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PART II
INTELLIGENCEA. ENEMY

During this reporting period 1 - 30 November 1968, there have been 17 contacts with units from 4 to 15 enemy. Contacts have resulted in (11 KIA's, 5 POW's, capturing of 7 AK-47 rifles, 23 ChiCom grenades, and two chemical delay blasting caps).

There have been two attempted acts of sabotage, one on 24 Nov 68 at the CAU DO BRIDGE (AT 998706) and one on 28 Nov 68 at the HA DONG BRIDGE (AT 991642): Both attempts were made by floating a demolition charge down river. These devices were discovered prior to reaching the bridge and were destroyed with grenades.

Captured documents revealed that elements of the 402nd Main Force Sapper Battalion are operating within the TACR. Movement of these elements have been from South West to North East.

B. WEATHER

The average high was 85 degrees and the average low was 70 degrees. During the month of November 68 there have been scattered showers.

C. TERRAIN

Rice fields and low lands are flooded and foot movement is from fair to poor. The winter rice crop is in the process of being planted and movement is restricted to paddy dikes in most areas.

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PART III

OPERATIONSA. ORGANIZATION AND DISPOSITION OF FORCES

During the month of November the Battalion continued its primary mission of providing defense for the DaNang TACR through extensive patrolling activity. During the 30 day period from 1 November to 1 December, 714 small unit combat patrols were run, 454 of which were at night, involving one or more ambushes in each activity.

Lima Company continued its defense of Cau Do Bridge (AT 998705) and Ha Dong Bridge (AT 990642) with one platoon at each position. The company's remaining platoon operated from a patrol base at (AT 971688).

Company M continued to patrol from 3 platoon patrol bases located at (AT 971688), (BT 035724), and (BT 013705).

Company I continued to serve as quick reaction force for the Battalion until 19 November, at which time it went OpCon to 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

Kilo Company remained OpCon to DaNang Special Sector as the Mobile Defense force for the entire month.

Numerous company size search and destroy operations were conducted in the Cam Ng, Yen Ng, in Trach, Ia Bong, and Le Son areas. Company (M) sweeps were also conducted in Ha Dong and the surrounding areas.

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PART II

TRAININGA. THE BATTALION CONDUCTED THE FOLLOWING TRAINING DURING THIS PERIOD

1. A formal Orientation/Indoctrination program was conducted for 23 personnel. Lectures were presented by the Battalion Commander, all Staff Sections, Supply Officer, Air Liaison Officer, Artillery Liaison Officer, Medical Officer, Chaplain, and Communications Officer. Special emphasis was placed on orders which govern the actions of the individual Marine, the Personal Response Program, the conditions in the AO under which Marines will serve, and the goals and missions of this Battalion. One full day of training was devoted to care and cleaning, safety features, familiarization firing, and zeroing of the M16A1 Rifle.
2. The 1st Engineer Battalion provided a 3-day land mine warfare and booby trap course for 43 personnel in the battalion.
3. Familiarization firing of the M-60 machine gun was conducted at the Hoa Cam Range for 56 personnel.
4. Familiarization firing of the 106 recoilless rifle was conducted at the Hoa Cam Range for 41 personnel.
5. Quotas were received and filled for formal training in Okinawa and in-country schools. This training includes the following.

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PART II

LOGISTICS

A. ENGINEER ASSISTANCE AND OTHER CONSTRUCTION

During this reporting period two Engineer Assistance requests were completed. Although the work request on strongbacking tents has not been initiated the battalion has been strongbacking tents, improving the messhall, BAS, and supply areas on a self help program.

B. SUPPLY

1. Class I, III, and IV supply support has been sufficient during November. Class II support still remains a problem area especially with Motor Transport spare parts.

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PART II

COMMUNICATIONS

A. PERSONNEL

As of 1 Dec 68 the Communication Platoon has 1 Officer and 74 enlisted on its rolls.

B. EQUIPMENT

1. As of 1 Dec 68 all T/E Communications equipment was on hand or on order.
2. The Battalion is now up to T/E on radio set AN/PRC-25.
3. 58 telephones sets TA-1/PT were placed on Priority requisition to augment the Battalion wire system and perimeter defenses.
4. The Message Center processed 31 outgoing messages and 878 incoming messages.

C. OPERATIONS / TRAINING

There were no major operations conducted during November.

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PART II

MEDICAL/DENTAL AFFAIRSA. PERSONNEL

1. On 30 November total strength was 2 Medical Officers, 1 Chaplain, and 56 Corpsmen. During this period 5 were transferred to other commands for duty. 2 Corpsmen were admitted to the hospital out of country. 5 Corpsmen were received for duty during this period. There was 1 WIA for the period.

B. PATIENT LOAD

1. For this period 730 patients were seen at BAS Sick Call for an average of 24 patients a day.

C. MEDCAP/DENTCAP

1. Medical aid was given to 840 Vietnamese civilians by the BAS.
2. 30 Dental patients were treated by the BAS during this period.

D. SANITATION

1. Sanitation has remained level since last month's report. There are many areas that are well within the command's capability to improve; eg., more fire barrels in troop areas, screening of all showers, proper care of latrines and urine barrels has shown some improvement since last month. There has been some improvements in correcting many of the repeated discrepancies on the weekly sanitation reports.

