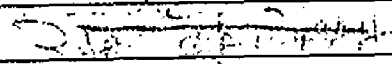

1. SUMMARY OF ENEMY SITUATION

a. The operation area has continuously been a staging area for the enemy. The area is on the route from Base Area 112 to all points in the Danang TACR and it receives supplies and personnel from NVN. The troops and supplies arrive at Go Noi and are injected into the lines of the VC within the area. The main operating area of the VCI is believed to be located here and probably all of the political and military plans and decisions are made at this location. This activity continues even though there have been continuous operations of various sizes within the area of operations.

2. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION

- a. Will the Enemy defend? If so, where and in what strength?
- b. Will the Enemy withdraw? If so, to where and in what direction will he move?
- c. Will the Enemy attempt to fight a delaying action, using SFOD's and small units to engage friendly forces allowing larger more lucrative targets to leave the area?
- d. Will the Enemy employ CS or any type of chemical agent in his attempt to protect his domain? If so, what type and in what quantity?
- e. Will the enemy attempt to use the civilian populace as a protective measure by employing the tactic of mingling with the civilians to avoid detection.

3. INTELLIGENCE ACQUISITION TASKS

a. Requests to higher units.

(1) 1st Marines - Provide aerial and photo reconnaissance as required.

(a) Furnish CIT and ITT support as required.

(b) Keep this unit appraised of all OOR and changing enemy situation that might affect the mission of this unit.

b. Orders to subordinate units.

(1) All companies

(a) All companies will report immediately all contacts with enemy forces to include, estimated size of enemy unit in contact, weapons, uniforms, and routes of withdrawal.

(b) Any sightings to include, size, activity, location, uniforms, times, and equipment.

c. Orders to attachments.

(1) Medical.

(a) DAS will report all PW's as treated.

(b) Any treatment of civilians that might be exploited by this unit of wounds inflicted by the VC.

(2) Communications.

(a) Report all attempts at jamming, interference and deception immediately.

(b) Any possible compromise by friendly units of code words, call signs, etc.

(3) Engineers.

(a) Report any unusual bunkers or protective shelters used by the enemy.

(b) Any unusual type of SFD's employed, or any unusual employment of SFD's.

4. MEASURES FOR HANDLING PERSONNEL, DOCUMENTS AND MATERIEL

a. DETAINEES - All detainees will be handled in accordance with the Geneva Convention and will be forwarded immediately to the Battalion collection point which will be designated. The immediate use of tactical information at Company level can be utilized prior to the detainee being sent to the collection point. Under no circumstances will detainees be mistreated. The proper tagging and the circumstance of capture cannot be overemphasized. A Battalion S-2 Scout is assigned to each Company to assist the Company Commander in the tagging and handling of detainees.

b. All captured documents will be immediately forwarded to Battalion S-2 and if found on a detainee, it should accompany him. The proper tagging and identifying of documents is imperative if the maximum amount of information is to be obtained from the documents.

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c. Captured Material - Captured material should be forwarded to the Battalion S-2 for determination of its Intelligence value, if any, and the claiming of War Trophies should be made at a later time. Every effort will be made by the S-2 to return all legitimate war trophies to the finder immediately if no intelligence value is found to exist. All captured material becomes the property of the U.S. Government and any attempt to conceal any item of this nature is punishable by law.

5. Maps of the operation area can be obtained at the S-2 Office, but a limited supply is on hand and it should be remembered to take only the amount of maps needed. Aerial photographs of the operation will be available in the S-2 Office.

6. COUNTER INTELLIGENCE

a. No friendly areas, thrust points, call signs, code words, or radio frequencies will be drawn, written or displayed in any manner on maps or notebooks that might fall into enemy hands or be compromised in any manner.

b. All detained personnel will be screened for possible CI interest.

7. REPORTS AND DISTRIBUTION

a. All companies will report any information of intelligence interest on the regular spot report. It is requested that enemy dead be examined for possible identification of the unit in contact and if identification cannot be made, so state in the spot report.

8. MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONS

a. Auxiliary Agencies.

(1) ITT. Interrogator Translator Teams are attached to this unit to attempt to extract information of intelligence value from the detainees from the field. They also render assistance in the translation of documents, etc. The ITT teams will be located in the Battalion CP with the Battalion S-2.

(2) CIT. Counterintelligence Teams provide assistance in identifying and neutralizing the VC Infrastructure.

b. Weather Service Plans.

(1) Daily weather reports will be issued and any information that will affect this unit's mission concerning the weather will be immediately issued.

c. Psychological Warfare.

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(1) The maximum use of Chieu Hoi's will be utilized. In the event a Chieu Hoi surrenders to this unit, he will be utilized to induce others to become [Redacted] Chams.

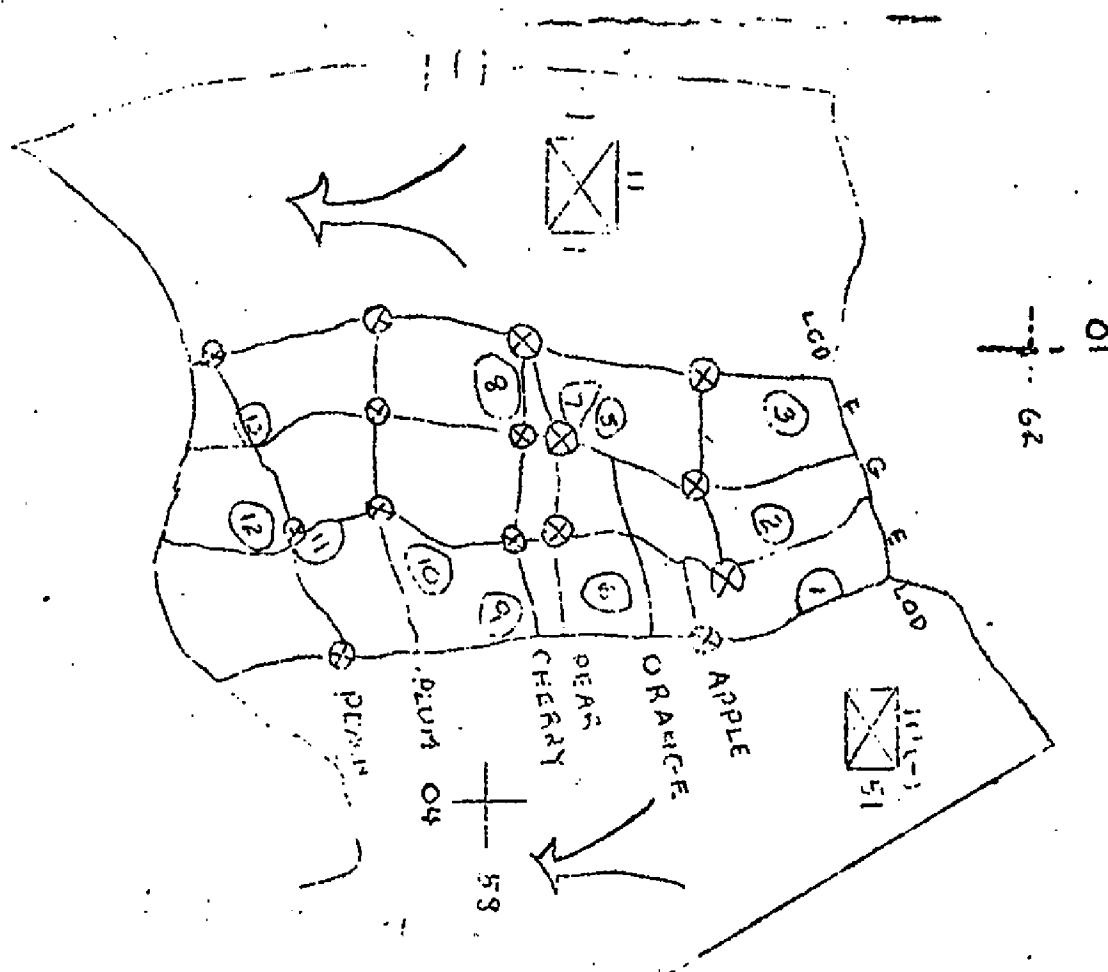
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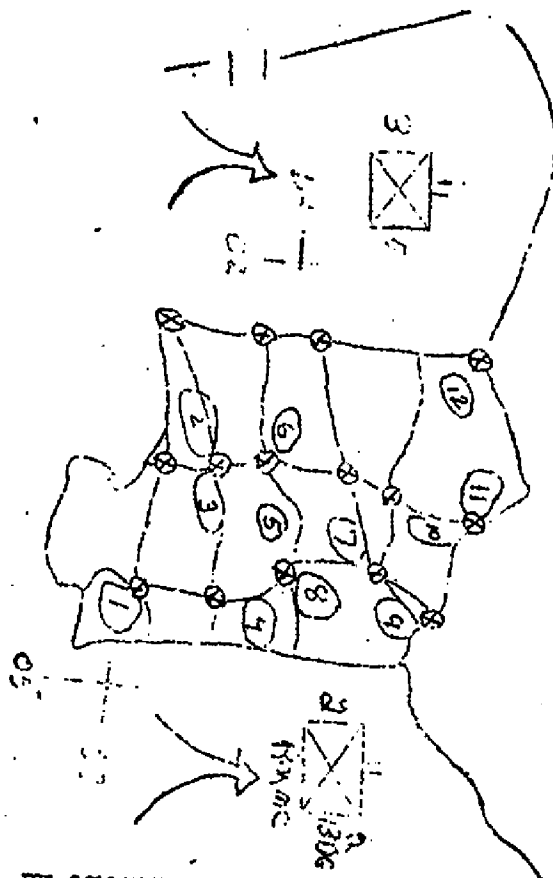

