Part II  
Narrative Summary

1. Personnel. Thirteen enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Two Officers and twenty-two enlisted members made use of R&R quotas to Okinawa, Taipei, Hong Kong, Australia, Hawaii, Penang, Kuala Lumpur, Singapore, and Bangkok. One officer and four enlisted members extended their tour during the month of January 1969.