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Part II

Psychological Operations, Civil Affairs

A. Psychological Operations

Psychological activities for November included 30 requested regular leaflet air drops and 13 special leaflet air drops with accompanying tape broadcasts. An APT Team was requested for three separate dates. The Battalion Psyops Team fully exploited a VC incident where a mine detonated and killed 12 civilians and injured 18 others. Leaflets with pictures were printed and these were distributed throughout the area in addition to intensified broadcasting. In addition to exploiting the above mining incident, other incidents which injured 8 civilians and killed 2 others were exploited. During the month the Psyops have been stressed through normal channels and also through the various CAP Units. In the last portion of the month there was a significant increase in the amount of munitions turned in for rewards. Payment for rewards totalled 5,900\$VN for the month. Hand distribution of leaflets totalled 17,050 for the month and 12 "water proofed" posters were put up along the MSR and at road check points. The broadcasting done by the battalion totalled 8 hours for the month.

B. Civic Action Projects

Civic Action Projects for the month included continuation of a pig project. Lumber was given to Phong Le (2), Duong Son (2). The S-5 section also distributed physical education kits to the schools in the above mentioned village. Fifty-eight additional applications for General Walt Scholarships were processed and will be sent to Division G-5 in the month of December. Twenty-one Care agricultural Kits and twenty-one Care Resettler Kits were acquired for distribution throughout this AOR. Med Cap activities run by the Battalion S-5 and Aid Station personnel accounted for 1,007 Vietnamese civilians treated, forty-nine inoculations given, and sixty-six cases of dental care. While on Med Caps fifty Care Elementary School Kits, 145 bars of soap, 200 combs, 36 pens and 60 toothbrushes were distributed. Transportation of families to visit medevaced persons was arranged at numerous times during the month by the S-5. An Aid Station at Cau Do Bridge, run by Lima Company, treated fifty-two civilians during the month. Forty-three civilians were medevaced to BAS of which 26 were sent onward to USOM and FLC's children's Hospital.

C. Training

One Vietnamese girl is being trained as a nurse and is an assistant on all medcaps.

031430H. H&S Company squad combat patrol found 2 surprise firing devices (M-26) at AT 983672. Five 105mm HE rounds were also buried in tree line. Devices and 105 rounds were blown in place.

040900H. Truck from C Company, 1st Motor Transport Battalion carrying V.N. civilian workers to Hill 55 struck a mine at AT 987648, resulting in 11 civilians and 1 ARVN KIA and 17 civilian and 1 USMC WIA.

111104H. Lima Company vehicular patrol spotted 7.V.C. at AT 985668. Activity fired M-60 and called in 60mm mission with negative results.

111420H. Lima Company squad combat patrol found three M-14 mines at AT 985641. Mines were destroyed in place.

130515H. V.C. escaped from 1st Marines compound. Patrol dispatched with negative results.

141115H. Kit Carson Scout attached to India Company tripped surprise firing device (M-26) on company sweep, wounding himself and two Marines at AT 985693.

141620H. Lima Company squad enroute to ambush site took small arms fire from unknown size enemy force at AT 987634. Unit returned fire and searched area with negative results.

162200H. Lima Company squad ambush spotted 10 V.C. at AT 974634. Opened fire with small arms and searched area with negative results.

170045H. Lima Company squad ambush spotted 10 V.C. in tree line at AT 97463. Fired small arms and called in 60mm mission. Activity searched area and detained one 55 year old male.

170220H. Lima Company road security personnel took automatic weapons fire from grid AT 988650 resulting in 1 USMC KIA, and 1 WIA. Activity returned fire with small arms.

171000H. Lima Company squad combat patrol found surprise firing device (M-26) at AT 967648. Device was blown in place.

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171500H. Soldiers from 1st Battalion, 51st ARVN found body of dead V.C. buried at AT 977635. Grave was fresh. KIA believed to have been result of previous night's contact.

182000H. Marine from Lima Company squad enroute to ambush tripped surprise firing device (2/M-26's) at AT 969639 resulting in 3 USMC WIA's.

201700H. India Company passed OpCon to 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

202000H. Lima Company squad enroute to ambush site spotted approximately 40 V.C. at AT 980645. Called 105mm HE mission and searched area with negative results.

212100H. Lima Company squad ambush spotted 1 V.C. at AT 959639. They opened fire with small arms and M-26's, then searched area with negative results.

220840H. Squad ambush from CAC 6 received automatic fire from approximately 3 enemy at BT 005704 resulting in one Popular Force KIA, one USMC WIA, and one Popular Force WIA.

220215H. Lima Company fire team ambush received automatic weapons fire from approximately 8 enemy at AT 985645. Activity returned fire with small arms, M-60 and called UH1E gunships resulting in 3 enemy KIA (bodies recovered), 1 AK-47 captured, and 1 USMC WIA.

221030H. Vietnamese national showed Lima Company squad combat patrol the location of one chi-com grenade rigged as surprise firing device. Vietnamese national rewarded with 1000 piasters from V.I.P. fund.

230210H. Lima Company fire team ambush spotted 1 V.C. at AT 990649; opened fire with small arms resulting in 1 V.C. KIA (body recovered) and 1 AK-47 captured.

231320H. Lima Company squad combat patrol found one M-14 mine rigged as surprise firing devices at AT 980648. Mine was destroyed in place.

240210H. Lima Company bridge security personnel at AT 999706 threw grenades at object floating in river, resulting in large secondary explosion.

250135H. Lima Company fire team ambush took small arms fire from estimated 1 enemy at AT 984649. Activity returned fire and searched area with negative results.

261930H. Lima Company squad enroute to ambush site took automatic and semi-automatic weapons fire from unknown size enemy force at AT 968638 resulting in 1 USMC WIA.
