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2. Administration

a. Awards. On 28 September 1967 Lieutenant Colonel A. F. BELBUSTI, Battalion Commander, presented 1 Bronze Star to a member of this Battalion.

b. Promotions. There were 14 sergeant, 68 corporal, 33 lance Corporal and 10 private first class promotions during the month of September.

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3. Intelligence

a. On 100333H Sep67, CAP-D4 was attacked by an estimated 150 Viet Cong using bangalore torpedoes, mortars, and B-40 rockets. The position was completely overrun in the attack, which lasted 30 to 45 minutes before the Viet Cong withdrew. No confirmation of an enemy unit could be found, but it is felt that the attacking force was most likely elements of the V-25 Mainforce battalion and probably approached and withdrew from across the Hoi An River.

b. On 110300H Sep67, this Battalion's Command Post received five (5) 140mm rocket rounds, all of which landed in or near the artillery section causing minor damage. Artillery fired counter-rocket concentrations on suspected rocket launching sites located southeast of the Battalion's Command Post below the Hoi An River.

c. On 110320H Sep67, Hieu Nhon District Headquarters was attacked by an estimated Viet Cong battalion using B-40 rockets, 57mm recoilless rifles, mortars, and satchel charges. The position was completely overrun in the attack, which lasted 15 minutes. No confirmation of an enemy unit could be found, but it is felt that the attacking force was elements of the V-25 Mainforce battalion guided and supplemented by the Q-12 local force company. The attacking force most likely approached from the immediate south.

d. When compared with the previous reporting period, the number of incidents increased just slightly in all categories indicating a continuation in the enemy's policy of harassment and hit-and-run raids.

e. Weather during the reporting period remained favorable to friendly operations within the battalion's TAOR. Water barriers continued to be no problem. The increasing precipitation as yet has not affected operations.

f. The Viet Cong initiated a total of 148 incidents during the reporting period. These incidents are categorized as follows:

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4. Operations and Training

a Operations

(1) The 1st Bn(-) conducted a search and destroy operation on Barrier Island during daylight hours. No significant contact was made.

(2) The Bn conducted normal small unit operations during the month of September. In addition to these operations, the Bn provided security for GVN installations in Dien Ban and Hoi An during the month of September.

(3) Companies A & B conducted a search and destroy operation in Zone 1 of this TAOR. No significant contact was made.

(4) Company A conducted a two day search and destroy operation in Zone 1 of this TAOR. No significant contact was made.

(5) Company C conducted a two search and destroy operation in conjunction with 3/1 in the Viem Dong area. No significant contact was made.

(6) Small unit operations during September resulted in two significant contacts.

(a) Early on the morning of September 10 CAP B-4 was attacked and overrun. This resulted in 7 USMC KIA, 7 USMC WIA, 2 PF KIA, 2 PF WIA and 5 PF KIA.

(b) Companies A and C were conducting search and destroy operations in the Tan My (1) area and the "Horseshoe" area. A Company killed 2 VC and C Company killed 5 VC hiding in caves and/or tunnels. C Company also captured 3 VC, detained 2 Vietnamese and captured 3 weapons.

(7) The Bn conducted extensive small unit operations within the TAOR to find, fix and destroy enemy forces and supplies. During September the Bn conducted 400 fire team, 558 squad, 51 platoon and 6 company operations.

b Training

(1) The following schools were conducted in the Battalion area during September 1967.

(a) One starlight scope school was given for 15 men. The class included 1 hour of class room instruction and two hours of practical application and firing at night.

(b) Three four day orientation courses were conducted for a total of 86 men.

(c) Two, two hour classes were given on the E8 CS-1 Root Disperser System. 65 men attended.

(d) Companies were individually instructed in the use of the Mask, Field Protective, M-17 and a CS gas chamber was used to test Gas Masks.

(e) B&B Co fired the 900" range to test fire and zero their weapons.

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Logistics

a. Supply. During the reporting period, the overall supply situation remained satisfactory with discrepancies. The excesses revealed by the August inventory were invoiced to FLC during September. Some shortages exist, however. These include accessories for M/PAC-25, certain sizes of jungle utilities, jungle boots, some office supplies and items of 782 gear (magazine pouches, canteen covers, helmet sweat bands, and pistol holsters). Previously reported shortages of sandbags no longer exist. Operational emphasis on supply warehousing procedures and supply maintenance of records was stressed during September.

b. Maintenance

(1) Motor Transport

- (a) Seven M42A1 trucks deadlined 3rd echelon, one 2nd echelon : two code X'd.
- (b) One M-170 ambulance deadlined 3rd echelon.
- (c) One MRC-83 deadlined 2nd echelon.
- (d) One M27442 platform deadlined 2nd echelon.
- (e) Two M-107 trailer tank code X'd.

(2) Supply. Three typewriters turned into general supply maintenance company 1st FSR, two of these typewriters have been in for repairs since 26 July.

(3) Engineer. Water pump maintenance continued as a problem area, generator maintenance requirements were high but were resolved during September.

