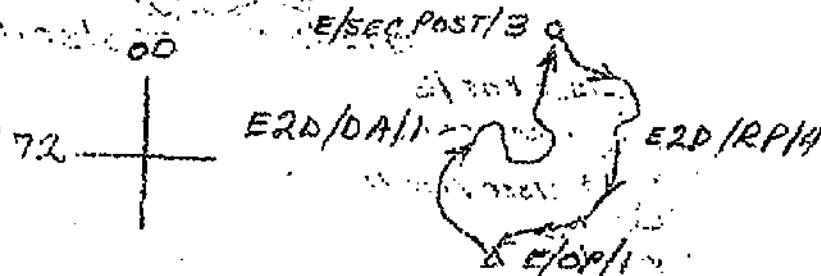

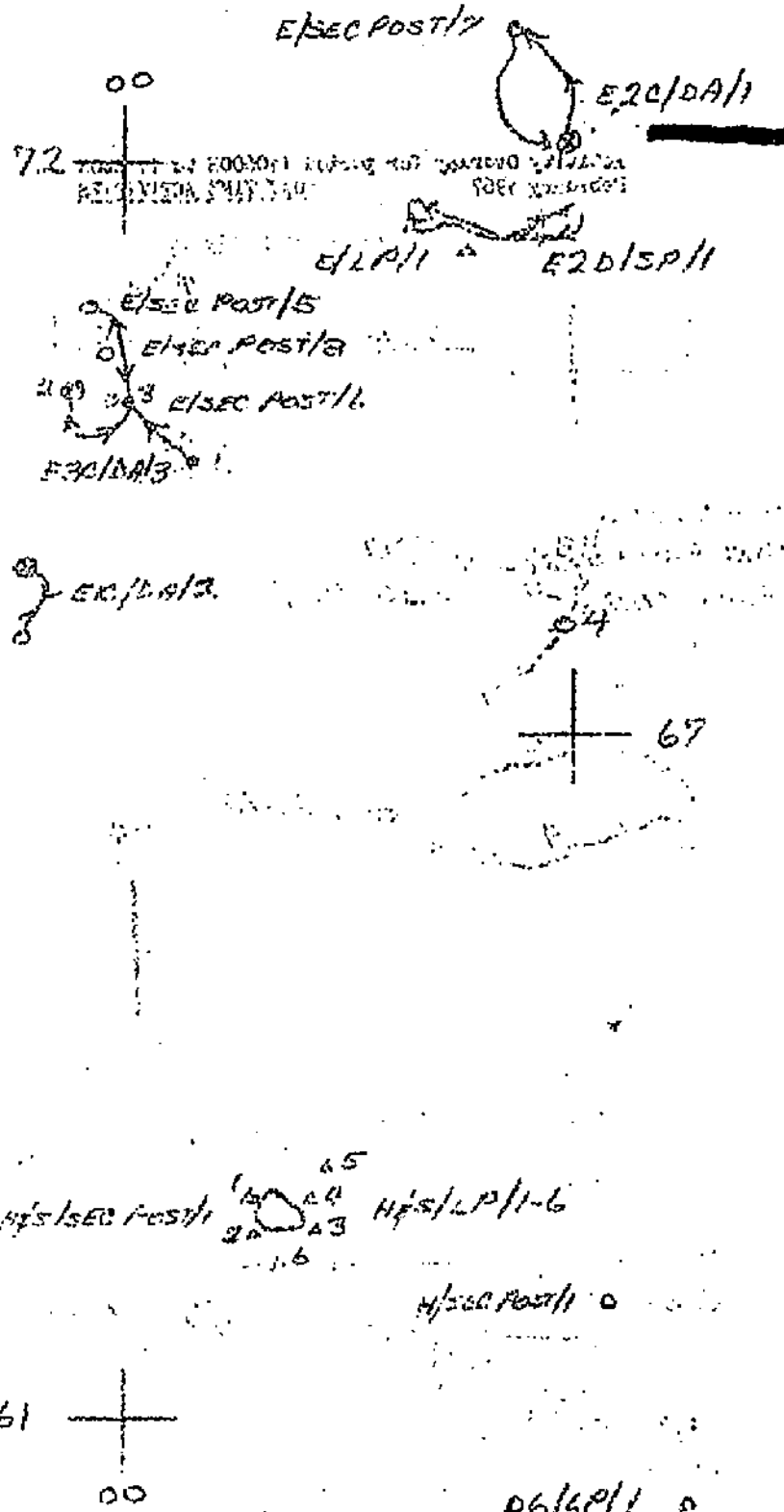

