



SECTION B
ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN

1. Enemy. Since movement of the 1st Marines to the new TAOR, enemy initiated activity has decreased markedly.

a. It appears that the enemy units have withdrawn to the mountain area in the western portion of the TAOR, probably for rest and re-equipping. This is partially borne out by the apparent reluctance on the part of the enemy to engage FVMAF units.

b. With the winter rice harvest soon to begin, it is anticipated that night activity will pick up substantially as the enemy again concentrates his efforts towards the collection of food stuffs.

c. The most significant action during the month occurred on 26 March, when Companies "A" and "C" conducted a search and destroy operation on a reported base camp area in the vicinity of AT 8268 and AT 8269. The operation resulted in two NVA KIA, 12 weapons captured, 7500 rounds of small arms ammunition captured, plus 137 RPG/mortar rounds and assorted equipment captured. Two NVA KIA's were found in graves, presumably killed by artillery some time previous to the operation.

d. On 25 March, Company "C" discovered a base camp in the vicinity of AT 820694. Although no contact was made with enemy forces, 40 nose assemblies for 82mm and 60mm mortar rounds were found, as well as mortar increments and RPG rounds.

e. Units of the 1st Marines, in conjunction with CAP units and ARVN units operating within the 1st Marines' TAOR, accounted for 64 VC/NVA KIA's and seven VC/NVA POW's, plus 75 bunkers and seven tunnels destroyed. Two base camps were also destroyed.

f. Enemy units operating within the 1st Marines' TAOR include the R-20th Bn., Q-84th Bn., T-87 Sapper Bn., Hai Van Engineer Bn., and elements of the 31st NVA Regiment. Probable and suspected units include the C-7 and C-31 LF Co's, the 575th Rocket Bn. and elements of the 573rd Rocket Bn.

g. Anti-personnel and anti-vehicular mine incidents decreased somewhat from the previous month with 75 found and 21 detonated, for an average of 78.1 percent detection to 21.9 percent detonation. Mine incidents decreased 33 percent over the previous month.

3. Ground Surveillance. During the month, 241 seismic, 586 pressure and 78 magnetic activations were received and 49 fire missions were called, consisting of 12 rounds of 106mm, 128 rounds of 107mm, 191 rounds of 105mm and 328 rounds of 81mm fire. Results of the fire missions were, for the most part, not observed.

4. Weather. There were few days of rain during the month, with only light rains amounting to .03 inches. Neither friendly nor enemy operations were hindered by the weather. The average high was 85 degrees, the low 70 degrees. Humidity averaged 80 percent.

5. Terrain. The terrain which falls within the 1st Marines' TAOR is divided into two main land forms, the coastal plains and the low mountains further inland. The coastal plains consist of poorly-drained flat areas of rice cultivation and some dryland farming. Riceland elevations rarely exceed 20 meters, and average five meters, in some areas east of the low mountains and foot hills, west of DaNang.

There are low mountains within three kilometers of the coast, overlooking DaNang. These low mountains are separated from the higher mountains, to the west, by a rolling plain varying in width from three to nine kilometers. Slopes within the low mountains are commonly 30 to 35 percent, becoming more gentle as they merge into the coastal plains. The highest elevation in these low mountains is 364 meters.

West of the low mountains, elevations rise sharply and the terrain becomes extremely rough. Rugged, steeply-sloped mountains predominate for approximately one third of the area along the entire western portion of the TAOR. The exceptions, other than the coastal plains, are the river valleys. Multi-canopied forest, with dense undergrowth, is prevalent throughout the mountainous area.

Rivers and streams run throughout the TAOR, both W-E and N-S. The five main rivers, the CU DE, VINH DIEN, CAU DO, TUY LOAN and YEN, are navigable by shallow-draft boats.

Located within the TAOR are Routes 1, 1B, 1C, 3, 6, 8, 10, 12E, 12W, 13, 13, 539, 540, 542, 544 and 545. Most of these routes are elevated and pose no navigational problems, except during and after heavy monsoon rains, when they become flooded in portions.

