PART II
Narrative Summary

1. Personnel: Five officers and eighteen enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Two officers and eighteen enlisted members made use of R & R quotas to Manila, Singapore, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hong Kong, Taipei, and Hawaii. Six officers and nineteen enlisted members were joined on the rolls of this company during the month of August. Two enlisted members extended their overseas tours during the month.

2. Combat Operations and Training Classes: Classes were conducted on 6, 7, 8, and 9 August on Fam firing of T/0 weapons for battle zero. On 18 August 1969, the 1st Marine Regiment moved from its previous combat base located at Duong Son (2) to its present location. The move was completed on 21 August without damage or loss of equipment or personnel. The remainder of the month was used to repair and construct adequate living quarters.

3. Motor vehicles suffered no accidents, damage or pilferage during the month. Total miles traveled during August was 11,911. Three vehicles were downline for a total period of 93 days due to the lack of sufficient parts.
