SITREP FOR PERIOD 082400H TO 092200H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Contacts. At 090545H, Company K patrol received six rounds small arms (carbines) fire from vicinity coordinates BT 445166. Patrol returned thirty rounds automatic fire in direction of enemy muzzle flashes. Fire ceased and immediate search was conducted of enemy positions. Search uncovered one VC body in black pajamas. No weapons or equipment were recovered.

B. Miscellaneous

1. In accordance with verbal order from Commanding Officer, 1st Marines, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines provided two rifle companies and command group to Chu Lai Defense Command in order to relieve elements of the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines, of responsibility for security of MAG-12 airstrip, Class V Ammunition Dump, and RMK vital installation. Relief commenced 081000H and was effected 081200H.

2. At 090920, Company K uncovered cave on river bank vicinity coordinates BT 435148. Five meters from opening was a bamboo tree arched as crude bow with arrow pointing to cave (no trip wire). Cave was ten feet in depth, two by three feet at opening, enlarging to four by six feet in chamber where one U.S. poncho, one blue plastic Vietnamese poncho, and key chain were found. Pursuant to search cave was destroyed.

3. At 091945H, Company L patrol, accompanied by the members of Self Defense Corps from Hamlet of An Tay (2), vicinity coordinates BT 523083, apprehended Popular Force member with a .45 caliber pistol which, according to roster of weapons assigned Popular Force personnel, should not be in this man's possession. Popular Force member was placed under security and will be turned over to Popular Force Platoon Leader in morning.

