INTELLIGENCE

1. The month of January was characterized by a substantial increase in boobytraps and mining activity. During this period, boobytrap activity increased 130%. Of these, 73% were found, and 27% were detonated. This seems to indicate that the enemy strategy in 1/1's TAOR shifted somewhat to a tactic of avoiding solid contact and denial of areas through the use of boobytraps.

2. There were indications of increased enemy activity in the Dodge City Area. These indications were borne out by the continuous rebuilding of previously destroyed bunker complexes by the NVA/VC. A wounded POW, who had been captured on 26 January by Company "D", reported that elements of the 3rd Battalion, 36th NVA Regiment, had returned to the Dodge City Area since the completion of Operation MEADE RIVER.

3. Reports of terrorist activities in the AO decreased, but reports of enemy employment of night-time propaganda broadcasts increased over last month.

4. Over 30,600\$VN was paid as Voluntary Informant Payments, reflecting the increased effectiveness of the Volunteer Informant Program.

5. On 3 January, at about 2300, the S-5 and the Division's Audio Visual Team were returning from AN TU(1), where they had shown a movie when they were attacked by 2 to 4 VC. The VC were armed with AK-47 weapons and grenades, and the attack was primarily intended to be of a harrassing nature.

6. On 4 January, Company "A" discovered a bunker complex of 10 bunkers arranged in an oval shape centered around BT018602. In the center was a two level command bunker, 51x61x71. The surrounding bunkers were slightly smaller, and all had been composed of debris from previously destroyed fortifications.

7. On 6 January, Company "A", while on a sweep in the Dodge City Area, took approximately 30 NVA under fire at AT995594. Later, 120 NVA were sighted further south. All the enemy were dressed in green and khaki uniforms.

8. On 9 January, a squad of Company "B" in the road position on Anderson Trail East, located at BT020636 was hit by four RPG rounds and light small arms fire. The fire originated from BT002633. The results of this encounter were 1 USMC KIA and enemy casualties not known.

9. On 19 January, Company "C" made contact with a 10 man enemy force at BT066636. The enemy attacked with B-40 rockets and small arms fire from cover of spider holes and bunkers. Both Company "C" and the enemy force sustained negative casualties.

10. During the night of 24 January, a VC unit of unknown size announced with a megaphone to the people of Ngan Trung hamlet (BT 067640) to stay away from the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines cantonment and not to use the road to Pho Ho hamlet (Vicinity BT0763). The people were also cautioned to remain indoors from 1800-0600.

11. During the night of 25 January, an enemy psyops unit (platoon size) broadcast by loudspeaker at BT025610. The broadcast was intended for ARVN soldiers in the area and was of an Anti-Government nature rather than Anti-American.

12. On 31 January, two platoons of Company "A", two platoons of Company "B" and the 106 recoilless rifle platoon cordoned and searched the village of An Tu(2) (BT028625). These units were supported by S-2 personnel, the 1st Sub-Team of 3rd IIT, the 1st Sub-Team of 3rd CIT, and 6 members of the Provisional Reconnaissance Unit. Numerous old fighting holes and collapsed tunnels were discovered, and one VC suspect was apprehended because of information provided by an informant.

OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

1. Operations

a. MISSION. 1st Battalion, 1st Marines was assigned mission to:

(1) Conduct unilateral, joint and combined offensive operations within assigned TAOR to locate and destroy enemy bases and locate installations, with emphasis on those forces and bases which pose the greatest threat to GVN control of important population and economic centers and to the security of military installations.

(2) Deploy forces throughout the assigned TAOR to provide defense of the DaNang Area and military complex with emphasis on routes of approach to probable rocket/mortar launch positions, including waterways.

(3) Support the Revolutionary Development Program within the assigned TAOR.

