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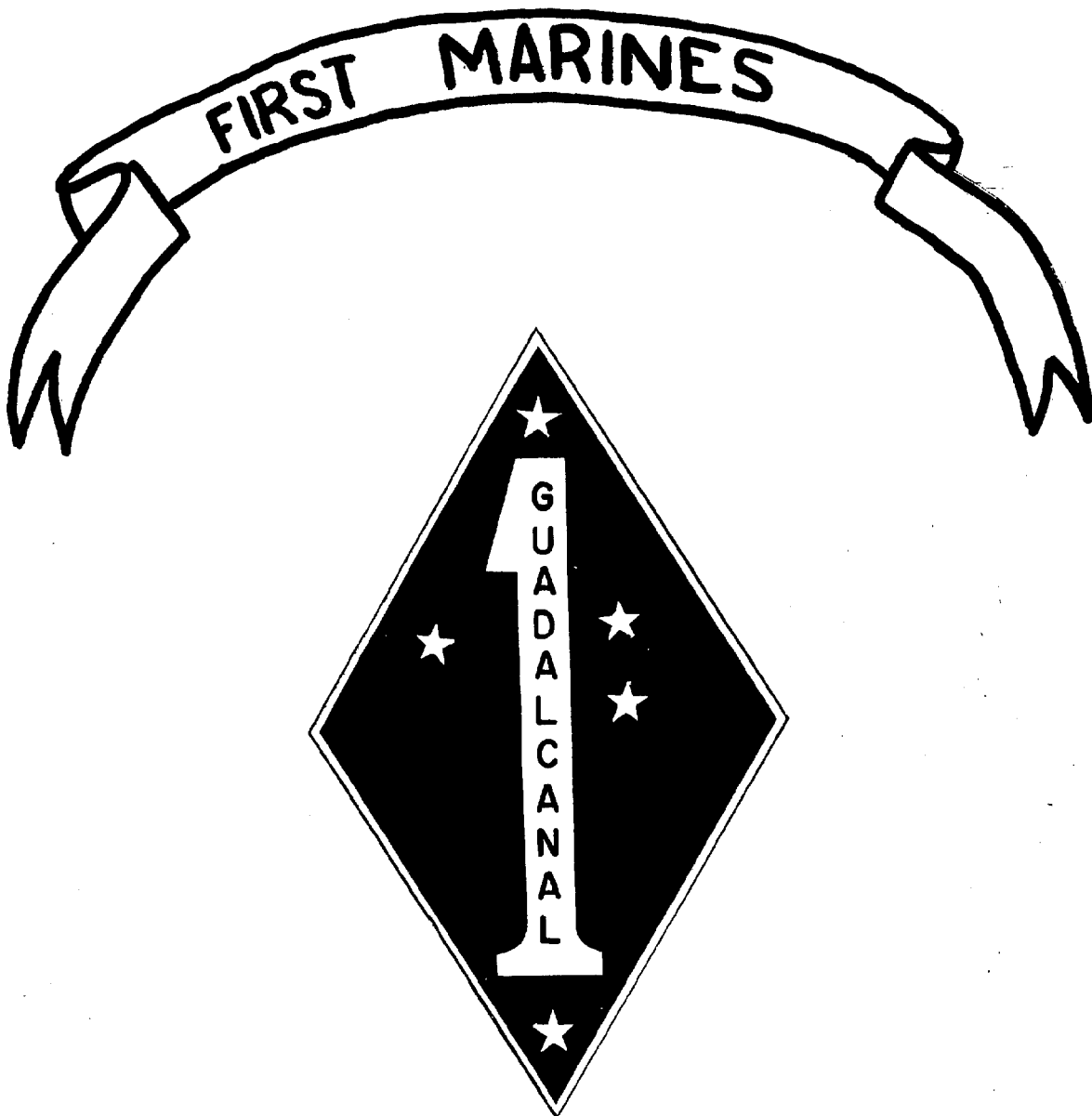

SECTION B
ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN

1. Enemy. Except for a brief high point on 1 February, enemy offensive activity directed against the 1st Marine Regiment was at a low level throughout February.

a. The enemy began February with widespread, but ineffective, attacks by fire. Activity remained insignificant throughout the Tet holidays while the enemy generally observed his unilateral cease fire.

b. The anticipated third phase of the enemy's Winter-Spring Campaign failed to materialize. Activity generally consisted of reconnaissance, counterreconnaissance, and logistical efforts for the remainder of the month with Marine offensive activity critically curtailing the enemy timetable.

c. There were reports from several sources that the enemy has reinforced Local Force units, which have been suffering from a manpower shortage, with NVA units and individuals. Local Force units were mainly targeted against disruption of the Pacification Program.

d. KINGFISHER operations continued through the month of February. Although not as lucrative as during the initial period of January, these operations continued to inflict casualties upon the enemy and, it is felt, maintained sufficient pressure upon the enemy so as to prevent their build-up of forces for any proposed large-scale activity during the Tet period.