1. SITUATION

a. Enemy Forces.

2. MISSION. The 2nd Battalion 1st Marines Fire Support Coordination Center (FSCC) will exercise overall responsibility for planning, coordinating and controlling all supporting arms fires supporting 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines, to ensure maximum effective fire support and troop safety.

3. EXECUTION

a. Concept of Operations. Fire Support Coordination will be in accordance with references (b) thru (e). Precleared zones in effect during Phase II and III are designated in Appendix 1. Within the precleared zone, appropriate No Fire Lines (NFL) and Fire Coordination Lines (FCL) will be established to provide ground safety for the operating forces. Appendix 2 defines those coordinating measures as they apply to Operation PIPESTONE CANYON. Coordination of supporting arms fire will be effected at the Company level whenever feasible.

b. 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines FSCC.

- (1) During Phase II coordinate all supporting arms fires within assigned zone of action short of the NFL.
- (2) During Phase III coordinate all supporting arms fires within assigned zone of action short of the NFL.

(3) During Phase III coordinate and clear with the 1st Marines FSCC all request for supporting arms fire short of the NFL established to protect the blocking force North of Go Noi Island.

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c. Coordinating Instructions.

(1) All requests for supporting arms fire plotting within 500 meters of or within the boundary of an adjacent unit whose zone of action is within the precleared zone require coordination and clearance with the appropriate FSCC if the fires plot short of the MFL in the zone of action concerned. Supporting arms fires plotting forward of the MFL in adjacent zones of action within the precleared area are clear to fire without further coordination.

(2) All required coordination and clearance of supporting arms fire between adjacent U. S. Marine Corps Battalion will be effected at the Battalion FSCC level.

(3) All required coordination and clearance of supporting arms fire between adjacent U. S. Marine Corps and ARVN/ROKMC units will be effected at the 1st Marine FSCC.

(4) All requests for Naval Gunfire support will be requested through the 1st Marines FSCC (Naval Gunfire Liaison Office) unless otherwise authorized by the 1st Marines FSCC.

