SECTION B  
ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN

1. Enemy. During the month of September, enemy activity reached a high for the Summer months due to a continuation of the enemy's Summer/Fall Campaign. Enemy initiated contacts were directed against friendly CP's, bridges, PPB's, and patrols. On 9 September, a platoon of Company "I", while being led by a Hoi Chanh to retrieve his weapon, received small arms fire and RPG rounds from a platoon size enemy force. The unit returned fire with small arms, automatic weapons and M-79 fire, resulting in 14 NVA KIA, 9 VCS detained and 200 lbs. of rice captured. On 12 September, 1st Marines' Scout Snipers observed 5 VC/NVA moving north along the Song Yen. The Snipers opened fire resulting in 3 VC KIA, 1 NVA KIA, and 1 VC WIA POW. During September, the enemy also continued his high rate of propaganda and acts of terrorism. Several NVA flags and numerous propaganda leaflets were found throughout the 1st Marines' TAOR. In Ai My Hamlet, vic AT918571, during a meeting in the Hamlet Chief's house, VC terrorists threw in a 20 lb. satchel charge, killing 3 civilians and wounding 8. During an official's meeting in Ngan Cau Hamlet (1), vic BT065688, a 14-year-old boy threw in a satchel charge, resulting in 7 civilians killed and 26 wounded. Also, two incidents of Viet Cong kidnappings of young boys were reported within the 1st Marines' area. Several notable enemy ammunition caches were discovered during September. On 20 September, a detainee led a squad from Company "E" and members of 3rd IFF to 28 122mm rockets buried at BT073638. On 29 September, Company "K" found 48 RPG rounds with boosters buried in canisters, located at AT958559. One food cache was discovered by 2nd Battalion's S-5 when they found 700 lbs. of rice, 25 lbs. of potatoes, and 5 lbs. of salt in a field located at BT062643. Marine units also found and destroyed 90 enemy bunkers and tunnels within the TAOR.

a. Enemy units reported operating in the 1st Marines' TAOR during September were the R-20th Battalion, the Q-82nd Battalion, the 223rd Transportation Battalion, and local hamlet guerrillas. This is the first time the 223rd Transportation Battalion has been known to operate within the 1st Marines' TAOR.

b. The number of mines/SFD's encountered in the 1st Marines' TAOR during September were the highest of the Summer months. On 8 September, 27 SFD's were found during a sweep along the Song Yen. Surprise Firing Devices continue to be made from U.S. ordnance, such as grenades, mortar and artillery rounds, or cans filled with C-4.

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Two-hundred and thirty mines/SFD's were encountered, with 173 found and 57 detonated, 5 by civilians. Mines/SFD's continue to inflict the majority of Marine casualties.

c. There were six lob bomb and one rocket attack initiated within the 1st Marines' TAOR during September. Marine forces found a total of 39 122mm rockets, 3 rocket launching sites and 1 lob bomb site. The time, number and detonation of the rocket and lob bomb attacks are listed below.

2. Volunteer Informant Program (VIP). The VIP Fund during the period continued to pay out large sums of money. The majority of ordnance was U.S. made and usually turned in by Vietnamese children.

3. Ground Surveillance. With the use of ground surveillance sensors and night observation devices (NOD's) throughout the TAOR, over fifty artillery missions were called in to harass and prevent enemy movement within the TAOR. Ground surveillance sensors have helped to confirm or deny suspected enemy infiltration and supply routes located within the 1st Marines' TAOR.

4. Weather. Warm, humid weather prevailed throughout the TAOR and had little or no effect on friendly or enemy operations. The average high for September was 90 degrees and the average low was 74 degrees. The average humidity for the month was 76% with 13.45 inches of rainfall measured.

5. Terrain. The 1st Marines' TAOR consists of fertile rice paddy land, and wooded areas and sand dunes. Scattered throughout the TAOR are many hamlets, rivers, streams and bamboo hedges. Located in, or passing through the TAOR are Routes 1, 1B, 1C, 1D, 4, 12E, 12W, 13C, 538 and 540.

