



2. ENEMY, WEATHER AND TERRAIN

a. General. Enemy contact was moderate for the eight days that the unit was at Con Thien; With a number of instances enemy contacts of incoming mortar and artillery fire was heavy for the period and harassing in nature. One day recorded 57 mixed rounds of fire, one day 23 rounds, one day 12, one 5, one 3, and three days no fire was received. On 4 March 1968 Golf Company plt. patrol made contact with a 35 man NVA force. Hotel, Golf and CP reacted and NVA broke contact with 11 NVA confirmed KIA on ground.

On 9 March 1968 Carousel command post and three line Companies moved to C-2 and C-2 Bridge. The contact at C-2 and C-2 bridge was light for the reporting period. 15 March 1968 Foxtrot held in position 10 detainees, and reported 3 ran to the south west. On 22 March Echo killer team made contact with 13 NVA. Echo Company reacted and enemy broke contact with 2 confirmed KIA. There were 8 confirmed by air strike.

Incoming for the period at C-2 and C-2 bridge was light with one day recording 15 rounds and 14 days with no incoming reported.

On 23 March the unit moved South West to Ca Lu YD 0048 to open a new operation on 1 April 1968. Enemy contact was light for the remainder of the month.

(5) 164th Artillery Regiment, strength unknown, located at S. E. Vinh Linh as of 28 Aug 1967.

d. Weather and Terrain

(1) Weather: During March, the generally mild weather permitted unimpeded resupply and improvement of defensive position at Con Thien and C-2/C-2 Bridge. The rainfall was very light and had no effect on friendly operations.

(2) Terrain: Con Thien area has no change of terrain that we can see of. C-2 and C-2 Bridge area was low rolling hill area and no objects to interfere with vision whatsoever. However there was low under brush. Ca Lu is laying between hills on both sides and jungle grass which is about 4 feet high in some places. Trees and under brush are covering the area of Ca Lu.

For the period 23 to 31 March S-2 also assumed the S-5 forward duties. This included the use of about 70 locals for LZ work and help with filling sand bags and other jobs as required for the defense of the LZ Stud.

The relationship of Marines with Locals was very good in the reporting period. The unit was relieved of this duty on the afternoon of 31 March, by CG 1st Cav. (Air Mobile).

3. Organization and Operations

a. The Battalion continued to fulfill the mission of maintaining the defense of Con Thien until 8 March 68, at which time the Battalion was displaced to position C-2 and C-2 Bridge with the mission of defending these two positions. Patrol activity was increased in both positions with emphasis on night patrols and ambushes. On 4 March 68, a platoon patrol made contact with a 35 man NVA Force. Hotel and Golf Companies reacted resulting in 11 NVA KIA's before contact was broken by the NVA.

Enemy mortar and artillery fire slightly decreased during the first 8 days of this month, with 100 rounds of mixed mortar and artillery fire recorded, with few casualties sustained and no significant material damage. From 9 March to 22 March, defensive position C-2 and C-2 Bridge recorded 15 rounds of enemy artillery fire resulting in few casualties and no material damage.

On 23 March the Battalion displaced to LZ Stud near Ca Lu in Cam Lo Province where the Battalion was given the mission of providing security for 1st Air Cav. Division and security for LZ Stud. Defensive positions were being prepared to include defensive wire before being relieved for another mission. One significant contact was made when an element of Foxtrot Company was ambushed while on a Search and Destroy Operation. Friendly casualties were 5 KIA's and 11 WIA's. A platoon from Echo Company was inserted to extract the 5 KIA's from Company "F" and their equipment. As a result of this insert Company "E" had 1 KIA and 3 WIA's.

b. Air

(1) Helicopter

1st Marine Aircraft Wing Helicopters in support of 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines lifted 21 USMC WIA and 4 USMC Ill on twelve Emergency Medevac missions. In addition, there were 11 priority medevac missions carrying 13 USMC WIA and 1 USMC Ill, two routine medevacs were also flown carrying 8 USMC KIA, 1 USMC WIA, and 1 KIA Scout Dog.

One reconnaissance flight was made during the month carrying Unit Commanders and Staff Personnel over planned operation areas. Three Passenger pickups were made at 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines at Con Thien and C-2 during the month.

(2) Fixed Wing

Five close air support sorties were flown during the month of March, total ordinance expended was not available. These air strikes accounted for 18 confirmed KBA, 16 Bunkers destroyed, 16 Bunkers damaged, 200 meters of trench line destroyed, and one mortar position destroyed.

Of 36 T.P.Q.-10 requests submitted, a total of 35 were run, during which 8 secondary explosions were observed.

c. Artillery and Fire Support

(1) During the period from 1 March 68 to 21 March 68 fire support was provided by 2nd Battalion, 12th Marines and the general support batteries of the 1st of the 40th Army Artillery Group. From 22 March 68 till 31 March 68 fire support was provided by 1st Battalion, 12th Marines and 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, and the 1st of the 30th Army Artillery Group.

(2) Round expenditure for the month of March was 4,069 of assorted calibers of artillery. 81mm round expenditure was 6,782.

4. Training

The training for the period of March was much the same as reported for the month of February, consisting of orientation and F&M Firing for new troops, filling school quotas, and Company/Platoon level classes on General Military Subjects. Company/Platoon classes and practical exercises were conducted on the Starlite scope.

Two classes were conducted on medevac procedures and individual first aid.

New replacements received usual orientation instructions, with added emphasis on weapons safety. All new personnel fired individual weapons for familiarization and zeroing at short distance.

5. Logistics and Supply

a. Logistics

(1) All classes of supply, except Class V as listed below, were adequate to meet requirements during March.

