Part II

Narrative Summary

1. Personnel. Two officers and fourteen enlisted personnel completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Twenty members of this company made use of R & R quotas to Hong Kong, Kuala Lumpur, Hawaii, Tokyo, Singapore, Taipei, and Bangkok. Two enlisted members extended overseas tours with three men departing on special thirty day leave in connection with tour extensions.

2. Combat Operations and Training. Members of this Company participated in "Operation STONE" during the period 12-19Feb67. The C. P. was harassed on four separate occasions by small arms fire and one hand grenade, resulting in no Marine casualties. No VC casualties reported. Improvements continue to be made on the C. P. perimeter in the form of additional wire, additional fighting holes, and improvements on present positions. The Combined Action Unit continues to live and operate in Duong Son (2). Listening posts, ambushes, and patrols continue. Indoctrination was conducted for all personnel joined during reporting period.

3. Logistics.a. Supply.

(1) During the month of February this organization submitted 264 requisitions of which 24 were a priority 05, 162 a priority 12, and the remaining 78 a priority 17.

(2) Quantities of material on hand was sufficient to satisfy 67 per cent of the recurring demands received. Shortages are on valid priority requisitions.

b. Motor Transport.

(1) Motor Transport vehicles suffered no accidents, damage or pilferage during the month of February.

(2) Motor Transport vehicles traveled a total of 13,491 miles during the month of February.

(3) Two vehicles were deadlined during the month of February and turned into FLSC for repair.
