## INTELLIGENCE

1. The month of February was characterized by a substantial decrease of Surprise Firing Devices (SFD) and mining activity. A breakdown of the month's SFD activity indicates that 77% of all devices were found and 23% were detonated. This decrease in SFD activity was probably caused to a great extent by the land clearing operation that was conducted by Company "C" in the area south of Tu Cau Road and east of the Vinh Dien River. Another possibility is that any VC/NVA in the area may have desired to clear some of the infiltration routes to the DaNang area in order to facilitate troop movements.

2. Indications of substantial enemy activity in the southern Dodge City area were discovered by Company "B" and Company "M" when they operated in the area from 14 to 22 February 69. There were many well worn paths and recently used bunkers in the area. Company "B" and Company "M" also found a substantial quantity of ammunition and weapons, including an 82mm mortar.

3. Enemy initiated <sup>ATTACKS</sup> ~~att~~ for the month totaled 42, reflecting a decrease of 22 from the previous month. However, enemy KIA's increased from 38 to 56.
4. Volunteer Informant Payments amounted to 10,400\$VN, a decrease of 20,200\$VN from the previous month. This decrease is probably a result of the decrease in mining and SFD activity. VIP payments for the year totaled 41,000\$VN.
5. On 1 February, Company "D" detained 14 people while on a cordon and search at Thanh Quit (5) (BT041632). Of these 14 detainees, one was classified a Civil Defendent by ITT. This cordon and search was initiated by reports by two informers.
6. On 2 February, Company "B" detained 10 people during a cordon and search of An Tu (1); Company "B" later discovered two men hiding on the roof of a building. Of the people detained, four were ascertained to be VC infrastructure in the village. The most significant of all material found was 258,000\$VN that was found hidden in the roof of a house. The informers were also utilized during this cordon operation.
7. On 9 February, a platoon of Company "B" detonated an SFD on the Fam-Fire range. This incident resulted in 13 casualties to the platoon and illustrated the necessity of taking extensive precautions against SFD's when anywhere outside the immediate compound.
8. On 12 February, two children threw a hand grenade at a privately employed policeman who works at the Battalion trash dump. No casualties were effected.
9. During their sweep in southern Dodge City from 14 to 22 February Company "B" and Company "M" found in excess of 195 bunkers, numerous ammunition for both small arms and crew served weapons, a PnC-25 radio, and several weapons, including a complete 82mm Mortar.
10. On 21 February, Company "C" found a propaganda float drifting down the Vinh Dien River. It was decorated with NLF flags, flowers, and Anti-American literature.
11. On 27 February, Company "C" observed approximately 100 VC/NVA in the vicinity of An Tu (2). The enemy force was moving from South to North, made a flanking movement, and began moving West to East on line. They were engaged with small arms, mortars and artillery. The forward movement was stopped and they proceeded to disperse in several directions across the paddy. The following morning numerous blood trails were discovered.

## OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

1. Operations:

a. Mission. 1st Battalion, 1st Marines was assigned mission to:

(1) Conduct unilateral, joint and combined offensive operations within the assigned TAOR to locate and destroy enemy bases and locate installations, with emphasis on those forces and bases which pose the greatest threat to GVN control of important population and economic centers and to the security of military installations.

(2) Deploy forces throughout the assigned TAOR to provide defense of the DaNang area and military complex with emphasis on routes of approach to probable rocket/mortar launch positions, including waterways.

(3) Provide security of the Tu Cau Bridge (BT031649)

(4) Locate and interdict routes of infiltration in the TAOR to include waterways.

b. Operations

(1) On the first of February 1969, the Battalion was conducting aggressive combat operations against the insurgent enemy forces within the assigned TAOR. During the period from 1 February until 13 February 1969, Company "A" had the assigned mission of providing security along Anderson Trail (Route 10W) and patrolling in conjunction with the 51st ARVN Regiment from outposts in the Southeast sector of the TAOR. Company "B" continued saturation patrolling in the Duc Ky area (vic AT 9961) and La Tho Bac (3) south of the rocket barrier, while Company "C" continued to provide security for the Tu Cau Bridge and saturation patrolling North and South of the Tu Cau Road and East of the Vinh Dien River. Company "D" was held as the Battalion reserve and assigned the mission of Sparrow Hawk and Bald Eagle.

