b. There were 5 enemy initiated attacks for the month of August. This represents a continuous decline in enemy activity within 1st Battalion's AO. Enemy KIA's decreased from 21 to 4 for the month of August.

c. On 1 August 69, B and C Co's conducted a cordon and search of An Thanh (1) (vic BT 033617). In addition psyops and medops were held. There were a total of 19 detainees, 4 of which were turned over to ITT and 15 of which were taken to Dien Ban for questioning by the NPFF.

d. On 4 August 69, the S-2 security patrol made contact (vic AT 986681) with an unknown size enemy force. On checking out the area the S-2 patrol found expended AK-47 cartridges and 1 M-26 apparently dropped by the enemy.

e. On 9 August 69, A Co with the 3rd CIT team sighted 1 VC (vic AT 991629) in a tree line, unit took the enemy under fire. The enemy fled leaving behind miscellaneous 702 gear and chicoms.

f. On 10 August 69, A2 spotted two people entering the Cau Do River at 2200. A2 engaged the enemy with small arms and 61's. On checking out the area the unit found 1 female VC KIA (vic AT 996705).

g. On 11 August 69, D2 spotted 25 VC/NVA moving from north to south (vic AT 025615). Engaged the enemy with artillery and 81's. Searched area with negative results.

h. On 13 August 69, D3 while in PPB unit received 3 M-79 rounds and 20 small arms rounds. Unit returned fire and checked area with negative results (vic AT 030621).

i. On 13 August 69, engineer truck while accompanying D2 on mine sweep of Rt #4 detonated a box mine resulting in 2 KIA and 2 WIA (vic AT 015569).

j. On 16 August 69, C3 found one large irrigation pump and jeep engine in good working order. Engine returned to supply system and pump destroyed (vic AT 986606).

k. On 18 August 69, C CP found a small bunker and tunnel complex consisting of 10 bunkers and one tunnel. Bunkers were destroyed. All bunkers appeared to have been recently used and miscellaneous 782 gear was found in the area (vic BT 005605).

l. On 21 August 69, C Co found a small cache consisting of U. S. radio batteries, AK-47 rounds, C-rations, 7 chicom, miscellaneous 782 gear and documents, 5 M-16 magazines, 9 M-79 rounds, 1 20 lb rock mine, and 1 U. S. .38 cal. revolver (vic AT 985555).

m. On 29 August 69, S-2 with B and C Co's cordoned and searched the village of Lo Huan (2). Approximately 600 people were screened and processed by psyops programs as well as medcap. A total of 4 civilians were detained and later released as innocent civilians.

3. OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

A. OPERATION

(1) MISSION. 1st Battalion, 1st Marines was assigned the mission to:

(a) Conduct deliberate, detailed searches to find, fix, capture, and/or destroy enemy forces (NVA/VC/VCI), harbor sites, supplies and fortifications in the "Dodge City" Area of Operations in conjunction with Phase IV of Operation PIPESTONE CANYON.

(b) Conduct unilateral, joint and combined offensive operations within the assigned TAOR to locate installations, with emphasis on those forces and bases which pose the greatest threat to GVN control of important population and economic centers and to the security of military installations.

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(c) Deploy forces throughout the assigned TAOR to provide a defense of Danang area and military complexes with emphasis on routes of approach to probable rocket/mortar launch positions, including waterways.

(d) Locate and interdict routes of infiltration in the TAOR to include waterways.

(e) Assume responsibility of Mobile Reserve from 8 August 1969 until 31 August 1969.

(2) OPERATIONS

(a) On 1 August 69, Company B and C conducted a cordon and search of the village of An Thanh (1) (Vic BT 033617) in conjunction with NPTF units and a team from 3rd CIT. A total of nineteen civilians were detained for processing and interrogation.

(b) From 3-7 August 69, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines (-) (Rein) operated in Northern Que Son Mountains in conjunction with Operation DURHAM PEAK.

(c) From 16-19 August 69, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines (-) (Rein) operated in Northwestern "Dodge City", conducting joint operations with ROK forces in conjunction with Phase IV of Operation PIPESTONE CANYON.

(d) On 29 August 69, Company B and C conducted a cordon and search of the village of La Huan (2) in conjunction with a team from 3rd CIT. Four Vietnamese civilians were detained for processing and interrogation.

(e) From 29-31 August 69, Company B and C and the Battalion CP participated in operations in Southwestern Que Son and Southeast Duc Lac districts.

(3) ARTILLERY

(a) During the month of August, Battery A, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its mission in direct support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

(b) In addition Batteries A, B and C, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines; Battery D, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, and Battery G of 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines fired in support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines' activities.

(c) During the month of August, there were 46 observed targets expending a total of 1517 rounds. There was also a total of 198 unobserved targets expending 2,243 rounds. These targets were in the form of preemptive fires, prep fires, and TOT's, as well as intelligence targets.

(d) In order to provide maximum artillery support to Operation DURHAM PEAK, 11th Marines displaced Battery B to fire support base Pony. Battery C was displaced to Hill 55 to maintain fire support for 1st Battalion, 1st Marines new TAOR.

