Narrative Summary

1. Initial Entries. None.

2. Contacts

a. At 160800H, vicinity BT 965656, Company L patrol received small arms fire at close range. Patrol returned fire; VC broke contact. Search of the area revealed several expended M-16 casings.

b. At 160645H, vicinity BT 046639, Company K lead blocking element received small arms fire, two rounds M-79, and one 81mm mortar shell rigged as a mine and detonated electrically, resulting in one DMC KIA (P.O. VAC). Company continued to advance into assigned blocking positions.

c. At 160945H, vicinity BT 035678, Company M patrol apprehended two female VCS in house where medical supplies found fifteen September. In addition, satchel containing photos and documents was discovered. VCS and satchel forwarded to Battalion G-2.

d. At 161050H, vicinity BT 960660, Company L sweeping element discovered punji pits (three), one of which contained a CHICKEN grenade. Also found was a bamboo pipe filled with explosive. All devices destroyed in place.

3. Miscellaneous

a. At 160200H, vicinity BT 039729, Company I patrol apprehended one male VCS. Suspect was wearing green utilities; ARVN Lieutenant indicated that his identification was inadequate and improper. Suspect subsequently forwarded to Regimental S-2.

b. At 160900H, Company K assumed blocking positions from BT 034657 to BT 060650 in support of search and destroy operation conducted by ARVN forces in 1st Battalion, 1st Marines Tactical Area of Responsibility.

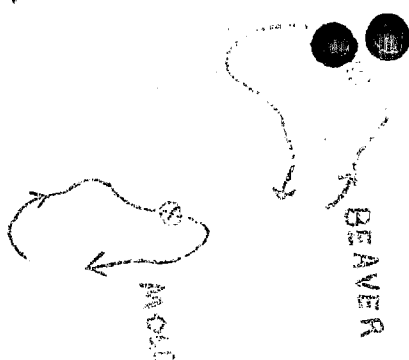

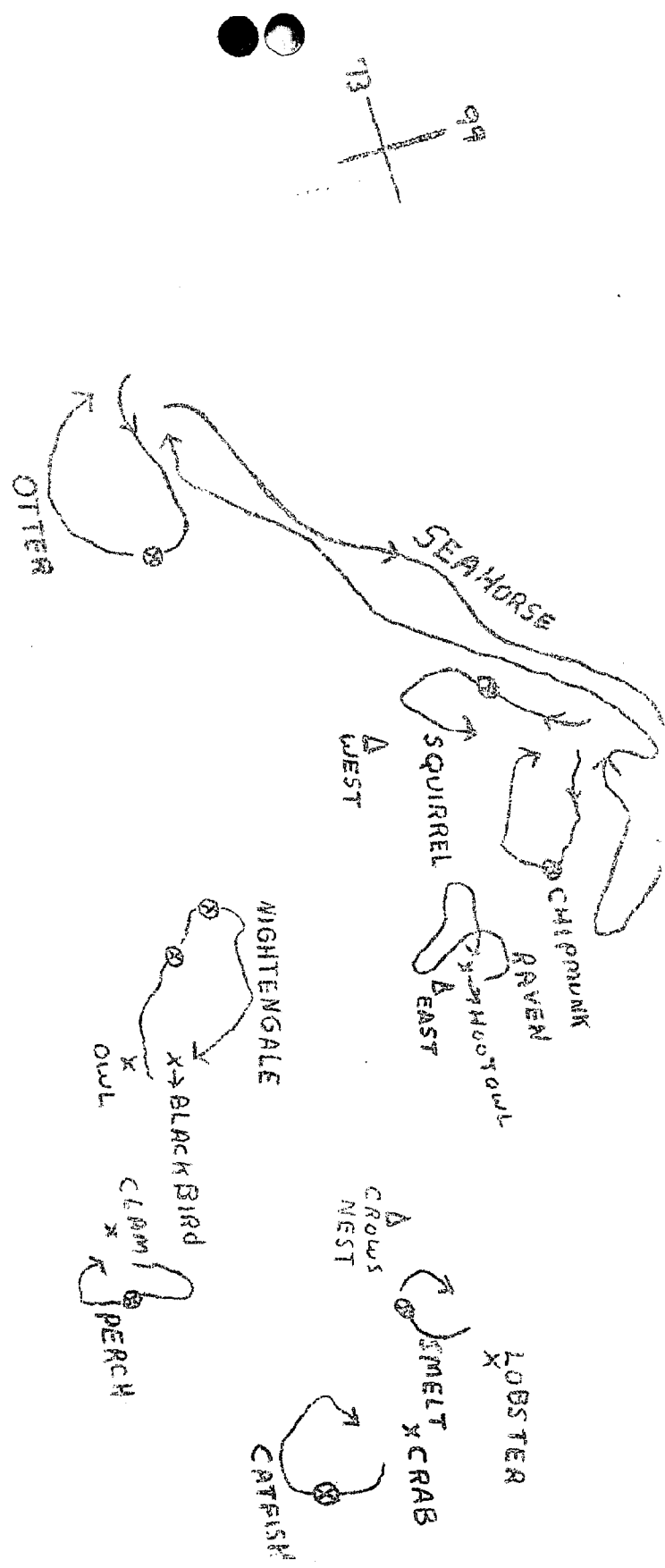
DAY PATROLS FOR PERIOD 180600H TO 190600H

