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(4) On 18 November at 1322H, Companies "E" and "G", 1st Marines, with elements of the 4/51st ARVN in blocking positions, conducted a heli-borne assault on a suspected VC headquarters in the vicinity of (AT997607). As the assault elements landed, an unknown number of enemy attempted to flee but were engaged by a blocking force consisting of one platoon of Company "E", assisted by one Cobra gunship, and three enemy were KIA and two PW captured. During the period 18-20 November, a continuous search of the area resulted in an additional three enemy killed, three individual weapons captured, 85 detainees, five bunkers destroyed and 275 pounds of foodstuffs captured.

(5) On 28 November at 1615H, the 1st Marines' Quick Reaction Force (H-3), reacting to IOD sighting of three enemy in the vicinity of (AT971518), conducted a heliborne assault. Upon landing two enemy were flushed from hiding and were engaged by Cobra gunships firing on board ordnance. The two enemy were KIA. Further search of the area resulted in two additional enemy killed, one Hoi Chanh, two detainees, and 14 bunkers found. The bunkers were family type shelters consisting of reinforced concrete block construction approximately 4'x8'x12'. The bunkers were not destroyed. The Hoi Chanh has revealed considerable information on enemy Commo Liaison routes, methods of operation and unit locations deep within base area 112.

d. Units of the 1st Marines, in conjunction with CAP and ARVN units operating within the 1st Marines' TAOR, accounted for 18 enemy KIA's, five PW's and 81 bunkers and tunnels destroyed during the month of November.

e. Enemy units operating within the 1st Marines' TAOR include elements of the Q.90, Q.91, Q.92 and T-89th Sapper Battalions, the Q.82, Q.83, Q.84, and Q.85 Local Force Battalions, the 31st NVA Regiment, the 38th NVA Regiment, the 575th and 577th Rocket Artillery Battalions, the R-20th Main Force Battalion and the Q.55 Independent Company. Probable and suspected units include the T-87th Sapper Company; Hai Van Engineer Company; D-3 Infantry Battalion; 140th and 150th Transportation Battalions and the K.600, K.625 and K.650 Transportation Companies.

f. Booby Trap and mine incidents totaled 59 during the month. Of these 40 were discovered and 19 detonated for a 67.8 percent detection rate.

g. There were 11 attacks by fire directed against 1st Marines' positions during November.

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PART II
SECTION B
ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN

1. Enemy. An extremely low level of enemy activity prevailed during the month of November.

a. In the southern portion of the 1st Marines' TAOR there was a marked lack of enemy activity. However, a slight increase in enemy initiated activity in the northern portion was experienced during the first week, but diminished to a low level during the remainder of the month.

b. One rocket attack was reported during the month. On 09 November at 1315H, E/2/1 CP at Hill 55 (AT970620) received a total of five 122mm rockets from (AT909649); a position located on the eastern slopes of Charlie Ridge.

c. Significant events for the month of November were:

(1) On 07 November at 0200H, an I/3/1 Platoon ambush observed 10-15 enemy 30 meters away at (AT920853) moving into KIM LIEN village. The unit initiated small arms fire and received enemy small arms fire and 82mm mortar fire in return but there were no friendly casualties. A sweep of the area revealed four enemy KIA's, two AK-47's and one enemy K-54 pistol.

(2) Based on intelligence indicating the use of Football Island as an enemy storage area and transfer point for food, a rice denial operation was conducted during the period 12-20 November by Companies "C" and "F", 1st Marines. Results of the operation were as follows: One enemy killed, one PW captured; one Civil Defendant captured, and 128 Vietnamese civilians detained; three individual and one crew-served weapon captured; approximately 8000 pounds of foodstuffs, primarily rice and corn captured or destroyed; 51 bunkers and four tunnels destroyed; three dud 250 pound bombs, two RPG rounds, 20 grenades, 120 blasting caps, 12 82mm mortar rounds, 18 82mm mortar fuzes, 3 cans of increments and miscellaneous clothing and documents captured.

