j. 7-31 Company "D" provided security for Hill 41 and Mike Tower plus conducting launch site denial operation within the Company Area of Operation by conducting active day and night patrolling and ambushing known infiltration routes.

k. 22-28 March Company "A" (-) and Company "C" (-) conducted Recon in Force Operation in the MANG CHOA area (vicinity AT803670).

l. 28-31 March Company "B" (-) conducted recon operations in southern AO extension (vicinity AT940630).

m. 29-31 March Company "A" (-) provided elements for the Battalion Reactionary Force.

n. 29-31 March Company "C" conducted launch site denial operation by conducting active day and night patrolling and ambushing known infiltration routes.

5. AIR SUPPORT

a. During the month of March 1970, 19 flights of fixed wing from MAG 11, 12 and 13 were flown in support of the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. The aircraft expended a total of 63,500 lbs. of bombs, 30,500 lbs. of napalm, 8 pods of 2.75" rockets and 500 rounds of 20MM ammunition. The damage assessment was as follows: 500 meters of tree line and 4 secondary fires.

b. OV10A Bronco aircraft from VMO-02 amassed 5 hours and 15 minutes of flight time in aerial observation, artillery spotting missions and close air support. The aircraft expended 6 pods of rockets and 9,450 rds. of 7.62 ammunition. A total of 2 1/2 hours were flown by OH19 Helicopters providing aerial illum. with 147 flares.

c. In support of combat operations in the TAOB a total of 36 sorties for 17 emergency, 14 priority, 9 routine medevacs were flown. Also 25 sorties were flown by CH-46D and CH-53 lifting and extracting 372 troops. 12 visual recon missions were flown with a total of 7 hours 40 minutes, flight time. Two administration runs totaling 45 minutes and 18 resupply runs with a total weight of 468,891 lbs. were flown.

6. ARTILLERY

a. During the month of March 1970, Battery "A" 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued to fire the majority of direct support missions for 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. Battery "WY" and "CG", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, Battery "F", 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, Battery "L" 4th Battalion, 11th Marines and Platoon "8" inch provided general support for 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. Also a small portion of Naval Gunfire was used.

2. INTELLIGENCE

a. There were 72,500 \$VN expended during March in support of the V.I.P., an increase of 67,500 \$VN over last months expenditures.

b. There was a total of thirty enemy contacts during the month of March. Five enemy KIA's resulted from these contacts.

c. On 8 March a listening post from "C" Company vicinity AT912713 spotted 1 enemy 50 meters away. The unit fired on the enemy and received M-79 fire in return. The unit immediately swept area of the enemy's location with negative results.

d. On 9 March a unit from "C" Company in an ambush position, spotted 10 enemy moving along the southeast bank of the river at AT903709. Unit fired on the enemy and received approx. 50 rounds of small arms fire in return. The enemy was seen falling as a result of the friendly fire delivered on them, but other enemy managed to retrieve the bodies. "C" Company unit called in artillery fire and later swept the known enemy position with negative results.

e. On 10 March the IOD located on Hill 270 with Company "A" spotted 20 enemy in the vicinity of AT865681. The enemy was carrying large packs, rifles and mortars or rockets. A fire mission was called on the enemy position, 6 bodies were observed after the fire mission but none were confirmed KIA or WIA.

f. On 10 March a patrol from "A" Company spotted 1 enemy at AT932678. The patrol fired on him and received small arms fire from an estimated three enemy. Patrol was reinforced by a platoon and swept area. Same enemy made contact and threw 3 Chicom hand grenades. The patrol again opened fire and the enemy fled. Enemy was wearing brown khaki uniforms and carried AK-47's. A search of the area was conducted with negative results.

g. On 12 March "A" Company made contact with enemy at AT920680. An ambush site at that location fired on the enemy and received fire in return. One enemy KIA and one AK-47 were found. The following morning a sweep of the area revealed a small ordnance cache of AK-47 ammo. One M-26 grenade and a few items of personnel equipment.

h. On 13 March in vicinity AT903688 a squad from "A" Company while in an ambush position made contact with an estimated 12 man enemy unit. The enemy initiated fire with machine guns and grenades. Two Marines were WIA. The unit returned fire with small arms and called 81MM Mortar fire on the enemy machine gun positions. A search of the area uncovered 1 enemy body and several spent M-79 rounds.