- (4) Provide security of the Tu Cau Bridge (BT031649).
- (5) Locate and interdict routes of infiltration in TAOR to include waterways.
- (6) Provide security for engineer projects and the upgrading of Route #1, Route #10, and other critical roads within AO.

b. OPERATIONS

(1) On the first of January 1969, the Battalion was conducting aggressive combat operations against the insurgent enemy forces within the assigned TAOR. Company "B" was actively participating in Operation TAYLOR COMCON under the operational control Task Force Yankee, however, Company "M", 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, was op/con to the Battalion and assigned the mission of saturation patrolling in the Duc Ky Area (vicinity AT9961) and La Tho Bac (3) south of the rocket barrier. Company "A" was held as the Battalion reserve and assigned the mission of Bald Eagle and Sparrow Hawk. Company "C" continued to provide security for the Tu Cau Bridge in addition commencing a land clearing operation of the area south of the Tu Cau road and east of the Vinh Dien River. Company "D" provided the necessary security along Anderson Trail and patrolled in conjunction with the 51st ARVN Regiment from outposts in the southeastern sector of the TAOR.

(2) The land clearing operation conducted by engineers in support of Company "C" progressed rapidly following the heavy rains during the early days of the month. The area consisting of approximately three grid squares is comprised basically of low rice paddies interspersed throughout with villages and hamlets bordered by thick bamboo treelines and hedgerows. One rifle platoon provided local security for the engineering equipment and personnel while a second patrolled extensively from 300 to 1000 meters in front of the operations. The principal problems incurred were equipment breakdowns which were planned for and handled expeditiously and mining incidents which are inherent whenever employing tracked vehicles.

(3) During January under 1st Marines Frag O 002-69 the Battalion conducted several company size combat patrol operations combined with the Reconnaissance Company of the 51st ARVN Regiment in the Dodge City Area north of Route 4. Patrol durations varied from 4 to 7 days with Company "A" commencing the operations and Company "D" following on two later occasions. On 4 January Company "A" killed 4 enemy when attacked by small arms fire from concealed positions. On the 5th, the Company accounted for 8 additional kills while firing artillery and organic weapons on an estimated company size unit. Numerous bunkers were found which had been constructed from debris of previously destroyed fortifications. Surprise firing devices were not a problem initially, however, they became notably more prominent in the latter part of the month, especially in areas surrounding river crossing sites.

(4) On 20 January 1969, Company "D" reinforced executed the first night heliborne assault to be conducted in the DaNang area. The Company was supported by transport helicopters from HMM-364 which carried it in the assault. Back-up support was provided by HMM-164 and HMM-165. Gunship escort was provided by HML-167, a TACA was provided by VMO-2, and an F4MS-16 aircraft was on station to illuminate the landing zones during and after the assault.

Planning was initiated at the Battalion's headquarters and involved a briefing and planning session at First Marines attended by the Commanding Officers, or their representatives, of the Battalion, First Marines, the squadrons involved, MAG-16, and the First Marine Air Wing. Demonstrative of the effectiveness and exhaustive detail of the planning is the fact that the assault troops were landed within one minute of L-hour without casualties or loss of any of the supporting aircraft.

#### c. ARTILLERY SUPPORT

(1) During the month of January, Battery "A", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, continued its mission of direct support of the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

(2) On 11 January, a platoon of the 107mm Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, moved into position in the 1st Battalion's cantonment. Their mission was to fire CS gas in support of the Battalion's operations in the Dodge City AO. On 12 January, 18 rounds of CS gas were fired in support of Company "D". The platoon displaced on 17 January.

(3) On 29 and 30 January, Battery "A" fired 60 propaganda rounds to support the Battalion's psychological operations.

(4) In addition to the aforementioned units, Batteries "B" and "C" 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, and Batteries "K" and "L", 4th Battalion, 11th Marines, fired in support of the Battalion's activities. These units fired 600 unobserved missions expending approximately 2500 rounds. The unobserved mission included TOP's, intelligence targets, and harrassing and interdiction fires.

#### d. AIR SUPPORT

(1) During the month of January 1969, an assortment of missions were run in support of the Battalion in the Dodge City Area and in the Battalion TAOR.