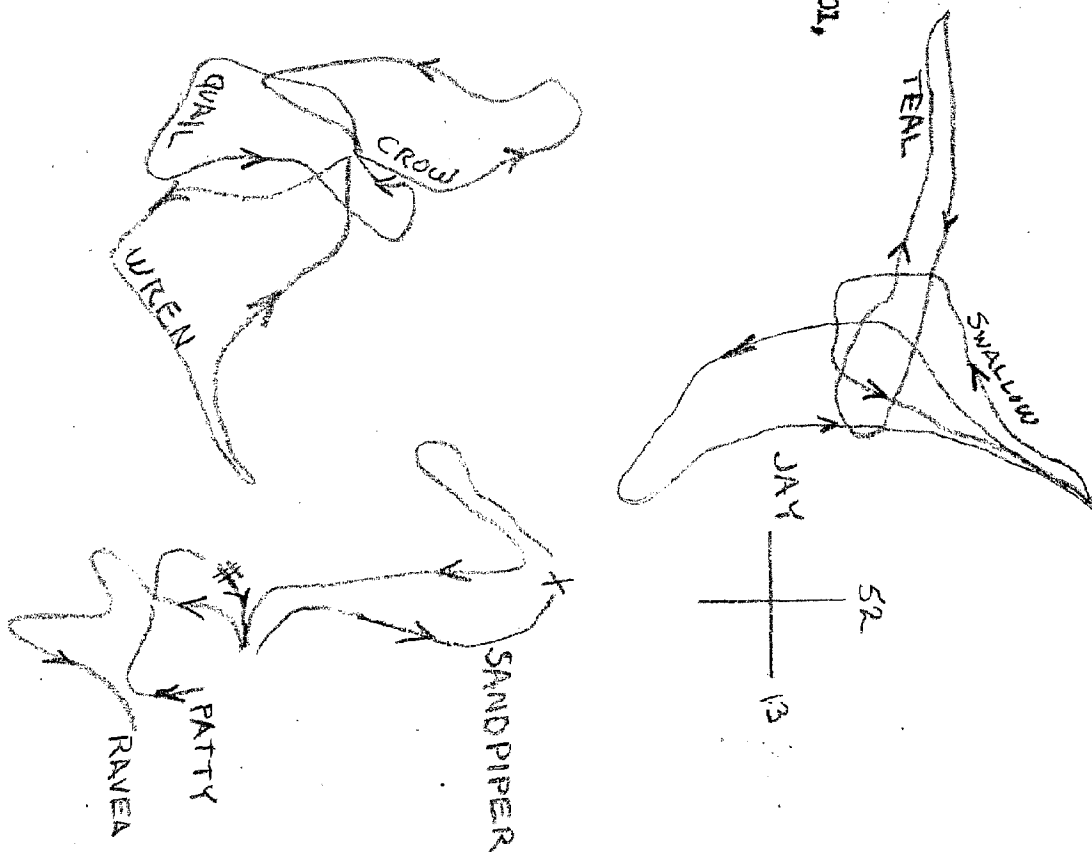

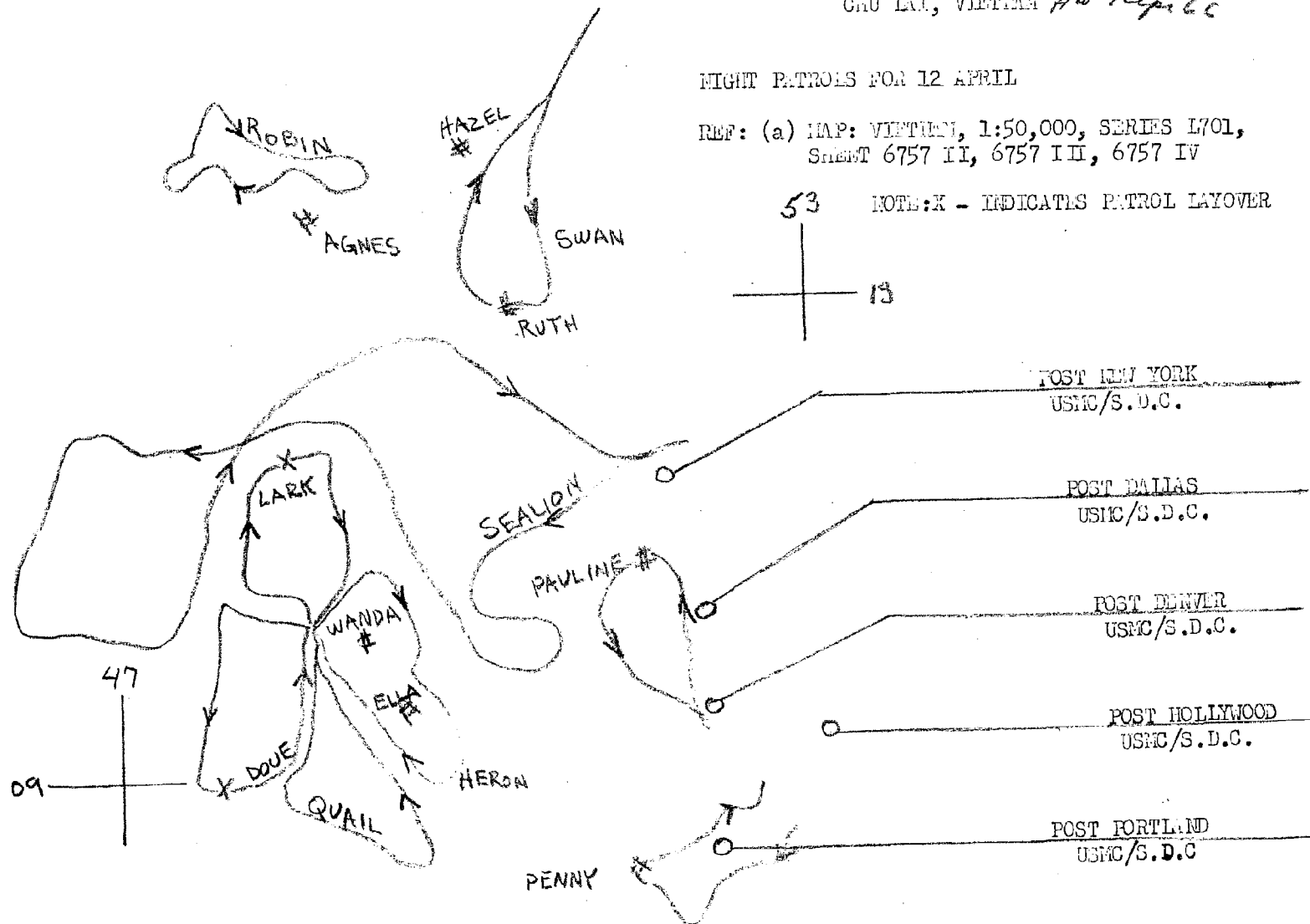

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Contacts

1. At 100300H, Company L patrol received four rounds small arms fire from tree line vicinity coordinates BT 507147. Patrol returned fire with twelve rounds small arms fire. Fire ceased. Area was searched without locating any confirmed VC casualties. At this same time, it was noted that a boat located thirty meters off shore may have been source of fire. Upon further investigation, and in consultation with village chief, it was established that boat in question was not VC but had grounded on sand bar and was abandoned early in the night.

2. At 101655H, Company K patrol, while searching stream bank vicinity coordinates BT 444149, sighted VC who attempted to evade capture by diving into water and swimming to underground cave with opening under water. The patrol continued to probe stream bank and uncovered tunnel complex. Patrol entered water and swam into cave; encountered VC who again attempted to escape; shot and killed VC. Upon further investigation, a larger cave complex, caves ranging from three to six feet high, three feet wide and four feet long, reinforced with bamboo matting, was discovered. Within these, two other VCs were found. VCs were placed under security and will be returned to Battalion for interrogation. Further search revealed nothing and caves were destroyed. No friendly casualties were sustained.

3. At 102030H, Company K Command Post received fifteen rounds small arms (carbine) fire from vicinity coordinates BT 434161. Fire was returned with 100 M-60 rounds, and two M-79 rounds. Area will be searched at first light. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

B. Miscellaneous. At 103400H, Company E, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines commenced relief of Company I, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines for responsibility of security of Glass V Dump and southwest sector of MAG-12 Airfield security. At 103530H, relief was effected and Company I returned vicinity of 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines Command Post.