INTELLIGENCE

1. The month of May was characterized by a decrease of almost half in VIP Funds over last month. The total for May was 280,480\$VN in comparison with the April total of 400,693\$VN. The decrease in the total amount spent was the result of a decrease in the VIP funds.
2. There were twenty enemy initiated attacks for the month of May. This is an increase of ten during the month of April. Enemy KIA's increased from 7 to 34 for the month of May.
3. On 4 May, a platoon from Company C (vic AT979679) found a VC/NVA camp-site with the aid to two Vietnamese boys. The site consisted of one shallow fighting hole and a cooking area. KCS estimated the site to be four to five months old. The unit found four SFD's around the cooking area. The SFD's were: 1 chicken with trip wire, 2 c-ration cans filled with C-3 and a trip wire.
4. On 5 May, a platoon from Company A located at AT974662 observed three individuals digging on the opposite bank of the Yen Ne River. Unit set up hasty ambush but were unable to kill or detain any of the enemy. A check of the area produced 12 chicom grenades, 12 M-26AL grenades, 4 AK-47 magazine (loaded), 5 medical kits, 7 homemade chicoms, 3,850\$VN, plus several items of clothing and 782 gear.
5. On 12 May, the 1st Marines CP located at AT986677-AT992674 was hit at 0215 by an estimated 80-110 enemy force. The enemy utilized B-40 rockets, RPG's, small arms and satchel charges. The western combat base returned fire with 81mm mortars, Gunships, artillery and small arms fire, resulting in 30 enemy dead with 10 POW's. Equipment found included, 1 Bangalore Torpedo, 5 B-40 rounds, 2 RPG Launchers, satchel charges, 30 homemade chicoms, 24 60mm rounds and some miscellaneous 782 gear.
6. On 15 May, an S-2 patrol found 2 VC/NVA belts with 8 chicom grenades, 2 AK-47 magazines, 1 pair of wire cutters, 1 Bangalore Torpedo and 3 satchel charges twenty meters outside the perimeter (AT992674).

OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

1. OPERATIONS

a. Mission. 1st Battalion, 1st Marines was assigned the mission to:

(1) Conduct unilateral, joint and combined offensive operations within the assigned TAOR to locate enemy installations, with emphasis on those forces and bases which pose the greatest threat to GVN control of important population and economic centers and to the security of military installations.

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ENCLOSURE (1)

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(2) Deploy forces throughout the assigned TAOR to provide a defense to the DaNang area and military complex with emphasis on routes of approach to probable rocket/mortar positions, including waterways.

(3) Provide security for the CAU DO Bridge (AT998705) and the HA DONG Bridge (AT990611).

(4) Locate and interdict routes of infiltration in the TAOR to include waterways.

b. Operations

(1) During the month of May the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines continued to conduct aggressive combat operations against the insurgent enemy forces within the assigned TAOR. Company A provided security for the HA DONG Bridge and patrolled extensively in the western and eastern portion of the TAOR. Company B continued to patrol aggressively in the DUC KY and LA THO BAC areas south of the rocket barrier while Company D provided security for the CAU DO Bridge and also patrolled the northern portion of the TAOR. Company C remained under the operational control of the Quang Da Special Defense Zone.

(2) On 19 May 1969 Company A in conjunction with elements of the 1st Battalion, 51st ARVN Regiment, cordoned off the villages of DUONG SON (2) and (3) (vic AT995674).

(3) On 30 May 1969 in preparation of Operation PIPESTONE CANYON, Company C returned under the operational control of the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. Company A went under the operational control of the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines on 31 May 1969.

(4) The 1st Battalion, 1st Marines (-) (Rein), on 31 May 1969, began active participation in Phase II of Operation PIPESTONE CANYON in the "Dodge City" area of the 1st Marines' AO.

c. Artillery

(1) During the month of May, Battery A, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its mission of direct support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

(2) In addition to Battery A, batteries B and C, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired in support of the Battalion.

(3) Sixty observed fire missions expending 1007 rounds were fired in support of the 1st Battalion's activities.

(4) Approximately 750 unobserved missions expending approximately 3000 rounds were fired. These unobserved missions included TOT's, H&I's, and intelligence targets.

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(5) In order to support Operation PIPESTONE CANYON, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines moved their operations south to the combat base in which Battery A is positioned. In addition, batteries B and C were also brought into the area to reinforce the fires of Battalion A.

d. Air Support

(1) During the month of May, 20 sections of fixed wing from MAG 11, 12, and 13 and 13 A-6 beacon hops were flown in support of the Battalion. The aircraft expended a total of 242,000 pounds of bombs, 31,500 pounds of napalm, 4 2.75 Rocket pods, and 8 5th Rocket pods.

(2) The damage assessment was as follows: (25) bunkers destroyed; (6) bunkers damaged; (6) huts destroyed; (425) meters of treeline destroyed; (115) meters of trenchline; and (10) fighting holes destroyed. A total of (6) tunnels were uncovered and partially destroyed. There were (4) secondary explosions recorded in the time period.

(3) OV-10 Bronco aircraft from VMO-2 flew 31 missions engaged in aerial observation, artillery spotting, and close air support for a total of 29 hours and 30 minutes flight time. The aircraft expended (25) 2.75 Rockets and 14,500 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition.

(4) Aerial illumination was provided for the Battalion by C-130 aircraft from VMGR-152. Flight time amounted to 34 hours and 15 minutes and a total of 320 flares were utilized.

(5) In support of combat operations in the TAOR, a total of 27 emergency, 9 priority and 7 routine medevacs were flown.

(6) UH-1E Gunships flying 3 hours in support of medevacs and ground troops expended 8 pods of rockets and 10,000 rounds of 7.62 ammunition. The ordnance expended resulted in 1 hut destroyed.

(7) The Battalion made use of 3 Regimental CPC packages and 3 administrative flights. Helicopters were utilized 6 times for visual reconnaissance missions for a total time of 6 hours and 35 minutes.

2. TRAINING

a. 75 replacements received indoctrination training conducted in accordance with 1st Marine Division policies.

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c. During the month of May, instruction on drug abuse was given to enlisted personnel and a separate class for the Staff and Officers.

LOGISTICS

1. During the month of May 1969 all sections under the cognizance of the Battalion S-4 functioned normally and efficiently without any unusual occurrences.

COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS

1. A frequency and call sign change went into effect on 090400H. Excessive interference was experienced from other stations on the 81mm Mortar conduct of fire net. This was corrected by a new frequency.

PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

1. Psychological activities for May included 28 aerial leaflet drops with accompanying tape broadcasts. Hand distribution of leaflets totalled 102,000 for the month. During the month, psyops has been stressed through Marine channels and through RF and PF units. The Battalion HB Team broadcasted for 7 hours. The 7th Psyops Battalion supplied the capability to show movies to civilians in the TAOR on five different occasions during the month. There were two SIR's during this month.

MEDICAL

1. A total of 523 patients were seen at sick call during the month of May. There were 50 of these referred to other medical facilities. There were 660 immunizations given during the month.

2. The Medical Civil Affairs Program treated 1000 Vietnamese civilians at the BAS and the normal visits to nearby villages and hamlets were conducted two or three times a week.

1. Headings:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "MP", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Endings:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
