INTELLIGENCEA. ENEMY

During the first twelve days of this reporting period there was a slight decrease in enemy activity. However, the enemy continued to harass small outposts and outlying units with small arms fire and snipers, coupled with an increase in the use of SFD's and mines.

Based on the interrogation of a Chieu Hoi from the 2nd Bn, 36th NVA Regt captured on 3 Mar 69 in the THANH HANH area, the decrease in enemy activity resulted from the enemy's exfiltration, which was a direct result of the enemy's failure to accomplish his missions in the CAU DO and CAM LE areas during the First Phase of the current offensive which started on 22 Feb 69.

On 12 Mar 69 the Battalion was relieved of responsibilities of its TAOR and assumed the duties as the Mobile Reaction Battalion for the 1st MarDiv, moving its Headquarters to relieve 1st Bn, 1st Marines C.P. in vicinity of BT 045632. While conducting two major search and clear operations in the TU CAU and AN TRA areas the only significant events which occurred were those of sporadic small arms fire, night probings, and numerous discoveries of SFD's and mines.

Before the Battalion assumed duties as the Mobile Reaction Battalion, 23 VC/NVA were KIA, 15 of these KIA's by a joint operation involving "M" Company, S-2 Scouts, and the 59th R.F. Battalion in the 3/1 TAOR. After becoming the Mobile Reaction Battalion, the Battalion accounted for 9 VC/NVA KIA making for a total of 32 VC/NVA KIA for the month of March 69. Contacts further resulted in the capture of 1 M-79 grenade launcher, 1 RPG-7, 1 SKS rifle, and 1 AK-47 rifle by the Battalion for the month of March 69.

Detainees have resulted in 1 Chieu Hoi, 7 innocent civilians, and 5 unclassified persons for the month.

12 SFD's were found and 11 detonated, the majority of these being either M-26/ChiCom type or 81mm/82mm type, with the exception of 2 "Daisy Chains"; the first being an M-26/81mm/60mm, and the second consisting of two 82mm mortar rounds with trip wire.

B. WEATHER

The average high has been 86° with an average low of 72°. Precipitation has been negligible.

G. TERRAIN

As the Battalion is mobile, terrain of course varies as the area of operations changes. The area immediately surrounding the Battalion C.P. is generally a coastal plain, having rice fields and sandy areas broken by tree lines. As warm weather and negligible rainfall continues, the area will be more accessible on foot and by tracked vehicles.

OPERATIONSA. ORGANIZATION AND DISPOSITION OF FORCES

During the first 12 days of March, the Battalion continued its primary mission of providing defense for the Da Nang TAOR through extensive patrolling activity. During the 12 days period from 1 March to 12 March, 325 small unit combat patrols were run 182 of which were at night, involving one or more ambushes in each activity. On 12 March the Battalion was re-located to Phong Luc (2) (BT013630) and carried out its assigned mission as Mobile Battalion for the Regiment throughout the remainder of the month.

India Company operated out of the Battalion C.P. as the Battalion reaction Company from 1-5 March. On 5 March India was assumed OPCON by 2/1 for operations in the Man Quan area (BT035688). On 8 March India was passed OPCON from 2/1 to 3/1 and returned to the Battalion C.P. as reaction company until 12 March. On 12 March, India Company moved with the Battalion to Phong Luc (2). From 19 March to 21 March India Company was OPCON to 1/1. On 21 March India was passed OPCON from 1/1 to 3/1.

Kilo Company operated from three PPB's located at Cau Do Bridge (AT999708), Cam Nam (BT013705), and Christmas Island (BT035722) until 4 March. On 4 March the platoon at Christmas Island moved to Cau Do Bridge after being relieved by a platoon from Mike Company. Kilo Company remained in these positions until 12 March when they moved with the Battalion to Phong Luc (2). Throughout the remainder of the month Kilo Company participated with the rest of the Battalion in mobile operations.

Lima Company operated with one platoon at (AT975642) and two platoons at Ha Dong Bridge (AT990642) until 12 March when the Company moved with the Battalion to Phong Luc (2). On 17 March Lima Company was assumed OPCON by 1/1 for operations in the An Trach (1) and (2) area (AT962662). On 22 March, Lima Company was passed OPCON to 3/1. Throughout the remainder of the month Lima Company participated with the rest of the Battalion in mobile operations.

