SECTION B
ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN

1. ENEMY. For the most part, enemy activity consisted of redeploying and resupplying for the much anticipated "TET" offensive. Enemy forces avoided contact with friendly units and concentrated instead on propaganda, reconnaissance and rehabilitation activities. Contacts consisted primarily of isolated sightings and sporadic exchanges of small arms fire. Exceptions were the operations conducted by Company "B", 1st Battalion and Company "M", 3rd Battalion in the DODGE CITY area and activities following the "TET" holidays.

a. During operations in the DODGE CITY area, Company "B" and Company "M" made numerous contacts with enemy forces and succeeded in disrupting the enemy's supply and redeployment activities. In the process they inflicted several casualties on enemy forces. Among the items of equipment captured were one 82mm mortar and two heavy machine guns. Enemy losses in DODGE CITY totaled 42 KIA and one PW.

b. Enemy initiated contacts increased shortly after the "TET" holidays. On 230215H Feb, elements of the Q-91st Sapper Battalion launched the much heralded Winter-Spring Campaign. Using RPG's and satchel charges, they attacked artillery positions in the 2nd Battalion CP. Results of the action were 15 VC KIA and four PW's captured. Enemy forces also attacked friendly positions at the Cam Lo Bridge, Thanh Quit Bridge, Cap-2-5-3, Ha Dong Bridge, and friendly patrols throughout the TAOR.

c. Enemy units reported to have been deployed in the First Marines TAOR during the month of February were: elements of the 36th NVA Regiment, the R-20 Battalion, Q-91st and Q-92d Battalions, the T-89th Battalion, elements of the 68B NVA Artillery Regiment.

d. The number and employment of SFD's varied little from January, with a total of 137. This is a slight decrease from last month's total of 153. The majority of SFD's, which last month were in the 1st Battalion TAOR, shifted to the 2nd Battalion TAOR. The SFD's continue to be simple but effective devices made from grenades, mortar and artillery rounds or homemade from soft drink cans or C-Ration cans. SFD's were emplaced along trails, roads, and other areas frequented by friendly patrols. Most of the SFD's employed trip-wires. Pressure and command detonation were found on other SFD's. Of the 137 SFD's encountered 109 were discovered and neutralized, 28 were detonated.

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e. The enemy launched one rocket attack from within the 1st Marines TAOR. At 230345 Feb, OP Crowsnest, observed three rockets being fired from vic BT025673. Counter rocket fire was called and firing ceased.

f. There were 3 incidents of mortar fire and 2 incidents of RPG fire reported this month. On the 23rd, both 1st and 2nd Battalions received mortar and RPG fire. On the 25th, Company "F", 2nd Battalion received an unknown number of 82mm mortar rounds.

2. WEATHER. During February the weather had little or no effect on enemy and friendly operations. There was a total of 0.04 inches of rainfall during the month. Average high temperature for the month was 79° and the average low was 68°. The average humidity was 70% and visibility was good to excellent.

3. TERRAIN. The 1st Marines TAOR consists of fertile rice paddy land containing many small hamlets. Vegetation consists of stands of bamboo, hedgerows, and some wooded areas. Rivers and canals are found throughout the TAOR. Located in or passing through the TAOR are routes 1, 1B, 1C, 12B, 12W, 13C, and 538.

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PART II
SECTION C
OPERATIONS

1. During the month of February, the 1st Marines (Rein) continued to conduct offensive combat operations in the DANANG TACR. In addition to day and night small unit combat patrols and ambushes, the 1st Marines conducted seven cordon and search, or block and search operations. Of those operations conducted six were in coordination and cooperation with RVNAF.

a. On 2 Feb 1969, Company "H" 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines, Company "B" and Company "D" 1st Battalion, 1st Marines conducted cordon and search operations in the vicinity of TAN HANH and TRA KIE (2). In the operation involving Company "H", four detainees were taken to IIT for further questioning concerning enemy operations in this TACR. In the operation involving Company "B", four detainees were taken to IIT for further questioning concerning enemy operations in this TACR. In the combined operation of Company "B" and "D", drugs, documents, clothing, \$258,000 Piasters hidden in the hut, and enemy ordnance (B-40 rockets, small arms ammunition, and grenades) were captured.

b. On 3 Feb 1969, elements of two companies 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, in co-operation and coordination with the 51st Regiment (ARVN) participated in a cordon and search operation in the vicinity of TAN HANH. Approximately 15 reinforced bunkers and numerous SFD's were found and destroyed. Nine detainees, five whose names were on the CIT Black-list, were taken to IIT for further questioning.

