INTELLIGENCE

1. During the period 1-10 February 1968 enemy contact was most substantial in the Hue City area. Companies "A" & "B" bore most of the brunt of the Tet offensive as they defended the MACV compound and moved out to secure portions of the city to the south of the Perfume River against an estimated 2 regiments of NVA who laid siege to the city. Continuous rocket attacks directed against the Hue-Phu Bai area accompanied continuous movement of VC/NVA in and around Hue. Along Highway 1 CAG units and bridge security forces of "D" Company had continuous contact south of Hue to the Truoi River.

2. From 11 February to 29 February enemy contact continued in Hue evincing elaborate planning and superb coordination.

3. During February enemy contact and sightings in the vicinity of the rock crusher, where "C" Company was deployed, vicinity of YD 7313, and along Highway 1 continued apace.

4. It is apparent that adjacent to each bridge on Highway 1 secured by "D" Company there exists fortified areas that serve as staging grounds for hard core VC who have been active in the region for a number of years. To wit: at YD 835174, southwest of Bridge 1; at YD 898113, and YD 905108, south of Bridge 2; at YD 932108, and YD 933110 east of Bridge 3, and in the vicinity of YD 9607 east of Bridge 4.

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A cordon and search of these areas is indicated which cannot be done adequately by the single company responsible for the security of the four bridges.

5. Sightings of enemy moving in large numbers all around the rock crusher area indicate the area constitutes an extensive staging ground for the NVA/VC. Active rocket sites in that vicinity, especially YD 7711, have been observed and it appears that ingress and egress to the city of Hue and the Phu Bai area goes largely unimpeded. Best intelligence indicates the enemy moves thence in a northerly and easterly direction.

Although the roads that lead southwesterly from YD 755134 give no indication of use by enemy vehicles, there are many reports from low level agents and from recon inserts of vehicular movement in that vicinity and in the road complex to the northeast of the rock crusher.

6. Best intelligence sources also indicate the location of the following enemy units: the 802 NVA Battalion at YD 845995; the Hue City Battalion at YD 738038; the 4th NVA Regiment at YD 995928 and the K4B Battalion at YD 915995.

7. The weather throughout the month was overcast and greatly hindered air support and helicopter movement. However, it lifted somewhat in the last days of the month.

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1. OPERATIONSa. General

(1) The Battalion, consisting of "A" & "B" Companies and a Command Group, participated in Operation HUE CITY during the month of Feb.

(2) Company "C" continued to occupy and defend rock crusher area vic YD 7313.

(3) Company "D" continued to provide bridge security at four key bridge sites located vic YD 840173; 913117; 926103; 951069.

(4) On 7 Feb 1968 1stLt C. B. MATTHEWS, Company Commander, Company "B" was killed in action while participating in Operation HUE CITY.

LOGISTICS

1. Supply. During the reporting period supply has been able to function very well, even though most of our operational stock is still absent from the Battalion due to the tactical situation. All classes of supplies are readily available and we have no major items in critical demand.

2. Maintenance

- a. One M-170 ambulance D/L for 3rd echelon maintenance.
- b. Two M-37 trucks D/L for 3rd echelon maintenance.
- c. Two MRC-83 Jeeps D/L for 2nd echelon maintenance.
- d. Sixteen M274A2 platform trucks D/L for 2nd echelon maintenance which is mostly due to a critical shortage of starter assemblies and

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spark plugs. Eleven are D/L for 3rd echelon maintenance.

e. Fourteen M422A1/A2 utility trucks D/L for 3rd echelon maintenance.

3. Engineer. The following work requests have been submitted to Public Works:

a. Grading the ground around the mess hall.

b. Installation of 250 feet of guttering around the mess hall.

c. Construction of a 4 feet by 250 feet concrete walk around the mess hall.

d. Construction of a grease trap for the mess hall.

e. Construction of a 20 feet by 20 feet tropical hut for washing garbage cans.

f. Construction of a berm around the Battalion ammunition supply point.

4. Ordnance

a. Two 106 recoilless rifles D/L for 3rd echelon maintenance.

b. One M-79 grenade launcher D/L for 3rd echelon maintenance.

c. The Battalion's M-60 machine guns are repairable, but old and do not hold up in the field, which necessitates repeated 2nd and 3rd echelon maintenance.