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Contacts. At 111900H, Company L, on island of Hoa Xuan, observed three VC apparently carrying one rifle and one mortar 500 meters south of Company L Command Post at vicinity coordinates BT 434154. VC were taken under fire with fifteen rounds small arms fire and ten rounds 81mm mortars. Due to closing darkness, Company L was unable to complete detailed search of area; thorough search will be conducted at first light. No friendly casualties or confirmed VC casualties.

B. Miscellaneous

1. At 110230H, one of the two VCs captured by Company I 101655H (reference SITREP for period 092400H to 102300H) attempted to escape. VC evaded physical recapture; and, after being warned to halt, was shot and killed as he ran through front lines.

2. In accordance with verbal order of Commanding Officer, 1st Marines, at 070000H, Company I (-) commenced relief of Company L (Rein) on islands of Ky Hoa and Ky Xuan. Relief was effective 111200H; and at 111330H, Company L (Rein) commenced relief of Company I (Rein) on island of Hoa Xuan. Relief was effective 111630, and Company I (Rein) returned to Battalion Command Post, last elements arriving 111900H. 2nd Platoon, Company I will continue to provide Sparrow Hawk Squad, as well as maintain fifteen-minute reaction capability.

No VC were observed in the area. The area of the burned house was searched. Twenty meters from the house, a tunnel complex was located measuring eight feet in diameter and ten feet in length with a connecting tunnel, five feet in diameter and five feet long. There was one underwater entrance. No arms or documents were located in the tunnels. The tunnels were destroyed.

3. At 151900H, Company L lines at BT 437157 received four rounds of small arms fire from vicinity coordinates BT 439161. Fire was returned with twenty-seven rounds of small arms fire and four rounds of M-79 fire. At the same time, the Company L outpost at vicinity coordinates BT 435157 received sixteen rounds of small arms fire from vicinity coordinates BT 441148. Fire was returned with twenty-four rounds of small arms fire and ten rounds of 81mm mortar fire. A LVT with one fire team mounted was dispatched to search both areas. Nothing was found. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties.

