SECTION B
ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN

1. Enemy. During the month of August, enemy activity increased over last month in the 1st Marines TAOR. The reason for the step up of enemy activity is attributed to the enemy's Summer/Fall Campaign, which began 12 August. In the early hours of 12 August, the Company "E" Patrol Base received 20-30 grenades, 20-30 RPG rounds, and small arms fire from a platoon size enemy force of the R-20th Battalion. Company "E" returned fire and called in a fire mission resulting in 9 VC KIA, 1 VC POW, 2 RPG launchers, 7 AK-47's and 1 9mm pistol captured. One half hour earlier, Combined Action Platoon (CAP) 2-7-3-(BT 018665) came under heavy attack from approximately 25 VC/NVA, receiving grenades, RPG's, satchel charges and small arms fire. The CAP unit returned fire resulting in 3 VC KIA and capturing 1 RPG Launcher, 1 AK-47 and 1 9mm pistol. The largest contact in the TAOR occurred in the early morning of 19 August, when an unknown size enemy force attacked the Company "A" Patrol Base, located AT 984675, the old regimental CP. Company "A" returned fire with organic weapons, artillery and had Spooky on station, killing 14 NVA soldiers and capturing 3 AK-47's. In keeping with the campaign, acts of terrorism and enemy propaganda were at the highest level in many months with reports of VC propaganda broadcasts in friendly hamlets and several NLF flags flying from high points in the TAOR. During a hamlet ceremony in Le Son (1) (AT 985661), two VC dressed as ARVN's entered the hamlet, killing the village chief, the hamlet chief, the daughter of the hamlet chief and wounding two other Vietnamese civilians.

a. Enemy units reported operating in the 1st Marines TAOR during the month of August were the R-20th Battalion, the Q-82nd Battalion and local hamlet guerrillas.

b. The number of mines/SFD's encountered in the 1st Marines TAOR increased over the previous month. On 12 August, Company "L" found an enemy minefield consisting of 7 homemade mines with tripwires located AT 959677. Three-hundred meters to the south, Company "L" found 4 M-26 grenades rigged as surprise firing devices. Mines continue to be made from U.S. ordnance such as grenades, mortar and artillery rounds or cans filled with C-4. One-hundred and thirty-six mines/SFD's were encountered, 71 were found and 65 detonated. Enemy mines/SFD's continue to inflict the majority of Marine casualties.

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c. There were two rocket and four lob bomb attacks initiated within the 1st Marines TAOR during August. Counter rocket fire was called on each site. The time, number and point of detonation are listed below.

2. Volunteer Informant Program (VIP). The VIP fund during the period continued to pay out large sums of money. The majority of ordnance was U.S. made and usually turned in by Vietnamese children. Listed below are the expenditures for the month of August.

3. Ground Surveillance. A new plan for employment of ground surveillance sensors has been implemented in the Eastern TAOR to aid in the detection of enemy movement and to learn his routes of resupply and infiltration.

4. Weather. Warm, humid weather prevailed throughout the TAOR and had little or no effect on friendly or enemy operations. The average high for August was 98 degrees and the average low was 76 degrees. The average humidity for the month was 74% with no rainfall measured.

5. Terrain. The 1st Marines TAOR consists of fertile rice paddy land, wooded areas and sand dunes. Scattered throughout the TAOR are many hamlets, rivers, streams and bamboo hedges. Located in or passing through the 1st Marines TAOR are routes 1, 1B, 1C, 1D, 4, 12E, 12W, 13C, 538 and 540.