SECTION C
OPERATIONS1. GENERAL

(a) The month of March was one in which the operational commitments of the First Marine Regiment remained at a high level. During the period, emphasis was placed upon intensified operations in defense of the Da Nang Vital Area, i.e. rocket belt security operations, rice denial activities and support of the Pacification Campaign through participation in the Combined Unit Pacification Program (CUPP). The first week of March was occupied with the phased relief in place of the 26th Marines. On 1 March, 3/1 (-) passed to the operational control of the 26th Marines and relieved 3/26 and elements of 2/26, assuming responsibility for the security of Hai Van Pass, Lien Chieu Esso Depot and Nam O Bridge. Meanwhile, 5th Marines assumed OPCON 1st Plt, H/3/1 (CUPP), and the Leprosarium Combat Base (AT998664) was reduced and abandoned. Responsibility for the Cau Do Bridge was assumed by 1/5 on March 2nd. The relief of the 26th Marines by the 1st Marines and relief of Hill 55 Garrison by the 51st ARVN Regiment were completed on 6 March. The 1st Battalion relieved 1/26 and 3/1 returned to the OPCON of the 1st Marines. By 1335, the orderly relief in place of the 26th Marines was complete, the Regimental CP was functioning at Camp Perdue and the 1st Marine Regiment was conducting normal combat operations in a new TAOR which stretched in a belt around Da Nang from Hai Van Pass to south of Marble Mountain, encompassing more than 534 square kilometers.

(b) On 22 March, Quang Nam Province-wide elections were conducted with few attempts by the enemy to disrupt the political process. First Marines' units were not employed actively as security forces but stood by to lend assistance if required. During the latter part of March, liaison visits were conducted to Hoc Vang, Hieu Duc and Dien Ban District Headquarters to begin planning for the 1st Marines providing security for the rice harvest. The Battalions were directed to conduct close liaison and coordination with their respective districts to determine priorities and local security requirements. The current rice harvest season is expected to run until at least 30 April 1970.

(c) During the month, most of the small unit operations conducted were of platoon and squad size. This permitted patrol saturation throughout the TAOR in order to deny the enemy access to rice and to degrade his ability to launch rockets against targets in the Da Nang Vital Area. The most significant operation was conducted by the 1st Battalion west of OP 270. During the period 22 to 28 March, Companies "A" and "C" conducted a highly successful reconnaissance in force in an enemy base camp area in the AT 8286 grid. One NVA soldier, seven

individual weapons, four crew-served weapons, an RPG grenade launcher, 25 mines, 92 mortar rounds, more than 500 grenades, nearly 8,000 small arms rounds and large amounts of assorted ordnance, medicine and equipment were captured.

(d) M/3/1 (CUPP) passed to the ADCON/OPCON of 3/5 on 6 March; however, that afternoon, one squad was transferred to 2/1 as its CUPP platoon (T-1). In the 3/1 TAOR, CUPP 1 and 2 continued normal operations. Formerly of K/3/26, these two squads were transferred to 3/1 as units of Company "I" when 3/1 assumed responsibility for the zone on 1 March. As the month ended, the 1st Marines continued operations with three platoons, obtaining good results. The disposition of CUPP forces was as follows:

(e) Upon assumption of the responsibility for the 26th Marines' TAOR, the 1st Marines assumed responsibility for the operation, construction, maintenance and defense of the Da Nang Anti-Infiltration Sensor System (DAISS). Subsequently, however, except for defense and sensor target engagement, the Regiment was relieved of all responsibilities by the Sensor Control and Management Platoon (SCMP).

(f) The month ended on a note of apprehension. Reports from a variety of sources indicated that the enemy would attempt intensified attacks against the Da Nang Vital Area. A period of six days was mentioned, commencing the night of 28 March. The First Marines intensified its night operations with increased saturation patrolling of the TAOR, culminating in the commitment of nearly 200 patrols and ambushes the night of 31 March, including the patrols of D/1/5 which was OPCON to 2/1 for the night.

2. COMBAT SUPPORT OPERATIONS

A. ARTILLERY

(1) Throughout the month of March the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its assigned mission of providing direct support fires for Marine and ARVN units operating in the 1st Marines' TACR.

(2) Displacements:

(a) On 6 March Headquarters Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines displaced from Hill 55 to the Northern Artillery Contonment concurrently with the relocation of 1st Marines to its new TACR. The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines Command Post was opened at 1600 at AT 925795.