(1) The most significant KINGFISHER operation took place on 14 February in the vicinity of AT 960563 when Company "E" landed and engaged an unknown size enemy force. Results of the operation were 6 NVA KIA, 1 NVA POW, 2 NVA KIA (Airs), 1 weapon captured and 12 bunkers destroyed.

(2) On 24 February, Company "C" KINGFISHER landed in the vicinity of AT 956560. Although contact was not made with the enemy, the unit found and destroyed 10 bunkers.

e. There were several instances of enemy psychological operations during the month. These involved the display of NVA and NLFVN flags prominently near hamlets and villages, accompanied by placards enjoining FVNAF to cease fighting and to allow the Vietnamese people to solve their own internal problems.

f. On 17 February, Regional Forces personnel reported to the 1st Battalion the location of two rocket-shaped objects. A unit was dispatched to the area in the vicinity of AT 973677, where five 140mm rockets were found in a stream.

g. On 22 February, Company "K" observed 20 VC/NVA in the vicinity of AT 929620 at 2000H. Another 40 VC/NVA were observed in approximately the same vicinity. The enemy was taken under fire by artillery and a "Shadow" gunship. A search of the area was conducted under artillery illumination and three 140mm rockets were found.

h. Units of the 1st Marines, in conjunction with CAP units and ARVN units operating within the 1st Marines' TAOR, accounted for 55 VC/NVA KIA's and 4 VC/NVA POW's, plus 97 bunkers and 29 tunnels destroyed.

i. Enemy units operating within the 1st Marines' TAOR include the R-20th, Q-82nd, Q-83rd, Q-84th Battalions and elements of the 31st NVA Regiment. Suspected and probable units operating within the 1st Marines' TAOR are elements of the 36th NVA Regiment and 141st NVA Regiment.

j. Anti-personnel and anti-vehicular mine incidents decreased significantly from the previous month with 111 found and 36 detonated, for an average of 75.6 percent detection to 24.4 percent detection.

k. There were no rocket attacks during the period against 1st Marines' positions.

(1) There was a decided increase in mortar attacks on positions within the 1st Marines' TAOR during February, with a total of seven incidents as compared to three for the previous month.

(2) There was one lob bomb incident during the month. On the night of 19 February, Company "M" received one round of unknown type ordnance. A check of the impact area indicated the round to be possibly a 105mm.

(3) There were seven B-40 (RPG) rocket attacks against 1st Marines' positions during the month, as compared to nine the previous month.

3. Ground Surveillance. The majority of ground surveillance activity during February occurred in the Regimental Headquarters area.

a. During the month, 219 seismic and 55 magnetic activations were received and 17 fire missions were called, consisting of 142 rounds of 105mm fire and 12 rounds of 81mm fire. Fire missions were not observed visually.

4. Weather. The monsoon season continued with few days of rain amounting to .78 inches for the month. Neither friendly nor enemy operations were hindered by the NE monsoon weather. The average high was 85 degrees, the low 65 degrees. Humidity averaged 68 percent.

5. Terrain. The 1st Marines' TAOR consists of mountainous terrain in the extreme western portion, piedmont in the central portion and coastal plains in the eastern portion. The central and eastern portions are characterized by cultivated rice areas, villages and bamboo thickets. Some dryland farming exists in the eastern portion. Rivers and streams run throughout the TAOR, both N-S and E-W. Located within the TAOR are Routes 1, 1B, 1C, 1D, 4, 12E, 12W, 13, 538 and 540. These roads are elevated and pose no navigational problems, except during and after heavy rains, when they become flooded.