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6. Operation Pipestone Canyon. 1st Marines with support from 3rd and 4th Battalions, 51st ARVN; 2nd ROKMC Brigade, and Provisional Land Clearing Company completed it's third month of search and destroy operations in the Dodge City/Go Noi Island area. Searching forces continued to make contact with enemy units and find numerous enemy bunkers and hiding places. On August 5th, a 3/51st ARVN ambush at BT 003543 initiated contact with an unknown size enemy unit resulting in 8 VC KIA and 5 captured AK-47's. Company "M", while on a company sweep on August 31st, observed 24-30 NVA moving east in the vicinity of AT 958534. The company called in artillery, 81mm mortars and engaged the enemy with small arms and automatic weapons fire resulting in 20 NVA KIA. While searching the area, Company "M" found 27 well constructed bunkers containing food and miscellaneous equipment and detained 12 Vietnamese in the area. Over 500 enemy bunkers and tunnels were found and destroyed during the month of August. Company "K" found a mutually supporting bunker/tunnel complex at AT 976568 which had been recently used. There was an increase in the number of enemy caches found in the Area of Operations over last month. In the area of several bunkers and tunnels, Company "M" found 2x155mm rounds, 5x81mm rounds, 17xM-79 rounds, 8xM-26 grenades, 4xClaymore mines, 3xLAWS, 10 sticks of C-4, 40 blasting caps, 40 feet of det cord and small amounts of rice, corn and tobacco. Friendly forces encountered fewer enemy mines/SFD's this month than in the 2 previous months of operations; finding 35, detonating 19 and observing numerous secondary explosions.

SECTION C
OPERATIONS1. GENERAL

a. The month of August opened with the 1st Marines committed to Operations PIPESTONE CANYON and DURHAM PEAK, to the defense of the Danang vital area and to conducting patrols and ambushes within the TAOR. The 1st Marines were deployed in such a fashion so as to deny the enemy freedom of movement within the TAOR. The 1st Battalion, 26th Marines was responsible for the defense of the Eastern TAOR, including the Tu Cam Bridge (vic BT01640), and the Cau Ha Combat Base (vic BT071656). The 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines was responsible for the defense of the Western TAOR, including the Cau Do Bridge (vic AT999705), the Ma Dong Bridge (vic AT991641) and the Duong Son (2) Combat Base (vic AT991678). The 3rd Battalion also was responsible for maintaining a force on Western Go Noi Island (PIPESTONE CANYON AO). The 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines was committed to Operation DURHAM PEAK and was under operational control of the 5th Marines. The 1st Battalion, 1st Marines had assumed the mission of mobile battalion, or, in other words, was Regimental Reserve.

b. Operation PIPESTONE CANYON continued with Regiment maintaining one (1) rifle company on western Go Noi Island while Operation DURHAM PEAK terminated for the 1st Marines on 7 August 1969 to allow BLT 1/26 to backload and depart the area on 8 August 1969. Immediately upon the departure of BLT 1/26 the regiment commenced preparations to expand the TAOR in accordance with division orders.

c. Throughout the month of August, in support of the Accelerated Pacification Campaign (APC), the 1st Marines (Rein) conducted cordon and search operations designed to destroy VCI operating in the TAOR.

d. On 151100Z Aug 1969 the 1st Marines TAOR was expanded and the Regiment assumed operation control of 3/7 and 1/7. The CP moved to Hill 55 (Camp Joseph E. Muir) and opened at 181000Z Aug 1969. At the same time 3/7 was released to 7th Marines and they departed for their new regimental CP at LZ BALDY. They were followed by 1/7 on 29 Aug 1969.

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57502. OPERATION PIPESTONE CANYON

a. The month of August saw Operation PIPESTONE CANYON enter its fourth month with Phase IV continuing. At the beginning of the month, Company "L" was patrolling on Western Go Noi Island; 3/51 ARVN was operating on central Go Noi Island; 4/51 was operating in DODGE CITY; and elements of the 2d ROKIC Bde were operating on Eastern Go Noi Island and in Easter DODGE CITY area.

b. Light contact was maintained with the enemy throughout the month in the PIPESTONE CANYON AO. The enemy continued to attempt to avoid contact and to harass friendly forces with surprise firing devices.

c. On 2 August 1969, Co "M" relieved Co "L" in place on Western Go Noi Island and continued the active patrolling and ambushing activities required to deny the enemy access to infiltration routes on and through Western Go Noi Island.

d. At 2230H on 5 August, the 3/51st ARVN ambushed an unknown size enemy force vic BT003534. The ambush was successful and eight VC were killed, four AK-47's were captured and the ARVN's sustained no casualties.

e. At 1000H on 6 August, 3/1 (-)(Rein) commenced a search and destroy operation in DODGE CITY. After some difficulty, caused by an LVTP5 throwing a track, 3/1 (-)(Rein) crossed the line of departure at 1300 and commenced its attack.