(2) A total of 31 close air support missions (fixed wing) were flown by MAG-11, MAG-12, and MAG-13 in support of the Battalion expending a total of 92,500 pounds of bombs, 19,000 pounds of napalm, 24 pods of aircraft rockets, and 8,100 rounds of 20mm ammunition. Damage assessment was as follows: enemy KIA, 2; structures destroyed, 27; structures damaged, 4; bunkers destroyed, 4; bunkers damaged, 2; 370 meters of treeline destroyed; 500 meters of trenchline destroyed; 2 secondary explosions, and 2 sampans destroyed.

(3) A total of 45 hours of flight time was amassed by OV-10 aircraft of VMO-02 on reconnaissance and artillery spotting missions in support of the Battalion.

(4) A total of 12 hours were flown by C-130 aircraft of VMGR-152 providing aerial illumination for the Battalion.

(5) A total of 33 emergency, 41 priority, and 24 routine helicopter medevac sorties were completed.

(6) UH-1E gunships used in support of medevac and resupply helicopters expended 8 rocket pods and 4,000 rounds of 7.62 ammunition.

## LOGISTICS

1. Supply. On 4 January the fiscal section received an inspection from the division comptroller. The inspection was unsatisfactory. The Battalion's obligations of funds were not properly recorded and kept up to date. The section was given 30 days to correct the discrepancies.

All month the section prepared for its reinspection in fiscal and an inspection in supply from the Division Material Management Inspection Team on 21 February 1969. All company and section supply accounts were inspected and T/E allowance lists were reviewed in preparation for the inspection. A rough of the Battalion's phase II budget estimate was submitted to 1st Marines S-4 at the end of January.

During the first part of the month action was taken to turn in all personal effects which had been held in supply because of the lack of identification of the destination. Coordination with the S-1 and all the companies helped in getting most of the personal effects turned in by the end of the month. A Battalion order is currently being rewritten to further expedite the turn-in of personal effects.

2. Maintenance. The deadline rate for prime and non-prime movers has greatly improved over last month's. At the present time the deadline stands at 14% (11 of 80). The scheduled preventive maintenance is up to date.

Projects that have been completed this past month which increase the effectiveness of the motorpool are a double grease rack and a trailer lot.

3. Engineer. During the month of January engineers continued to make considerable improvements on drainage conditions in the cantonment. Also, roads were graded and low areas filled. In addition, 7th Engineers built 16 four-hole heads and 3 strong-backs. Presently a 50 foot sentry tower for the Battalion is under construction on Anderson Trail East. Construction has also begun on the Staff and Officer's Mess which was destroyed by fire in December 1969.

4. Ordnance. The Battalion armory was inspected by 1st Marines on 21 January. The outcome of this inspection was satisfactory with no discrepancies. The armory has greatly improved over previous inspections.

5. Transportation. No major problems arose in transportation during January with all five trucks of Company "B", 1st Motors, running continuously thus giving the Battalion excellent truck support.

6. Embarkation. On 14 January 1969, the Battalion received a courtesy inspection from 1st Marines S-4 on embarkation. The rifle companies received a satisfactory, however, H&S Company received an unsatisfactory. At 2000H on 14 January 1969, a meeting was held to discuss the results of the embarkation readiness inspection to make each company/section aware of the discrepancies noted, to recommend proper corrective actions, to direct each company/section to submit corrected embarkation data, and to schedule a date for reinspection by the Battalion S-4.

#### COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS

##### 1. Radio.

a. On 5 January a construction team from 7th CommBn installed two 40 foot telephone poles near the Battalion COC bunker. Six RC-292 antennae, 4 AS-390 antennae were mounted on the poles by the comm section.

2. Generators

a. One J-124 generator was exchanged with NSA due to faulty governor.

Rewiring was continued as much as equipment on hand would allow, with most of the work being done in the Companies "B" and "C" areas.

MEDICAL

1. General. A total of 800 patients were seen at sickcall, 90 of which were medevaced to other medical facilities. No unusual problems were encountered during the month. There were 12 new cases of venereal disease seen and treated. During the month, 1066 individuals were immunized. A tickler file is maintained for those personnel needing immunizations.

2. Evacuation and Specialty Treatment. Transportation to medical specialty clinics at 1st Medical Battalion and NSA Hospital is provided daily by S-4. An ambulance is used for emergency runs. Medevac helicopters are called where time is of critical importance.