(5) Night Defense Fire plans requiring coordination and clearance of the 1st Marines FSCC will be forwarded to the FSCC by 1700 daily. The 2nd Battalion 1st Marines FSCC will be notified on cleared night defensive fires and they may be also fired without further clearance contingent upon Battalion requirements.

(6) Position reports on FC's will be submitted every four hours.

(7) All requests for supporting arms fire plotting within a No Fire Zone will be coordinated and cleared with the 1st Marines FSCC (Forward).

d. TARGET INFORMATION

a. Target List. Ref (c), Appendix B (Target Information) to Annex B (Intelligence).

b. Restrictive Targets.

(1) Special emphasis is required to ensure strict adherence to the rules of engagement, reference (a).

(2) Supporting arms fire delivered against targets on or adjacent to that portion of National Route # 1 within the area of operation will be strictly controlled in order to insure minimum damage to the road. Fuze VT and time is recommended against targets on or adjacent to National Route # 1. Fuze delay will not be utilized unless explicitly authorized by the Coordinator Allied Forces or Commanding Officer 1st Bn, 11th Marines.

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5. SAFETY

a. Aircraft Safety.

(1) Artillery fire will check fire when it appears that projectile trajectories will endanger friendly aircraft.

(2) Unless special coordination measures are prescribed, fires of helicopter routes are restricted to observed fires where the observer is capable of ensuring the safety of the helicopter using the route.

b. Restrictive Fire Plan.

(3) When heavy artillery and, or Naval Gunfire could endanger a simultaneous air support mission, a restrictive fire plan is employed. The 1st Marines FSCG will promulgate the restrictive fire plan.

(4) The unit requesting an air support mission recommends a restrictive fire plan if deemed appropriate. The 1st Marines FSCG will not impose a restrictive fire plan contrary to recommendations of the requesting unit unless the need is clearly indicated.

(5) The ground Commander exercises prudent judgment in use of restrictive fire plans to permit the maximum use of all supporting arms available in the accomplishment of the ground force mission.

c. Landing Zone Assignments.

(6) Helicopter landing zones will be prepared by supporting arms prior to their use by helicopters executing a tactical lift.

6. SAFETY OF BATTLE POSITIONS

a. 1st Fire Line.

(1) The Battalion Commander and Battalion Staff Officer is responsible for recommending, recommending changes in the location of the 1st Fire Line and forwarding these locations up the chain of command both artillery and infantry. These recommended changes will be successively approved or modified. As a general guideline, the 1st Fire Line will be maintained at a minimum of 1000 meters forward of advancing ground elements.

b. Fire Coordination Line. The Fire Coordination Line will be prescribed and published by the Commander Allied Forces based on the recommendation of the Commanding Officer, 1st Marines.

