2. SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENES PARTAINING TO:

a. Personnel. Twenty-three Officers and men from the Company made use of Rim Quotas to Ekinawa, Mong Mong, Bangkok, Tokyo, Taipei, Muala Lumpur and Mawaii.