5. Food Services. During most of the reporting period three meals were being served daily by our mess hall. However due to shortages in A and B rations and due to operational commitments only two meals are now being served daily.

6. Cantonment and Camp Facilities. Several projects have been initiated to improve our cantonment. Work requests have been submitted to public works so that these projects might be accomplished. These projects are listed under paragraph 3.

7. Transportation. Maintenance problems with vehicles is still a major hinderence. Due to the present tactical situation we are having problems receiving adequate truck support.

8. Embarkation. All embarkation data is up to date with sufficient embarkation personnel assigned.

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COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS

1. GENERAL

a. On 1 Feb 1968 the Battalion CP was established in cantonment area 5 in the Phu Bai Combat Base.

b. "A" Company was deployed in Hue, "B" Company remained in CP until 3 Feb 1968 and then were deployed in Hue. "C" Company was positioned at rock crusher and "D" Company was deployed on Hill 180 and Bridges 1, 2, 3 and 4 leading into Hue.

2. RADIO. Radio communications to higher headquarters were maintained continuously with no problems encountered.

3. WIRE

a. Wire communications to higher headquarters were maintained continuously.

b. On 4 Feb 1968 the Regimental CP group installed one trunk to our Command Group forward and on 15 Feb 1968 installed a second trunk completing our intergraded wire and radio relay with our Battalion CP rear.

4. MESSAGE CENTER. Continuous courier service for incoming and outgoing message traffic has been maintained. Regiment is Crypto guard for this Battalion.

5. MAINTENANCE AND SUPPLY. Maintenance has been properly performed on all equipment. Supply is outlined in paragraph 6. below.

6. PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED

a. The shortage of repair and accessory parts for the AN/PRC-25 continues to be acute, especially whip and tape type antennas and bases. One PU 239 is at Yokosuka and PU 348 at Okinawa both in for repairs.

b. We are currently operating on a 150 KW camp generator which malfunctions frequently due to wear. A replacement is not available at this time.

c. Two AN/PRC-25 radios and one radio set control group AN/GRA 39A were combat lost during Operation HUE CITY and have been requisitioned.

d. Three men were killed in action and five men were medevaced out of country. The Division CEO has been informed of our losses in order to program replacements.

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MEDICAL

1. During the month of Feb 1968 the Battalion Aid Station was located with the Battalion's rear echelon at Phu Bai. During this period the following trends were noted:

a. A decided increase in upper respiratory infections and viremia-like syndromes. We ascribe this to the protracted exposure to inclement weather experienced in and around Hue.

b. There was also a moderate increase in the number of VD cases.

c. Due to operations in and around Hue, there was also a moderate increase in cases of diarrheal diseases, most of which were self-limited.

- 1 Feb Bridge security unit from Company "D" received S/A from unknown number of VC on Bridge #2. Returned fire resulting in five VC KIA.

Companies "A", "G" (2/5) and Battalion Command Group continued operations in Hue City. Progress very limited due to heavy enemy fire.

- 2 Feb Company "F" (2/5) became OPCON to the Battalion in Hue.

The Battalion continued operations in Hue City with progress still limited due to heavy enemy resistance.

- 3 Feb Company "H" (2/5) became OPCON to the Battalion in Hue.

Bridge #2 security unit from Company "D" received fire from approximately 10 VC. Returned fire resulting in one VC KIA and one AK-47 captured.

Bridge #4 security unit from Company "D" captured one VC POW.

Companies "F", "G" & "H" reverted back to OPCON of 5th Marines at 031400H Feb 1968.

- 7 Feb The Battalion continued operations in Hue City against heavy enemy resistance with some progress being made.

While returning from a resupply run to "C" Company's position, truck convoy was heavily ambushed. Reaction forces from Company "C" and 5th Marines dispatched to scene and returned fire resulting in eight VC KIA.

- 8 Feb Battalion continued operations in Hue City with increased progress being made.

- 9 Feb Hue operation continues with enemy losses in both personnel and equipment mounting.

- 10-29 Feb Hue City operation continued with enemy resistance lessening as the end of the month approached.

- 15 Feb Company "D" security unit from Bridge #4 received heavy fire while on patrol from estimated VC platoon. Returned fire resulting in 4 VC KIA.
