Narrative Summary

1. Personnel. Five officers and twenty-four enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Six officers and twenty-four enlisted members joined the company during December. Four officers and twenty-one enlisted members made use of R&R quotas to Manila, Okinawa, Singapore, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hong Kong, Hawaii, and Taipei. Three enlisted members extended their overseas tours during the month of December.

2. Combat Operations and Training. Personnel were instructed on and FAM fired the .45 cal. pistol, M-14 and M-16 rifle, and the M-60 machine-gun. Marines also received instructions on Drug Abuse, Malaria/prevention, foot care, call for fire, night illumination, call for air, and Med-Evacs. Headquarters Company personnel actively participated in the defense of Hill 55.

3. Logistics

a. Supply. Headquarters Company Supply continued to draw equipment from FLC in Danang. Shortages in priority equipment were kept to a minimum and all shortages are valid priority requisitions.