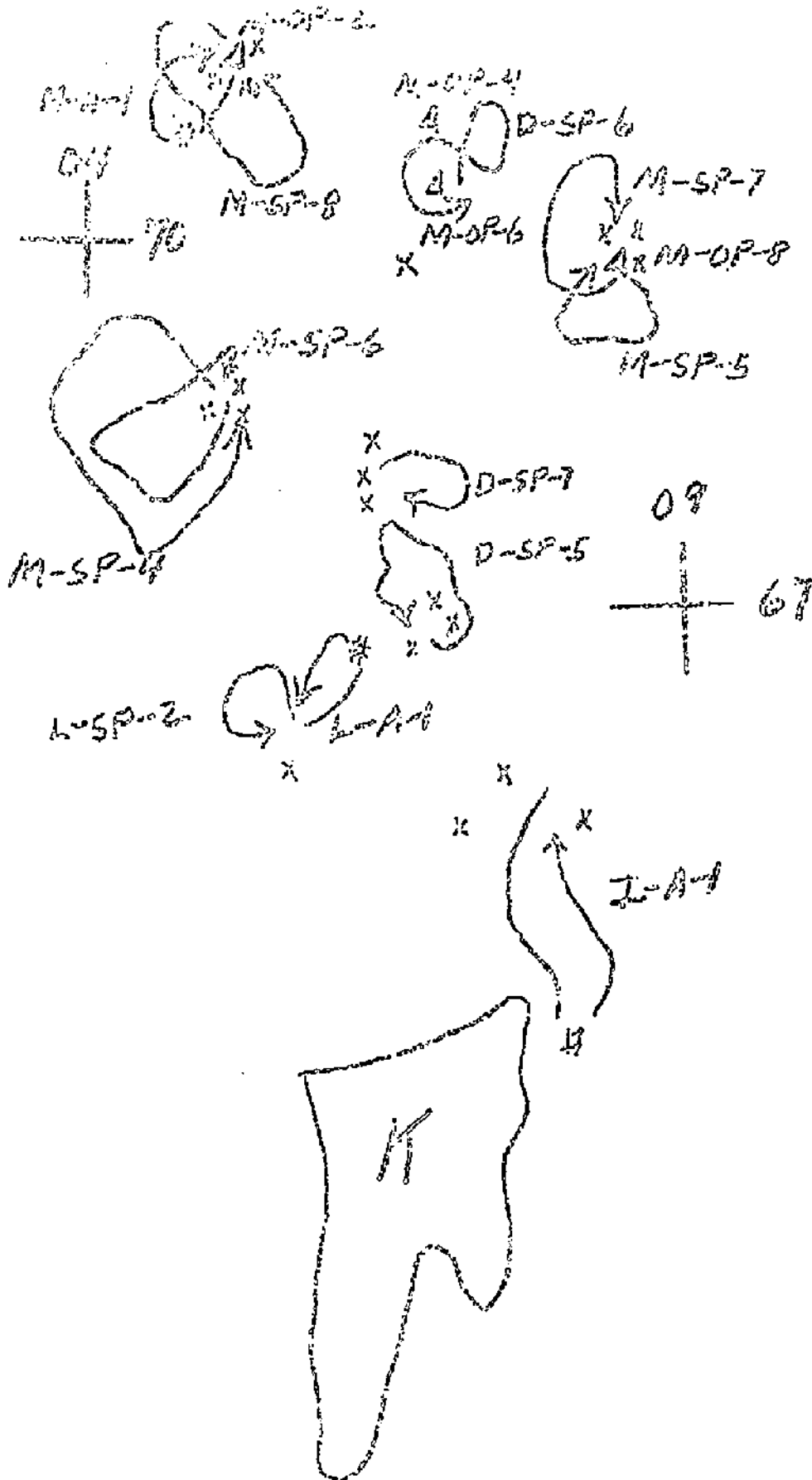

