NARRATIVE SUMMARY

DECLASSIFIED

1. Personnel. Six Officers and thirty-three enlisted Marines completed overseas tours and rotated to JONUS. Thirty-one enlisted Marines made use of R & R quotas to Manila, Singapore, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hong Kong, Taipei, Australia and Hawaii. Three Officers and thirty-four enlisted Marines joined this Company during the month of November. Three enlisted Marines extended their overseas tours during the month.

2. Combat Operations and Training Classes. Classes were conducted on the importance of Drug Suppression, M-16 rifle, M-72 LAAM, M-60 Machine Gun and M18A1 Claymore mine (to include FAM firing). Headquarters Company, First Marines actively participated in the defense of Camp MUIR.

3. Motor Transport. One vehicle suffered an accident during the month resulting in approximately \$500 in damages to the front end. Total miles traveled during November were 13,500. There were five vehicles deadlined during the month, for a total of 35 days, due to time spent at FSR for repair and lack of sufficient parts.