(3) On 15 November at 2258H, a squad from G/2/1 and a Vietnamese Seal Team acting on intelligence indicating a VC political meeting was taking place at AN TRA village (BT078693), conducted a sweep of the village. As the squad swept through the village, five VC in two sampans were forced into the Seal Team ambush. As the sampans moved into the killing zone they were taken under fire resulting in five VC KIA. One body was recovered from the river, however the other bodies and weapons were not recovered. Two ammo cans containing documents were found in the sampans, as well as, assorted food and clothing.

2. Volunteer Informant Program. VIP expenditures increased over the previous month's total. The majority of expenditures were paid to civilians for miscellaneous ordnance. Listed below are the expenditures for the month of November:

3. Ground Surveillance. There were eight metallic activations recorded during the month. These activations were utilized for intelligence acquisition and as a result no fire missions were called.

4. Weather. Rainfall during the month was moderate with a total of 10.27 inches of rain. Flooding conditions due to heavy rains during October continued into November marginally hindering 1st Marines' operations while severely hampering the enemy. Cross-country movement remained difficult during the month and was generally channelized along rice paddy dikes and elevated trails in the lowland areas. The average high temperature was 87 degrees and the low was 65 degrees. Humidity averaged 84 percent.

5. Terrain

a. The terrain in the 1st Marines' TAOR is divided into two primary features, the coastal plains and low mountains. The coastal plains consist of poorly drained flat areas of rice cultivation and dryland farming. Riceland elevations rarely exceed 20 meters and average five meters, in the area east of the low mountains and foothills, west of DA NANG.

b. There are low mountains within three kilometers of the coast, overlooking DA NANG. These low mountains are separated from higher mountain formations to the west by a rolling plain varying in width from three to nine kilometers. Slopes on the low mountains are commonly 30 to 35 percent, becoming more gradual as they merge into the coastal plain. The highest elevation in this group is 364 meters.

c. West of the low mountains across the rolling plain, elevations rise sharply and the terrain is extremely rugged. Steeply-sloped mountains predominate for approximately one third of the area along the entire western portion of the TAOR. The exceptions, other than the coastal plain, are the river valleys. Multi-canopied forest with dense undergrowth is prevalent throughout the mountainous area.

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d. Rivers and streams fragment the TAOR, both E-W and N-S. The seven main rivers, the CU DE, VINH DIEN, CAU DO, TUY LOAN, VU GIA, THU BON and YEN are navigable by shallow-draft boats.

e. Located within the TAOR are Routes 1, 4, 538, 539, 540, 541, 542, 543, 544, 545 and 587. All of these routes are elevated and pose no trafficability problems, except during and after heavy monsoon rains, when they are flooded in low spots.

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SECTION C
OPERATIONS1. GENERAL

a. The month of November continued as a period of diminished enemy activity throughout the 1st Marines' TAO. While emphasis continued to be placed on intensified preemptive operations for rocket belt security in defense of the DA NANG Vital Area, rice denial operations were conducted in cooperation with the Armed Forces of the Republic of Vietnam and local territorial forces. Support of the accelerated pacification program continued with participation in the Combined Unit Pacification Program.

b. On the 1st of November at 1500H the Assistant Commandant of the Marine Corps, General Lewis W. WALT visited the 1st Marines' CP where he received an operational briefing and orientation by the Commanding Officer, 1st Marines. After the briefing General WALT addressed the Officers and men of the 1st Marines in the Camp Perdue Mess Hall.

c. On 10 November at 1700H the Commanding Generals of III MAF and the 1st Marine Division attended the Marine Corps Birthday cake cutting ceremonies of the 1st Marines at Camp Perdue.

d. On 12 November at 1430H Colonel MEINZIN, USA, A'sst C/S G-3 and Colonel DOYLE, USA, A'sst C/S G-1 of XXIV Corps Headquarters visited the 1st Marines' CP where they received an operational brief from Colonel KELLEY, CO, 1st Marines.