(b) On 6 March, Battery "A", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines displaced from BT 013627 to Hill 10. The Battery displaced by echelon with guns 1 and 2 beginning the displacement at 0850, followed by guns 3 and 4 at 1105 and guns 5 and 6 at 1425. By 1500 all guns were laid and ready to fire on a principal direction of 5000 mils, with the battery center located at AT 924651.

(c) At 0850 on 6 March, Battery "C", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines displaced from AT 963609 to the Northern Artillery Contonment. The battery displaced by echelon with guns 1 and 2 beginning the displacement at 0850, followed by guns 3 and 4 at 1105 and guns 5 and 6 at 1425. By 1600 all guns were laid and ready to fire on a principal direction of 5500 mils with the battery center located at AT 922794.

(d) On 21 March one towed 155mm howitzer was helilifted from Hill 10 (AT 923691) to Hill 270 (AT 865681), in order to bring fire on an enemy cave complex approximately 2500 meters to the west.

During the month of March, the following ships fired in support of the 1st Marines: USS ALBERT DAVID (DE 1050), USS HENDERSON (DD 785), USS HENRY B. The fires of these ships were pre-emptive in nature as they attacked harbor sites and infiltration routes in the western portion of the TAOR.

C. AIR SUPPORT

(1) The First Marines moved to the 26th Marines' TAOR during the period of 1 March 1970 to 6 March 1970. The troop lifts were accomplished in an expeditious manner and a total of 1,922 troops were lifted on 1 March and 6 March. The resupply requirements for the new TAOR set a record for logistical lifts for the 1st Marines of a million and a half pounds of cargo. The strategic placement of PAC's on the high enemy activity observation posts has improved the accuracy and timeliness of close air support. There was a definite decrease in utilization of beacon-controlled air strikes due to aircraft non-availability caused by aircraft modification. There was an increase in the number of TPQ-10 missions due to the innovation of the TPQ-10 back-up to beacon-controlled air strikes. This provides the coverage of targets and prevents the loss of the same due to aircraft systems malfunctions. The continuous utilization of a night close air support package has denied the enemy the use of many infiltration routes and staging areas. A project was initiated for the improvement of the landing zones in the new TAOR.

(5) Anti-aircraft fire incidents. There were ten anti-aircraft incidents which is a decrease from previous months. This can be attributed to the proper planning and utilization of gunship escorts for unsecure zones in 1st Marines' TAOR.

D. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS:

(1) In conjunction with Mobile MedCaps in the Battalion CAAOR's, the Regimental HB Team has been used to broadcast Rice Denial, Rewards, Chieu Hoi, and Health and Sanitation themes to the outlying village areas. A total of 10 aerial broadcasts and leaflet drops were made in the 1st Battalion CAAOR. In the 2nd Battalion CAAOR, aerial broadcasts and leaflet drops were requested on seven occasions. Themes used were Rice Denial, Pro-GVN, Chieu Hoi, Health and Sanitation and Rewards. HE and HB Teams were used to show movies and play tapes at a large MedCap at Kim Lien (H) (AT926860) while a total of 400 patients were treated.

(2) The Regimental HB Team is being utilized twice a week at each Battalion in conjunction with Mobile MedCaps in their CAAOR. The HB Team has also been used in ordnance turn-in at each Battalion. This ordnance turn-in to the HB Team is having favorable results at every Battalion because the young children are beginning to trust the GVN and Allied Forces more than in previous months.

1. Supply - Logistics

a. The major logistics operation during the month was the displacement of the Regimental Headquarters and the 1st and 3d Battalions to new operating areas. Commencing 27 February, the 3d Battalion began its displacement from the Hill 37 Combat Base and surrounding area to its new TAOR and Command post located at grid coordinates 938784. In addition to the five (5) M-35 trucks regularly assigned to the Battalion from 1st Motor Transport Battalion, four (4) M-54 trucks with tractor trailers and eight (8) M-35 trucks with M-105 trailers were provided from Division assets. The three day move was completed on 1 March at which time the Hill 37 Combat Base was turned over to elements of the 51st ARVN Regiment. The major troop movement was conducted on 1 March by helicopter.