f. At 1930 on 6 August, M/3/1 while sweeping an area in the vicinity of AT969559, received small arms fire from an unknown size enemy force. The Marines returned fire with organic weapons and requested and received artillery support. The results of the encounter: two NVA killed by artillery.

g. In general, very little contact was made with the enemy by 3/1 (-)(Rein) during their operation in DODGE CITY. Several of the reported contacts occurred on 8 August. At 0900 1/3/1 in the vicinity of BT023604 received approximately 100 rounds of small arms fire from a tree line to their north. The company returned fire with organic weapons, 50 caliber machineguns, and 90mm tank fire. As a result of the encounter, one Marine was WIA and one NVA was killed. Later the same day, the scout/sniper team attached to K/3/1 observed two NVA vic BT012584. Two shots were fired, and two NVA died.

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h. On 9 August, 3/1 (-)(Rein) terminated the search and destroy operation in DODGE CITY and returned to the Duong Son (2) Combat Base.

i. At 1400 on 10 August, M/3/1 on Western Go Noi Island via AT976536 observed ten NVA in high grass. The Marines of Company "M" fired 81mm mortars, 105mm DS Arty, and 8" GS Arty at the NVA force. During the fire mission, an additional ten NVA were seen to get up and attempt to flee the area. As a result of the prompt and accurate fire, eleven NVA were killed by artillery.

j. During the month a continuing effort to keep Route 4 open to traffic was being made. This effort, while in general was successful, was not without losses. At 1140H on 13 August, a two and one-half ton truck detonated a 40 pound box mine via BT015569. The explosion killed two Marines, wounded two Marines, and destroyed the truck.

k. At 1200 on 15 August, the Provisional Land Clearing Company (STEAMROLLER) returned to DODGE CITY. K/3/1 commenced providing security for land clearing operations.

l. At 1000H on 16 August, L/1 commenced a combined operation in DODGE CITY with elements of the 2nd ROKMC Bde. This operation continued, with no significant contact being made, until 19 August.

m. At 0800H on 19 August, C/1/1 relieved K/3/1 of the responsibility for providing security for land clearing operations in SOUTHWESTERN DODGE CITY. The 1st Provisional Land Clearing Company was levelling that area of DODGE CITY bounded on the west by grid line 98, on the east by the RR Berm, on the south by the river and on the north by Route 4.

n. At 1515 on 21 August, M/3/1, supported by a light section of tanks from Company "B", 1st Tank Battalion, conducted a sweep operation on western Go Noi Island. During the operation, a tank detonated an unknown size mine. Three Marines were wounded and evacuated and the tank received moderate damage as a result of the explosion. At 0345 the following morning, M/3/1 while in a Company Patrol Base was attacked by an unknown size enemy force. The enemy fired small arms, and RPG's, one of which hit the previously disabled tank. As a result of this encounter, one USMC was KIA, two USMC were WIAE, one tank was hit by RPG's, one VC was killed, and one AK-47 was captured.

o. At 1700H on 22 August, a tank, supporting M/3/1 detonated a mine. The tank was destroyed by the fire which resulted from the detonation of the mine. Six Marines were wounded and evacuated.

p. At 1000H on 22 August, the Provisional Land Clearing Company was withdrawn from Southwestern DODGE CITY, after having cleared 2,594,000 sq meters, and returned to 7th Engineers.

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q. On the 26th and 27th of August, 3/1 (-)(Rein) conducted a combined operation with the 51st ARVN in western DODGE CITY Area.

r. At 1100H on 31 August M/3/1, while on a company sweep vic AT958544, observed 27 NVA and called 81mm mortar and DS artillery on the enemy force. Six were killed by Arty, 11 were killed by 81's and three were killed by small arms fire for a total of 20 NVA dead.

s. Phase IV of Operation PIPESTONE CANYON continued through the month of August. This phase of the operation consisted of combined USMC, ARVN and ROKMC operations in the AO, patrols and ambushes on western Go Noi Island, and land clearing operations in southwestern DODGE CITY - all of which were designed to deny the enemy freedom of movement and to destroy any enemy forces encountered within the PIPESTONE CANYON AO.