SECTION C
OPERATIONS1. GENERAL

(a) The month of February was one in which the operational commitments of the First Marine Regiment remained at a very high level. During this period, which included TET, the Vietnamese lunar New Year, special emphasis was placed upon the normal operational commitments of the regiment. These include the defense of the Da Nang vital area, rocket belt security, rice denial activities, and support of the Accelerated Pacification Campaign (APC) through participation in the Combined Unit Pacification Program (CUPP). There were also other significant events which took place during this period; one of which was the improvement of the Regiment's KINGFISHER patrols throughout the TAOR. Ten KINGFISHER patrols were conducted resulting in 12 VC/NVA killed, three VC/NVA captured, and five individual weapons captured. These results were obtained during a time span in which no other units were making any contact whatsoever. Also during this period "G" Company was returned to the operational control of the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines in the northeastern section of the TAOR. It was also during the month of February that the First Marine Regiment began making liaison with the Twenty-sixth Marine Regiment concerning a relief in place by the First Marines. On 27 February, Quang Nam Provincial Forces assumed responsibility for the bridges in the area. These included the Tu Cam Bridge (BT033648), the Ha Dong Bridge (AT990642), the Golden Gate Bridge (AT963604) and the Dai Loc Bridge (AT915577). There were two other significant events which occurred on 27 February. The first of these was the return of the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines to the operational control of the 7th Marine Regiment. The 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines had been under the operational control of the 1st Marines during the high threat period of the TET holiday. The second significant event on 27 February was perhaps one of most important. At 1400 on 27 February elements of the 105th RF Company replaced the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines at the Cau Ha Combat Base in another step in the Vietnamization of the war. The 9th Engineer Battalion's Provisional Land Clearing Company conducted a land clearing operation in the Man Quan area from 10 February to 22 February with Company "F", 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines providing security. The land clearing company also conducted a clearing operation in the Le Son area beginning on 24 February with elements of Company "B", 1st Battalion, 1st Marines providing security.

(b) During the month of February most of the small unit activities were of platoon or squad size. This permitted patrol

(c) The CUPP continued to operate around the population centers with good results. Its method of operation remained the same. As the month ended, the disposition of CUPP forces within the 1st Marines was as follows:

The 3rd Battalion had responsibility for the security of the western TAOR, including Hill 37 (AT915581) and Hill 22 (AT954667). The 1st Marines' Regimental Headquarters remained at Hill 55 (AT970620).

(1) The First Marines continued to employ air support where it offered a significant advantage. Recognizing the shortage of helicopter assets and the limitations imposed by marginal flying weather, the Regiment substituted other means of transportation wherever possible. This resulted in a reduction of over 97,688 pounds of logistical lifts from the previous month's totals. A general reduction in air support was experienced due to a decrease in valid targets, and adverse weather conditions. Ten KINGFISHER missions were conducted with 12 enemy KIA's, three POW captures and five IWC.

5750**D. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS**

(1) During the month of February, an effort was made by 1st Marines to cause the enemy to Chieu Hoi. EARLYWORD broadcasts were made on seven (7) occasions, five (5) of these broadcasts in conjunction with KINGFISHER operations. On February 1, Operation KINGFISHER was patrolling an area 2,000 meters north of Hill 55 (AT961639) when several VC/NVA with weapons were spotted moving to a covered area. EARLYWORD was called on station and broadcasts were made to individuals in their hiding places. EARLYWORD coaxed several VC/NVA to lay down their arms and surrender after a firefight between the enemy and USMC forces. That particular operation resulted in 10 VC/NVA KIA and 10 VC/NVA POW. EARLYWORD was cited as being instrumental in the capture of the 10 POW.

(2) HB Broadcasting Teams, working in Operation SAVE-A-LEG, conducted face-to-face communications with villagers of Chau Son (3) (AT958604), Yen Ho (1) (AT988663), and Yen Ho (3) (AT986681) hamlets. These teams solicited civilians participation in the Voluntary Informant Programs with the result that 13 pieces of ordnance were recovered at a cost of 2,120 \$VN in rewards.

(3) PsyOps Exploitation Teams (POET) reacted to three (3) VC atrocities during February. A seven-year old Vietnamese male was killed by a VC booby trap at "Sea Bee Bridge" (AT914589) and two (2) mine explosions on Highway 545 (AT922552) on consecutive days killed a total of 13 Vietnamese civilians. Dai Loc District provided 3rd Battalion with PsyOps support to exploit both incidents.

(4) A total of six (6) Serious Incident Reports were initiated by 1st Marines during February. Five (5) of these reports covered incidents involving the accidental deaths of two (2) and injuries of nine (9) Vietnamese civilians as a result of their proximity to enemy forces during contact with Allied units. Final reports have been submitted on these five (5) incidents and maximum solatium payments have been made to the victims or their relatives. Foreign Claims are not appropriate to these cases as they involve combat operations. The sixth SIR involved the shooting of a charging water buffalo by a Marine. Solatium has been paid for the animal and a Foreign Claim is being processed by 3rd Battalion.