i. On 15 March "A" Company sighted 8 enemy in vicinity of AT835685 moving east to west. A fire mission was called on the enemy resulting in 2 enemy KIA's.

j. On 17 March "B" Company observed an enemy setting a booby trap in vicinity of AT956671. A search of the area revealed one 60MM mortar round with trip wire along trail. While returning to the company position unit spotted one enemy with pack and weapon. Unit exchanged fire with the enemy. Negative results.

k. On 25 March at 1500 hours a platoon from "C" Company was searching cave complexes in vicinity of AT823693. One NVA soldier was seen coming down the trail on higher ground. Unit opened fire and captured the NVA. Another NVA was seen escaping into the thick vegetation.

l. On 25 March at 1600 hours the 1st Platoon of "C" Company found a base camp in the hills, vicinity AT820694. The camp consisted of tables, chairs, beds and ladders. Unit found a weapons cache and a few articles of enemy equipment.

m. On 27 March the 3rd Platoon of "C" Company found a trail leading to a cave complex consisting of 24 individual caves, large enough to hold 4-6 men each. Unit also found a cache of assorted small arms ordnance.

n. On 28 March a unit from "A" Company encountered 1 NVA in vicinity of AT847694, in a cave. Attempt to capture NVA resulted in small arms fire exchange and one NVA KIA.

3. OPERATIONS AND TRAININGa. OPERATIONS

(1) MISSION. From 1-5 March 1970, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, was assigned the mission to:

(a) Be prepared to deploy a Battalion (-) Force anywhere within the 1st Marine Division TAOR on order.

(b) Conduct unilateral and combined operations within the TAOR to locate and destroy enemy forces and logistic installations with primary emphasis on those forces and bases which pose the greatest threat to GVN control of important and economic centers and to the security of friendly military installations.

(2) MISSION. From 6-31 March 1970, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, was assigned the mission to:

(a) Upon relieving 1st Battalion, 25th Marines, conduct unilateral and combined offensive operations within the TAOR to locate and destroy enemy forces and logistic installations with primary emphasis on those forces and bases which pose the greatest threat to GVN control of important population and economic centers and to the security of friendly military installations.

(3) TASKS. From 1-5 March 1970, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, was assigned the following tasks:

(a) Deploy forces throughout the assigned TAOR to provide defense of the Da Nang Vital Area with emphasis on routes of approach to probable rocket and mortar launch sites.

(b) Provide security forces for the Can Do and Ha Dong Bridges.

(c) Provide local security as required for the combat base at Phong Lac (2) grid BT015627.

(d) Provide one rifle company on a continuous basis OPCON to 1st Marines, for employment as a vertical assault company (Code name "Bald Eagle") or elements thereof (Code name "Sparrow Hawk") for platoon size operations. In addition to "Bald Eagle" and "Sparrow Hawk" be prepared to conduct special platoon helicopter operations (Code name "Kingfisher") as a vertical assault element on intelligence targets and targets of opportunity within 1st Marines TAOR.

(4) TASKS. From 6-31 March 1970, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, was assigned the following tasks:

- (a) Occupy and defend Hill 10, AT923694.
- (b) Provide security for CP on Hill 270, AT865681.
- (c) Occupy and defend Hill 41, AT934663 and "Mike Tower", AT924675.
- (d) Provide security for engineer projects within TAOR to include road mine sweeps.
- (e) Operate, maintain and defend that portion of the Da Nang Anti-Infiltration System (DAIS) within TAOR.
- (f) Be prepared to provide a reaction force for the relief of Hieu Duc District Headquarters and/or Combined Action Company 2-1 elements.
- (g) Be prepared to employ a vertical assault company (Code name "Bald Eagle") or elements thereof (Code name "Sparrow Hawk") for platoon size operations.