(1) Problem areas

(a) All types of repair parts for M422A1's and M274A2's remained extremely hard to acquire during March.

c. ^{Motop} Motor Transport

(1) No difficulties arose in this area other than listed in paragraph 5. b(1)(a) above. Vehicles for the move from Con Thien to C-2, C-2 to Ca Lu, C-2 to Dong Ha, and Dong Ha to Ca Lu were adequate to meet all requirements.

d. Roads

(1) Access roads and MSR's remained passable during March.

e. Fiscal Obligation

(1) Obligation during March for FSA items were 52,737.62 dollars.

f. Equipment Repairs

(1) During March 45 tactical equipment repair orders were submitted to FLSG. Of these 25 were completed. As of 31 March 20 items of Combat Essential Equipment were deadlined.

g. Miscellaneous

(1) The Battalion changed locations twice during the month of March. The first move was from Con Thien to C-2 and the second was from C-2 to Ca Lu. Resupply for the rifle companies continued to come from Dong Ha and Phu Bai in an acceptable manner during the month.

6. Civic Action

During the first part of March, the activities of this section were directed toward the Thay Phuong Refugee Center.

Our main interest was directed toward sanitation facilities. The heads installed last month were maintained, and further efforts were made to dispose of the trash which had accumulated at the center.

The Naval personnel conducting our Med-Caps noted that a possible Cholera outbreak could arise. With the help of Alpha Medical Battalion Supply, representatives from this section obtained serum and syringes for a consultant of this problem. Approximately two-hundred (200) people were immunized. Individual shot cards were signed and dated.

In the latter part of this month, this section was directed by the Regimental S-5 Office to conduct new operations in the CAP HOTEL #2 area. Liaison was made with the NCOIC of that compound and projects were discussed. We combined our Naval personnel and supplies, and a regular Med-Cap was organized and initiated. Toilet articles such as soap, tooth paste, and toothbrushes were obtained from Regimental S-5, and distributed to the people as needed.

Psychological Operations

During the Month of March, the Psychological Operations of this Battalion were limited, but successful.

Coordinating with our daily Med-Cap, health leaflets pertaining to brushing teeth, washing, and disposing of human waste and refuse, were distributed to the patients. Not all of the leaflets placed on order were obtained, and it was subsequently learned that a new distribution list for psychological Warfare leaflets is in effect. All desired leaflets may now be obtained by submitting a requisition form to: Detachment I, 7th Psychological Operations Battalion, APO 96337.

All Psychological Operations in conjunction with our forward elements in the vicinity of C-2 (Con Thien), were executed by the 244th Psychological Operations Company at the request of Third Marine Division.

8. Communications

(1) Moved from Con Thien to C-2 Position and installed Communication systems. Supported C.P.'s at C-2 proper and at C-2 Bridge position. Existing wire lines were relayed as well as alternate lines to all Companies and the BAS. 8 Radio Nets were guarded in the Battalion COC.

(2) Moved from C-2 to Cam Lu Airfield set up initial wire communications for defense of area. Were relieved by 1st Battalion, 1st Marines and moved to new position south of Airfield and set up CP for Rear Command Group.

9. Medical and Dental

This Battalion Aid Station treated 143 sick call patients during the month of March. No combat casualties were treated. No immersion foot cases were noted at the Battalion Rear. At the BAS forward a total of 41 casualties were treated. Of this total 27 were medevaced to "D" Medical Battalion. The remaining were returned to duty. Also 9 JEM's and 1 USN ZIA were prepared for shipment to Graves Registration, Dong Ha.

10. Chaplain

a. Protestant Divine Services. There were 47 Protestant Services held during the month of March with a total attendance of 946.

b. Catholic Divine Services. There were 13 Catholic Services held during the month of March.

c. LDS Quarterly Meeting. Two of the men from this Battalion were given the opportunity for attending the LDS Quarterly meeting.

d. Red Cross Messages. Six Red Cross messages were delivered by the Battalion Chaplain.

Efforts will probably be directed towards interdicting or harrassing convoys between Dong Ha and Ca Lu. Infantry forces equipped with rockets, mortars, and recoilless rifles are to be dispersed along Route #9 to accomplish this. There is reason to believe that direct artillery support pieces up to 75mm pack howitzers are in position over looking Camp Carroll. Additional artillery north of the Ben Hai River possess range capability to conduct attack by fire along Route #9 from Dong Ha to and including Ca Lu. Reports indicate that Forward Observers from the 164th Artillery Regiment have been active in areas from Cam Lo to Camp Carroll. There is specific indications that Dong Ha will be taken under artillery attack on 26 March 1968. Attacks by fire are expected area-wide within the Divisions TAOR, with emphasis on Dong Ha, Camp Carroll, and possibly the airfield under construction north of Ca Lu.</p>

During the break out 2 USMC were wounded, one was the patrol leader who was hit twice but remained in control of the patrol and established and directed the defense perimeter until relieved by the reaction force. The scout dog attempted to attack and NVA firing at members of the patrol and was shot in the head and killed, the dog handler fired at the NVA and saw him fall but was unable to confirm a KIA. Two NVA were confirmed killed by a grenade during the breakout. The reaction force under the guidance of the AO effected juncture at about 201445H when the reaction force approached the patrols position, 2 NVA were observed and killed. Upon approach of reaction force NVA disengaged and contact was not regained. Reaction force checked area. One NVA appeared to have been an NCO however the body was set a fire to the clothing and his ammunition was cooking off. After departing to return to C-2 25 rounds of 60mm was received near friendly position. Rounds were off target and not effective. The patrol leader feel the civilians were a diversion for the NVA to encircle the patrol.