b. On 4 March, the Regimental Headquarters commenced its move from Hill 55 to Camp Perdue and the 1st Battalion initiated its displacement from the Phong Luc Combat Base and surrounding area to its new TAOR and Combat Base at Hill 10. The Regimental Headquarters, in addition to its regularly assigned three (3) M-35 trucks, was augmented by two (2) M-54 trucks with tractor trailers and six (6) M-35 trucks with M-105 trailers. The 1st Battalion utilized its regularly assigned five (5) M-35 trucks in addition to four (4) M-54 trucks with tractor trailers and seven (7) M-35 trucks with M-105 trailers provided from Division assets. Again the major troop movement was conducted by helicopter on the final day of the displacement, 6 March 1970. The Phong Luc Combat Base was turned over to elements of the 51st ARVN Regiment on 5 March and the Hill 55 Base on 6 March.

c. It should be noted that in each displacement indicated above, relocating units began moving available supplies and equipment into new positions up to ten (10) days in advance of the scheduled movement date.

d. All T/E and Special Allowance equipment, operating stocks and garrison property were removed from the bases being turned over to the ARVN. All buildings, electrical distribution systems and defensive wire was left intact for incoming 51st ARVN forces.

e. The LSA/LSU Complex on Hill 55 was gradually phased out of operation and completely closed down on 6 March. At that time supply point distribution, with the PLC providing all classes of supply, was the sole means of supply support for the remainder of the month.

1. PUBLIC WORKS

a. Much of the work done in the previous month was directed towards the construction and completion of schools. First Battalion provided 20 sheets of tin and 20 bags of cement to Duyen Son (4) (AT942663) to build a school and 15 bags of cement to Phu Son (1) (AT943651) to build an additional classroom for their school.

b. To assist in the completion of the school at Xuan Tra New Life Hamlet (BT066675), 48 2"x4"x8' boards, 80 2"x4"x14' boards, and 24 sheets of plywood were delivered. Furniture for the school was also made with these supplies.

c. Third pattalion has developed a market place at Quan Nam (AT904-818) and is awaiting the arrival of building materials to complete the project.

2. WELFARE

a. The First Battalion S-5 provided enough lumber to rebuild 3 houses burned down during contact between CAP 2-1-4 and VC/NVA.

b. The pig project at Hoa Hai (BT065675) is doing well. The people report a sizeable profit after marketing the pigs. Welfare in this village is increasing and the people are able to care for their own needs.

c. The Third Battalion S-5 distributed eight (8) truck loads of scrap lumber to Hoa Khanh Orphanage (AT953790) to use for firewood.

3. EDUCATION

a. General Walt Scholarships were presented to 170 children within Second and Third Battalion's CAAOR.

b. The Xuan Tra School was just completed and will open after assignment of two teachers by Hoa Vang District Headquarters.

4. HEALTH

a. There were 2,771 civilians treated under the MedCap/DentCap program. Mobile MedCaps were started by two of the battalions and have been instrumental in reaching the people of the outlying villages who would not have received this treatment. Second Battalion distributed 44 boxes of produce to the three New Life Hamlets and 210 boxes of fish were given to Xuan Tra and Tu Cau (BT049659).

5. AGRICULTURE

a. Xuan Tra's pig project is showing positive results. Food scraps from the Second Battalion messhall and 1,000 pounds of corn obtained through G-5 have been used to increase the yield.

1. During the month of March 1970 the 1st Marines Communication Platoon provided radio, telephone (integrated land-line and radio relay) and teletype circuits from Camp Perdue to the 1st Battalion and the 2nd Battalion. Radio and wire were the principal means of communication with the 3rd Battalion and the 1st Marine Division. Comm/Crypto guard for 1st Motor Transport Battalion, 11th Motor Transport Battalion, and 7th Engineer Battalion was maintained by the Communication Center. The Communication Center received 2,003 and transmitted 208 messages.
2. The main area of concern during the month of March proved to be the difficulty in establishing and maintaining reliable wire communications from the 1st Marines radio-relay site on Hill 327 to Camp Perdue through the division cable system.
3. Emphasis during the month of March was placed on completing the displacement of the Regimental Command Post from Hill 55 Combat Base to Camp Perdue and rebuilding and relocating the facilities here to suit the needs of the Regiment.
