NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Personnel. Four officers and thirty-three enlisted Marines completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. One officer and sixteen enlisted Marines made use of R & R quotas to Manila, Singapore, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hong Kong, Taipei, Australia and Hawaii. Eight officers and twenty-five enlisted Marines were joined on the rolls of this Company during the month of October. Four enlisted Marines extended their overseas tours during the month.

2. Combat Operations and Training Classes. Classes were conducted on 1 and 2 October on "Personal Responsibility," 8 and 9 October on "Calling in/Directing Arty and 81mm Illum," 15 and 16 October on "Drugs, Malaria and Care of Feet," on 22 and 23 October on "Basic Map Reading, Compass Intersection-Resection," 29 and 30 October on "M-60 Machinegun," (to include FAM firing). Headquarters Co., 1st Marines actively participated in the defense of Camp MJIR.

3. Motor Transport. Vehicles suffered no accidents, damage or pilferage during the month. Total miles traveled during October were 14,559. There were eight vehicles deadlined during the month, for a total of 66 days, due to time spent at FSR for repair and lack of sufficient parts. One vehicle was turned into FSR for survey and was replaced with a new one.
