2. Sequential Listing of Significant Events as they Relate to:

- a. Personnel. Eighteen men from the company made use of R&R Suotas to Okinawa, Taipei, Hawati, Kuala Lumpur, Yong Kong, Bangkok, Manila, Singapore, Penarg, and Tokyo.
