Sequential Listing of Significant Events as they relate to:

- e. <u>Personnel</u>. During the reporting period two enlisted men were on emergency leave. Twenty-two men from the Company made use of Had Quotas to Okinawa, Hong Kong, Bangkok, Tokyo, Taipei, Manilla, Singapore, Hawali, and Kuala Lumpur. One officer and 20 entisted completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. One Staff Sergeant was commissioned a Second Lieutenant, two LOpis were promoted to Cpl 14 PFC's to LOpi and five Pyts to PFG. Three enlisted men were wounded in action. Two were returned to duty and the third was a Medivae to CONUS. Four Summery Court Martials and one Special Court Martial were conducted during August for violations of articles 80, 81, 107, 108 and 134 of the UUMJ.
- b. Compat Operations and Training. During August there were no operations in which Headquarters Company participated. Improvements continued to be made on the CF Ferimeter. Additional wire was laid and heavy underbrush and trees were cleared on the east flank. The CF was harressed on five separate occassions by automatic weapons fire and grenades. The ensuing firefights resulted in two Marines WIA and one VC KIA (prob) and one VC WIA (prob). Daily use of patrols and ambushes have been initiated to give added warning to the CP and to discourage future VD probes. Two VCS have been captured on the above mentioned patrols,

DEPAILED CHRONOLOGY

- 1. At 010530H, 1st Marines perimeter received one grenade from unknown number of VC's resulting in one USMC WIA.
- 2. At 101200H, 1st Marines perimeter received sniper rounds from approximately one VC resulting in no casualties. Fire team sent to check area. Negative results.
- At 101930H, 1st Harines perimeter received S/A fire from an unknown number of VC's. Condition 1 was set and perimeter was manned by all hands. Patrol was dispatched with negative results. No casualties received.
 - 4. At 102350H. Headquarters Company ambush fired on one VC resulting in one VC WIA (prob).
 - 5. At 221945H, 1st Marines parimeter received S/A fire from unknown number of VC's resulting in one USMC WIA. Heturned S/A and MG fire with negative results.
 - 6. At 132050H, 1st Marines perimeter received S/A fire from unknown number of VC's. No casualties received. Returned S/A fire resulting in one VC KIA (prob).
- 7. At 272145H, 1st Marines perimeter observed man w/flashlight. Selivered S/A fire with negative results.