Mike Company operated with one platoon at Steel Bridge (AT999699), one platoon at Cam Le Bridge (BT025715) and one platoon in the Battalion C.P. from 1-4 March. On 4 March Mike Company relieved the Kilo Company platoon at Christmas Island (BT035722) and occupied a new PPB at (BT023713). On 12 March, Mike Company moved with the Battalion to Phong Luc (2). Mike Company was assumed OPCON by 2/1 for an operation on 18 March, in the vicinity of Ngan Cau (1), and passed OPCON back to 3/1 on the same date. On 29 March, Mike Company was assumed OPCON by 2/26 for operations in the vicinity of Hill 10 (AT925690) and to facilitate movements of troops for Operation Oklahoma Hills.

On 3 March Delta Company 1/1 was assumed OPCON by 3/1 for operation in the Tan Hanh area (AT995655) and passed OPCON back to 1/1 on the same date.

On 25 March, 3/1 conducted one of the largest night helo lifts ever held in the 1st Marine Division in the An Tra (1) and (2) area (BT085695). On 24 March the Battalion was given 2 hour notice to dispatch 2 companies and the Battalion C.P. to Marble Mountain Air Facility in staging prior to the early morning heli lift. At 0400H, with India Company moving overland, Kilo, Lima Companies and the Battalion C.P. were helilifted from Marble Mountain into the target area along the coast. The cordon and search operation continued for three days and resulted in the uncovering of numerous tunnels, bunkers and the finding of many surprise firing devices.

During the month, cordon and search operations of Battalion size were conducted in Tan Hanh (AT995655), Tu Cau (3) (BT048658), Cam Sa (1) (BT083646), An Tra (1) and (2) (BT085695), Tra Lo (BT089682), Ap Da Phuoc (AT947787), and Thon Trung Nghia (AT986775).

The Battalion (-) assumed a 2 hour alert for Operation OKLAHOMA HILLS as the Reaction/Exploitation Force at 1100H on 31 March.

B. AIR SUPPORT/DEFENSE

1. Fixed Wing

During the month of March 3/1 was supported by VNO 2 and MAG 12. Observation aircraft were used 9 times for a total of 18 hours on station, expending approximately 10 2.75 inch rockets.

3/1 TACP ran 4 flights of A1A dropping 10,000# of bombs and 2,000# of napalm. They also used 5 inch Zuni rockets and 20mm gun pods. They were responsible for 4 secondary explosions and 3 secondary fires.

2. Rotary Wing

This month 3/1 was supported by HMM 364, HMM 263, VC 2, and HML 167 of MAG 16.

Aircraft completed 23 medevac missions consisting of 9 emergencies and 14 priority and routine medevacs. The average time per medevac was 26 minutes. CH-46 helicopters flew resupply sorties carrying a total of 6,600# and 67 troop transport sorties lifting approximately 1460 troops. HML 167 aircraft flew 7 visual reconnaissance missions.

c. Artillery

Direct support artillery was provided by "A", "B", and "C" Batteries, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. Reinforcing artillery support was provided by 4th Battalion, 11th Marines. Numerous missions were fired in support of troops in contact. After 12 March, the firing of H&I's and TOT's was limited due to the Mobile Battalion concept. Registrations of defensive fires were [REDACTED] A total of 165 H&I's and 76 TOT's were fired in support of 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines.

TRAININGA. THE BATTALION CONDUCTED THE FOLLOWING TRAINING DURING THIS PERIOD

1. A formal Orientation/Indoctrination Program was conducted for 131 personnel. Lectures were presented by the Battalion Commander, and all the staff sections including the supply section, Air Liaison Officer, Artillery Liaison Officer, Medical Section, and Communications Section. Special emphasis was placed on orders which govern the actions of the individual Marine, the personal response program, the conditions in the AO under which Marines will serve, and the goals and missions of this Battalion. One full day of training was devoted to safety features of all weapons and care and cleaning, familiarization firing, and zeroing of the M16A1 rifle. The Quick Kill method has been adopted by this Battalion to train new personnel during the indoctrination period.

2. Familiarization firing of the M16A1 rifle and .45 caliber pistol was conducted at the Battalion Rifle Range for 368 personnel of all five companies.

3. Familiarization firing of the M-60, M-79, and 50 caliber was conducted at the Battalion Rifle Range for 163 personnel of India, Kilo, Lima, and Mike Companies.

4. Quotas were received and filled for formal training in Okinawa and In-Country Schools. This training includes the following:

5. Company training and technical MOS training for H&S Company was conducted on a weekly schedule with all companies completing an average of 6 hours of training weekly.