3. OTHER OPERATIONS

a. Expanded TAC. During the month, the 1st Marines (Rein) continued aggressive patrolling and ambush operations with heavy emphasis on the rocket belt. Cordon and search operations were conducted by elements of the Regiment in six hamlets designated for upgrading in accordance with the Accelerated Pacification Campaign (APC). On 151100H August, the Regiment assumed control of the expanded TAC in accordance with Division orders, and also assumed opcon of 3/7 and 1/7. The Regiment was not to remain at five battalion strength for long however, as 3/7 returned to its parent regiment on 180600H Aug 1969 and 1/7 followed on 211000H Aug 1969. First Marines opened their new CP on Hill 55 at 181000H Aug 1969.

b. DURHAM PEAK. The 1st Battalion phased into Operation DURHAM PEAK (controlling headquarters: 5th Marines) during 3-4 August 1969 relieving the 2nd Battalion and remained in the Que Son Mountains until 7 August when they were withdrawn and returned to the Regiment.

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c. Cordon & Search. During the month of August, several cordon and search operations in support of the Accelerated Pacification Campaign (APC) were conducted by the 1st Marines. These operations were as listed in the following sub-paragraphs:

(1) On 1 August, the 1st Battalion conducted a cordon and search of An Thanh (1) (vic BT030618), and 1/26 conducted a cordon and search of Vien Tay (1) (vic BT040640);

(2) On 2 August, 1/26 conducted a cordon and search of An Tra (1) (vic BT079696);

(3) On 4 August, 3rd Battalion conducted a cordon and search of Bo Hung (2) (vic BT028651);

(4) On 11 August, 2nd Battalion conducted a cordon and search of Tan Luu (vic BT078703);

(5) On 29 August, the 1st Battalion conducted a cordon and search of La Huan (2) (vic AT9760).

d. Miscellaneous

(1) A squad combat patrol, at 020800H, from K/3/1 detonated a surprise firing device vic BT027623. As a result of the explosion, seven Marines were wounded in action and evacuated, and three Marines were wounded in action and not evacuated.

(2) At 0815H on 6 August a 1st Marine AO spotted six NVA with weapons vic BT070628. The NVA opened fire at the AO, the AO returned fire and killed four NVA.

(3) On 8 August BLT 1/26 was CHOPped to CG, 1st Mar Div.

(4) At 0130H on 12 August, E/2/1 while in a Company Patrol Base vic BT098665 was attacked by an unknown size enemy force. During the attack, the unit received 25 grenades and three RPG rounds. The unit returned fire and successfully repulsed the enemy attack. The results of the encounter: one USMC KIA, four USMC WIAE, nine VC KIA, one dtnee, one pistol, four AK-47's and two RPG launchers captured.

(5) On 12 August, the 3rd Battalion conducted a search and destroy operation astride the Song Yen to locate possible rocket caches.

(6) On 15 August, 3/1 began displacing to Hill 37.

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(7) On 181100H August, a truck in a convoy moving elements of 3/1 to Hill 37, detonated a mine via AT954593. As a result of the explosion, ten USMC were wounded and evacuated, one Marine was wounded and not evacuated, and one 2½ ton truck was destroyed.

(8) At 1645 on 11 August, a platoon combat patrol from L/3/1 detonated a 60mm round rigged as an SFD via AT972660. While extracting the wounded, a daisy chain of SFD's was detonated. The results of the two mining incidents: one USMC KIA, six USMC WIAE, and three USMC WIANE.

(9) On 18 August the 1st Marines CP displaced to Hill 55.

(10) At 2200H, on 20 August, the 1st Marines received the first lobbed bomb attack. One 105mm round, the explosive filler of which had been replaced with ammonium nitrate, was lobbed into the combat base. The round failed to detonate.

(11) On the night of 21, 22 August, the 1st Marines' CP was attacked by rockets. In two attacks, three hours apart, Hill 55 took a total of 3x140mm rockets (one of which failed to explode), and one 155mm lob bomb. Damage and casualties were light.

(12) The month of August, with Operation PIPESTONE CANYON continuing, with 2nd Battalion, and 1st Battalion participating in Operation DURHAM PEAK, and with the expanded TAOR remaining a major area of concern, fully occupied the 1st Marines. Enemy forces, while launching one rocket attack on DaNang and while attacking, on two occasions, fixed installations within the Regimental TAOR, continued to harass the busy Marines of the 1st Marines with SFD's.