(2) The land clearing operation commenced by Company "C" on 1 Jan 1969 was successfully terminated on 7 Feb 1969. Company "D" under the 1st Marines Frag O 016-69, went op/con to 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines on 8 February 1969 at 0810H, to be utilized as additional security for the Cau Do and Cam Le Bridges. Company "D" returned op/con to 1/1 on 12 February 1969 at 0938H.

While Company "B" was preparing for extensive combat operations in Dodge City, Company "D" assumed control of the Duc Ky area (vic 9961) and La Tho Bac (3), south of the rocket barrier.

(3) During the period from 14 February until 22 February under 1st Marines Frag O 019-69 the Battalion conducted extensive search and clear operations in the Dodge City AO south of Route #4. These operations were conducted by two companies, Company "B" and Company "M" opcon to 1/1, and the battalion forward command group. The activities in this sector of the Dodge City AO were in conjunction with the combat operations of the 51st ARVN Regiment north of Route #4. Through exhaustive searching techniques, considerable caches were discovered. On 15 February, Company "M" found one (1) 82mm Mortar complete and one (1) PRC 25 Radio complete with one headset and an antenna. On 17 February caches of bangalore torpedoes, B-40 Rockets, AK-47 rounds, one AK-47, and one Chi-C om light machine gun were found. Also on 17 February, Company "M" was attacked by an unknown force of VC/NVA resulting in 9 enemy killed by small arms and air strikes. On 19 February, Company "B"'s night defensive positions were probed resulting in 2 NVA killed. Company "B" again on 21 February had their night positions probed. With the utilization of a field expedient, fougasse, and small arms, Company "B" accounted for 5 enemy killed.

The tactical control of the combat operations in the "Dodge City" area was transferred from 1st Battalion, 1st Marines to 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines on 22 February 1969. The 1st Battalion command group and Company "B" were returned to the Battalion cantonment by helicopter in the afternoon of 22 February. At that time the 3rd Battalion command group and Company "A" arrived in "Dodge City" to continue the combat operations with Company "M". The following afternoon, Company "A" was returned to the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines when the combat operations in "Dodge City" were terminated.

#### c. ARTILLERY

(1) During the month of February Battery "A", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its mission of direct support of the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

(2) In addition, Batteries "B" and "C", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, Batteries "K" and "L", 4th Battalion, 11th Marines and the 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) supported the 1st Battalion's activities.

(3) During February 121 observed missions were fired expending 3243 rounds. Approximately 500 unobserved missions expended approximately 2500 rounds. These unobserved missions included H&I's, and intelligence targets.

d. AIR SUPPORT

(1) During the month of February 1969, an assortment of missions were run in support of the Battalion. A total of 50 close air support missions (fixed wing) were flown by aircraft from MAG-11, MAG-12, and MAG-13, expending a total of 139,500 pounds of bombs, 34,500 pounds of Napalm, 4 pods of aircraft rockets, and 13,300 rounds of 20mm ammunition. Damage assessment was as follows: Enemy KBA, 2; structures destroyed, 10; structures damaged, 5; bunkers destroyed, 13; bunkers damaged, 6; 315 meters of tree line destroyed; 350 meters of trenchline destroyed; 1 secondary explosion, and 2 sampans destroyed.

(2) A total 53 hours of flight time was amassed by OV-10 aircraft of VMO-22 on reconnaissance, artillery spotting missions and close air support in support of the Battalion. Twenty-nine pods of aircraft rockets and 5,200 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition were expended fulfilling this mission. Damage assessment was as follows: Enemy KBA, 3; structures damaged, 3; structures destroyed, 4; and 3 sampans destroyed.