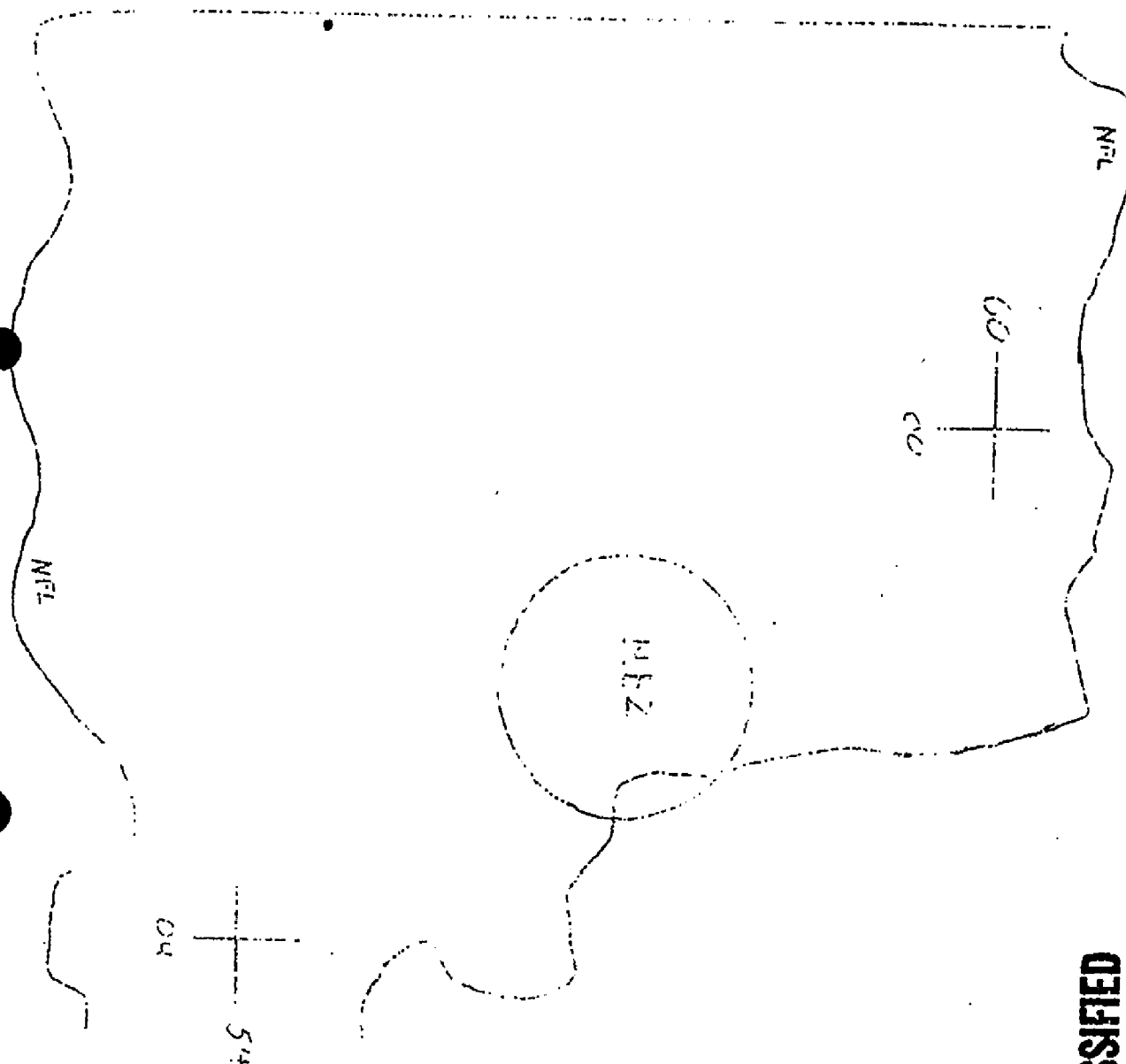

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Appendix 2 (Definitions) to Annex D (Fire Support Coordination) Operation Order 002-69

1. No Fire Line

a. The No Fire Line (NFL) is a line short of which artillery or ships do not fire except on request of or by coordination and clearance with the supported Commander, but beyond which they may fire at any time without danger to friendly troops. The term "short of which" will always refer to the relationship of the NFL and the troops it is established to protect. The purpose of the NFL is to expedite firing across boundaries into adjacent zones of action without endangering the forward elements of the maneuver force or the blocking force.

b. The NFL is shown by a broken red line on the situation maps and/or firing charts of all artillery units and FSCU's. A date/time group accompanies the NFL and indicates the time it becomes effective.

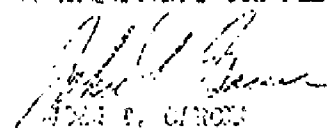
c. The format for transmitting NFL locations is as follows:

2. Fire Coordination Line

a. The Fire Coordination Line (FCL) is established to coordinate all fires between a blocking force and an attacking force. Before fires can be extended across the FCL, prior clearance must be granted by the headquarters of the force on the other side of the line.