Narrative Summary

1. Late Entries. None.

2. Contacts

a. At 180745H, vicinity BT 059699, Company M patrol observed four male VCS at a distance of 400 meters, vicinity BT 056705. VCS fled at sight of patrol. Patrol pursued VCS physically and by fire. VCS broke contact. Search of area revealed dead Vietnamese female, age thirty-six. Battalion S-2 notified of incident.

b. At 181200H, vicinity BT 966672, Company I patrol received small arms fire from west bank of Song Yen River, vicinity BT 964670, from estimated one VC. Patrol returned fire; enemy fire ceased. Patrol continued on assigned mission and was unable to conduct search of area because of river barrier.

c. At 181220H, vicinity BT 967668, Company I patrol received small arms fire from estimated three VC, vicinity AT 965669, resulting in two USMC KIA (MEDEVAC). Patrol returned small arms fire and one round M-79. VC broke contact and patrol continued on assigned mission.

d. At 181255H, vicinity BT 088689, Company K patrol engaged approximately eight VC who were fleeing to the village of Tan An, vicinity BT 090691. During pursuit, patrol was engaged by additional VC resulting in one USMC KIA, four USMC WIA (one DOW and three sustained minor wounds). Patrol returned intense volume small arms fire and fifteen rounds M-79. Artillery fires called on VC with good coverage. Immediately after artillery fire lifted, Company K patrol conducted thorough search and sweep of village discovering one VC KIA and two M-14 magazines near body. Blood on trails indicated two VC WIA (probable).

3. Miscellaneous. From 080000H to 181200H, F4U aircraft broadcasted propaganda tapes vicinity grid squares 0367, 0467, 0567, 0667, 0767, 0768, and 0769. Theme of tapes was the futility of the VC breaking with the government and continuing a war that could lead only to separation from family and impending death.

VC successfully evaded patrol but lost note book, which listed various types of medical supplies and treatment, given to VC during the time period of 20 to 21 September. Notebook forwarded to Regimental S-2.

- a. VC or VCS. One VCS.
- b. MED/CAV. Fifteen men, twenty women, and forty children were treated.
- c. Pay War. District Pay War Team presented a series of lectures explaining the presence of the military forces, and their efforts and success in the past.
- d. Food Distribution. 100 pounds of rice, sixty pounds of ham, and forty gallons of soup used to prepare one meal.
- e. Results of Census. Census established at twenty men, fifty-five women, and 120 children.
- f. Significant Events. 210 pounds of C4 were utilized to destroy five caves and eight punji pits, one body trapped with a CHIC M grenade.
- g. Commander's Evaluation. No VC were killed or apprehended in this County Fair. The reason for this is believed to be due to a possible compromise of the operation made highly probable by the postponement of the operation on three previous occasions by the ARVN forces. Notwithstanding this, a measure of success was gained as evidenced by the discovery and destruction of the large, freshly dug cave complex. In addition, the presence of Vietnamese Forces and officials in a hamlet with many VC connections greatly enhanced the government's image and countered VC propaganda in this critical period preceding the National elections.

1. Late Entries. At 261945H, vicinity BT 077704, Company K platoon checked ID cards of three VCS. Two were in order but VCS claimed each other were VC. All were forwarded to Battalion S-2.