e. During the 14th and 15th of November 1/1 (-) conducted search and destroy operations in the "Football Island" area vicinity (ATB952). This operation uncovered numerous enemy bunker complexes and large caches of food supplies; the operation was terminated prematurely due to threatening weather conditions.

f. On the 15th of November a combined operation of a squad of G/2/1 and a Vietnamese Navy Seal Team ambushed two sampans on Finger Lake (BTO76697) killing five VC and wounding one.

g. On the 18th of November Brigadier General CHADLE, USAF, A'sst C/S J-6, MACV visited the 1st Marines' CP where he received a brief from the Communications Officer, 1st Marines and viewed an experimental switchboard (SB-3082).

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h. During the period of 18-20 November 2/1 (-) combined with units from the 51st ARVN Regiment conducted a Cordon and Search operation in the vicinity of QUANG BONG (1) (AT990610). This combined operation was highly successful, resulting in eight enemy KIA's, four NVA captured, two weapons captured and numerous pieces of field equipment and intelligence documents captured.

i. Major General A. ADAMS, DCG, FMF PAC, visited OP RENO on the 22nd of November where he received an operational brief and orientation of the 1st Marines TAOR from the CO, 1st Marines.

j. On 22 November the 1st Marines initiated a Quick Reaction Force (QRF). This force consists of a Reinforced Platoon and a Helicopter package of one UH1E, three CH46's and two Gun ships. The Platoon (Rein) is OPCON to the Regiment and is located at the Regimental OP at Camp Ford.

k. During the period of 22 to 28 November the 1st Marines employed its newly developed Quick Reaction Force on three different targets. The most significant of these was the village of THON BON (2) (AT972518). The results of this operation were three enemy KIA, three Detainees captured, two of whom were found to be VE.

l. The month of November closed without further significant events. Enemy sightings and contacts remained as in the past few months at a very low level.

2. COMBAT SUPPORT OPERATIONS

a. ARTILLERY

(1) Throughout the month of November, the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its assigned mission of providing direct support fires for Marine and RVN units operating in the 1st Marines TAOR. "L" Battery, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines provided reinforcing fires as required throughout the month.

(2) The ship was utilized to fire pre-emptive targets in the western portion of the TAOR. On 24 November, the USS OKLAHOMA CITY fired observed missions in 3d Battalion, 1st Marines' TAOR on an enemy harbor site resulting in negative surveillance due to foliage cover. On 26 November, the USS OKLAHOMA CITY fired observed missions in 3d Battalion, 1st Marines TAOR on an enemy harbor site resulting in enemy harbor site neutralized, three secondary explosions and 150 meters of tree line destroyed. One mission was controlled by an aerial observer but no surveillance was available.

c. AIR SUPPORT

(1) The First Marine Aircraft Wing executed more heliborne assault missions for the 1st Marines during November than in any other month this calendar year. The initiation of the Quick Reaction Force (QRF) on 23 November 1970 proved to be a definite asset in the accomplishment of the mission to provide ground forces to exploit enemy

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sightings, intelligence targets and battle damage assessment by the means of heliborne assault forces. The helicopter support package for this ORF consists of three CH46's, two AH1G's and one UH1E(S) for the Command and Control Group. A total of four ORF missions were executed and completed successfully during November.

November produced an increase in the number of TPQ-10 missions flown in support of the 1st Marines. This was due to the increased availability of the DA NANG ASRT for the control of the TPQ-10 missions. The number of close air support and beacon controlled air strikes remained constant with the previous month's total.

The first employment of the CBU-55 in Vietnam was accomplished in the 1st Marines' TAOR with questionable results; however, subsequent missions proved to be more successful and proper employment of the CBU-55 will be determined after more testing of the weapon and its delivery.

