Approximately 150 villagers were in attendance. No men of military age were in the hamlet during the operation. Villagers seemed friendly and cheerful. They seemed to be very grateful for sickcall and gifts.

G. Reaction of people.

Villagers throughout 1/1 TACR, within the MRR continues to be friendly towards Marines. No incidents between U. S. and Vietnamese Nationals occurred which would result in alienating the villagers against U. S. Forces. (Also see Para. F Above)

Approximately 300 villagers attended. They were very receptive and paid much attention to both lecturers. At the end of the lecture, both lecturers received much applause. The civic action portion of the operation consisted of sickcall (see para. C above); and distribution of goods (see para C above).

The people of An Tan were very friendly and seemed very grateful for sickcall and gifts. This was the first time such an operation has held in this area. The people seemed quite surprised at our capability to show police and lay music.
