NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. PERSONNEL. Three officers and thirteen enlisted Marines participated in R & R during the month of April, to Manila, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hong-Kong, Taipei, Australia, Okinawa, and Hawaii. Eight enlisted personnel completed their tours in WestPac and rotated. Three officers and eight enlisted Marines joined Headquarters Company during the month of April. There were two extensions granted during the month.

2. COMBAT OPERATIONS AND TRAINING. Classes were conducted at Camp PERDUE on Leadership, Moral Guidance, Drug Abuse, and Courtesy and Discipline.