LOGISTICS

1. Supply - Logistics

a. The primary thrust of logistics operations during the month was directed at preparing the Regiment for the forthcoming displacement of the Regimental Headquarters and two Battalions to new locations. The Cau Ha Combat Base was turned over to the Government of Vietnam on 27 February and bases at Phong Luc, Hill 55 and Hill 37 were prepared for turnover to the 51st ARVN Regiment early next month.

b. Normal Supply point distribution, with the FLC providing all classes of supply, was the primary means of supply support during the month. The organizations of this Regiment utilized Logistic Support Unit - Two (LSU-2), Ammunition Supply Point - Two (ASP-2), and the FLC complex as their supply point sources. Unit distribution, provided from LSU-2 and the LSA co-located at Hill 55, was utilized to support units operating in isolated areas. The Hill 55 LSU/LSA complex also provided supply support to the 2d Provisional Land Clearing Company while operating in the 1st Marines tactical area of responsibility.

c. LSA Payne (Hill 55) conducted 163 helicopter lifts which delivered 383,369 pounds of cargo and 166 passengers. The above totals include the following major resupply items provided to the 2d Provisional Land Clearing Company:

2. Lines of Communications. There were no significant changes to the roads within the 1st Marines TAOR during the month of February.

3. Bridges. MCB-121 completed repairs on the Tu Cau Bridge. The bridge is now equipped with a vertical lift span which allows patrol craft to pass underneath. MCB-74 continued to build a new bridge adjacent to the Cao Do Bridge and to improve bridge approaches.

4. Transportation

a. During the month of February, twenty 2 1/2 ton trucks were assigned in direct support of the 1st Marines. These trucks, from 1st Motor Transport Battalion, were allocated to each Battalion and Headquarters Company to support day-to-day resupply requirements and troop movements.

b. On the 27th and 28th of the month the 3d Battalion was augmented with four (4) M-54 trucks with tractor trailers and seven (7) M-54 trucks with M-105 trailers to support their displacement to a new TAOR.

5. Maintenance and Engineer Assistance

a. Equipment maintenance was provided by 1st FSR. The following table depicts the number of Headquarters Company, 1st Marines Tactical Equipment Repair Orders submitted and completed during February 1970.

c. MCB-74 completed the perimeter lighting system, water distribution system, construction of a shower and erection of two maintenance facilities. The 1st Engineer Battalion completed their land clearing effort in the vicinity of Hill 55.

6. Embarkation: There have been no significant changes in the embarkation readiness of the 1st Marines during the month of February.

7. Sanitation: Conscientious sanitation programs have been continued by all organizations of the 1st Marines. All sanitation problems receive immediate command attention and a high state of police is maintained throughout 1st Marines Combat Bases.

8. Medical

a. During the month of February, medical facilities were maintained throughout the Regimental TAOR; each holding routine sickcall twice daily and giving emergency treatment as required.

b. The medical facilities were manned by a total of 7 Medical Officers, 171 Corpsmen, 3 Dental Officers, and 3 Dental Technicians.

CIVIL AFFAIRS-CIVIC ACTION

1. PUBLIC WORKS

a. During the month of February, large quantities of materials were distributed throughout the 1st Marines CAAOR in an attempt to finish incomplete Civic Action projects. Due to an impending change in CAAOR for 1st Marines, it was essential that all projects be completed or that sufficient materials be provided for their completion during February.

b. Twenty sheets of tin and 20 sacks of cement were given to Quang Dong (3) hamlet (AT993620) for completion of the hamlet primary school. Twenty sheets of tin and 20 sacks of cement were given to the CUFP, for use in the reconstruction of damaged houses in Bich Nam (1) hamlet (AT-992635).

c. Materials were provided for completion of two temples during February. Forty sheets of tin and 40 bags of cement were provided to Vietnamese laborers at Ha Tay (BT019643) and Qua Giang (1) (BT018668) hamlets to complete temples during February.

d. One truckload of lumber, 25 4"x4"s and 250 bags of cement were given to Hai An hamlet (BT064675) to upgrade the hamlet school and civilian housing. Three bags of cement were given to Tu Cau hamlet (BT-042653) for the manufacture of well rings.

e. The MedCap building at Cau Ha combat base was dismantled and reconstructed at Ngan Cau hamlet (BT061665) by Ngan Cau villagers. This building will continue to be employed as a MedCap station.

2. WELFARE

a. A total of 32,000 \$VN in AIF funds was paid for the local hire of unskilled labor during February. Forty-seven workers were employed six days each week throughout the 1st Marines' CAAOR. Provisions have been made to assure that only one member of any family may be employed through AIF funds so that the maximum number of families may benefit.

b. Excess food from the 2nd Battalion messhall was distributed to Xuan Tra (BT065675), Tu Cau (BT042653) and Ngan Cau (BT061665), hamlets. Xuan Tra villagers received 600 pounds of meat and 800 pounds of vegetables. Tu Cau villagers received 800 pounds of meat and 500 pounds of vegetables. Xuan Tra villagers received 400 pounds of meat.

c. One hundred pounds of clothing were given to Dai Loc District for distribution among refugee families.