NIGHT TIME ACTIVITIES



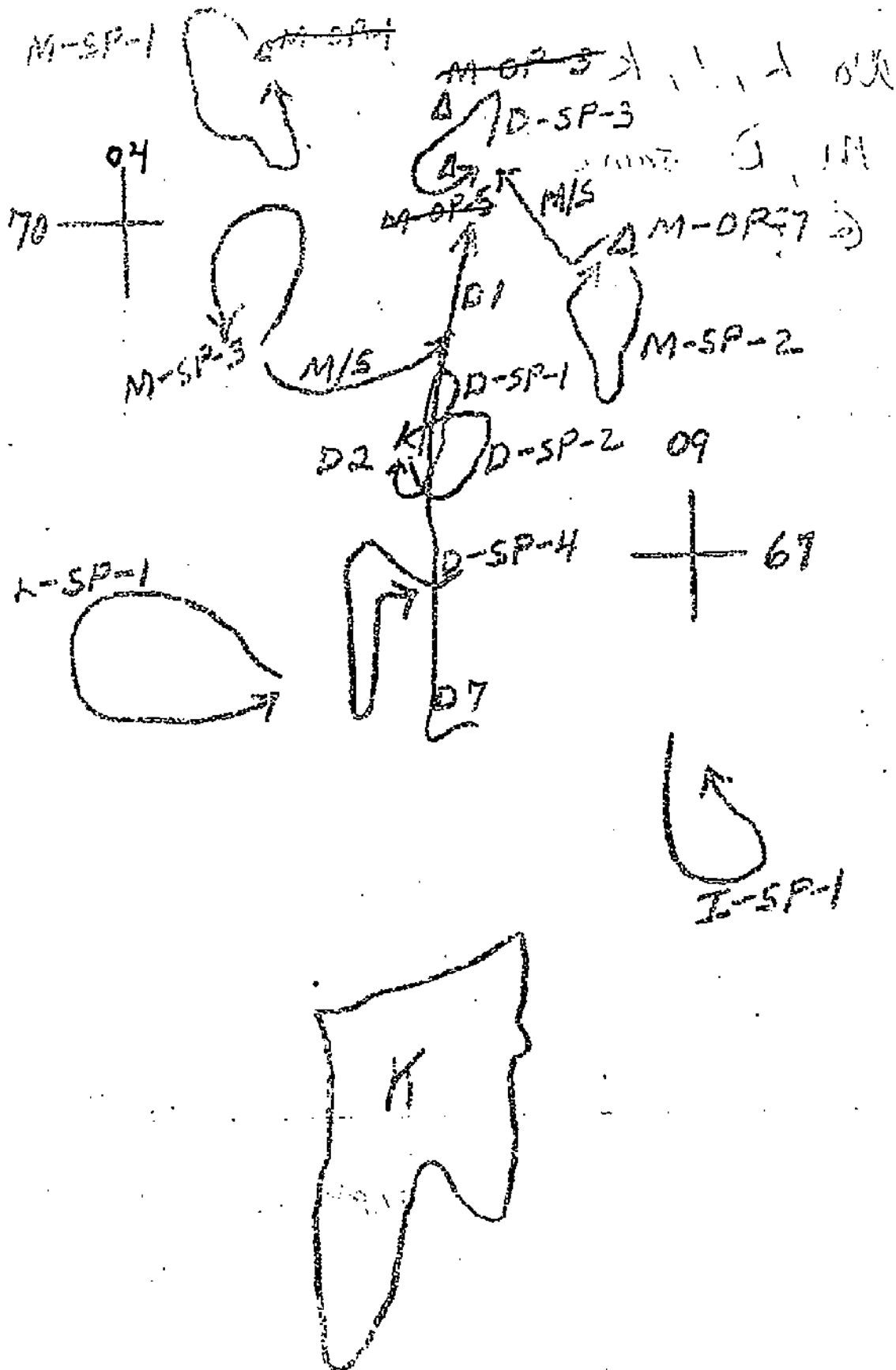