c. A search and clear operation involving one company 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines in co-operation and coordination with the 51st Regiment (ARVN) was conducted on 12 Feb 1969 in the vicinity of CAU HA (2). The operation resulted in the destruction of nine bunkers and detention of 33 civilians for questioning. 1000 lbs of rice was also uncovered. Also found were 16 SFD's, one B-40 rocket, one RPG round, two LAAM's, 11 81mm mortar rounds, 24 60mm mortar rounds, three cases of 60mm fuzes, three cases FRC-10 batteries, three boats and miscellaneous equipment and personal gear.

d. On 14 Feb 1969, 1st Marines combined with the 51st Regiment (ARVN) to deny the VC/NVA use of the DODGE CITY area. The basic concept of the block and search operation called for Company "H" and Company "B" to be helo-lifted to the southern end of DODGE CITY. Two Bn's of the 51st Regiment (ARVN) would operate in the northern end of DODGE CITY while elements of the 7th Marines and 5th Marines would operate across the SONG THU PHU River to the west and southwest respectively. This closely coordinated operation denied the enemy use of an area needed by

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him to accomplish his mission of infiltrating the DANANG area during TET. The 1st Marines destroyed 183 sophisticated and well reinforced bunkers and tunnel complexes, captured two heavy machine guns, five SKS rifles, one AK-50 assault weapon, 5100 rounds of small arms ammunition, 117 B-40 rockets, an 82mm mortar tube with a plotting board, 17 mortar rounds, and 1500-2000 lbs of food. Artillery, air strikes and the individual Marine accounted for 42 enemy KIA's during this eight day operation.

e. On 23 Feb 1969 one company of the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines with one company of the 51st Regiment (ARVN) conducted a cordon and search of CAM SA (1) BT082648. Results, ten detainees, three pull friction fuzes, 50 ft of trip wire and miscellaneous tools.

f. On 23 Feb an estimated 70 VC/NVA took the 2/1 CP under fire at approximately 0215. Organic weapons fire and small arms from the Marines immediately accounted for 15 enemy KIA's and two wounded POW's. A search of the area later added two PW's, 15 AK-47 weapons, six B-40 rockets, two RPG launchers, one 9mm pistol, a bangalore torpedo, two 20-lb shaped charges, small arms ammunition and miscellaneous items of equipment.

g. On 26 Feb 1969 elements of the 2nd and 3rd Battalions, 1st Marines conducted a search and clear operation in the vicinity of VIEM DONG, CAM SA (1) and (2), and the MAN QUAN Peninsula, resulting in 14 VC/NVA KIA's, uniforms, NVA flags, and small arms ammunition captured.

h. Further liaison was made concerning coordination between 1st Marines and commanders of units within the Marble Mountain Mortar Belt. A command relationship annex to Regimental Op Order 314-68 will be published and disseminated to the units directly concerned.

2. Artillery and Naval Gunfire

a. Artillery

(1) General. During the month of February, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines and general support units of the 11th Marine Regiment provided artillery support for Marine and ARVN units in the 1st Marines TAOR. Coordination of fires was especially stressed to optimize artillery support. Counter rocket doctrine was also stressed to provide rapid and accurate counterbattery fire. 1st Battalion, 11th Marines provided spot teams at Crow's Nest BT06797049, Hawk AT97417039, and Parrot AT99266774 for counter rocket surveillance.

b. Naval Gunfire. The USS New Jersey (BB-62) fired eight missions and 78 rounds of prep fire in support of Company "B" and Company "M" on 13 February in the 1st Marines TACR prior to these two companies being helo-lifted to the southern border of DODGE CITY for a block and search operation.

a. General: The 1st Marines conducted a two company operation in DODGE CITY area and continued to employ maximum air support for this operation and throughout the rest of Regimental TACR during the month of February.