b. SPECIAL OPERATION

- a. 1-2 March Company "A" provided security operation for the HA DONG and CAM BO BRIDGES.
- b. 1-31 March Company "B" provided launch site denial operations in the CAM LE/LA BONG/YEN NE/BO BAN/LA CHAU area.
- c. 1-6 March Company "C" was OPCON to 1st Marines as the Regimental Training Company and assumed "Bald Eagle" responsibilities.
- d. 1-3 March Company "D" was OPCON to 1st Marines as security for Land Clearing detail.
- e. 3-5 March Company "A" was assigned duty as Battalion reaction company.
- f. 4-6 March Company "D" conducted detailed search of streams and river in AN TRACH/LE SON/YEN NE/CAM NE area.
- g. 6 March 1st Battalion, 1st Marines (-) conducted tactical troop lift by helicopter from PHONG LUC Combat Base to Hill 10 (AT922691), Company "A" (-) Hill 270 (AT865681), Company "B" remain in BO BAN/LA CHAU area (AT950680), Company "C" to PHONG NINH AN/NTNH AN area (AT910710), Company "D" to Hill 41 (AT934664) and Mike Tower (AT922674).
- h. 7-31 March Company "A" provided security for Hill 270 and elements for the Battalion Reaction Force.
- i. 7-31 March Company "C" conducted launch site denial operations within Company Area of Operation by conducting active day and night patrolling and ambushing known infiltration routes.

b. Forward observers in the field requested 79 missions for 981 total rounds. 190 missions were divided among AM 24 and Seaside for a total of 2,257 rounds. Total for fire missions were 3,238. There were 698 unobserved targets fired for the month of March, expending 6,181 rounds. These were in the form of preemptive and intelligence fires.

7. TRAINING

a. 276 replacements received indoctrination training conducted in accordance with 1st Marine Division policies.

8. LOGISTICS

a. During the month of March 1970, the Battalion displaced to a new area of operations. The relocation proceeded as planned with no significant problems encountered. The Phong Lac Combat Base was turned over to GVN forces, as directed. Improvements in the two combat bases at Hill 10 and Hill 41 and at GP's Reno and 270 are proceeding at an acceptable rate. A continuing emphasis is being placed on upgrading living conditions and defenses at all of these fixed positions.

b. Resupply of subordinate units has become a major function of the S-4 section. During March a total of approximately 600,000 lbs. of supplies, equipment and personnel were lifted by helicopter to units in the field.

c. The only recurring problems during the month have been the inadequacy of the potable water supply, and a faulty power line system within the combat base at Hill 10.

9. COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS

a. During the month of March all sections in the communications platoon functioned normally and efficiently with no unusual occurrences except in the Generator Section.

b. After taking over Hill 10 combat base the power usage of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines increased 25-45 KW over that of the 26th Marines. An imbalance of phases in the generators cause the burning out of voltage regulators on three 100 KW generators. Engineering assistance is still needed to balance the phases on our generators now in operation. A request for engineering assistance has been submitted and is presently pending action.

c. The generators presently in operation are running at a level that is substantially less than 100% effective.

10. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS/CIVIL AFFAIRSa. PUBLIC WORKS

(1) Provided 20 sheets of tin and 20 sacks of cement to DUYEN SON (4) (AT942663) to build a school.

(2) Provided 15 sacks of cement to PHU SON (1) (AT943651) to build an additional classroom in their school.

b. WELFARE

(1) Gave lumber to rebuild 3 houses burned down during contact between CAP 2-1-4 and VC/NVA.

(2) Distributed clothing for the needy at PHU SON (1) (AT943651) and DUYEN SON (4) (AT942663).

c. EDUCATION

(1) Negative report for this month, due to change of CAACOR.

d. HEALTH

(1) The Battalion treated 492 civilians at our Battalion Med-Cap and 1,170 civilians during the mobile Med-Caps within the CAACOR.

e. AGRICULTURE

(1) Negative report for this month.

f. SOCIAL

(1) Provided rides for 11 civilians to various hospitals in the Da Nang area to visit relatives.

g. SECURITY

a. A three man H3 team promoting ordinance burn-in was employed in the PHU SON (1) (AT936651), DUYEN SON (4) (AT942663), BO BAN (2) (AT966699) during the month.

h. SOLIATIUM

- (1) No solatium payments were made during this reporting period.