6. Operation PIPESTONE CANYON. During the month of September, enemy activity in the DODGE CITY/Go Noi Island area decreased to the lowest in the last four months. Only three significant contacts were reported during September, resulting in 12 VC/NVA KIA, 3 SKS's, 2 AK-47's, 1 M-1 Carbine, and 1 RPG Launcher captured. No significant caches were found in the area of operations. Twenty-three enemy bunkers and tunnels were found and destroyed during September. Twenty-two mines/SFD's were encountered by friendly forces, finding 16 and detonating 6. Enemy forces reported operating in the DODGE CITY/Go Noi Island area were the R-20th Battalion, the Q-82nd Battalion, the 223rd Transportation Battalion, and local hamlet guerrillas.

SECTION C  
OPERATIONS1. GENERAL

a. The month of September saw the 1st Marines committed to a wide range of interrelated activities, including Operation PIPESTONE CANYON; the defense of the Danang vital area; vigorous patrolling and ambush operations within the rocket belt; the support of the Accelerated Pacifica-tion Campaign (APC); rice harvest security in coordination with GVN rice denial operations and the provision of security forces for the GVN sponsored elections which were held on the 7th and 28th of September. The 1st Marines were deployed so as to deny the enemy his freedom of move-ment within the TAOR. The 2nd Battalion continued to be responsible for the defense of the Eastern TAOR, including the Tu Cau Bridge (Vic BT041640), the Cau D. Bridge (Vic AT999705), the Ha Dong Bridge (Vic AT991641), the Cau Ha Combat Base (Vic BT071656) and the Leprosarium (Vic BT098664). The 3rd Battalion continued to be responsible for the defense of the Western TAOR, including Hill 37, the Golden Gate Bridge (Vic AT965604), the Marshall Bridge (Vic AT919598), the No Name Bridge (Vic AT999699) and the MCB Bridge (Vic AT915506). The 3rd Battalion was also tasked with responsibility for maintaining one rifle company on Western Go Noi Island (PIPESTONE CANYON AO). The 1st Battalion continued its mission as Mobile Battalion (Reg-imental Reserve) throughout the month. At 1730H on the 4th, the battalion with two companies returned to the operational control of the 1st Marines after being OPCON to the 7th Marines at LZ DALBY since 1330H, 29 August. At 1120 on the 25th, the 1st Battalion with three companies was again committed to a search and destroy operation in Northeastern DODGE CITY as part of Phase IV PIPESTONE CANYON. The 1st Battalion again assumed its responsibility as the Regimental Reserve at 1030H on the 29th, when it terminated operations in DODGE CITY.

b. Normal patrol and ambush activities were conducted throughout the 1st Marines TAOR (less PIPESTONE CANYON), with increased emphasis placed on combined operations with elements of the 51st ARVN Regiment and local Regional Force units. Overall, these small unit activities resulted in an increase over the previous month in the number of sightings and contacts with small groups of VC and NVA, as the enemy focused his attention on rice gathering operations throughout the TAOR.

2. OPERATION PIPESTONE CANYON

a. September saw Operation PIPESTONE CANYON enter its fifth month with Phase IV continuing. As the month began, Company "M" was saturating Western Go Noi Island with patrols and ambushes, while 3/51st ARVN was conducting similar activities on the central portion of the island. To the north, 4/51st ARVN was operating in DODGE CITY; and three companies of the 2nd ROKMC Bri-gade were operating on Eastern Go Noi Island and in the Eastern DODGE CITY area.

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B. Within the PIPESTONE CANYON AO, contact with the enemy remained generally light, with enemy activities limited for the most part to harassing friendly forces with surprise firing devices, while attempting to avoid contact as much as possible. However, as the month progressed, sightings of small groups of enemy soldiers north of Route 4 indicated the presence of an unknown size enemy force in the Northern DODGE CITY area. This prompted the commitment of the 1st Battalion with three companies to that area on the 25th to search out and destroy the enemy and his supply caches in North and Northeastern DODGE CITY.

(1) At 1120H on the 25th, Companies "C" and "D" were heli-lifted into zones located at AT990595 and BT010604. Simultaneously, Company "A" and the Battalion CP, reinforced with a section of tanks and a section of amphibian tractors, crossed the LCD along Highway 4 and moved north to block enemy attempts to exfiltrate southward from the battle area.

