PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Personnel. One officer and sixteen enlisted personnel completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Twenty-six members of this Command made use of R&R quotas to OKINAWA, HAWAII, BANGKOK, HONG KONG, TOKYO, MANILA, TAIPEI, SINGAPORE, and KUALA LUMPUR. One enlisted member extended his overseas tour, with eight men departing on special 30 Day Leaves in connection with tour extensions. One member departed on 30 Day Special Leave as result of re-enlisting. This company suffered 1 KIA enlisted; 1 DOW enlisted; 2 WIA enlisted; (one med-evac and one non-evac) and one WIA Naval Officer.

2. Combat Operations and Training. The Command Post was harrassed by S/A fire on four separate occasions resulting in no Marine Casualties. At 0001H on 1 September 1967, an explosion near post #14 was classified as an incoming grenade; again resulting in no casualties. Listening post, ambushes and patrols continue. Practice alerts were held on two separate occasions to insure readiness of all personnel.

3. Logistics

a. Supply. During the month of August this organization submitted 359 requisitions of which 10 were priority 02; 30 on priority 05; 204 on priority 12 and the remaining 115 on priority 17.

b. Motor Transport

(1) One motor transport vehicle was destroyed by an enemy explosive device during the month of August.

(2) Motor Transport Vehicles travelled a total of 21,742 miles during the month of August 1967.

(3) Eight vehicles were deadlined for a total of 76 days, due to lack of parts.