3. MedCap. An on-base MedCap was conducted daily except on Sundays. During the month of January, 2322 patients were treated. In addition 2 or 3 mobile MedCaps were held each week in the nearby hamlets. Patients were referred to Yusom Hospital for in-patient treatment when it was indicated such referral was necessary. X-ray and laboratory facilities were available for Vietnamese civilians at 1st Medical Battalion.

4. Preventive Medicine. Water samples were collected every Monday from various potable water containers, mainly from the water point, mess halls, and Lyster Bags. These water samples were sent to Preventive Medicine Unit at DaNang for Bacteriological examinations.

CIVIC ACTION-PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

1. During the month of January, the MEDCAP reached a total of 2,949 persons, with 11 patients referred to the medical officer. This is more than 100% increase over last month's total. The Plague Eradication Program has reached the outstanding total of 2,949 persons inoculated in our entire TAOR. In addition to the routine medical program, the Battalion is presently training three young Vietnamese girls who will soon be competent nurses.

- b. Bo De School, Viem Tay (BTO34640), is nearly completed.
  - c. Plague Eradication Program is steadily moving at an outstanding rate.
  - d. Construction of a school in Ha Tay is pending Province approval.
  - e. Rebuilding Bich Nam (BT997636) is pending Province approval as a refugee hamlet.
  - f. The Tram-Y-Te (Aid Center) approach at Giang Nam (BT 024657) is nearly completed.
  - g. Construction of a Tram Tin (Information Station) (BTO42622) has been started in Thanh Quit.
  - h. Agricultural projects in Thanh Quit, Viem Tay and Giang Nam, are progressing slowly due to dry weather.
  - i. Cattle Innoculation Program began on 16 January 1969 in Ha Tay by innoculating 460 cattaa and Water Buffalo.
3. No additional General Walt Scholarships were given out this month, leaving the total at 1,350\$VN scholarships and 2,100\$VN scholarships presented to students in our GAAOR.
4. In Personal Response thirty new Marine arrivals were orientated this month on Vietnamese customs and religions.
5. A total of 506 CARE school kits were given to the students of the Bo De School in Viem Tay.
6. Five solatium payments 5400\$VN were paid to Vietnamese civilians.
7. PsyOps during the month of January remained at about the same level as December due to continuous VC activity. During the month PsyOps distributed 3153 leaflets, 3701 newspapers, 600 poster, 380 magazines, 1 aerial leaflet drop, 2 artillery leaflet firings, and 9 ME movie presentations with a total of 1331 in attendance. The APT team was employed at Thanh Quit for 3 days. The GDT team performed at Giang Nam (BTO24657), and Thanh Quit with 540 persons attending.
8. The S-5 section delivered 838 pounds of food stuffs, throughout the GAAOR.

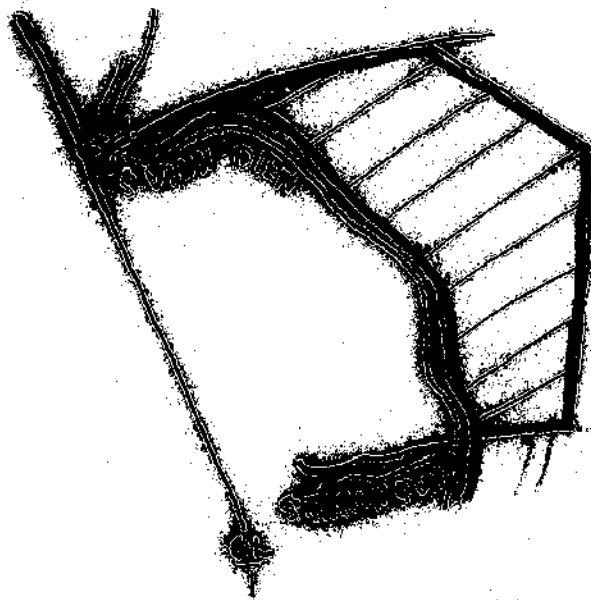
