## NARRATIVE SUMMARY

DECLASSIFIED

1. PERSONNEL. Three officers and 26 enlisted Marines completed their tours in WesPac. Twenty-five Marines made use of the R & R quotas to Manila, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hong-Kong, Taipei, Australia, Hawaii, and Okinawa. Nine officers and forty-one enlisted personnel joined the Company during the month of February. There were no overseas extensions during the month.

2. COMBAT OPERATIONS AND TRAINING CLASSES. Training classes were held during the month of February with emphasis on personal response, Starlite scopes, claymore mines, M-72 LAAW, and the M-60 machine gun. Pam-firing of the M-14, M-16, M-60, and M-79 were held throughout the month. Headquarters Company, First Marines, actively participated in the defense of Camp MUIR.

3. MOTOR TRANSPORT. This Company experienced no accidents during the month of February. The total number of miles driven by Company vehicles was 14,460. There were a total of 9 vehicles deadlined for a total of 66 days. Five for second echelon, four for third echelon, and one code H.
