensive civil affairs/PsyOps program commenced with the goal of returning the citizens of these hamlets to a pro GVN attitude. On 26 December, the hamlet chiefs were reinstated in their respective hamlets. Elder council meetings have been held and the local government has begun to function in each hamlet. Intensive aerial leaflet drops and broadcasts have been conducted daily and MED-C/PS commenced on 26 December 1967. An indication of the results of the efforts in these two hamlets can be derived from the facts that there have been no contacts with the VC since 24 December, MEDC/P response has increased from 30 on 26 December to 300 on 29 December and there has been one incident of a hamleteer delivering three VC explosive devices to the Marines.

e. "Operation Mine Find" continued throughout the reporting period with excellent results. Cumulative totals of explosive devices recovered by civilians as of the end of the reporting period is 370. Detailed listing is as follows:

f. Throughout this reporting period the First Marines provided increased support for Rough Rider convoys in the form of reaction forces, with a total of twelve convoys being supported. In accordance with CG, 3d Marine Division messages 130647Z and 130851Z, December 67, the First Marines maintained responsibility for the Division Reserve from 140600H to 312400H. 2d Battalion, 1st Marines acted as Division Reserve from 140600H to 220659H December, when relieved by 2d Battalion, 4th Marines at 220700H. 2d Battalion, 4th Marines continued mission of Division Reserve until relieved 311800H by 1st Battalion, 1st Marines for the remainder of the reporting period. On 221000H, 1st Marines chopped OpCon of 2d Battalion, 1st Marines to 9th Marines in connection with the relief of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines at Con Thien. At 221630H, 1st Marines assumed OpCon of companies B and C, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, and at 231620H, assumed OpCon of Headquarters, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines and Companies A and D from 9th Marines. At 251137H, 1st Marines chopped OpCon of Company D, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, to 4th Marines in support of operations. During the period 241800H to 251800H, 1st Marines observed the Christmas cease fire. On 280800H, chopped OpCon of Company B, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines to 4th Marines in support of operations. At 291300H, assumed OpCon of 1st Battalion, 3d Marines (-). (Headquarters, 1st Battalion, 3d Marines and Companies B and D). At 311400H, assumed OpCon of Companies B and D, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, from 4th Marines. At 311800H, 1st Marines commenced observance of the New Year's Cease Fire.

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3. AIR SUPPORT AND DEFENSE

a. General. Air operations in the First Marines AO were hampered during the month of December by two periods of inclement weather, lasting for a total of 10 days.

b. Helicopters. During December there was a total of 158,763 lbs. of cargo and 4,997 trips carried in support of the First Marines. The total troops lifted includes 66 medevacs.

c. Fixed Wing. Close air support sorties totaled 8 while the total ordnance expended by CAS and FQ-10 missions was 118,000 lbs.

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4. FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION (Artillery and Naval Gunfire)

a. General. Fire support coordination in the 1st Marines A- continued on a routine basis. A two hour period of instruction covering air, artillery, and naval gunfire support and the coordination of supporting arms was prepared by the respective liaison officers. This instruction was presented to officers and CO's at Regimental Headquarters on 10 and 11 December and to the officers and CO's of 2d Battalion, 1st Marines, on 17 December. Counter-mortar drills were conducted frequently during the month. On the night of 15 December, the 1st Battalion (-), 11th Marines expended 341 rounds of counter-mortar fire following the mortar attack on Quang Tri Airfield. On 29 December, 1st Battalion (-), 11th Marines, chopped UpCon of Battery "A" to 3d Battalion, 12th Marines. Battery "B" dislocated to Camp Evans. 1st Battalion (-), 11th Marines on 29 December. Battery "I" occupied the position at YD 313543 that was formerly occupied by Battery "B".

b. Operation COBOL. 1st Battalion (-), 11th Marines, continued to provide direct artillery support to the 1st Marines from their primary positions. On 8 December, Battery "A" dislocated to YD 332469 to support 2d Battalion, 1st Marines, in a three day search and destroy operation in the vicinity of Hill 80 (YD 247443), returning to primary position on 12 December.

c. Naval Gunfire. There were no naval gunfire support ships on station in support of the 1st Marines during the month of December.