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SECTION D

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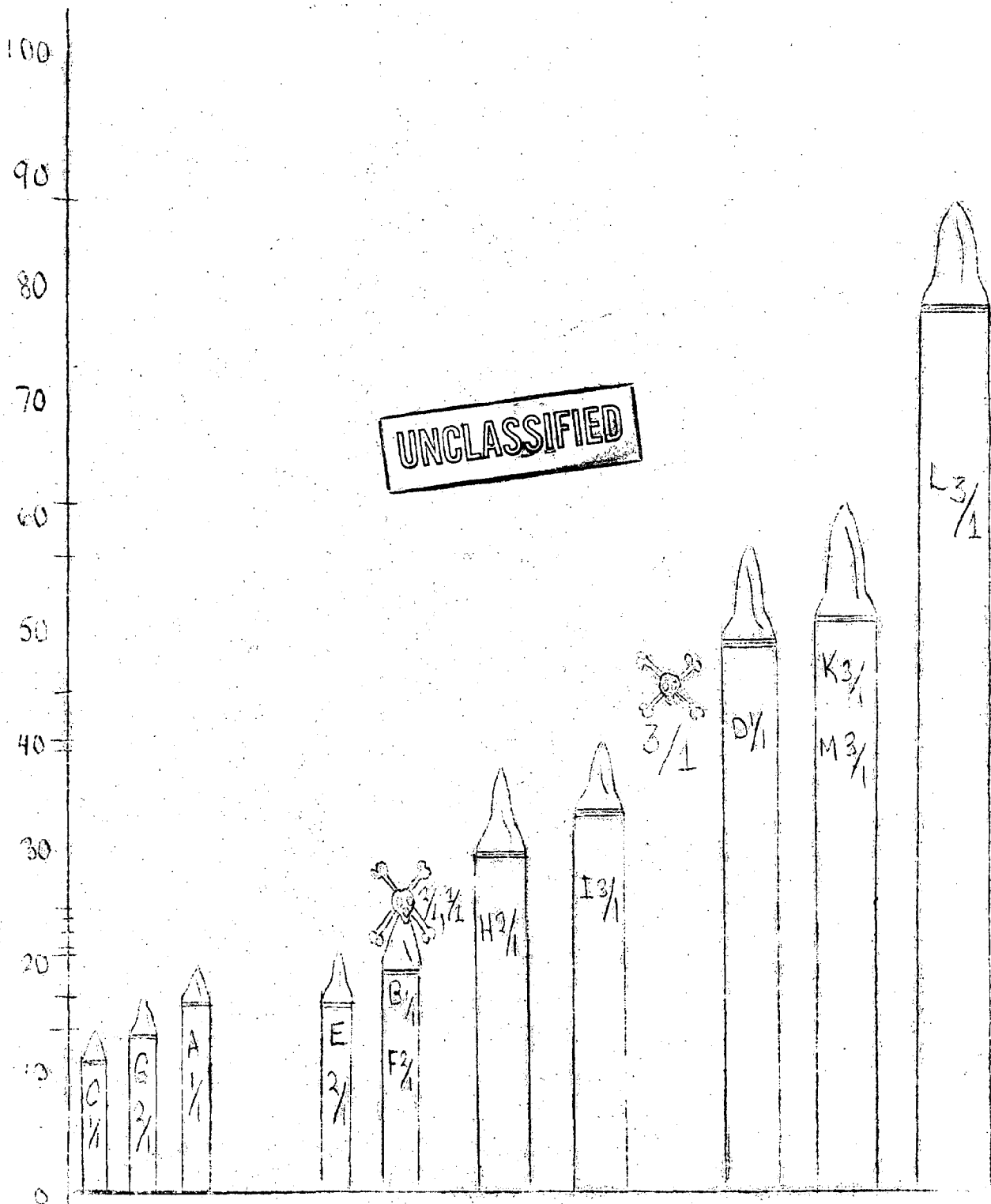
MARKSMANSHIP PROFICIENCY FOR FEB 69

PART II
SECTION E
LOGISTIC

1.1. SUPPLY. Normal day to day supply operations continued throughout the month with FLC as the supply point for all classes of supply. The fiscal records of the 1st Battalion were inspected this month with satisfactory results. A Supply Inspection Team from Division inspected Headquarters Company and 1st Battalion as part of the quarterly CMMI. Both units received a satisfactory rating. Phase II, Budget Submission was completed this month.

2. TRANSPORTATION. In general the transportation support was excellent this month. On a few occasions heavy trucks were in short supply for special requirements, but the delay was never critical. The 11th Motor Transport Battalion provided this command with seven additional trucks to augment the housekeeping trucks from 1st Motors. The augmentation was for the purpose of providing a capability of rapid reaction during this period of increased enemy activity.

3. MAINTENANCE AND ENGINEER ASSISTANCE.

a. Major construction in all cantonments is progressing very well. Tactical Engineer Support during the month was very satisfactory.

b. The equipment maintenance was provided by 1st FSR. The table depicts the number of Tactical Equipment Repair Orders submitted during February and of those submitted, the number completed:

4. EMBARKATION. During the month of February a Division Embarkation Team inspected Headquarters Company and 1st Battalion. The remainder of the regiment will be inspected in March and April.

5. SANITATION. All commands have active and responsive sanitation programs which have accomplished improvement in all areas. Construction of new head facilities has eliminated many persistent problems.

6. MEDICAL. During the month of February, medical facilities were maintained throughout the Regimental TAOR; each holding routine sick call daily and providing emergency treatment. The 1st Marines continues to have a low malaria incidence rate. Close supervision and control of pets has insured prevention of rabies and other diseases incurred from exposure to stray animals. Medical Facilities were manned by a total of 7 Medical Officers, and 158 Corpsman.