11. MEDICAL

a. PERSONNEL. One Medical Officer, 1 Chaplin, 53 Hospital Corpsmen (25 HM's BAS, 28 HM's line company corpsmen). During the month of March personnel were received as follows: 2 HM's from 3/26; 3 HM's from 1/26; 2 HM's from 1st Shore Party; 2 HM's from 1st Tank Bn.; 1 HM from COMUS. During the month of March 6 HM's were transferred to COMUS and 3 HM's were transferred to 1st Medical Bn. for duty.

b. FACILITIES. The BAS consists of 7 buildings, which are used for sickcall, administration, laboratory, supply, health records, shot clinic and living quarters for personnel assigned to BAS. Other facilities consist of 1 bunker used for ward and mass casualty collection.

c. DAIY ACTIVITIES. Sickcall is held from 0600-0900 and 1300-1400 daily including Sundays. Emergencies are seen any time.

(1) A total of 412 patients were seen at sickcall. Three physical exams were conducted, 80 lab tests were performed. During the month no Marines were admitted to the ward. Illnesses treated at BAS consisted of 12 FUO's, 28 URI's, 69 skin disorders, 12 acute Diarrhea, 24 VD, there was no Malaria, Bronchitis or Immersion Foot. Other illnesses were headaches, minor lacerations, blisters, strains, etc. 180 Marines were sent to other medical facilities for consultation in ENT, HP, ORTHO, etc.

(2) Transportation is provided for patients referred to other medical activities. The BAS ambulances are used only for emergency or as required. Medical evacuation via helicopter is used when evacuation time must be reduced or roads are closed.

(3) 973 shots were given.

(4) Civilian Red-Cap in the Battalion area amounted to 1,662 persons seen.

d. WEEKLY ACTIVITIES. Sanitation inspections of the contonement and messing facilities are conducted at routine intervals.

12. RELIGIOUS SERVICES

a. Twenty Protestant services were conducted for the Battalion during the month of March. The total attendance was 570. The number receiving communion was 114.

b. Four Memorial services were conducted. The attendance was 337.

c. Three Protestant services were conducted by the Battalion Chaplin for other units. The total attendance was 32. The number receiving communion was 25.

d. Eight Catholic Masses were conducted for the Battalion. Total attendance was 102.

e. One hundred twenty men were visited in the hospitals. Four men were visited in the III MAF Brig.

f. Two lectures were given in the troop indoctrination on the religions of Vietnam. The attendance was 47.

g. Twenty-five men attended the Protestant Monthly Rally in Da Nang.

h. Three Division Chaplain's meetings were attended.

- 010545H D-33, while conducting night ambush in vicinity AT971658, initiated small arms fire on 2 VC/NVA moving in tree line (Ref: Spot Rpt# 1).
- 011530H B-21, while conducting combat patrol in vic. AT953683, found and destroyed 1 booby trap consisting of 2 lb. box mine utilizing 1' xl'xl' foot trap and trip wire initiator (Ref: Spot Rpt# 2).
- 011610H B-21, while conducting combat patrol in vic. AT949678, found and destroyed a command detonated mine consisting of 3 105MM HE shells utilizing electrical blasting caps, wired in series, employing 100 meters of lead wire (Ref: Spot Rpt# 3).
- 011945H D-31, while providing security for land clearing operation in vic. AT972644, exchanged small arms fire with 2 VC/NVA with negative results (Ref: Spot Rpt# 4).
- 011950H D-3, while providing security for land clearing operation in vic. AT972644, exchanged small arms fire with 10 VC/NVA with negative results (Ref: Spot Rpt# 6).
- 012245H D-31, while conducting search of area where enemy contact was made at 011945H, found 1 hastily employed booby trap consisting of M-26 grenade employing trip wire (Ref: Spot Rpt# 4).
- 020030H Combat Base, located at BT015627, received 6 Lob Bombs from BTC20627. All Lob Bombs were 105MM HE and failed to detonate, however, 1 rd. did penetrate the roof of the exchange causing undetermined damage to stock in storeroom. Examination of launch site disclosed 2 craters 5 meters apart and measuring 8 feet in diameter and 5 feet deep (Ref: Spot Rpt# 7 and # 12).
