2. SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS PARTAINING TO:

a. Personnel. Twenty-three Officers and men from the Company made use of RYR Quotas to Minawa, mong Mong, Langkok, Tokyo, Taipei, Muala Lumpur and Lawaii.