(4) Ordnance. The battalion inventory, LTI and fam firing of M16's is completed, but will be continued on an as required basis. Of 921 authorized M16 rifles 888 are issued, 17 were on requisition and 17 were at FSR for repairs. Disconnectors and recoil springs for the .45 cal pistol were high usage items which continued in short supply.

c. Food Services. The messhall continued to serve A-1-11, Headquarters 4-11, "L" Battery 4-11, 1st platoon 3rd 8 inch Howitzer Battery in addition to H&S Company and one rifle company in garrison. Infantry units and two CAP units were provided chow, food supplements and ice in the field.

d. Cantonment and Camp Facilities. "A" Company 1st Engineers completed the watershed roof for the battalion COC bunker. 7th Engineers graded the laterite road within the Battalion C.P. on several occasions, however, the request for resurfacing and addition to this road is still a valid need with the abandoning of the company patrol base at BT 017572 and the salvaging of materials and Class IV efforts to improve existing positions continued. Additional tent decks were required and valid work requests were submitted for them.

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e. Transportation. The overall transportation picture was impaired by the excessive shortage of M422's due to 3rd echelon deadlines and excessive usage requirements on available vehicles. Previously reported need for assignment of two additional 6x6 trucks still existed.

f. Water. The water point continued to provide 18,000 gallons of water per day with a need for additional water points at critical locations within the TAOR.

g. Embarkation. One Battalion Embarkation NCO attended the Division Embarkation Course and one will be scheduled as soon as a quota is available. The Battalion has three Embarkation schooled officers. Unit embarkation data is up to date, with unit embarkation efforts continuing.

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6. Communications and Electronics

a. General. Radio, wire and message center operations were conducted with no interruptions of essential services.

b. Radio. During the month of September no major difficulties were encountered.

c. Wire. During the month of September a very sharp increase in V.C. activities was noticed in cutting of battalion wire lines outside the C.P.

d. Message Center. Normal "ON LINE " crypto operations were conducted.

e. Maintenance and Supply. Difficulties are outlined in subparagraph (g).

f. Problems Encountered. The shortage of repair and component parts for the AN/PRC-25 radio continued to be serious.

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7. Fire Support Coordination

a. During the month of September, Battery A, 1st Bn, 11th Marines was in direct support of 1st Bn, 1st Mar. Battery L, 4th Bn, 11th Marines and one platoon of the 3rd 8" howitzers provided general support and reinforcing fires. During Operation Shelbyville on 22-28 September, Battery C, 1st Bn, 11th Marines fired in support of the TAOR. Each letter company in the battalion was furnished with two forward observer teams. Classes in map reading and forward observation procedures were conducted during each orientation period. Classes in forward observation procedures were also conducted for the 1st Bn company forward observers.

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9. Air Support

- a. There were 2 TPQ-10 missions cleared and run during September.
- b. A total of 40 Medevacs was flown and is broken down as follows:
13 Emergency Medevacs, 16 Priority Medevacs and 8 Routine Medevacs.
- c. There were 2 Priority Aerial Observer missions flown. There was 1 routine helicopter recon mission flown. Flareships were utilized in 1 emergency and 1 priority mission.
- d. This battalion furnished FAC Teams for eight Rough Riders in September.

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PART III

Sequential Listing of Significant Events

2 September Companies A & D and 1/1 Command Group conducted a S&D operation during daylight hours on Barrier Island.

4 September The Company Patrol Base in Zone 3 was evacuated. All defensive positions were removed or destroyed. This area was patrolled by a roving Company. A wrecker towing a Personnel Carrier was destroyed on Route 14 by a 300 lb command detonated mine. USMC casualties were: 3 KIA and 8 WIA.

5 September Company D chopped OPCON to 5th Marines for Operation SWIFT.

10 September Company C(-) and 1 platoon Company A chopped OI CON to 2/1. CAP D-4 was overrun by approximately 150 VC at 0333H. This action resulted in 7 USMC KIA, 7 USMC WIA, 2 PF KIA, 2 PF WIA, and 5 PF MIA.

11 September Company C(-) and 1 platoon Company A returned OI CON 1/1. Battalion CP received 5, 140 MM rocket rounds at 0300H resulting in 3 USMC WIA and light damage. At 0320H Hieu Nhon District Headquarters was attacked by an estimated VC Battalion. The position was completely overrun in the 15 minute attack.

14 September The boundary between 2/1 and 1/1 TAOBS was changed. Co A returned OI CON to 1/1.

16 September Company A chopped OI CON to 3/1.

21 September Company A returned OI CON to 1/1.

22 September Company D chopped OI CON to 1stMar

23 September Company D chopped OI CON to 2/1.

26 September Companies A and C conducted S&D operations in the Battalion TAOB. These operations resulted in 7 VC KIA confirmed, 3 POW's captured, 2 VN detained and 2 weapons captured.

29 September Company D chopped OI CON to 1/1.

30 September Received Frag Order 133-67 of 300037Z Sep

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Endings:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