6. Hoa Cam Range was utilized only one time during the month of March by the H&S Company 106 RR platoon.

7. Marksmanship training was conducted with 561 Marines participating. Training was conducted for the .45 caliber pistol, M-16 rifle, M-14 rifle, M-79 grenade launcher, M-60 machine gun, and 106 RR.

During this reporting period no engineer assistance requests were completed. This is due to the fact that this Battalion rotated positions with 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. The Battalion is in the process of improving the messhall, BAS, supply areas, and the cantonment in general.

1. Classes I, III, and IV supply have been sufficient during March. Class II support still remains a problem area especially with motor transport spare parts.

COMMUNICATIONS
A. PERSONNEL

As of 31 March 1969 the Communications Platoon had 1 officer and 76 enlisted on its rolls.

B. EQUIPMENT

52 telephone sets TA-1/PT placed on pri-2 requisition during October 1968 have not been received. Tracer action has been initiated.

C. OPERATIONAL/TRAINING

During March the Communications Platoon participated in the movement of the CP. The move was facilitated with no untoward incidents; normal communications were installed. Communications personnel participated in four (4) small operations of one (1) to four (4) days duration. During the latter part of the month the Communications Platoon prepared for the Division Quarterly Inspection.

MEDICAL/DENTAL AFFAIRSA. PERSONNEL

1. On 31 March, total strength was 2 Medical Officers and 56 Corpsmen. During this period 7 Corpsmen were transferred to other commands for duty. No Corpsmen were admitted to the hospital out of country. 11 Corpsmen were received for duty during this period. There were 2 WIA'S and no KIA'S for this period of time.

B. PATIENT LOAD

1. For this period 859 patients were seen at BAS Sick Call for an average of 27 patients per day.
2. There were: 21 patients diagnosed with V.D.; 2 patients diagnosed with NSU; 3 patients diagnosed with Heat Exhaustion; 15 patients diagnosed with Influenza; 15 patients diagnosed with Fractures; 194 patients diagnosed with Skin Infections; and, 14 patients diagnosed with Tonsillitis.

C. MEDCAP/DENTCAP

1. Medical aid was given to 675 Vietnamese civilians by the BAS.
2. 13 Dental patients were treated by BAS during this period.
3. BAS Corpsmen held a total of 34 MEDCAP/DENTCAP'S for the month of March.

D. SANITATION

1. Sanitation in the Battalion is good. Improvement has been noted since 3/1's arrival in this area. Two major discrepancies have been noted for this month:
(a) The enlisted mess hall needs a grease trap.
(b) The shower at the water point needs a drainage system.

Psychological Operations/Civil AffairsA. Psychological Operations

Psychological activities for 1 to 12 March included 12 requested leaflet air drops with accompanying tape broadcast. During this period, Psyops was stressed through Marine channels and also through ARVN, RF and PF units. Hand distribution of leaflets totalled 20,500 for this period. The broadcasting done by the Battalion HB Team totalled 5½ hours. The 7th Psyops Battalion supplied the capability to show movies to the civilians in the AOR on one occasion during this reporting period. The Battalion POET Team exploited one VC atrocity during the month by: photographing an assassination; face to face contact with the civilians living near the assassination site; psyops broadcasting; and, having leaflets related to the assassination printed and distributed.

On 12 March the S-5 section passed ADCON/OPCON under the 1st Marine Regiment.

b. Civic Action Projects

Civic Action projects for the reporting period included continuation of a pig project. The S-5 section also supplied materials and tools to various hamlets for the completion of a dispensary, rebuilding of a schoolhouse and a temple, and also for work on rebuilding homes that the VC destroyed or were destroyed by allied units pursuing VC. The above projects are being done in conjunction with the various CAP and RF units in the AOR. Engineer stakes, rolls of wire and sandbags were given to a hamlet chief for use in building a hamlet security compound. 20 pounds of soap, 15 pounds of clothes, and 10 pounds of candy were distributed to civilians throughout the AOR. In addition, a girls club in Tennessee sent 95 packages containing soap, clothing, shoes etc., which were also distributed. MedCaps were responsible for treating 420 civilians during the reporting period. Transportation for families to visit medevaced persons was arranged on numerous times during this period. During the period there was 1 serious incident which resulted in 4 solatium payments.

c. Training

Regional Force Companies are being used on MedCaps and are receiving additional medical training. One VN girl is being trained as a nurse and she will be responsible for the maintenance and functioning of a dispensary in Phong Le (2) (BT002702).