4. COMBAT SUPPORT OPERATIONS

a. Artillery

(1) Throughout the month of August, the First Battalion, 11th Marines continued the assigned mission of providing direct support artillery for Marine and ARVN units operating in both the 1st Marines TAOR and in the Operation PIPESTONE CANYON AO.

(2) During August, shifts in units OPCON to First Marines necessitated the shifting of artillery units. On 070810H B/1/11 was returned to the operational control of 1/11, having supported Second Battalion, First Marines on Operation DURHAM PEAK. A/1/13 and the mortar battery, 1/11 were returned to the operational control of the SLF on 100844H.

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(3) During the month of August, a new system of political clearance was initiated. Liaison with Quang Da Special Zone was effected by First Marines FSCC. Under this program, the Marine battalion that has tactical responsibility for the area of operation into which the target falls clears the target with the district headquarters concerned; ensuring the safety of the civilian populace.

d. Psychological Operations

(1) The PsyOps program has been progressing in each of the CAAOR's during the past month at a very successful rate. A daily broadcast and leaflet drop schedule has been established in each battalion's AO. The schedule is supplemented with the frequent employment of HB and HE Teams throughout the TAOR in support of all phases of PsyOps. The people are responding to the employment of PsyOps in support of MedCaps and DentCaps. Also, the effect of Gordon and Search Operation employing PsyOps yields a better response. The distribution of propaganda materials by infantry units continues at an active rate as does the Volunteer Informant Program. The vehicle that was used by the HB Team, attached to 1st Marinos, was pulled back to the 7th PsyOps Battalion for further commitments from there. Shortly after that the HB Team itself was pulled back to the 7th PsyOps Battalion to be committed upon request with prior warning time. This action resulted in a loss of timely exploitation that was readily available if an incident did occur. Broadcast time that was accomplished by the HB Team in a "Circuit Rider" role was completely curtailed. This affected our overall program as the battalions don't have the means or time to conduct "Circuit Rider" broadcasts throughout the TAOR. The switching of CAAOR's and moving of battalions has caused some difficulties

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and slowed our program temporarily. This was caused mostly by the changes in CAAOR boundaries and no information left on target audiences in the areas picked up in the AO expansion. PsyOps was employed in conjunction with programs being initiated in the Western CAAOR and in support of the rice harvest. During the turnover one terrorist act was committed in DAI LOC (AT916578) and was exploited in a timely fashion by a POET from the 7th PsyOps Battalion.

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5750**2. Marksmanship Training Report for August 1969.****a. Ranges utilized by 1st Marines:**

(1) During the month of August, 128 Marines were trained on the 1st Bn, 1st Marines range located in the vicinity of BT014627, spending a total of thirteen hours conducting M-16 FAM fire, obtaining battle-sights and practicing Quick-Fire/Quick Kill techniques.

(2) On the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines range during the month of August 131 Marines were trained in Quick Fire/Quick Kill techniques, M-16 FAM Fire and battlesights adjustment. The 1000 inch range is located at Second Battalion Command Post at Cau Ha 15 1/2 hours of training were conducted on the range.

(3) During August 170 Marines were trained on the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines range utilizing 2 1/2 hours of firing time. The range is located at the 3rd Battalion Command Post on Hill 37.

LOGISTICS

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1. SMITHY-LOGISTICS. Forward supply point distribution was used throughout August, with FLO providing all classes of supplies. The Command Material Management Inspection team conducted a supply inspection of 1st Battalion on 4 August awarding a rating of "satisfactory with discrepancies". Resupply was conducted from Hill 55 L94 during Operation FLINTSTONE GANYEN throughout August. Breakdown is shown below.

2. TRANSPORTATION. Motor transport support throughout August was excellent. The eighteen M54 2-ton trucks provided by the 1st Motor Transport Battalion, in direct support of the Regiment, were utilized to their maximum. Vehicular support from the 11th Motor Transport Battalion enhanced the Regiment's ability to pick up and deliver supplies, equipment and personnel, including personnel participating in the "Stack Arms" RAR program and in support of the regimental S-5 Civic Action Program. During August, the entire Regiment was redistributed throughout the TAOB, requiring constant transportation support. During the month 11th MT Battalion provided a total of 76 5-ton M55 trucks, 6 5-ton M52 tractor trucks, 15 M127 12-ton semi-trailers, and 23 3/4-ton M101 trailers, while 1st MT Battalion provided an additional 4 M54 2-ton trucks. Resupply capability was also achieved by the 3rd Battalion with the utilization of 6 M101 amphibious cargo carriers in support of tactical operations during late August.

