INTELLIGENCE

1. The month of March was characterized by a great increase in VIP payments. A total of 271,030\$VN was used in comparison to 10,400\$VN during the month of February. This increase can be attributed to the enlargement of our Battalion TAOR, which became effective on 12 March 1969, and the increase in fixed positions, primarily those at the north and south entrance to the Regimental cantonment.
2. Enemy initiated attacks for the month totaled 44, reflecting an increase of 2 over the previous month. However, enemy KIA's decreased from 43 to 36 for the month of March.
3. On 4 March a squad from Company "A", while on patrol, found one USMC pontoon boat (3' x 10'). The boat was anchored to both shores. It appeared to be used as a foot bridge.
4. On the night of 5 March vicinity 067644, 2nd Platoon, Company "B" initiated a night ambush resulting in contact with an estimated 150 VC/NVA. Company "B" used all organic weapons as well as artillery and an AC-47 aircraft. The contact continued into the early morning hours of 6 March, at which time the enemy broke contact and retreated. A check of the battlefield at first light turned up extensive blood trails and body drag marks. Interrogation of the people of NGAN CAU (1) produced the following additional assessment: Some 30-40 people were seized by the VC/NVA to carry dead and wounded. The villagers said that they saw at least 20 dead and as many litter cases, in addition there were numerous wounded.
5. On the morning of 19 March a platoon from Company "C" found one VC flag near an abandoned hut located near BIG BAC hamlet (vic 980633).
6. On 21 March Company "D" found three VC flags located near VIEM TAY (1) (vic 040641). One flag was rigged with an M-26 as an SFD. They also found VC propaganda leaflets attached to pagoda walls in the area.
7. On 22 March Company "C" found an NLF flag flying from a 25 foot pole. Propaganda leaflets and banners in English and Vietnamese were found in the vicinity near LA THO BAC (1) (vic 005628).
8. On 26 March, Company "D" found one U. S. publication, listing coordinates and approaches of airfields in Republic of Vietnam near LA THO BAC (3) (vic 007613).

OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

1. OPERATIONS.

a. Mission. 1st Battalion, 1st Marines was assigned the mission to:

(1) Conduct unilateral, joint and combined offensive operations within the assigned TAOB to locate installations, with emphasis on those forces and bases which pose the greatest threat to GVN control of important population and economic centers and to the security of military installations.

ENCLOSURE (1)

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(2) Deploy forces throughout the assigned TAOR to provide defense of the DaNang area and military complex with emphasis on routes of approach to probable rocket/mortar launch positions, including waterways.

(3) Provide security for the TU CAU Bridge (BT031649) from 1 March 1969 until 11 March 1969, the HA DONG Bridge (AT 990641) and the CAU DO Bridge (AT998705) from 12 March 1969.

(4) Locate and interdict routes of infiltration in the TAOR to include waterways.

b. Operations

(1) During the month of March the Battalion continued conducting aggressive operations against the insurgent enemy forces within the assigned TAOR. From 1 March 1969 until 12 March 1969 Company "A" had the assigned mission of saturation patrolling in the DUC KY area (vic AT9961) and LA THO BAC (3) south of the rocket barrier; while Company "C" provided security along route 10 and participated in continuous combat patrolling in conjunction with the 51st ARVN Regiment from outposts in the south-eastern sector of the TAOR. Company "B" provided security for the TU CAU Bridge and also conducted saturation type patrolling North and South of the TU CAU Road and east of the VINH DIEN River, while Company "D" remained as the Battalion reserve.

(2) On 2 March 1969, Company "D" cordoned and search the village of AN TU (1) (vic BT024637) and on 3 March 1969, Company "D" went opcon to the 3rd Battalion to be utilized as a blocking force in the vicinity of HA TAY (BT010645) and VIEM TAY (BT014648). Company "D", as the reserve company was employed again with one platoon from Company "A" attached, to cordon off the village of AN TU (1) (vic BT024637), in conjunction with a search conducted by the 1st Battalion, 51st ARVN Regiment, on 4 March 1969. On 5 March 1969, at 1600H, Company "D" was sent opcon to the 2nd Battalion to assist in combat operations in the vicinity of the MAN QUAN area (center of Mass BT035686). On 7 March 1969 Company "D" returned opcon to the 1st Battalion and on 8 March began search and clear operations in the eastern sector of the TAOR, south of the TU CAU Road and east of the VINH DIEN River.

ENCLOSURE (1)

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(3) On 12 March 1969, the 3rd Battalion and the 1st Battalion changed cantonments. The enlarged TAOR for the 1st Battalion included the area from the SONG YEN east to the SONG VINH DIEN and from the SONG CAU DO south to the SONG LA THO. As the Regimental reserve the 3rd Battalion has responsibility for 300 meters around the Battalion cantonment's perimeter. The new TAOR increases security responsibilities for HA DONG and CAU DO Bridges as well as the MSR and route 10w. Adjacent units within the new TAOR include two Battalions of the 51st ARVN Regiment, the 1st and 3rd Battalion, and Combined Action Platoon 2-5-3, 2-5-4, 2-5-5, 2-5-6, and the 59th Regional Forces Battalion. In the enlarged TAOR, Company "A"(-), became the Battalion reserve from 12 March until 24 March, when Company "A" went under the operational control of the Quang Da Special Defense Zone. Company "B" assumed responsibility for the CAU DO Bridge and the northeastern sector of the TAOR. Company "C" was assigned the mission of providing security for the HA DONG bridge and patrolling in the southeastern and southwestern sectors of the TAOR while Company "D" began saturation patrolling in the DUC KY area (vic AT9961) and LA THO BAC (3) area south of the rocket barrier.

c. ARTILLERY

(1) During the month of March, Battery "A", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its mission of direct support to the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

(2) In addition to Battery "A", Batteries "B" and "C", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired in support of the Battalion.

