## PART II Narrative Summary

- 1. Personnel. Two officers and twenty-three enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to ONUS. One Officer and fifteen enlisted replacements were joined into this company during December. Two Officers and twenty-one enlisted members made use of R & R quotas to Manila, Okinawa, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hongkong, Hawaii and Taipei. Three enlisted members extended their overseas tours during the month of December.
- 2. Combat Operations and Training. Thirty persons received instructions, Fam-Fired and zeroed their M-16 rifles. Eighteen members Fam-Fired the M-60 Machinegun and twelve fired the 4-79 Grenade Launcher during December. Fifteen members received instruction in the care and operation of the Starlight Scope. Practice alerts were held on three separate occasions during December.

3. Logistics.