(2) In general, very little contact was made with the enemy during the 1st Battalion's operation in Northern DODGE CITY. The most significant contacts with the enemy occurred on the 25th. At 1630H, a tank with A/1/1 detonated an 80 pound box mine (Vic BT006501) resulting in heavy damage to the tank and wounding four Marines. Later that evening, at 2015H, a platoon patrol base from C/1/1 (Vic AT991598) received automatic weapons fire, M-79 and possible B-40 rocket fire resulting in one Marine wounded. After returning fire with organic weapons, the enemy broke contact leaving no sign of casualties. Fifteen minutes later, a Company "C" LP in the same area received similar enemy fire. Again, after friendly employment of organic weapons, the enemy broke contact with no sign of enemy casualties. At 2300H, D/1/1 (Vic BT023598) received seven rounds of unknown size mortar fire and observed thirteen enemy soldiers to their east. Organic weapons, artillery and mortar fire were directed against the enemy and the suspected mortar site; however, darkness and dense vegetation precluded any battle damage assessment. No friendly casualties were sustained during this encounter.

(3) The remaining four days of the 1st Battalion's operation in DODGE CITY was characterized by minor encounters and sightings of small groups of enemy as the VC/NVA avoided contacts. Numerous bunkers and small caches of ordnance, supplies and equipment were found and destroyed as the battalion's efforts shifted to Eastern DODGE CITY. Here, numerous surprise firing devices were encountered, indicating that the enemy had withdrawn from the area. At 1930H, 29 September, 1/1 (-) (Rein) terminated operations in DODGE CITY and returned to the Mobile Battalion Combat Base.

3. OTHER OPERATIONSa. Rice Denial Operations

(1) Rice denial efforts conducted by the 1st Marines during September were characterized by saturation patrols and ambushes in those areas considered prime target areas for enemy rice gathering activities.

(2) In the Eastern TAOR, the 2nd Battalion working in coordination with GVN officials from Hoa Vang District centered its rice denial efforts in the heavily cultivated areas flanking the Song Cau Bien, south of Nui Kim Son. In the Western TAOR, the 3rd Battalion centered its denial operations in the rich rice producing areas flanking the Song Yen, north of Hill 55. Particular effort was directed to denying the enemy the rice grown east of Hill 22 (Vic AT953667) in the Bo Ban and Duyen Son areas where rice fields were declared by the Hieu Duc District Chief as belonging to the Viet Cong.

(3) Although the success of these denial operations was difficult to assess as September drew to a close, the presence of Marines in these areas undoubtedly had adverse effects on the enemy's rice gathering activities.

b. Election Security

(1) On 28 September, the GVN held a Province wide election to choose a representative to the Lower House of the National Assembly.

(2) Within the 1st Marines TAOR, a total of twenty-four polling places were established. Tasked with assisting Provincial Forces in providing security for these sites, the 1st Marines conducted extensive patrolling and ambushing near the polling sites on the night of the 27th. On the 28th, Marine security operations shifted to areas 500 meters from the polling sites, while Regional and Popular Forces provided close-in security during the elections. In addition to these patrol and ambush activities, a platoon from Company "M" with two OH-46 and two AH-1G helicopters, stood-by at Hill 55 on the 28th to provide immediate reaction to any terrorist incident which threatened the security of the election within the TAOR.

(3) As a result of these security efforts, the elections were successfully completed without incident.

BDA included 9 enemy KBA, 3 structures, 6 bunkers, 125 feet of tree line, 100 meters of trench line and 60 feet of trail destroyed. There were 4 secondary explosions, and 3 secondary fires observed. Exploitation of these secondary explosions by artillery produced three more secondary explosions.

## (3) Operational Discrepancies

(a) On 28 September, an Air Force flight under control of the 1st Battalion Air Liaison Officer struck the 51st ARVN compound (Vic BT015626), resulting in two ARVN wounded and damage to an M-60 machine gun and tent. No operational discrepancy report was submitted since the matter is still under investigation.

(b) On the 27th, an operational discrepancy was submitted to the 1st Marine Division advising it that SAVE-A-PLANE information passed to aircraft does not include ARVN supporting arms fire, and a recommendation was made that higher authority direct the ARVN to submit firing data to the 1st Marine Division FSCC.