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ANNEX-F

CIVIL AFFAIRS-CIVIC ACTION

1. During the month of February, civil affairs/civic action efforts at the Regimental and Battalion level were slightly lessened by the TET Holidays and the recent NVA/VC Offensive in the 1st Marines TAOR. However, on four (4) separate occasions positive pro-GVN and pro-Marine attitudes have been demonstrated by local villagers willingly disclosing to Marines the whereabouts of enemy units and their movements. Local villagers contacted S-5 at 1st Battalion and disclosed the presence of an NVA/VC force in the DUC KY area (vic AT986615). Local villagers also contacted S-5 at 3rd Battalion concerning enemy movements and their positions in the TAOR. On two (2) separate occasions, Marines of G&P unit 2-5-3 were contacted by local villagers and informed of enemy movements and positions in nearby villages. Other positive aspects that surfaced during the recent offensive were all the Battalion S-5's expedience in assisting civilian casualties. Their efforts have received a very favorable response from the local populace.

2. S-5 Personnel of 1st Battalion procured and distributed approximately 3,400 special TET packets consisting of candy, toys, and cookies for the children of THANH QUI (BT0463), HA TAY (BT007645), BO MUNG (1) (BT025657), and VIEM TAY (BT0464) Hamlets as well as the BO DE School (BT035636). As a result of these actions, S-5 personnel were invited to and participated in the TET Festivities in these hamlets.

3. The project involving relocation of four (4) hamlets to the XUAN TRA area (vic BT068691) has been temporarily interrupted due to increased enemy activity. Further progress is contemplated when normal conditions in the area have been restored. The MedCap program in the 2nd Battalion TAOR continues to gain momentum despite recent adverse conditions. A MedCap hold in BINH KY (BT0670) during the month resulted in 200 persons receiving medical treatment. An HE (Audio-Visual) Team was employed in conjunction with the MedCap, and Vietnamese reception to the program was highly favorable. The S-5 personnel also distributed 3,000 TET packets to the children in TRA KHE (2) (BT0768), NUI KIM SON (BT070705), and BINH KY (BT0670) Hamlets during the TET Holidays.

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4. S-5 Personnel of 3rd Battalion participated in Cordon and Search Operation in TAN HANH Hamlet (BTO05655) during the month of February. A population census was initiated and completed in conjunction with the operation resulting in a recorded population of 400 residents, consisting of men (118), women (132), and children (150).

5. In the civic action field, S-5 personnel distributed 4,000 TET presents to the children of PHONG LE (1) (AT995698), MIEU BONG (1) (BTO16685), DUONG SON (3) (AT995670), QUANG CHAU (2) (BTO09685), and YEN NE (3) (AT985679) Hamlets, once again because of their actions, they were invited to and participated in the TET Festivities in the above mentioned hamlets. S-5 personnel also procured two (2) truckloads of dunnaged lumber from the Deep Water Piers and donated some to the hamlet of QUANG CHAU (2) (BTO09685) for a continuing home building project located there. As additional resources become available, more will be done. The S-5 distributed ten (10) 2"x4"'s for construction of a MedCap building in PHONG LE (2) (BTO02702). The project was coordinated with CAP unit 2-5-6, which occupies the hamlet.

6. The Vietnamese within the 1st Marines TAOR continues to respond favorably to programs. Recently there has been a marked improvement in civic responsibility displayed by many of the hamlet chiefs and village leaders. This improvement should make possible an increasing number of joint Marine and Vietnamese development projects.

COMMUNICATIONS

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1. During the month of February 1969, the 1st Marines Communication Platoon continued to provide radio, telephone (wire and radio relay), and teletype circuits from the Duong Son (2) cantonment to the 1st Marine Division, 1st Battalion, and 2nd Battalion. The Platoon maintained Comm/Crypto Guard for 3rd Battalion. Telephone circuits were maintained to the 7th Marines, 1/11, and its ALPHA, BRAVO, and CHARLIE Batteries, 1st Tanks, Co A/1st Engineers, CAP 2-5-4, Hoa Vang Sub-District Headquarters, 51st ARVN Regiment, and 1/51.

2. Primary emphasis during the first half of February was upon preparation for the Division GMI of the Regimental Communication Platoon. Results were "Satisfactory - Noteworthy Throughout." Emphasis was also placed upon assisting the battalions in preparing for their respective GMI's. During the month extensive work was also done preparing for the Division Embarkation Inspection. The Communication Platoons results were "Satisfactory with Many Noteworthy Areas."

3. During the month of February 1969, GSM Training was held twice weekly for all members of the Platoon and one-half hour of technical training was conducted daily by each Section.

4. The battalions each received 180 of the AM/PRC-88 Radio Sets during the month of February. The formulation of a concept of employment, to meet the requirements of each battalion, the compilation of usage data and the recording of "lessons learned" commenced. The initial reaction of using units has been enthusiastic and the limited frequencies available has been the only problem area encountered.