(4) AIR SUPPORT

(a) During the month of August, 13 sections of fixed wing from MAG 11, 12, and 13 flew in support of the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. The aircraft expended a total of 122,500 pounds of bombs, 4,750 pounds of napalm. Eight bunkers destroyed, 600 meters of treeline, and 75 meters of trenchline.

(b) OV-10 Bronco aircraft from VMO-02 amassed 16 1/2 hours of flight time with aerial observations, artillery spotting missions and close air support. The aircraft expended 12 pods of 2.75 rockets and 6000 rounds of 7.62 in close support. A total of 15 hours was flown by C-130 and C-119 flareships providing aerial illumination with 511 flares. A total of 30 minutes was flown by AC-47 "Spooky" gunships.

(c) In support of combat operations in the 1st Battalion's TAOR, 24 emergency, 13 priority, and 9 routine med-evac sorties were flown. Seventy-six sorties were flown by CH-46 and CH-53 aircraft lifting and extracting a total of 1,671 troops. A total of 4 hours flight time was flown by "Cobra" gunships. They expended 8 rocket pods and 10,000 rounds of 7.62 ammunition. One visual reconnaissance mission was flown for a total of 30 minutes flight time.

4. LOGISTICS

a. During the month of August 1969, all sections under the cognizance of the Battalion S-4 functioned normally and efficiently with no unusual occurrences.

a. On 8 August 69, the platoon displaced with the Battalion to the combat base at Phong Luc (2).

b. The message center was re-established and re-created the Regiment teletype net. Two shut downs occurred during the month due to equipment failure, both were corrected within 24 hours.

c. Throughout the month the wire section has completely relayed the camp with new cable pairs and policed the local lines.

d. The Navy J-124 and J-125 generators have supplied the camp power with one shut down for 5 minutes.

6. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

A. PUBLIC WORKS

(1) Transportational assistance was given to the villagers of Ha Tay (vic BT 010645), to pick up 10 barrels of gasoline. This additional gas was needed to keep water in the rice paddies by using the village pump.

(2) Additionally, three cordon and searches were conducted. We provided food, water and shelter for a total of 1,100 civilians. The HE team made fine showings and the HD team broadcasted for 7 1/2 hours. Also, 1,100 Ban Tin newspapers, 5,000 Chieu Hoi passes, and 10,000 other assorted leaflets were distributed.

B. WELFARE

(1) Nine requests to rebuild homes have been submitted to this command. The homes were destroyed during firefights. The requests are being fulfilled as quickly as material becomes available.

(2) Ten bags of cement have been distributed to 5 families for the repair of five walls.

C. EDUCATION

(1) 50 school kits were given out to school children who had requested them. 500 more will be given out when the school year begins in September.

(2) 10 Vietnamese flags were given out to schools in the CAACR.

(3) Names for General Walt Scholarships are now collected. 220 scholarships is the goal for this command.

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D. HEALTH

(1) During the month, the Med-caps have treated 1,146 civilians medically and 56 were treated Dentally.

(2) The third and final set of Plague and Cholera shots for the students of Bo De School have been scheduled for early September.

E. AGRICULTURE

(1) 8 bags of cornmeal animal food were distributed to the villagers of Ha Tay (vic BT 010645) and An Tu (vic BT 025630). The food was used to help feed pigs belonging to the hamlets.

F. SOCIAL

(1) Negative

G. SECURITY

(1) Three cordon and searches were conducted in the AO. As a result several VCI were found.

H. SOLATUIM PAYMENTS

(1) 17,000VN\$ were paid out for 9 people wounded and 1 killed in Ha Tay (vic BT 010645) as a result of misdirected ordnance.

7. MEDICALA. PERSONNEL

(1) Two medical officers, 1 chaplain, 53 hospital corpsmen (23 HM's-BAS; 1 HM replacement; 29 HM's company corpsman). During the month 1 medical officer was transferred to the 9th Engineer Battalion and 2 medical officers were received from CONUS. One hospital corpsman was transferred to CONUS, 2 HM's were transferred TEMPU under treatment and 7 HM's were reassigned to units in the division rear. Hospital corpsman received during the month totaled 8, and 1 HM was advanced from HA to HN.

B. FACILITIES. The BAS consists of 9 huts which are used for sick call, administration, laboratory, supply, health records, shot clinic and living quarters for personnel assigned to the BAS. Other facilities consist of 1 brick building for storage of personnel effects and 5 bunkers.

C. DAILY ACTIVITIES. Sick call is held from 0800-0900 and 1300-1400 daily and 0800-0900 on Sunday. Emergencies are seen anytime.

(1) A total of 329 patients were seen at sick call, 15 were referred to other medical activities, 4 physical examinations were conducted, 128 lab tests, 20 admissions, 130 skin disorders, 9 upper respiratory infections, 10 VD, no malaria, and 22 diarrhea.

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(2) 585 immunizations were given.

(3) Transportation is provided for patients referred to other medical activities. The BAS ambulance is utilized only for emergency runs or as required. Medical evacuation via helicopters are called when time is of critical importance.

(4) Civilian MEDCAP is conducted Monday through Saturday from 0900-1100. During the past month 897 Vietnamese were treated. Only 1 mobile MEDCAP was conducted for this period.

D. WEEKLY ACTIVITIES. Sanitation inspections of the contonment and messing facilities are conducted at routine intervals.
