PART III
Narrative Summary

1. Personnel. 2 officers and 16 enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to COMUS during the month. 2 Officers and 21 enlisted men made use of R&R quotas to Hawaii, Australia, Kuala Lumpur, Manila, Okinawa, Tokyo, Taipei, Hong Kong and Bangkok. Three enlisted members extended their tours during the month.
2. Combat Operations and Training. Classes conducted during the month were on the use of the M16 and M14, Map and Compass Reading, Personal Response, M5 Pistol, M16-50 Rifle and Prevention and Treatment of Heat Casualties. On 18-19 March numerous stray rounds were received throughout the compound. One KIA occurred as a result.
3. Logistics. Motor transport vehicles traveled 18,736 miles during the month of March 1969. There was only one serious accident during the month which occurred on the 31 April 1969. It resulted in one Vietnamese civilian being killed.
