2. SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS PERTAINING TO:

a. Personnel. Twenty-three Officers and men from the Company made use of R&R Quotas to Okinawa, Hong Kong, Bangkok, Tokyo, Taipei, Kuala Lumpur and Hawaii. One Officer and ten enlisted men completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Fourteen enlisted men extended overseas tours, seven of which departed RVN on Special 30 day leave. One Staff Sergeant was promoted to Gunnery Sergeant, five Corporals were promoted to Sergeant, two Lance Corporals were promoted to Corporal, and seven Private's First Class were promoted to Lance Corporal. Four Private's First Class were promoted to Lance Corporal meritoriously and one Private was promoted to Private First Class meritoriously.

b. Combat Operations and Training.

(1) The CP was harassed on twelve separate occasions by small arms sniper fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No VC casualties were reported.

(2) Combined operating unit consisting of six Marines and 11 Regional Forces Troops has been established in Luong Son (2). Improvements continue to be made on the CP perimeter in the form of additional wire, additional lights, tin cans and trip flares placed in the wire. The combined operating unit conducted patrols and ambushes.

c. Logistics.

(1) Supply. A total of 400 requisitions were submitted to the Fleet Logistics Stock account. Nine requisitions were priority O2 for critical repair parts. Twenty were priority O5 for essential items, and the remaining constituted support and routine stock replenishment.



6Dec66 - 1940 CP received approximately ten rounds S/A fire resulting in no Marine casualties. Returned five rounds S/A fire with negative results.

8Dec66 - 2225 CP received approximately ten rounds S/A fire resulting in no Marine Casualties. Returned eight rounds S/A fire with negative results.

9Dec66 - 0015 CP received one round sniper fire resulting in no Marine casualties. Returned six rounds S/A fire with negative results.

12Dec66 - 1410 Combined operating unit received approximately 25 rounds S/A fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No return fire.

1415 Combined operating unit received approximately 15 rounds S/A fire resulting in no Marine casualties. Returned fire with four M-79 rounds with negative results.

13Dec66 - 2125 CP received one round sniper fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No return fire.

14Dec66 - 1922 CP received unknown number rounds S/A fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No return fire.

15Dec66 - 2240 CP received one round sniper fire resulting in no Marine casualties. Returned fire with two rounds S/A fire. Negative results.

18Dec66 - 2035 Combined operating unit received unknown number rounds S/A fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No return fire.

20Dec66 - 1835 CP received one round sniper fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No return fire.

24Dec66 - 0235 CP received approximately 30 rounds S/A fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No return fire.

30Dec66 - 2000 CP received approximately three rounds sniper fire resulting in no Marine casualties. No return fire.
