PART II  
Narrative Summary

1. Personnel. Two officers and twenty-three enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. One Officer and fifteen enlisted replacements were joined into this company during December. Two Officers and twenty-one enlisted members made use of R & R quotas to Manila, Okinawa, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Tokyo, Bangkok, HongKong, Hawaii and Taipei. Three enlisted members extended their overseas tours during the month of December.

2. Combat Operations and Training. Thirty persons received instructions, Fam-Fired and zeroed their M-16 rifles. Eighteen members Fam-Fired the M-60 Machine-gun and twelve fired the M-79 Grenade Launcher during December. Fifteen members received instruction in the care and operation of the Starlight Scope. Practice alerts were held on three separate occasions during December.

3. Logistics.

a. Supply. During the month of December this organization submitted 428 requisitions of which 57 were a priority 02, 65 a priority 05, 237 a priority 12, and the remaining 69 a priority 17. Quantities on hand were sufficient to satisfy 50% of the recurring demands. Shortages are on valid priority requisitions.

b. Motor Transport.

(1) Motor Vehicles suffered no accidents, damage or pilferage during the month of December

(2) Motor Vehicles traveled a total of 6,159 miles during December.

(3) Eleven Vehicles were deadlined for a total of 252 days due to lack of parts.