SECTION D
TRAINING

1. During this reporting period the first Marines continued its program of five-day combat orientation training for all units. Additionally, general military subjects training was conducted throughout the month. Subjects covered were primarily those determined to be the most needed by the Marines of the Regiment in conducting their daily operations. Subjects which received increased emphasis were:

- a. Post and Familiarization Firing of Individual/Crew Served Weapons.
- b. Mines, Booby Traps and Explosive Devices
- c. Offensive Combat
- d. Use of Supporting Arms In Offensive/Defensive Combat

- f. Repeated Gun Drills for Mortar Crews
- g. PFC Leadership
- h. Field Fortifications
- i. Scouting and Patrolling
- j. Field Sanitation, Personal Hygiene
- k. Care and Cleaning of Weapons and Equipment
- l. Hand and Arm Signals
- m. Ambushes and Ambush Techniques
- n. Land Navigation
- o. Revolutionary Development
- p. Medvac Procedures
- q. Field Operation, PFC-25
- r. Radio Procedures, PFC-25

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PART II
SECTION E
LOGISTICS

1. Logistic Situation. Logistic support for the First Marines (-) (Rein) has been adequate for the support of combat operations.
2. Supply. All classes of supply remained adequate. Our source continues to be FLSG-B at Dong Ha (old designation FLSU-1). We still maintain a small Regimental Rear in DaNang where personal belongings and garrison property are in storage.
3. Maintenance. Proper first and second echelon maintenance, especially in the area of motor transport, continues to present problems. Monsoon weather and lack of good maintenance facilities make it difficult to keep vehicles clean. Scarcity of certain spare parts, i.e., starters for M-27442, front hub assembly for the M-422, inner tubes for mules and Mitey Mites often cause vehicles to be deadlined. All items of equipment which are evacuated for repair can be expected to be gone for indefinite periods of time.
4. Services.
 - a. Messing. Mess facilities and the quality of food served continues to improve.
 - b. Sanitation & Hygiene. We have two bath units within the command which have been adequate to serve all units.
 - c. Laundry. Facilities are adequate.
 - d. Exchange. Facilities are adequate.
 - e. Medical & Dental. Facilities and services are adequate.
 - f. Transportation. With a company of 2½ ton trucks OpCon to the Regiment, we have experienced no difficulty providing adequate transportation for both administrative and tactical moves.

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PART II
SECTION F
CIVIL AFFAIRS/CIVIC ACTION

1. On 5 December 2d Battalion, 1st Marines started their daily Medcap. This Medcap has been quite successful, providing medical assistance for between 100 and 150 persons a day. During December, 2d Battalion, 4th Marines ran a total of eight Medcaps in four different locations, Nhan Bieu (2) hamlet, Ai Tu hamlet area, Ai Tu Catholic School, and Gieng Hien School.
2. In an effort to provide work for some of the refugees in 1st Marines Area of Operations two Civic Action projects were initiated in December. On 5 December, 42 refugees were hired to repair the La Vang road, and on 18 December 11 refugees were hired to build school desks/benches for distribution to schools throughout our Area of Operations. The refugees from both projects are being paid in commodities obtainable through CORDS in Quang Tri.
3. On 21 December seven officers and seven enlisted men commenced teaching conversational English classes in the Quang Tri Public High School. Eight two hour classes are taught each week with four classes being for the Vietnamese students and four being for the Vietnamese teachers. Enthusiasm for the project on the part of the students, teachers, and Marines has been very encouraging. Conversation and pronunciation of English are stressed in the classes.
4. From 23 December to 25 December fourteen Christmas parties were conducted in schools/orphanages throughout our Area of Operations. Christmas gifts were also supplied to two separate organizations, La Vang Chinh Orphanage and the Mai Linh District Chief, for further distribution to additional children. A total of 6570 gifts were distributed to Vietnamese children.
5. During December the hamlet chiefs of Nhu Le, Nhan Bieu (2) and An Don were reinstated in their hamlets. Formerly, all three hamlets had been VC controlled and the hamlet chiefs were afraid to live in their hamlets. However, with elements of 1st Marines providing security the hamlet chiefs returned to their hamlets and started rallying their people to the GVN. Some indications of success are the reduction of VC contacts, to insignificant isolated incidents, an increase in Medcap response from 30 on 26 December to 300 on 29 December, and there has been one incident of a hamleteer delivering three VC explosive devices to Marines.
6. Contacts with GVN and CORDS personnel were maintained throughout the month of December. All our Civic Action projects were closely coordinated with GVN and CORDS personnel.