(d) BDA included three enemy killed by air; destruction of five bunkers, 18 secondary explosions, 30 secondary fires and 1480 meters of treeline, 80 meters of trench line and 4 caves destroyed.

(3) Operational Discrepancies. None.

(4) Downed and Damaged Aircraft

(a) 5 November 1970 - Scarface 30, AHIG, made an emergency landing at BT086704 after losing the tail rotor. The crew was rescued and the helicopter lifted to Marble Mountain Air Facility.

(5) Anti-aircraft fire incidents. Anti-aircraft incidents decreased from the previous month. This was attributed to a decline in the fire incidents in and around Hill 52 (ZC214552).

d. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

(1) During the month of November the 1st Marines' MEDCAPS treated a total of 2,130 Vietnamese civilians. Units not organic to this command conducting MEDCAPS in the 1st Marines' CAAOR treated an additional 1,000 civilians. Another 43 persons received DENTCAPS. In conjunction with MEDCAPS, leaflets promoting rewards, rice denial, and anti-VC/NVA themes were disseminated. Broadcasts supporting the same themes were conducted by the HB team concurrently with the dissemination of printed material. The HB team also participated in tactical operations conducted by the 2d Battalion. During the early part of the month they warned the local populace in both the 1st and 2d Battalion areas to prepare for flooding caused by heavy rains. During the floods, the 1st Battalion assisted approximately 1,000 civilians rendered homeless and arranged for the evacuation and transportation of flood victims in cooperation with DAI LOC District. Aerial broadcasts and leaflet drops were conducted on 12 occasions throughout the CAAOR, but bad weather forced the cancellation of several flights. The Early word broadcasting system was utilized twice by the 2d Battalion to support 2/1 Marines in contact with enemy forces.

(2) Armed Propaganda Teams were employed to proselytize the people in both the 2d and 3d Battalion area. One team operated in the CHAU SON THAI CAM region (AT950605) of DIEN BAN District, conducting face-to-face communications and compiling blacklists of local VC

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personalities. The 3d Battalion's team operated in KIM LIEN hamlet (AT925856) of HOA VANG District, and collected significant information on VC activities in that area. Both teams performed in a highly satisfactory manner during their stay with 1st Marines.

(3) A Political Warfare team was used by the 2d Battalion during a special operation held in the LE SON area (AT981659). The team conducted face-to-face communications, distributed pro-GVN leaflets, and conducted MEDCAPS. They were used very effectively to control the crowds of people being screened during the operation.

(4) The HE Team was employed on 14 different occasions in 10 different locations before a total of 2,635 persons throughout the CAAR. Both daylight and nighttime showings were utilized. Crowd reactions continue to be most favorable.

(5) A PsyOps Exploitation Team (POET) was used to exploit GVN-Marine battlefield successes in the Hill 55 region of DIEN BAN District. Broadcasts and leaflets emphasizing strength of GVN and its allies were utilized throughout the area, as well as face-to-face PsyOps.

SECTION E
LOGISTICS1. Supply-Logistics

a. As in preceding months, the logistical posture of the 1st Marines continued to improve during the month of November. This improvement is attributed primarily to continued command interest in the MAREB reporting system and the Combined Allowance List (CAL) and utilization of the information derived from these reports as a management tool. The Regiment possesses 97% of the Combat Essential Equipment authorized by Tables of Equipment and Special Allowances. Of the quantities of equipment possessed, 94% is operationally ready. Redistribution of excess material between the Regiment and other Division units diminished considerably during November. However, redistribution of excesses to alleviate deficiencies within the Regiment continued as required throughout the month. There were no requests for modifications of T/E allowances during the reporting period. A review of special allowances was conducted and the recommendations, if approved by the Commanding General, will serve to reduce appreciably the quantity of special allowances on hand which are no longer required.

b. Supply point distribution, except as noted below for certain classes of supply for 1st Battalion, with Force Logistic Command providing all classes of supply, continued throughout the month. As reported previously, unit distribution of Classes I, III and V continued for 1st Battalion at Hill 37 with Logistic Support Unit #5 providing this support. Supply point distribution remained in effect for the remaining classes of supply for the 1st Battalion.