(3) Ninety-five observed fire missions expending 2,377 rounds were fired in support of the 1st Battalion's activities.

(4) Approximately 500 unobserved missions expending approximately 2,000 rounds were fired. These unobserved missions included TOT's, H&I's, and intelligence targets.

d. AIR SUPPORT

(1) During the month of March aircraft from MAG 11, 12, and 13 flew an assortment of missions in support of the Battalion. The aircraft expended a total of 79,000 pounds of bombs, 26,000 pounds of napalm, 4 pods of rockets and 2 pods of 20mm ammunition. The damage assessment for these missions was as follows: structures destroyed 5; structures damaged 1; bunkers damaged 1; 100 meters of trenchline; 600 meters of trenchline destroyed and 500 square meters of heavily booby-trapped area.

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A total of 6 hours and 35 minutes was flown by AC-47 gunships providing aerial illumination and expending 104,000 rounds of 7.62 ammunition.

OV-10 Bronco aircraft from VMO-02 amassed 16 hours of flight time in artillery spotting missions and close air support. The aircraft expended 7 pods of rockets and 1600 rounds of 7.62 ammunition resulting in 1 structure damaged. Nine visual reconnaissance missions were also flown during the month with a total of 5 hours and 30 minutes. UH-1E gunships also contributed a total of 2 hours and 45 minutes flight times on artillery spotting missions.

In support of combat operations in the TAOR a total of 35 emergency, 14 priority and 7 routine medevacs were flown. Also, 5 resupply sorties were flown lifting 6,000 pounds of cargo and 20 troops during the month of March.

2. TRAINING

a. The 120 replacements received in doctrination training conducted in accordance with 1st Marine Division policies. These replacements were instructed in six different classes.

c. During the month of March, Officers and Staff School was conducted to familiarize personnel with the new PRC/88 radio and the proper use of shackles sheets.

Responding to Regimental Bulletin 1500 of 16 March 1969, the Battalion outlined a comprehensive training program in patrolling ambushes for the four rifle companies (TAB B). Re-evaluation of past training requirements assigned in the 3rd Quarter FY 69 was reflected in an increase in certain training areas for the ensuing quarter. These increases and/or modifications were established in Battalion Bulletin 1500 of 31 Mar 1969 which set the minimum training to be accomplished in the 4th Quarter FY 1969 (TAB C).

LOGISTICS

1. On 10 March this Battalion initiated a move to change CP locations with 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines. Five M-54, 6x6 and trailers, and 12 M-35, 6x6 were used to shuttle the entire Battalion and all its equipment and supplies. The move was completed in 3 days with an additional 12 days before supply was operating efficiently again.
2. A shortage in billeting space was noted in the new cantonment and an additional 13 strongbacks have been requested, upon completion of this request the billeting problem will be alleviated.
3. In regard to embarkation the move showed that this battalion has the capability to move and stage within a 72 hour period. The only major problems that we are still experiencing is in regard to mount out crates for the field mess equipment.

COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS

1. The Communications Platoon started its move to the new cantonment on 11 March 1969. The move was completed by 1200 on 12 March 1969. Radio communications was continuous and there were no problems encountered during the move. A direct exchange of telephones and switchboards was effected with 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines to speed installations of wire communications. A direct exchange of KC/292 radio antennas was also effected for a rapid resumption of all radio communications in the CUC.
2. A call sign and frequency change went into effect on 0001, 30 March 1969. Excessive interference was encountered on the night of 30 March 1969 on the Battalion TAC primary frequency and also on Company "D"'s frequency. This was corrected by a change of frequency.
3. During the month each letter company was issued twenty one AN/PRC-88 squad level radios. An additional thirty AN/PRC-88 radios are available to H&S Company for use as needed. The amounts issued is on a trial basis, and it is expected to reduce the amount of AN/PRC-25 radios now in use within the Battalion.

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PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

1. The psyops aspect of the S-5 section was active during the month of March participating in the cordon and search of AN TU (1) (vic BT027644) and coordinating 32 requested leaflet air drops and aerial broadcasts. Newspapers and leaflets were also distributed in conjunction with mobile broadcast and movie teams. The goal of this activity was to inform the populace of GVN activities and outline the VC atrocities and assassinations that have occurred in the area. Active work in conjunction with the CAP's, Regional Forces and Popular Forces was also begun in the form of leaflet and newspaper distribution.

MEDICAL

1. From 1 March to 11 March 1969 the BAS consisted of eight huts and a permanent Vietnamese building. These structures were used as Officers, Staff NCO's, and corpsman quarters; sickcall treatment areas, supply, ward, shot room, baggage and mount-out supplies spaces and administrative and health records huts. From 12 March to 21 March the Battalion Aid Station moved to its present location. Four huts are utilized for quarters, supply storage, and treatment spaces.

2. During the month of March the BAS saw 456 persons during sick call and 1,442 immunizations were given. In the medical civil affairs program, a total of 1,157 Vietnamese people were seen. A mobile MELCAP was conducted on an average of three times a week to nearby hamlets and villages.

3. A side from the change of cantonments on 12 March 1969, the BAS continued to operate as normal, without any events of significance occurring during the month of March.