SECTION C
PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

1. First Marines continued normal psychological warfare operations during the month of December with only slight decrease in aerial broadcasts and leaflet drops due to inclement weather.
2. Air drops which are made simultaneously with aerial broadcasts, numbered 21. Approximately 191,000 leaflets were disseminated by hand, and ground broadcasts were conducted for 26 hours.
3. The PsyOps campaign appealed to three separate target audiences: NVA, VC, and uncommitted civilian population. The following themes were emphasized: Marines are friends, health and sanitation, rewards, Chieu Hoi (VC/NVA), NVA vs VC/NVA life, and VC destruction. Rewards and Chieu Hoi family appeal are stressed in the populated areas while hard corps Chieu Hoi themes with instructions to ralliers are stressed in the enemy controlled Hai Lang Forest.
4. The rewards program, which achieved considerable success during previous months, decreased in December as a result of gradual decline in the number of rewardable items. The following is a breakdown of December rewards:

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5. Armed propaganda teams used in conjunction with AB teams proves to be one of the most successful psyops communications. These two teams provide infantry with face to face persuasion as well as immediate long range propaganda capability. These teams went to the field on numerous platoon and company sized operations and achieve excellent results. During this reporting period, they have been directly responsible for the capture of four Viet Cong and numerous documents and equipment.

SECTION H
COMMUNICATIONS-ELECTRONICS

1. The Regimental Communications Platoon provided normal radio, telephone, teletype, and radio relay communications in support of the command, control, and administrative actions of the Regimental Headquarters throughout the month of December. Additionally, the Platoon provided communications in support of the Regimental mission related to Rough Rider convoys when scheduled during the month of December.
2. On 4 December, the Regimental AN/TRC-27 radio relay terminal at Ai Tu airfield, linking the Regimental Headquarters with subordinate Battalions north of the Thach Han River and with the airfield complex, was relocated. The relocation was made to take advantage of air station electrical power (400 cycle), which is abundant at the MATCU site. A further advantage of the new location was a closer proximity to the Battalions and to the airfield telephone system, thus reducing the problem of wire line outages due to vehicular traffic and construction equipment cutting the wire lines extending from the radio relay terminal. The Regiment provided a wire team to assist in this new communication installation.
3. On direction of the Regimental Executive Officer, the Regimental Communications Officer conducted a study of incoming message handling times (difference between Date-Time-Group and Time of Receipt) during the period 11Dec67 through 17Dec67. The average times for delivery to this Regiment were as follows: Flash 24 minutes; Immediate 8.3 hours; Priority 14.4 hours; and Routine 14.7 hours.
4. On 12 December, the Regimental Communications Platoon hosted a FMFPAC Maintenance Instruction Contact Team. Technicians and operators from the Regimental Headquarters and the artillery and infantry battalions within 1st Marine AO attended the presentation. The presentation was devoted to preventative maintenance procedures in a combat environment, and tips on how to most effectively utilize comm-elect equipment organic to infantry/artillery organizations.
5. On 13 December, the Regimental Communications Platoon activated a radio relay circuit with Headquarters, First Marine Division. During a period of several days, test messages were successfully exchanged. Constructed and installed an emergency electrical power "cross-over" permitting separate or simultaneous power system operation by "B" Co., 1st Medical Bn and Headquarters, First Marines.

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6. On 26 December, two AN/MRC-62 radio relay teams with equipment from Communications Company, 3d Marine Division reported to relieve two of the attached 7th Communications Battalion teams located at Headquarters, First Marines. The 3d Marine Division AN/MRC-62's were in place and operating the following day, one the Regimental line to Dong Ha, the other on the Regimental line to Phu Bai.
7. On 28 December, the Regimental Communications Officer dispatched two 7th Communication Battalion radio relay teams to Headquarters, 4th Marines to establish circuits from Camp Evans to Headquarters, 3rd Marine Division and 1st Marines CP. This is a temporary radio relay link to permit close coordination between the two Regimental Headquarters during the shift of their Regimental Command Posts.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

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d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

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a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

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4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