B. Miscellaneous

1. At 151100H, the 1st and 2nd Platoons of Company K with one FAC Team departed this Command Post as convoy security for a convoy ~~from~~ ~~from~~ 7th Motor Transport Battalion destined for Quang Ngai. These platoons returned to this Command Post at 151830H.

2. Company L continued search and clear operations on the island of Hoa Xuan (BT 43115) with enemy contact as set forth in paragraph A. above. Command post location and front lines remain the same. Company

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Contacts. At 170115, Company L ambush, vicinity coordinates BT 444155, opened fire on two VC in ambush killing zone. Immediately upon commencing fire, ambush received three rounds small arms fire from vicinity coordinates BT 445152 and four rounds small arms fire vicinity coordinates BT 448152, into which the ambush expended 200 rounds small arms fire and one hand grenade. The area was searched, and one VC KIA, one VC WIA, and one U.S. M-1 carbine with ten rounds were found. VC WIA was evacuated on first available transportation. No friendly casualties were sustained.

B. Miscellaneous

1. 3rd Platoon, Company I patrol Wren (reference: SITREP for period 152400H to 162200H) continued search for suspected mortar positions on island of Ky Xuan, and at 170130H, on the authority of 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines report that two 60mm mortar positions were sighted vicinity coordinates BT 491083 and BT 495078, the patrol was directed to investigate. This area was searched and at 170208H, the patrol reported fifteen to twenty rounds incoming from vicinity northwest of An Tan Bridge, amplified 170345H to report ten rounds received vicinity coordinates BT 496086 from the southwest. Immediately following this report, Patrol Wren was ordered to return to 3rd Platoon, Company I Command Post. At 170700H, S-3, 1st Marines informed this Battalion incoming mortar rounds on Ky Xuan were fired by 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines. Their mortars were apparently 180 degrees off gun-target azimuth.

2. At 170835H, 3rd Platoon, Company I patrol discovered slain male civilian on trail vicinity coordinates BT 491108. The body was identified as the Assistant Hamlet Chief of Dong Xuan, vicinity coordinates BT 487115. The man was believed to be assassinated, and the matter is now subject to further investigation by the Battalion S-2 in conjunction with the village chief of Dong Xuan.

3. At 171050H, Company L patrol noticed anti-American sign on school house vicinity coordinates BT 427158 and directed male VCS in immediate area to remove it. As the sign was being removed, a beeby trap exploded wounding the VCS. The VCS was treated immediately and forwarded to D-Med on first available transportation. No friendly casualties were sustained.

4. At 171200H, Company I received report from village chief of Long Thanh Dong that at 170500H an artillery shell impacted vicinity coordinates BT 499137. A squad was dispatched to investigate damage and found an unexploded 250 pound bomb. The area was immediately cleared of all personnel, and EOD Team notified. At 171300H, the bomb was disarmed and carried by helicopter to target island--there detonated.

5. At 171600H, Company L patrol discovered large jar of rice buried in house vicinity coordinates BT 446154 and conducted detailed search of surrounding area uncovering an additional one and one-half tons of rice. The rice was confiscated pending a thorough investigation by S-2 and interrogation team.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. CONTACTS

1. (Late entry) At 202100H Second Platoon, Company I patrol (BT519098) received seven rounds small arms fire from an estimated three to four VC vicinity coordinates BT518105. Without returning fire, patrol immediately deployed and advanced toward enemy muzzle flashes. Contact was lost, and search was conducted of suspected VC positions without results. No friendly casualties were sustained.

2. At 211240H Company L patrol (BT441148) received one round small arms fire from vicinity coordinates BT446146 and observed VC carrying rifle running into woodland. Patrol initially engaged VC with nine rounds small arms fire and again with an additional six rounds small arms fire when VC disappeared. Upon search of suspected enemy position, the patrol found one VC KIA and apprehended one VCS who was in the immediate area. VCS will be forwarded to ITT on first available transportation. No friendly casualties were sustained.