2. Lines of Communication. Severe monsoon conditions during late October and early November caused serious flooding in some areas of the 1st Marines' Tactical Area of Responsibility. The 1st Battalion's area suffered most from these storms and resultant flooding, with the piling of London Bridge severely damaged which made the bridge unsafe for military use. In addition, numerous cuts and culvert washouts severed Route 540 in many places. Engineer priorities of effort were established; London Bridge is currently being repaired and the severed Route 540 is open from DA NANG to Hill 65.

3. Transportation. The Regiment was augmented by twenty (20) M35 Trucks from the 1st Motor Transport Battalion. These trucks are utilized daily in performance of supply/resupply, troop administrative movements and other housekeeping functions. These vehicles are allocated within the Regiment as follows:

In addition to this regular motor transport augmentation, the 1st Marine Division continued to provide general and direct motor transport support for requirements beyond the capability of the Regiment. During the period, convoys utilized Route 1 and 4 East due to London Bridge being damaged.

4. Maintenance and Engineer Assistance

a. Equipment maintenance support was provided by the Force Logistic Command. The following table depicts the number of Headquarters Company, 1st Marines Tactical Equipment Repair Orders (TERO) submitted and completed during November 1970.

b. Although signs of improvement in Common Service Support rendered by the U. S. Army contractor, the Philco Ford Corporation, were noted in previous months, there was a marked decrease in the contractors response to work requests of an emergency nature during November. Requests of this type included repair of leaking water pipes, garrison property refrigeration equipment and other garrison property mess hall equipment.

c. A concentrated effort by the 1st Battalion to prepare the Hill 10 cantonment for turnover to the Vietnamese Government progressed satisfactorily during the latter half of the reporting period. The guidelines contained in CG 1st Marine Division message 292103Z July 70 were followed.

d. Shore party support by Company "C", 1st Shore Party Battalion has continued to be excellent; landing zone operation and the provision of material handling equipment for commitments in the 1st Marines' Command Post area were particularly noteworthy.

5. Embarkation. Preparation for the forthcoming Command Material Management Inspection (CMMI) caused greater attention to embarkation matters. Courtesy inspections by the Division Embarkation Officer and inspections conducted by Regimental personnel further improved the 1st Marines embarkation readiness. An increase in requests for mount out containers by

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units was noted, which indicates increased emphasis on embarkation planning on the Battalion level. These requests were considered at the Regimental level and most requests were forwarded to the Division for engineer execution. The assigned Regimental Assistant S-4/Embarkation Officer completed Embarkation School on Okinawa. Units organic to the Regiment will continue to be furnished quotas to this course as they are made available.

6. Sanitation. Conscientious sanitation programs have continued to receive immediate command attention and a high state of sanitation is maintained throughout the 1st Marines' TAOR. Sanitation inspections are conducted regularly by medical personnel organic to the Regiment in addition to the inspections conducted by the Preventive Medicine Unit of the 1st Medical Battalion.

7. Medical

a. Medical facilities were maintained during November throughout the Regimental TAOR. Each unit held routine daily sick call and treated patients within its capability as outlined in sub-paragraph c below.

b. The medical facilities were manned by a total of seven Medical Officers, one Dental Officer, 151 Corpsmen and one Dental Technician.