3. MAINTENANCE AND ENGINEER ASSISTANCE

a. Engineer effort and assistance during the month of August were excellent. The Land Clearing project, of a 1,000 meter radius around

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the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines Combat Base was completed with the support of (6) Bulldozers from 7th Engineers. A new 40ft VIP tower was constructed for the Regiment.

b. Equipment maintenance was provided by 1st PSN. The following table depicts the number of Tactical Equipment Repair Orders submitted and completed during August.

4. PACKAGING. Discrepancies which were noted in conjunction with the Command Material Management Inspection are still being corrected.

5. SANITATION. Conscientious sanitation programs have been continued by all of the 1st Marines Battalions and Headquarters Company. All sanitation problems receive immediate attention and a high state of police is maintained throughout the 1st Marines Combat Bases.

6. MEDICAL. During the month of August medical facilities were maintained throughout the Regimental TAOR. Each facility held routine sick call twice daily and gave emergency treatment to those who needed it. The medical facilities were manned by a total of 6 Medical Officers, 2 Dental Officers, 164 Corpsman and 2 Dental Technicians. CIVIL AFFAIRS-CIVIC ACTION

1. PUBLIC WORKS

- a. During this month work continued on resettlement at Tu Cau (BT 055658). Construction on the site was slow at first due to a lack of materials, however repeated dunnage runs and material assistance from 1st Medical Battalion and G-5 contributed to substantial progress. In addition, tin finally arrived from Dien Ban District and the houses went up quickly. To date nine homes have been completed, housing eighteen families. This month two wells were dug with four more planned for next month. Approximately ten new houses have been constructed, adjacent to the resettlement village, by people seeking GVN protection.
- b. Materials were supplied to various hamlets in the Dai Loc District for reconstruction of houses destroyed by artillery fire during contact missions. The S-5 section of the Western Battalion provided the necessary materials for the construction of desks and chairs for a newly built school in Dai Loc (AT 918576). Eighty CARE school kits were distributed to the children attending that school. Another school at Mieu Dong (BT 024682) was supplied with tin and cement in order to complete its reconstruction. This type of Civic Action is very popular with the local civilians and demonstrates our willingness to help with projects which do not directly benefit the Allied war effort.
- c. Ten barrels of gasoline (55 gallons each) were transported to the villagers of Ha Tay (BT 010645). The gas is needed to operate a village water pump used to keep the water in the rice paddies at the correct level.

2. WELFARE

- a. During the past month the 1st Marines have conducted several Gorden and Search operations at La Huan (2) (AT 980605), Bo Mung (BT 028657) and Vieu Tay (4) (BT 015648). Hot meals and water were provided to a total of 1100 civilians in the three areas combined.
- b. Contributions in the form of food were given to the people of Tu Cau and Xuan Tra resettlements. These included over 500 lbs. of fresh food and over 2000 lbs of captured rice. Throughout the 1st Marines CAACOR a total of three thousand pounds of fresh food and rice were distributed, exclusive of the food provided on three

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Gordon and Search operations. Two hundred pounds of soap were distributed through MedCaps as part of the sanitation and personal hygiene program which is being emphasized throughout the 1st Marines Civic Action Area of Responsibility. Six hundred (600) pounds of clothing were brought to the Tu Cau Resettlement and distributed throughout the hamlet.

3. EDUCATION

- a. A school at the Xuan Tra (BT 064676) resettlement hamlet is still in the planning stages and work will commence as soon as the necessary supplies are made available. One school at Dai Loc (AT 918576) was completed this month and personnel from the S-5 section of the Western Battalion attended the dedication ceremony.
- b. The 1st Marines have submitted applications for 300 General Walt Scholarships for the school year that will start in September. At this point it is doubtful that we will receive the funds to support all these children (500 piasters each) due to the relatively small amount the 1st Marine Division was allocated.
- c. At present 130 school kits have been distributed and 500 more will be given out as soon as the school year begins.