B. MISCELLANEOUS

1. At 210131 on order from Commanding Officer, 1st Marines 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines was designated Reserve Battalion in conjunction with 7th Marines/ARVN operation to commence 210900H. Command Group Alpha, Company K, and Company M were alerted for immediate deployment.

2. At 211400H 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines was advised to displace Battalion(-) to MAG-36 airfield, and at 211500H Command Group Alpha, Company K and Company M departed this Command Post. Helo-lift of these elements commenced at 211630H with last elements departing 211715H.

3. 211950H Popular Forces reported to 3rd Platoon, Company I that during the night three VC are expected to return to their homes on island of Ky Xuan vicinity coordinates BT43094. Accordingly, patrol Crow was directed to establish ambush vicinity coordinates BT493087 on Seng An Tan river where the VC are expected to cross to Ky Xuan. Patrol Wren established ambush vicinity coordinates BT495082 near suspected VC homes. As of 212200H no contact has been made.

4. At 212055H Secan. Platoon, Company I, patrol Fortland reported that two Vietnamese males in an Tay Sonlet coordinates BT524087 had apparently been knife fighting and one of these men badly cut. A fire team was dispatched to these coordinates and at 212400H returned this Command Post with the Vietnamese casualty, who was immediately forwarded to B Med.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Intelligence. Negative.

B. Contacts. At 231400H, vicinity coordinates BT 481147, a squad patrol from Company L found three grenade booby traps in the area around one house. Three Vietnamese, one in the house and two nearby, were apprehended as VCS due to close proximity to the booby traps. The VCS in the house indicated that a VC had been in the area. The other two VCS denied this. All three VCS were forwarded to ITT. The booby traps were destroyed. No friendly casualties.

C. Miscellaneous

1. The 1st Platoon, Company I conducted a search and destroy patrol on "Fish Island" commencing at 230930H. The platoon landed vicinity coordinates BT 461125 and moved east through the island to vicinity coordinates BT 483125. At vicinity coordinates BT 471125, three 81mm mortar and rounds were found and destroyed. At vicinity coordinates BT 476125, three 81mm mortar round fin assemblies were found. All male Vietnamese on the island of military age had proper identification cards. No enemy contact. No friendly casualties.

2. At 231500H, vicinity coordinates BT 435165, a Company L patrol apprehended one Vietnamese male who stated he could supply information concerning the VC, including description of weapons and methods of collecting taxes. In addition, he stated that he knows the names of some VC. He was forwarded to ITT for processing.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Late Entries. At 262135H, vicinity coordinates BT 438161, Company M lines received 300 rounds of small arms fire from vicinity coordinates BT 443163, BT 439156, and BT 437154. Fire was returned with 200 rounds of small arms fire and six rounds of 81mm mortar fire. Four 81mm illumination rounds were fired in support. The areas from which fire was received were checked at first light, 27 April 1966, with complete negative results. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties.

B. Contacts. Negative.

C. Miscellaneous. At 270550H, a Company M ambush at vicinity coordinates BT 427162 observed two Vietnamese running at vicinity coordinates BT 432161. A contact to surprise curfew was in effect at the time. In addition, Company M had been fired upon in the early part of the night as set forth in paragraph A. above. Due to these factors, the ambush fired on the two Vietnamese with small arms fire, one M41, and one M-79 round. The area was searched with negative results. At approximately 270700H, two Vietnamese females, ages fifty-five and ten, with minor shrapnel wounds, entered the Company M Compound. They indicated that the wounds were a result of the above incident and that they knew they should not have been in the area. First aid was administered and the two Vietnamese were forwarded to D-Med for further treatment. They were subsequently returned to their village, Hoa Xuan (1). They will receive daily treatment at the Company M Compound. A Backlash Report has been filed.