## (4) Downed Aircraft

(a) On 19 September, a OH-53 landed at Hill 37 with battle damage caused by three bullet holes received at an unknown time and place. The aircraft landed at 1717H and was repaired and flown out the following day. The Aircraft call sign was DIMMER 6-0 and it was on Mission 14.

(b) On 19 September, an AH-1G Cobra was reported missing at 1945H in the vicinity of AT9065. It had been shot down and the co-pilot was dead. The pilot died on 24 September. The aircraft call sign was HOSTAGE PENNY and it was on Mission 5 med-evac for another organization.

5750d. Psychological Operations

(1) Throughout the TAOR a combined effort utilizing all available assets to exploit the Rice Denial theme was employed. Aerial broadcasts and leaflet drops were employed daily by each battalion emphasizing Rice Denial; furthermore, themes such as Sanitation and Hygiene and Pro-GVN were interlaced at selected targets. Hand distribution of leaflets, posters, and Ban Tin and Tu Do newspapers at timely intervals such as prior to the rice harvest and again just prior to the elections, stressed the combined effort of ARVN and Free World Forces to combat the communist effort. The successful, and uninterrupted elections were exploited to create a favorable psychological effect among the populace residing in the 1st Marines TAOR. This was accomplished by aerial broadcasts and HB Team broadcasts throughout the TAOR. MedCaps treated an ever-increasing number of people, and helped to promote Sanitation and Hygiene themes, while on Cordon and Search Operations.

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2. Marksmanship Training Report for September 1969.

a. Ranges utilized by 1st Marine Regiment:

2. TRANSPORTATION. Motor transport support throughout September was excellent. The eighteen M54-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ -ton trucks provided by the 1st Motor Transport Battalion, in direct support of the Regiment, were utilized to their maximum. Vehicular support from the 11th Motor Transport Battalion enhanced the Regiment's ability to pick up and deliver supplies, equipment, and personnel. During September, the 3rd Battalion sent four Companies to the "STACK ARMS" R&R Program. This was supported by 11th Motor Transport Battalion. They also provided 80 5-ton M55 trucks to transport personnel to and from their destination. Nine M116A1 Amphibious Cargo Carriers were used in support of tactical operations during September.

3. MAINTENANCE AND ENGINEER ASSISTANCE

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a. Engineer support during the month of September was excellent. Headquarters received two 5 KW generators from the 1st Engineer Battalion and had them installed to provide electricity for the Combat Base perimeter lights. A ten man portable shower was provided and installed by the 1st Engineers for 2ndBn personnel at the Tu Cau Bridge. First Shore Party Battalion supported Headquarters with a Road Grader and Scoop Loader to help prepare for the monsoons. Also, a forklift was provided for the 1st Battalion to assist in relocating their Battalion Supply Section.

b. Equipment Maintenance was provided by 1st FSR. The following table depicts the number of Tactical Equipment Repair Orders submitted and completed during September.

Each combat base held routine sick calls twice daily and gave emergency treatment as required. The medical facilities were manned by a total of 5 Medical Officers, 4 Chaplains, 165 Corpsmen, 2 Dental Officers and 2 Dental Technicians.

## CIVIL AFFAIRS-CIVIC ACTION

1. PUBLIC WORKS

a. During the month of September, work continued on the resettlement at Tu Cau (BT055658) and Xuan Tra (BT063675). Progress was limited by the advent of the north-east monsoon and by a lack of vehicles to transport necessary materials. At the Tu Cau resettlement, fifty (50) new homes were constructed. Work began this month on another resettlement at Ngan Cau (BT063657). At the present time, thirty-five (35) homes have been erected housing approximately seventy (70) families.

b. The combination of heavy rains and poor drainage at Xuan Tra (BT058675) has caused minor flooding throughout the hamlet. Engine support has been requested from division and will be available shortly. At Co Cam hamlet (AT910584), a religious pagoda is under construction and is now 90% complete. Twelve cots and two rolls of screen were provided to the 1st Battalion, 51st ARVN Regiment to assist in the construction of a Battalion Aid Station. The Aid Station will be operated jointly by the U.S. Navy Corpsmen and ARVN medical personnel.