4. HEALTH

- a. MedCaps treated approximately 3600 people this past month. Three Gordon and Search operations accounted for approximately half of these. Construction of a MedCap building is planned for the Western Battalion's CP. It will be located outside the main gate of their compound. One Vietnamese male nurse has been trained and serves with U.S. Navy Corpsmen on all MedCaps. DentCaps were responsible for treating approximately 60 people.
- b. The third and final set of Plague and Cholera shots for the students of Bo De School (BT 034640) have been scheduled for early September.

5. AGRICULTURAL

- a. Rice harvest time is approaching and plans are underway to provide security for the harvest. District officials have set up schedules for the various areas and the S-5's and S-3's will be working closely with the harvesting operations to ensure that the

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Viet Cong do not interfere.

b. Eight bags of cornmeal were distributed to the villagers of Ha Tay (BT 010645) and An Tu (BT 025638). The food was used to feed pigs supplied through U.S. agricultural sources.

6. SOCIAL

a. During the past month, personnel from the three Battalion S-5's provided transportation for local Vietnamese to visit with their relatives in hospitals throughout the Da Nang area.

b. During the past month, orientation lectures were given to all incoming troops. The lectures covered Civic Action, Psyops, Personal Response and Vietnamese Customs and Religions. Personnel from the Division Personal Response Team gave lectures to 870 Marines throughout the Regiment.

7. SECURITY

a. During the past month three Cordon and Search operations were held as part of Phase II of the 1969 Pacification and Development Plan to eliminate Viet Cong and Viet Cong Infrastructure from the hamlets within our TAOR. The program has been highly successful and has resulted in the capture or killing of 30 local Viet Cong agents.

b. The protective wire around the barn at the Tu Cau Village was completed this month. Additional wire is being laid to improve the position. Regional Force troops have built numerous bunkers on the barn and they run patrols at night to provide added security.

c. During this reporting period it was decided to obtain an overlay from each of the four districts in our TAOR, depicting the areas which are populated and are not to be fired into for H&I purposes. This should greatly reduce the number of civilians accidentally hit by H&I fire. At present an overlay has been received from Hoa Vang District, and Dai Loc District Headquarters. Within the next two weeks Dien Ban and Hieu Duc Districts should respond.

8. SOLATIUMS

a. There were numerous incidents during the month requiring solatium payments. Altogether thirty-eight (38) solatiums were paid out totalling 60,000 \$VN. Some of the incidents were caused by H&I fire and counter rocket fire. However, most were due to increased enemy activity which resulted in many contact artillery missions.

COMMUNICATIONS

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1. During the first part of August 1969, the 1st Marines Communication Platoon continued to provide Radio, Telephone (integrated landline and radio relay), and Teletype Circuits from Ducng Son (2) Combat Base to the 1st Marine Division and the 1st Marine Division and the 2nd and 3rd Battalions. The Communication Center maintained Comm/Crypto Guard for the 1st Battalion until 12 August. From 12 to 18 August the Communication Center Guarded for the 3rd Battalion. Telephone Circuits were maintained with the 7th Marines, 1/11, Battery "C", 1st Tanks, Co. "A", 1st Engineers, Non Vang Sub-District Headquarters, 1/51st ARVN and 51st ARVN Regiment. From 19 August to the end of the month, as a result of the move to Hill 55, the above services were afforded plus the Communication Center assumed Comm/Crypto Guard for 7th Marines, 1/7, 3/11 and 6th Platoon 1st Radio Battalion on 19 August. Comm/Crypto Guard was picked-up for 1/11 on 20 August and on 22 August dropped for 7th Marines and 3/11. On 24 August the Comm/Crypto Guard was dropped for 1/7. Again, as a result of the move to Hill 55, additional Telephone Circuits were installed and maintained with the following units: 5th Marines, Co. "B", 1st Tr Bn, LSA, LSC, 6th Platoon, 1st Radio Battalion and 3rd Platoon, Co. "A", 1st EngBn.
2. During August emphasis was placed on displacing the Regimental Headquarters.
3. During the latter part of the month, the main area of concern was the AC Voltage loss experienced throughout the Compound. Division Engineers have been notified and an Electrical Contact Team is expected.