(3) A total of 6 hours were flown by C-130 aircraft of VMGR-152 providing aerial illumination for the Battalion.

(4) A total of 24 emergency, 15 priority, and 19 routine helicopter medevac sorties were completed.

(5) UH-1E Gunships used in support of medevac and resupply helicopters expended 25 rocket pods and 9,600 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition, resulting in 1 KBA.

(6) Seventy-one assault support troop lift and resupply sorties were also flown during February.

2. TRAINING

a. The 222 replacements received indoctrination training conducted in accordance with 1st Marine Division policies. These replacements were instructed in six different classes.

e. The below listed training classes were given during the month of February 1969.

(1) An excellent movie, "A Trip to Where?", which discussed the harmful effects of barbituates, narcotics and LSD, was shown prior to the nightly movie. This movie was shown each night during the second week in February.

(2) Officers and Staff School by CO, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. 43 attended.

#### LOGISTICS

1. Supply. During the first week of February the Battalion was given a fiscal inspection by the Division Comptroller. The results of the inspection was satisfactory with discrepancies. Phase II of the Battalion's budget estimate was submitted to the 1st Marines this month and will be incorporated into the Regimental Budget. During the latter part of February the supply section received an inspection from the Division Material Management Inspection Team. The results of this inspection was satisfactory with discrepancies.

2. Motor Transport. The 17% deadline rate for prime and non-prime movers has nearly remained the same as in January, (14 of 79). During this past month a Division Inspection Team evaluated our operational as well as our administrative aspects and awarded noteworthy ratings in the areas of dispatching, records, preventive maintenance system, supply parts and embarkation. Only two areas had discrepancies and the final evaluation was satisfactory with discrepancies. The motor pool has almost completed a large fuel distribution station that will amply supply fuel for the entire Battalion in the future. The new fuel station also eliminates the threat of water sediments in the Mo-gas.

3. Cantonment and Camp Facilities. During the month of February no major changes took place in the cantonment area. Engineers did progress considerably in building the Staff/Officer mess this month and the anticipated completion date is the middle of March. Also during the month the battalion received approval of five previously submitted work requests: (a) Renovation of the Battalion COC Bunker, (b) Repair/replacement of drains in the Battalion showers, (c) Construction of sentry tower east of Tu Cau Bridge and South of ML-12E, (d) Construction of 20 metal frame barricades, (e) Construction of 2,50' sentry towers, one at southeast sector of the Battalion CP and one on Route ML-12W.

#### COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS

1. On 8 February 1969 the Communications Platoon had a preliminary inspection by 1st Marines. The results of this inspection was satisfactory. The Communications Platoon supported the Battalion's operations in "Dodge City" by providing 12 men to accompany the CP group. The problems encountered in "Dodge City" were minor. There was slight interference from an Army unit and some difficulty in radio transmission. Both of these problems were corrected by changing frequencies and using directional antennas. On 20 February the Communications Platoon was inspected by Division and found satisfactory with discrepancies. On 26 February, radio school was conducted for CAP 2-5-5. The classes included proper radio procedures, use of shackles, authentication and medevac procedures.

#### CIVIC ACTION AND PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

1. During the month of February, the total MEDCAP treated 1,642 persons with 7 persons referred to the Medical Officer. The MEDCAP program has temporarily decreased due to Tet celebrations.

2. Civic Action projects that are pending or started but incomplete are as follows:

a. Rebuilding Bich Nam (BT997636) has received Province approval.

b. Building of school in the Ha Tay (BT008642) has received Province approval.

c. Thanh Quit School (BT040625) is pending completion and opening after March elections.

#### MEDICAL

1. During the month of February 1969, There were no significant events that occurred in the Battalion Aid Station. Activities proceeded as normal with no alterations in standard operations.