CIVIL AFFAIRS-CIVIC ACTION1. PUBLIC WORKS

During November the 1st Battalion provided six truckloads of sand for repair work to walkways at the DAI LOC High School (AT916577). The 2d Battalion distributed tin and plywood to LE SON hamlet (AT 981659) for repair work to the school, damaged by floods and high winds. Cement and tin were also provided for TAN LUU hamlet (BT086690), to be utilized to complete the new school constructed through the joint efforts of the hamlet PSDF's and the R.D. cadre. The R.D. cadre of XUAN TRA New Life Hamlet (BT064673) was given plywood to be made into pro-GVN and anti-VC signs for local display. Construction on a swing set was completed in HOA LONG village, and the old church was provided with materials to repair holes in the roof. Speed limit signs were posted on main roads passing through village areas throughout the 2d Battalion's CMAOR. The 3d Battalion provided building materials for the church in LOC HOA (AT925771), damaged by high winds during November typhoons.

2. WELFARE

The 1st Battalion continued to distribute health and comfort items to needy civilians in DAI LOC District. The 3d Battalion provided the PHUOC THANH Orphanage (AT956787) with foodstuffs and building materials, and also gave tin, lumber, and nails to a local hamlet resident whose home was destroyed by typhoon winds. Throughout the Regiment a total of 367,250\$ VN was paid to local hire workers under the Assistance in Kind (AIK) fund.

3. EDUCATION

The 1st Battalion provided the DAI LOC High School with 100 school kits, and with Marines to assist in the teaching of English to local children and hamlet residents. The Regimental S-5 also conducted English classes at a local high school in DA NANG. The 2d Battalion continues to emphasize its school construction program, and the school in TAN LUU hamlet (BT086690) is near completion. A request for building materials to repair schools damaged by recent storm winds has been forwarded to the appropriate District officials.

4. HEALTH

This Regiment's MedCaps treated a total of 2,130 civilians during November, and units not organic to this command conducting MedCaps within the 1st Marines' CMAOR treated an additional 1,000 persons.

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District MedCaps manned solely by Vietnamese personnel, are now being emphasized throughout the CAMOR. During the month of November 43 persons received DentCaps. The 2d Battalion continued to distribute excess foodstuffs from their mess hall to local refugee hamlets, and during the past month they delivered more than 100 cases of meats, vegetables, and fruits to TU CAU (BT035652), TAN LUU (BT066690), and LE SON (AT981659) New Life Hamlets.

5. AGRICULTURE

The Village Self Development Fund is oriented to the agricultural requirements of the various communities, and provides the people the opportunity to use GVN channels for their needs. It is utilized by the various villages throughout the 1st Marines' CAMOR to implement Civil Affairs programs and projects.

6. SOCIAL

Members of the Regimental S-5 section attended two social meals during the past month, and the Regimental Commander hosted the HOA LONG Village Chief for lunch and a discussion at the 1st Marines' P at Camp Perdue.

7. SECURITY

Two cases of hand illumination cannisters were delivered to the People's Self Defense Forces (PSDF) of XUAN TH (NLH) (BT064673) to aid them during periods of poor illumination.

8. SOLATIUM

The 2d Battalion paid a total of 8,000\$ VN for two incidents resulting in the death of two Vietnamese civilians.

COMMUNICATIONS

1. During the month of November, the 1st Marines' Communication Platoon continued to provide radio, telephone and teletype circuits from Camp Perdue to the Battalions. Telephone and teletype circuits to the 1st and 2d Battalions were via integrated wire/radio relay, and via 1st Marine Division cable system to the 3d Battalion. The Regimental Quick Reaction Force was provided communication maintenance and instruction by the Communication Platoon.
2. The Communication Center processed a total of 2,055 messages during November, 343 outgoing and 1,712 incoming. No significant circuit outages occurred, although some disruptions of service were encountered due to power failures at the 1st and 2d Battalions.
3. The Tech Shop received a total of 117 TERO's during November. Of these, 77 were for 2d echelon repair of which, 65 were completed and returned to the using section. Forty TERO's were for 3d echelon and higher, and of these 29 were completed and returned. An additional 27 TERO's pending from previous months were completed.
4. The major effort of the Communication Platoon during November was in improvement of existing facilities and preparation for the forthcoming QMI.