2. Contacts

a. At 271145H, vicinity BT 048694, Company L platoon received small arms fire from vicinity BT 053678 resulting in two USMC WIA, both MEDEVAC. Platoon returned small arms fire and searched area with negative results.

b. At 271200H, vicinity AF 960683, Company I patrol discovered grenade rigged as mine, destroyed in place.

c. At 271230H, vicinity AF 996698, Company L patrol searched house, found assorted items of medical supplies, material for rigging mines, and apprehended three VCS. Supplies and VCS forwarded to Regimental S-2.

d. At 271325H, vicinity AF 964674, Company I platoon received small arms fire from approximately six VC located at AF 964672. Platoon returned small arms and 81mm mortar fire; VC broke contact and fire ceased.

e. At 271400H, vicinity BT 068678, Company L patrol received small arms fire from six VC located at BT 068676 resulting in two USMC WIA, one of which was MEDEVAC. Patrol returned fire and continued sweep.

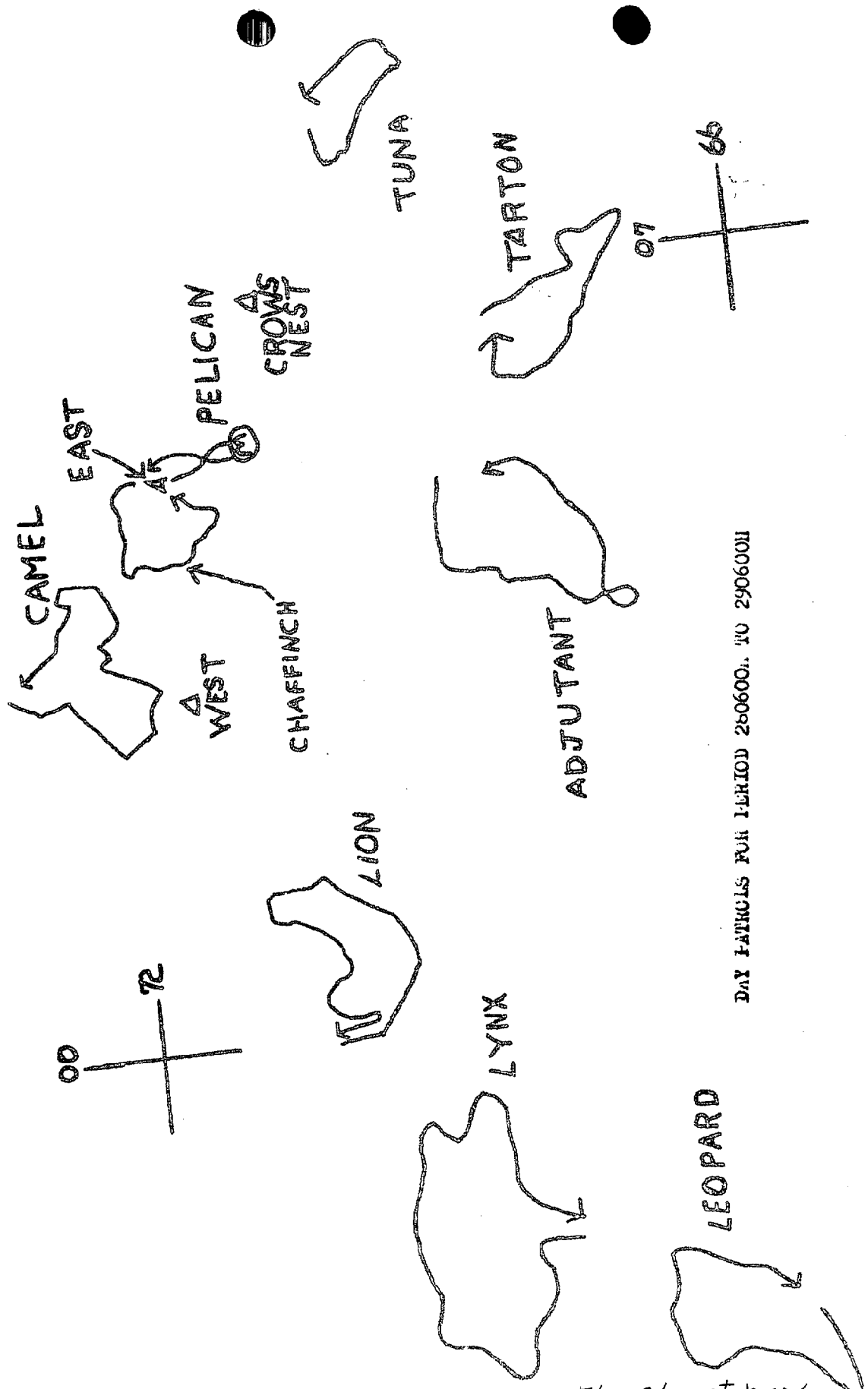

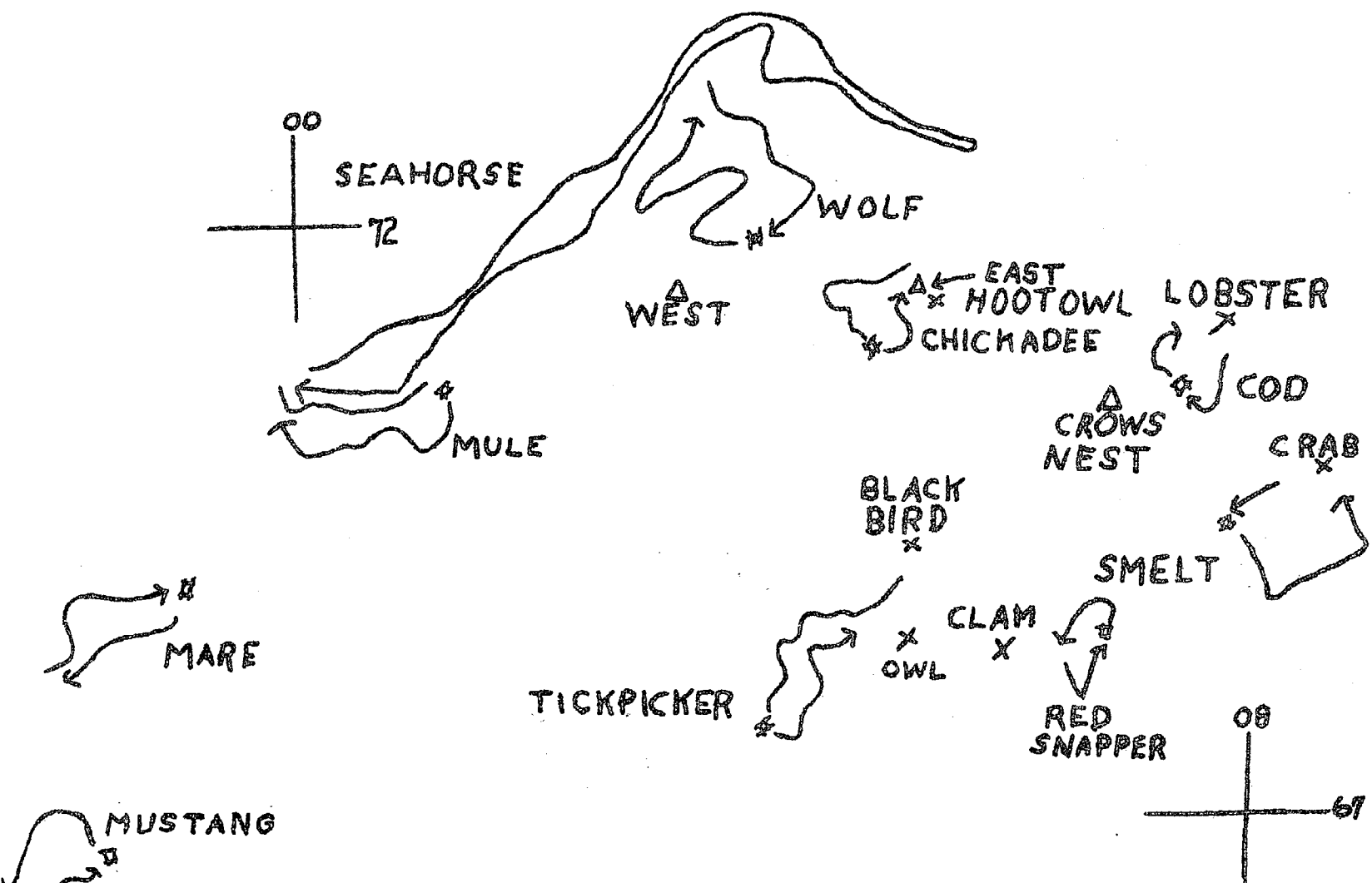

Narrative Summary

1. Late Evening. At 272345H, vicinity AT 972663, Company I patrol received small arms fire from estimated eight VC, vicinity AT 969666. Artillery FO immediately called in fire mission; VC broke contact, and one secondary explosion was observed. Area searched at first light with negative results.