2. WELFARE

a. Throughout the 1st Marines CA OR, a combined total of 1,750 pounds of fresh food and rice was provided to the civilians.

b. A total of 175 pounds of clothing was given to the displaced civilians now living at the Ngan Cau resettlement (BT063657). In addition, forty pairs of shower shoes were distributed to the children of that same settlement. Seventy-five pounds of clothing and sixty pairs of sandals were given to the people of Dai Loc (AT920525).

c. During this month twelve (12) requests were submitted to this command to aid in rebuilding war damaged homes. At present, five requests have been filled requiring twenty sheets of tin and four truckloads of lumber, obtained from dunnage runs to Deep Water Pier. Other requests will be filled as transportation and materials become available.

3. EDUCATION

a. In order to expand the Loc Xuan Elementary School (AT918577), two truckloads of lumber were given to the people of that hamlet. Six additional truckloads of lumber were given to the Ave Maria Parish School (AT910576) for construction of classroom furniture. The ground was graded for the site of the Phu Dong Elementary School (AT922581) and eight truckloads of bricks, one of lumber, and one of tin, were provided for its construction.

b. This month was the start of the new school year and, consequently, 220 General Valt Scholarships were distributed to deserving children throughout the CAOR. Since there were more children than funds allocated, a General Valt Scholarship Fund Drive was initiated throughout the Regiment. Approximately \$700.00 had

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been collected as of 30 September 1969.

#### 4. HEALTH

a. This month a greater emphasis was placed on MedCaps of both types: Mobile, and those located at the Battalion Command posts. As a result of the increased MedCap program, 5,320 civilians were treated medically. More emphasis was also placed on combined Marine and Vietnamese MedCaps, which have been highly successful. Dental treatments for the month consisted of seventy-eight civilians being treated. A total of fourteen civilians were evacuated to various hospitals in the Da Nang area for treatment.

b. A total of 120 pounds of soap was distributed at the numerous MedCaps throughout the CAOR. Also, 13,000 Health and Sanitation leaflets were distributed in conjunction with sanitation lectures.

c. Two Vietnamese males have been trained by U.S. Navy personnel and are used as assistants in our MedCaps.

#### 5. AGRICULTURE

a. One pig project in Dai Loc (AF916578) is now being supported with leftover food from the 7th PsyOps Battalion mess hall. Two pigs were given to the people of Tu Cau (DF054656) to replace the two that were killed during a tactical operation.

#### 6. SOCIAL

a. Movies from the 7th PsyOps Battalion were shown on four occasions to civilians throughout the CAOR. All holidays were supported and personnel from the S-1 Section attended the festivities. A total of 110 pounds of candy was distributed to the children throughout the CAOR in recognition of the children's holiday, TRUNG THU; and 40 pounds of candy were distributed to the children of Tan Luu (DF077705) for the celebration of the Mid-Autumn Festival.

b. Two Ancestral Worship Ceremonies, one in Loc Chanh (AF922583) and one in Dai Loc (AF916578), were attended by 3-5 personnel.

#### 7. SECURITY

a. During the month, rice was harvested throughout the CAOR and Marine forces were committed to provide security for the harvesters.

b. Fifty rolls of barbed wire were given to the people of Tan Luu (DF077705) for security of their hamlet elections. Hamlet and village elections were held on 28 September. Marine forces provided patrols and security near the polling places through the CAOR.

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8. SOLATIUMS

a. A total of 28,000 VN\$ was paid out this month for the death of seven civilians. Five of these killed by misdirected ordnance, one by small arms fire of unknown origin, and one killed by a Marine Corps vehicle.

b. A total of 6,000 VN\$ were paid out for damages and destruction due to misdirected ordnance.

COMMUNICATIONS1. General

(a) During the month of September 1969, the 1st Marines Communications Platoon continued to provide Radio, Telephone (integrated landline and radio relay), and teletype circuits from Hill 55 Combat Base to the 1st Marine Division and the 2nd and 3rd Battalions. Radio and wire were the principle means of Communications with 1st Battalion. Channel 5 of the Dial Circuits was down for the entire month of September. Comm/Grypto Guard for the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines was maintained by the Communications Center. Communications Center received 1,639 messages and 296 messages were transmitted. The Communication Center was rebuilt and rewired inside. As a result of 1st FSR's moving to FLC, all receipts for equipment in the DX program were reconciled.

(b) Emphasis during September was on improving wire communications within the Regiment and improving the power wiring on Hill 55.