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57503. EDUCATION

a. Two hundred-eighty four General Walt Scholarships were awarded to students throughout the 1st Marines' CAAOR during February. Of this total, 98 scholarships were supported by contributions collected by the battalions.

b. The An My (AT927608) and Phu Dong (AT920582) Schools were completed during February. The schools at Xuan Tra and Hai An are near completion with only interior work to be done. The framework for the Ngan Cau School is completed and further materials are being made available for the school as work progresses.

4. HEALTH

a. MedCaps treated 4,885 civilians throughout 1st Marines' CAAOR during the month of February. Of this total, 1,506 were treated by Vietnamese nurses at hamlet MedCap stations in Ngan Cau, Tu Cat, and Xuan Tra hamlets. Thirty-six Vietnamese civilians were treated or evacuated for wounds received as the result of hostile action.

b. A total of 63 Vietnamese were treated by DentCaps during February.

c. A MedCap station has been set up at the Cau De Bridge (AT999706). It is expected that this MedCap will treat approximately 50 civilians each day. This MedCap station will be turned over to 1st Battalion, 5th Marines on 7 March 1970.

5. AGRICULTURE

a. Pig projects throughout the 1st Marines' CAAOR have continued to improve hamlet economies during February. Selective breeding of Vietnamese and American pigs has resulted in a healthier and larger offspring with a greater market value. This new breed of pig brings the highest prices on the marketplace in and around Da Nang.

b. A total of 5200 pounds of corn has been provided to pig projects in the hamlets of Ngan Cau, Tu Cat, and Xuan Tra. The number of pig projects in Dai Loc District increased to 19 during February.

c. Four plowing kits were given to farmers at An Tu (1) hamlet (BT026642).

6. SOCIAL

a. Third Battalion Marines attended four meals during the observance of TET.

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b. Two social meals were attended by the Assistant Division Commander and Village Chiefs of Hoa Vang District in order to promote better working relationships between Marine units and Vietnamese governmental agencies.

c. Transportation was provided to 46 Vietnamese civilians so that they could visit sick or wounded relatives throughout the Da Nang area.

7. SECURITY

a. An HB team was employed in Chau Son (3) (AT958604), Yen Ne (1) (AT988663), Xuan Tra (BT065675), and Ngan Cau (BT061665) hamlets in conjunction with Operation SAVE-A-LEG. Thirteen pieces of dud US ordnance were turned in to this team during February.

b. The people of Xuan Tra hamlet were given 1200 sandbags to be used for the building of additional family bunkers.

8. SOLATIUM

a. A total of 16,000 \$VN in solatium was paid to the survivors of four Vietnamese boys killed during a combat action in the 2nd Battalion CAAOR. Responsibility for their deaths could not be determined. Solatium payments were made in the best interests of the USMC.

b. Four thousand \$VN solatium was paid to the widow of the Thanh Thuy village chief for the death of her husband. The chief was killed in a VC ambush during the TET season.

c. One thousand \$VN solatium was paid for 350 tobacco plants damaged due to Marine operations at La Tho Bec (1) hamlet (BT006635).

Communications

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1. During the month of February 1970, the 1st Marine Communications Platoon continued to provide Radio, Telephone (integrated Land Line and Radio Relay), and Teletype circuits from Hill 55 Combat Base to the 1st Marine Division, the 3rd Battalion and the 2nd Battalion. Radio and Wire were the principal means of communications with the 1st Battalion and the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines. Comm/Crypto Guard for the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines was maintained by the Communications Center. The Communications Center received 1653 messages and transmitted 198 messages.
2. The main area of concern during the month of February again proved to be the continuing difficulty in establishing reliable Radio Relay Communications between Hill 55 and the 5th and 7th Marines and the difficulty in maintaining the cable between Hill 55 and the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines and the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines.
3. Emphasis during February was placed on preparing for the forthcoming displacement of the Regimental Command Post and aiding the 1st and 3rd Battalions in their displacement. Close liaison with the 26th Marines was effected to allow a smooth transition of responsibility for the new Command Post.

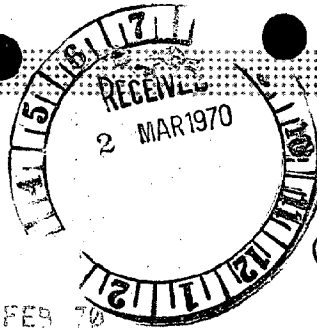