2. Contacts

a. At 280935H, vicinity BT 846697, during search phase of County Fair Operation, killed three VC hiding in tunnel complex by RV/USMC forces. The three VC KIA had two CHIGOM grenades, three bandoleers of .30 caliber ammunition, assorted documents, medical supplies, and one M-1 rifle. The names and effects of the three VC KIA were subsequently forwarded to Hoa Vang District Headquarters.

b. At 281135H, vicinity BT 086691, Company E patrol received small arms fire, three rounds M-79 from estimated twelve VC, vicinity BT 087696. Patrol returned small arms fire, seven rounds 106mm recoilless rifle, and twelve rounds M-79. Enemy broke contact; patrol continued sweep.

3. Miscellaneous. Reference Regimental Journal entry number three, 26 September 1966. Popular Forces leader in Nui Kim Son reported that the three VC engaged in the grenade attack in Company K Command Post were killed by Marine fire.

4. County Fair 1-20 (terminated 281400H).

a. VC or VCS. Three VC KIA.

b. MBD/CAF. Ten men, fifty-one women, and forty-one children were treated.

c. Pay War. District officials presented series of Pay War lectures with theme that the VC terrorist campaign was futile and urged the inhabitants to support the RVN/USMC programs in the area.

d. Food Distribution. 200 pounds rice, four cases ham, and six cases condensed soup were used.

e. Results of Census. 185 inhabitants were registered.

f. Significant Events. Four tunnels were discovered and destroyed during this County Fair, including one which had an under water entrance approximately three feet by three feet by nine feet. Three VC were discovered in tunnel and killed. The tunnel, approximately three feet by three feet by nine feet was subsequently destroyed. Four grenades, 175 rounds .30 caliber ammunition, and M-1 rifle was captured.

g. Commander's Analysis. This County Fair must be termed a most successful one. The target hamlet has long been a source of VC activity with small arms fire and grenades rigged as mines encountered in practically every instance in which patrols have entered the area. The discovery of the hiding place and killing of three VC will undoubtedly have a severe psychological impact as well as irreplaceable personnel loss on the guerrilla units operating in the area. Intentions are to immediately exploit the psychological warfare aspects of the operations and urge local guerrillas in the adjacent hamlet to come over to the RVN side before a similar fate befalls them. Performance of Regional Forces troops was excellent.

Narrative Summary

1. Late Entries. None.

2. Contacts

a. At 301030H, vicinity BT 078683, Company L sweep force received small arms fire from vicinity BT 079682 resulting in two USMC KIA (MEDEVAC). Company L returned small arms fire, ten rounds M-79, and two rounds 3.5 WP. HU1E escort strafed VC positions. VC fire ceased; Company L swept through area without reestablishing contact.

b. At 301120H, vicinity BT 074685 and BT 077682, Company L discovered four punji pits, two of which were rigged as mines. One punji pit was rigged with a CHICOM grenade and the other was rigged with a dud M-79 round. Both punji pits destroyed by demolitions.

c. At 301250H, vicinity BT 075680, Company L platoon sweep force encountered small arms fire from estimated three VC, vicinity BT 078674. Platoon returned small arms fire, three rounds 3.5 HE, five rounds M-79, and twelve rounds 4.2 Howtar. VC broke contact; area searched with contact not reestablished.

d. At 301410H, vicinity BT 080674, Company L patrol received 260 rounds small arms fire, vicinity coordinates BT 084673 and BT 084670. Forty rounds 4.2 Howtar fired on coordinates with good coverage. VC fire ceased; no further contact established.

e. At 301510H, vicinity BT 983694, Company I squad patrol received approximately 100 rounds small arms fire from coordinates BT 983697. Patrol returned small arms fire and called for artillery support. Battalion zone fire delivered over large area centered on VC position. Patrol continuing to search area.

a. At 301130H, vicinity BT 086691, Company K patrol, discovered blood, shrapnel, one plastic M-79 holder, and one mine warning sign written in Vietnamese. Believed to be evidence of VC detonating a mine he was attempting to emplace.

b. At 301315H, vicinity AT 992684, bridge security element apprehended two male VCS. The VCS had in their possession two practice grenades, one M-26 grenade, I.D. cards and assorted papers. VCS and material forwarded to Regimental S-2.

c. At 301400H, vicinity BT 055705, Company M patrol discovered two caves with dimensions approximately four feet by three feet by fifteen feet. The entrance to one of the caves was a fighting hole. Both caves destroyed; one male living in the immediate vicinity and whose name appears on the black list, was forwarded to ITT as VCS.
